DESCRIPTION

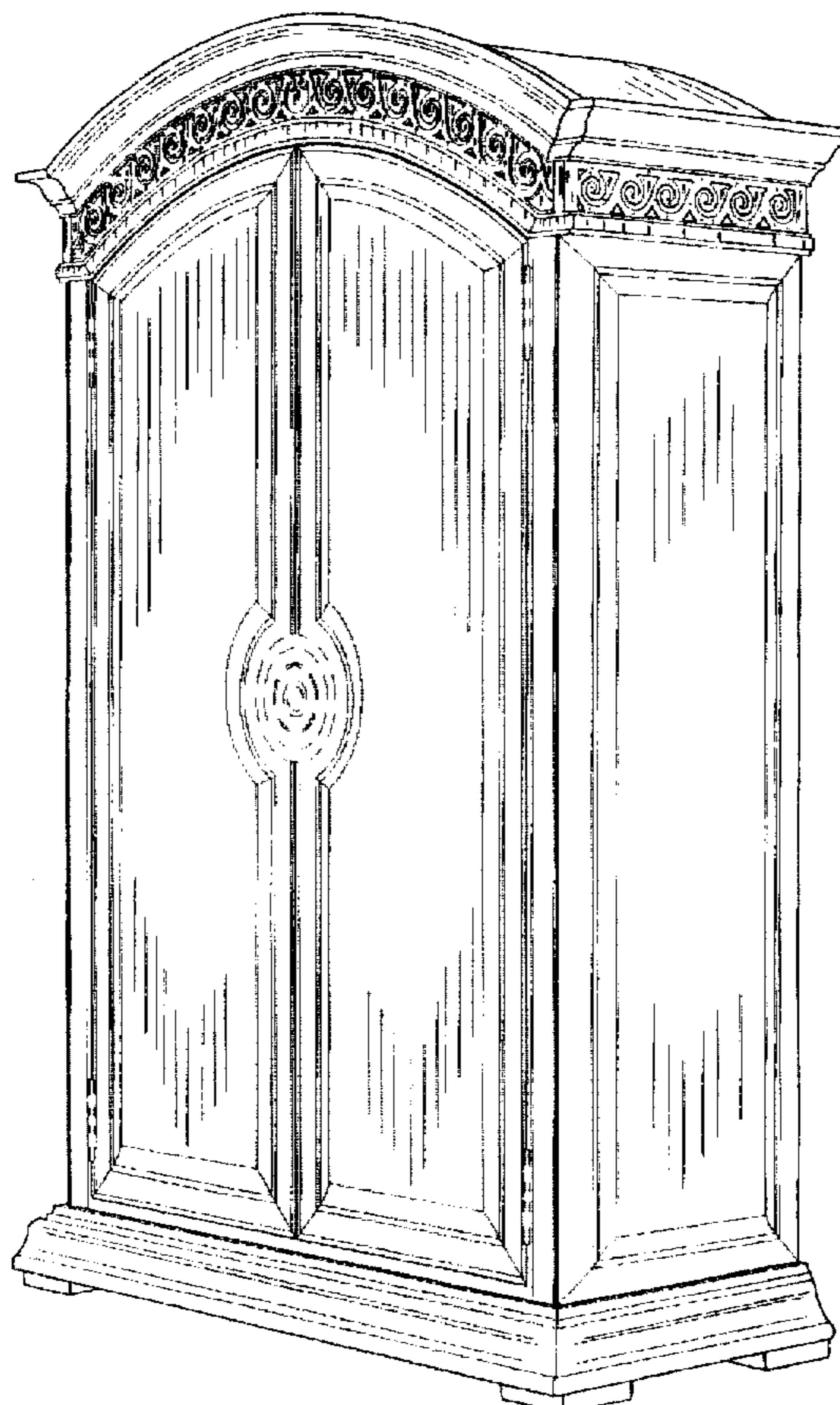
FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of an armoire showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side view, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown; and,

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

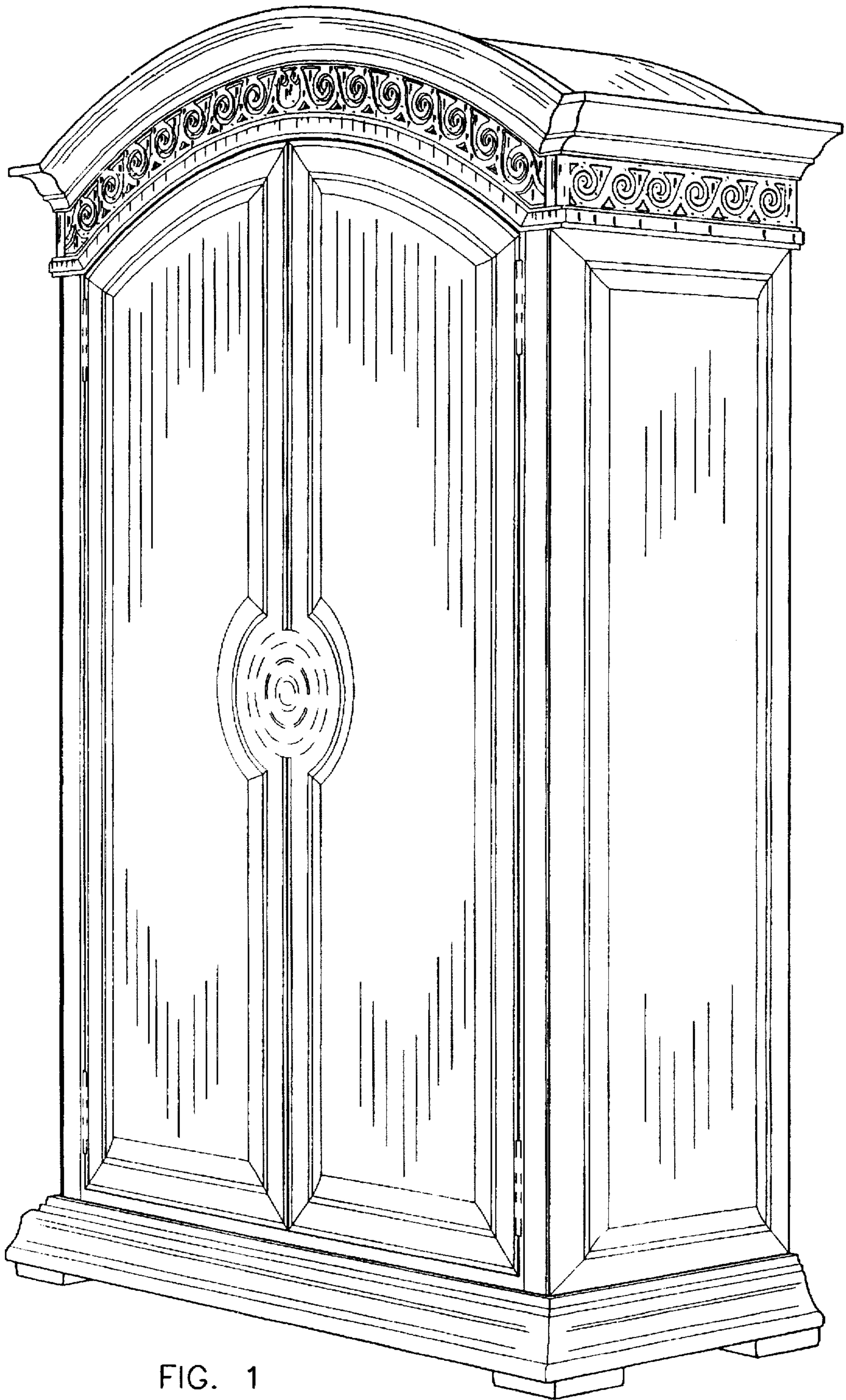

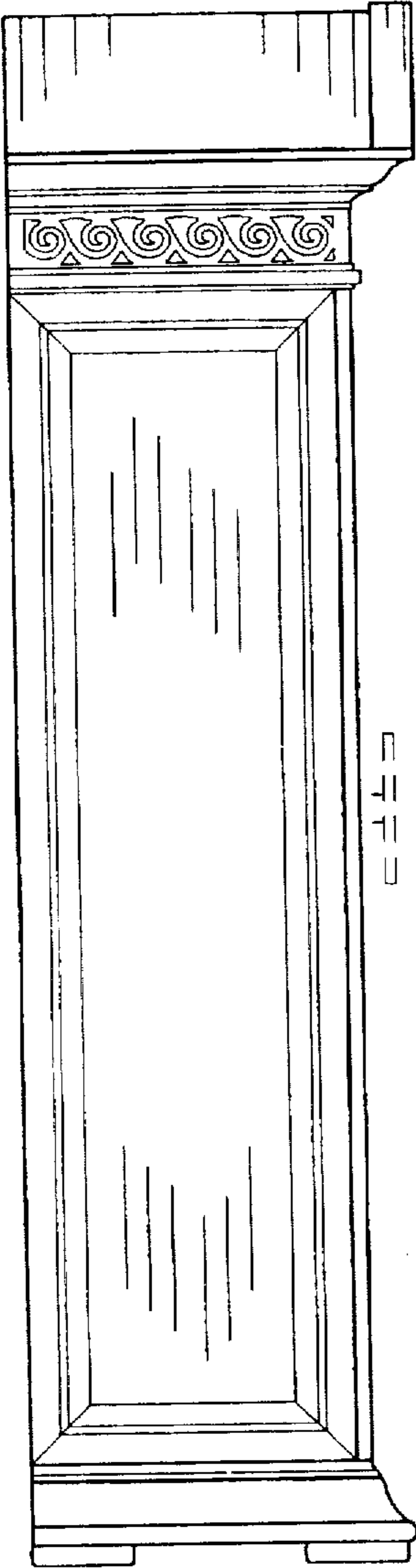

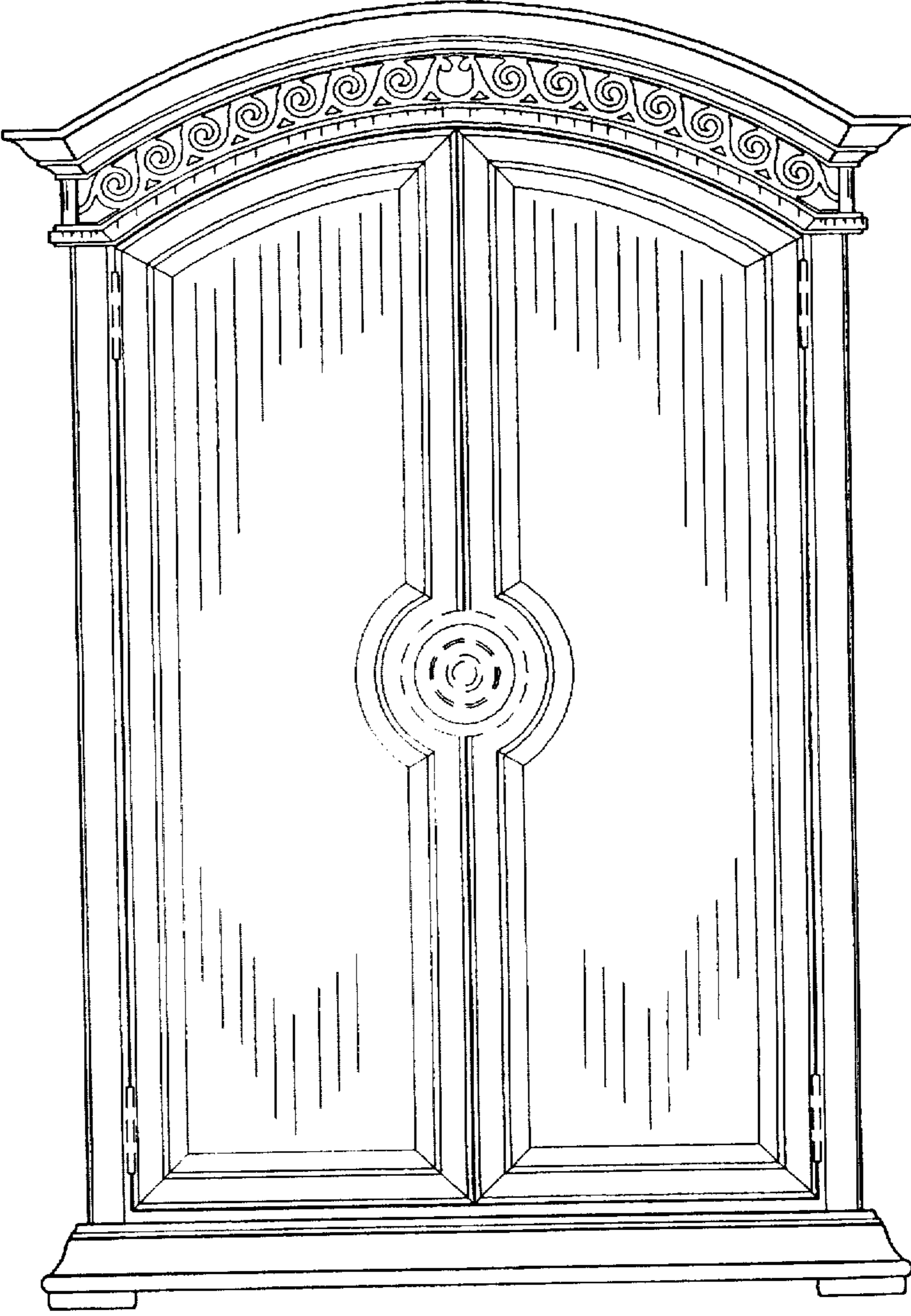
