The ornamental design for an alarm clock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an alarm clock showing generally the front side of our new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of an alarm clock showing generally the rear side of our new design;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

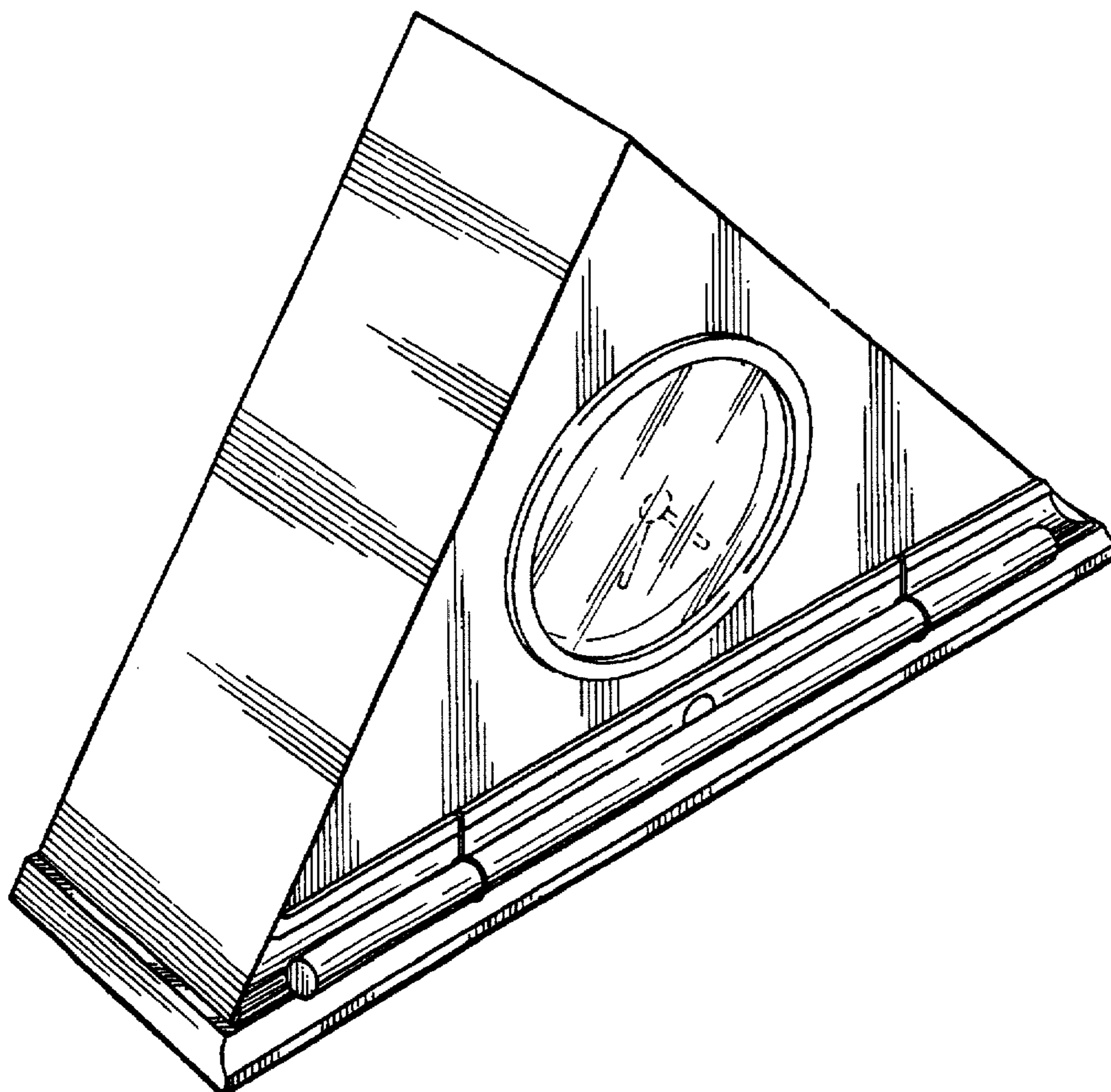
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

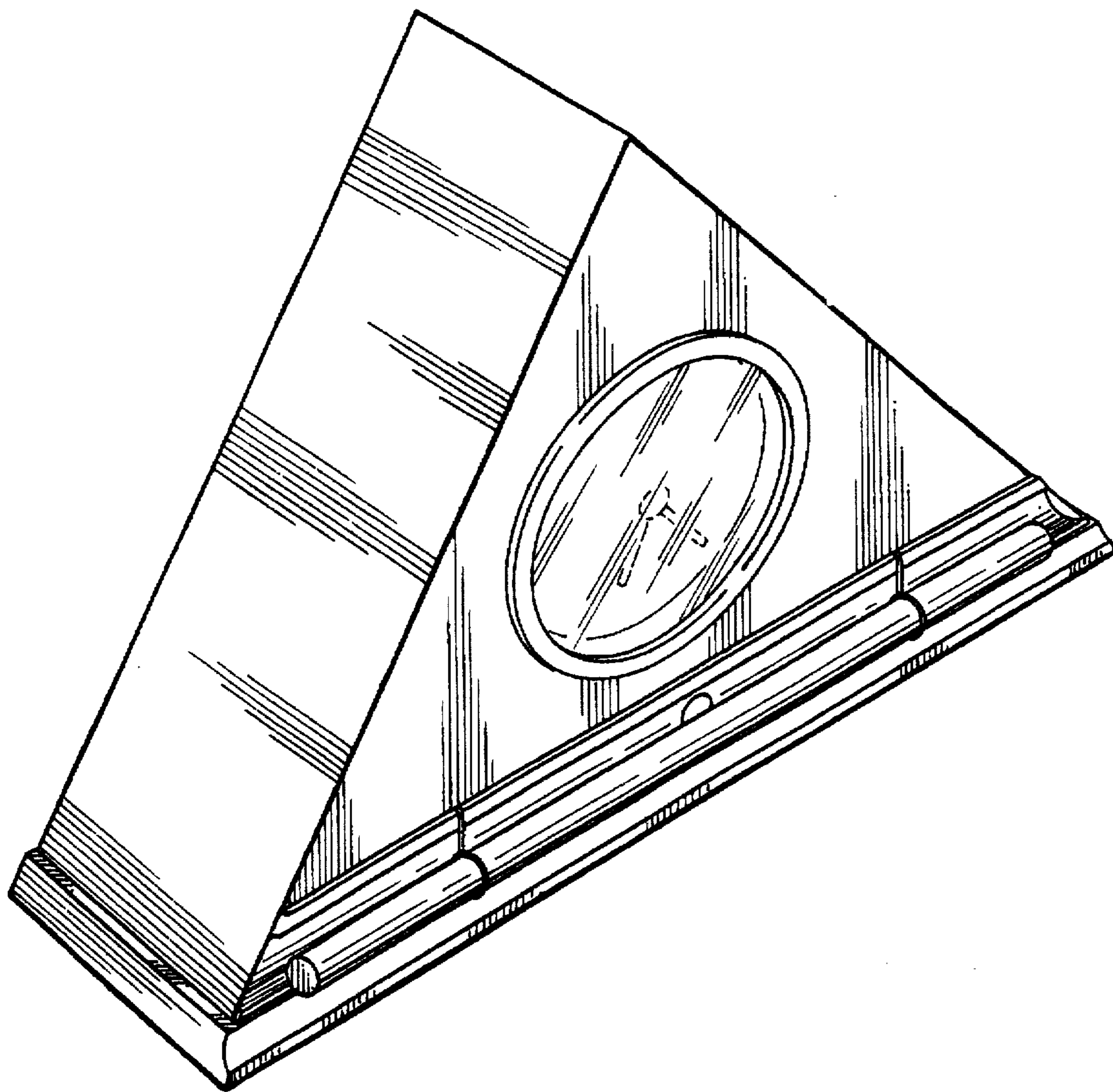

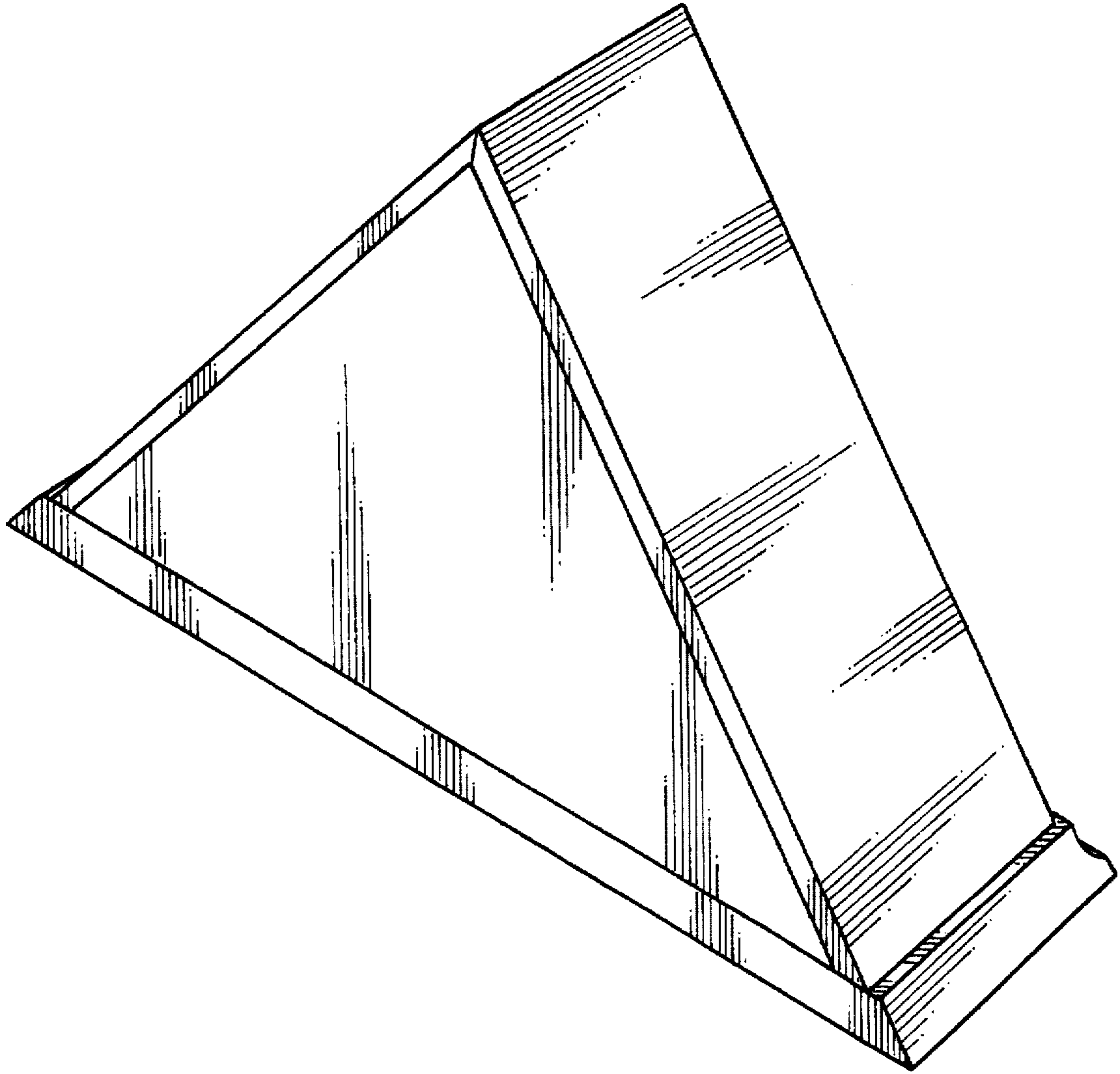

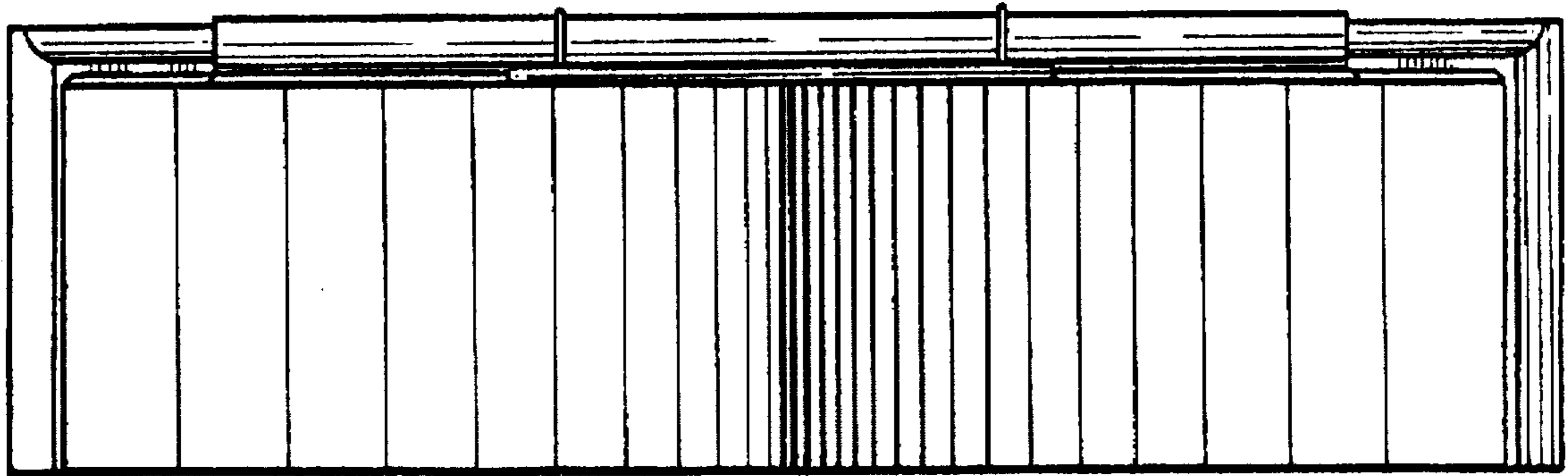

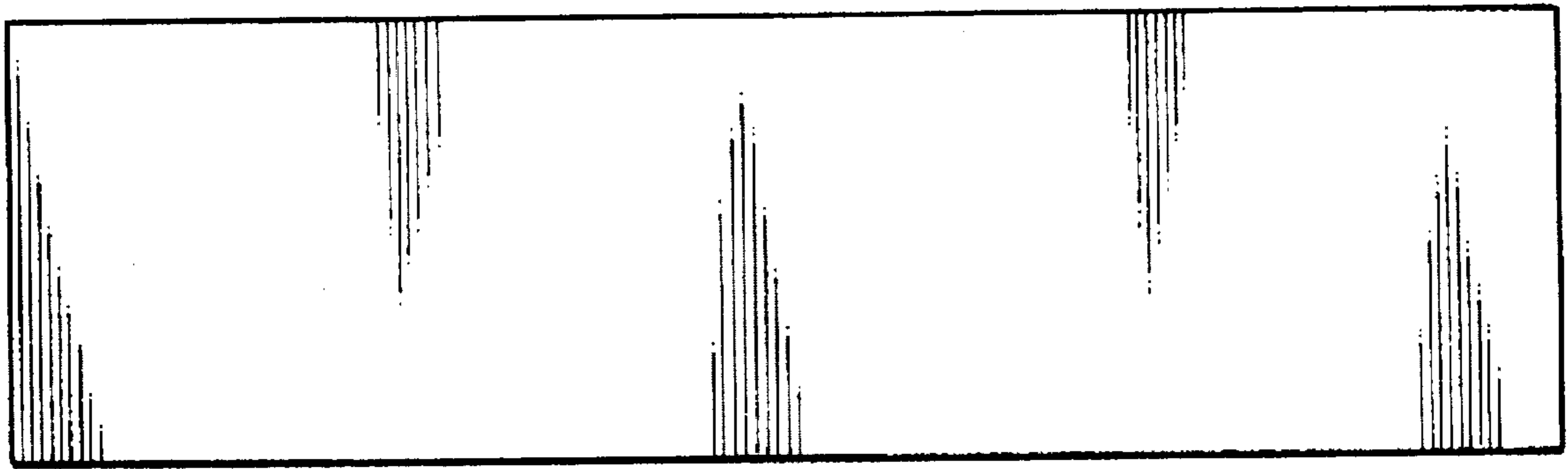

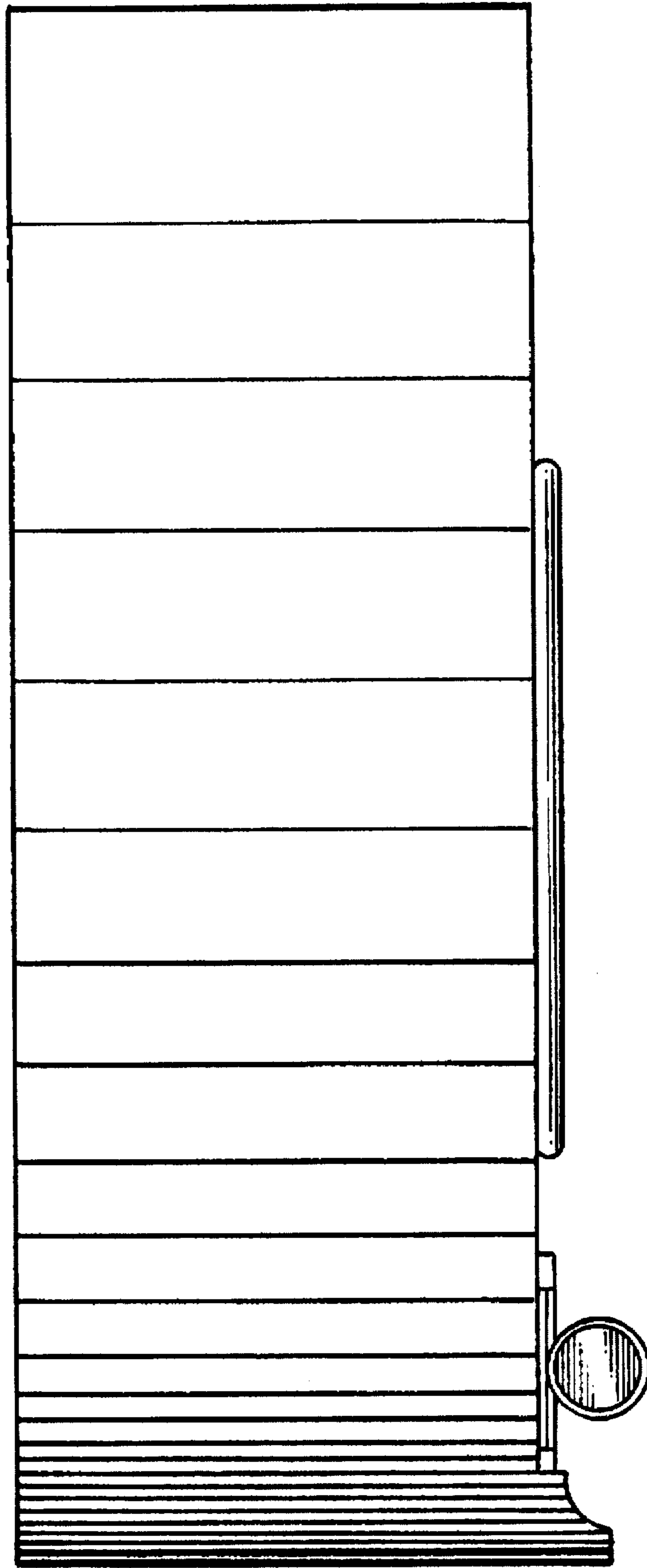

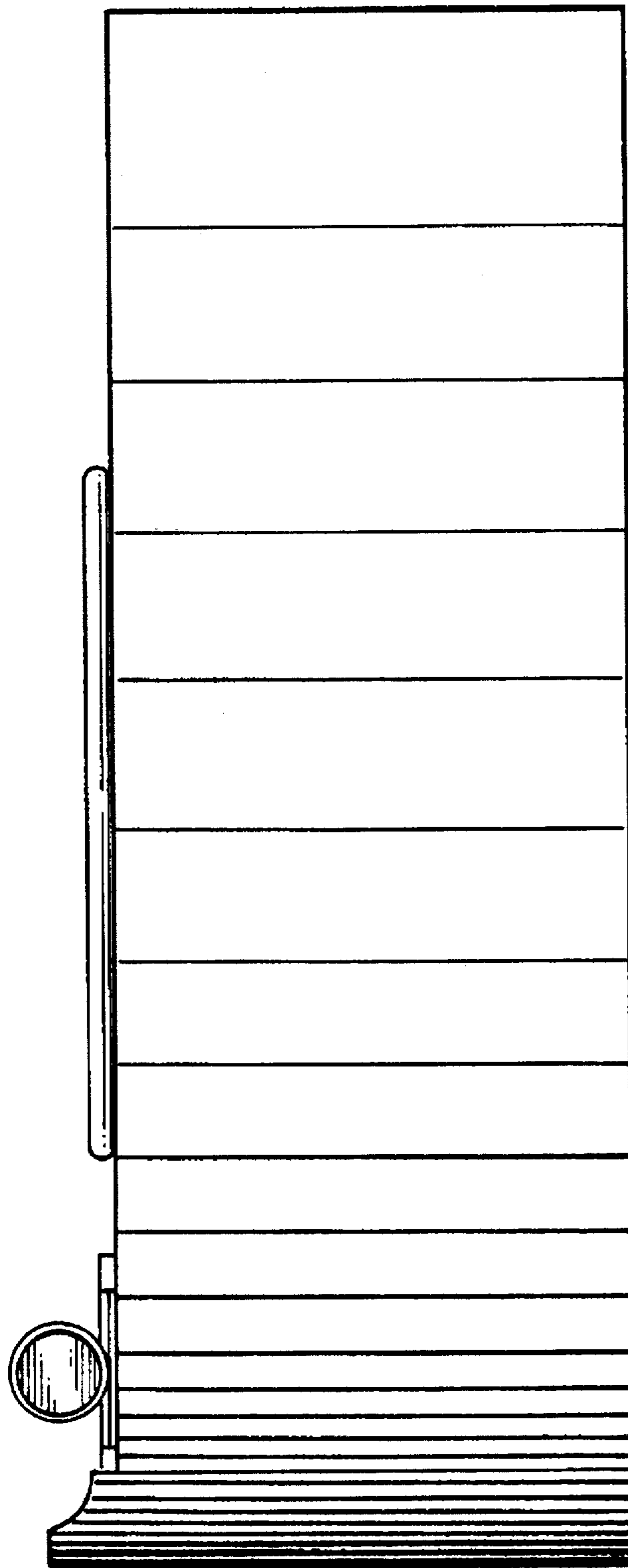

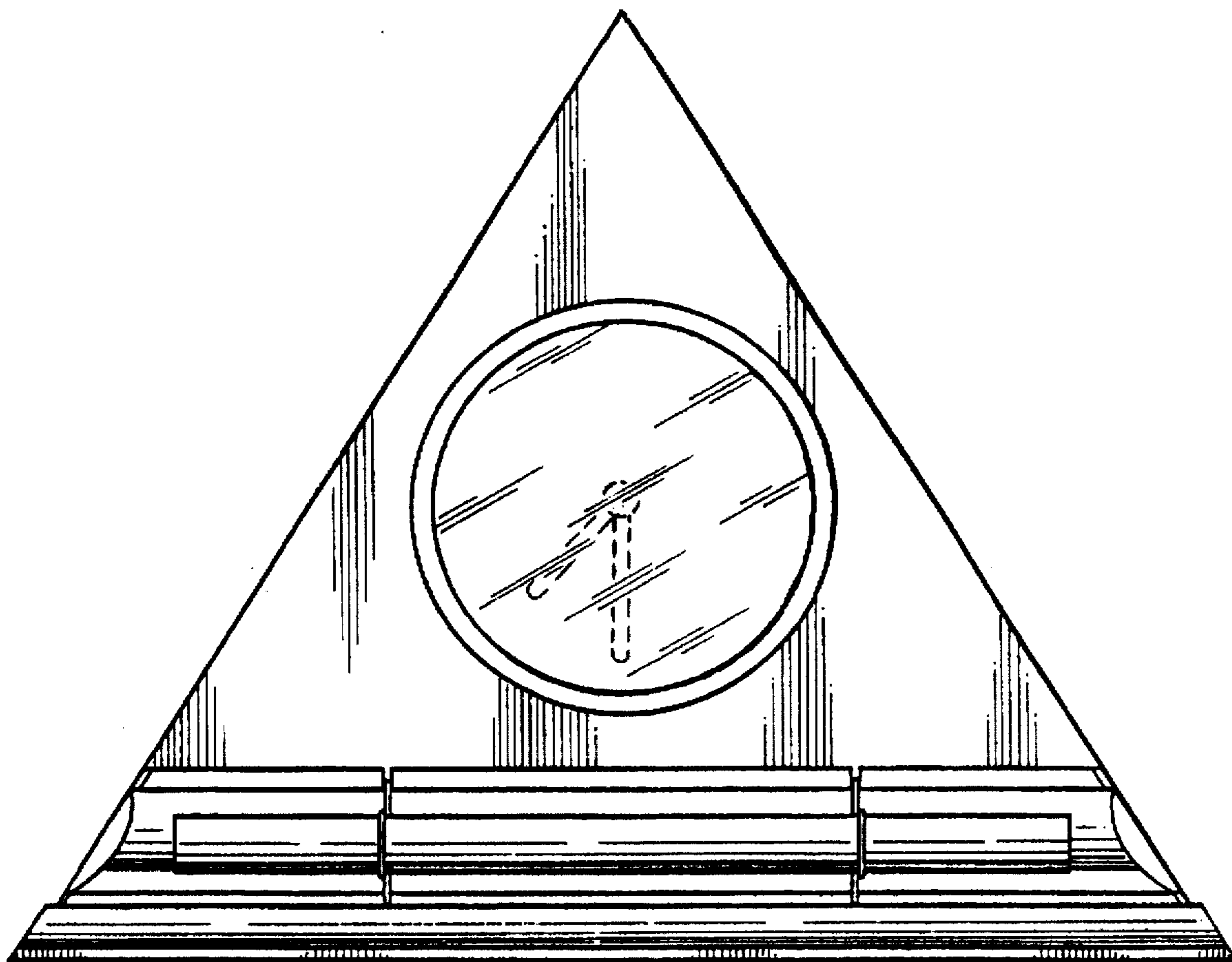

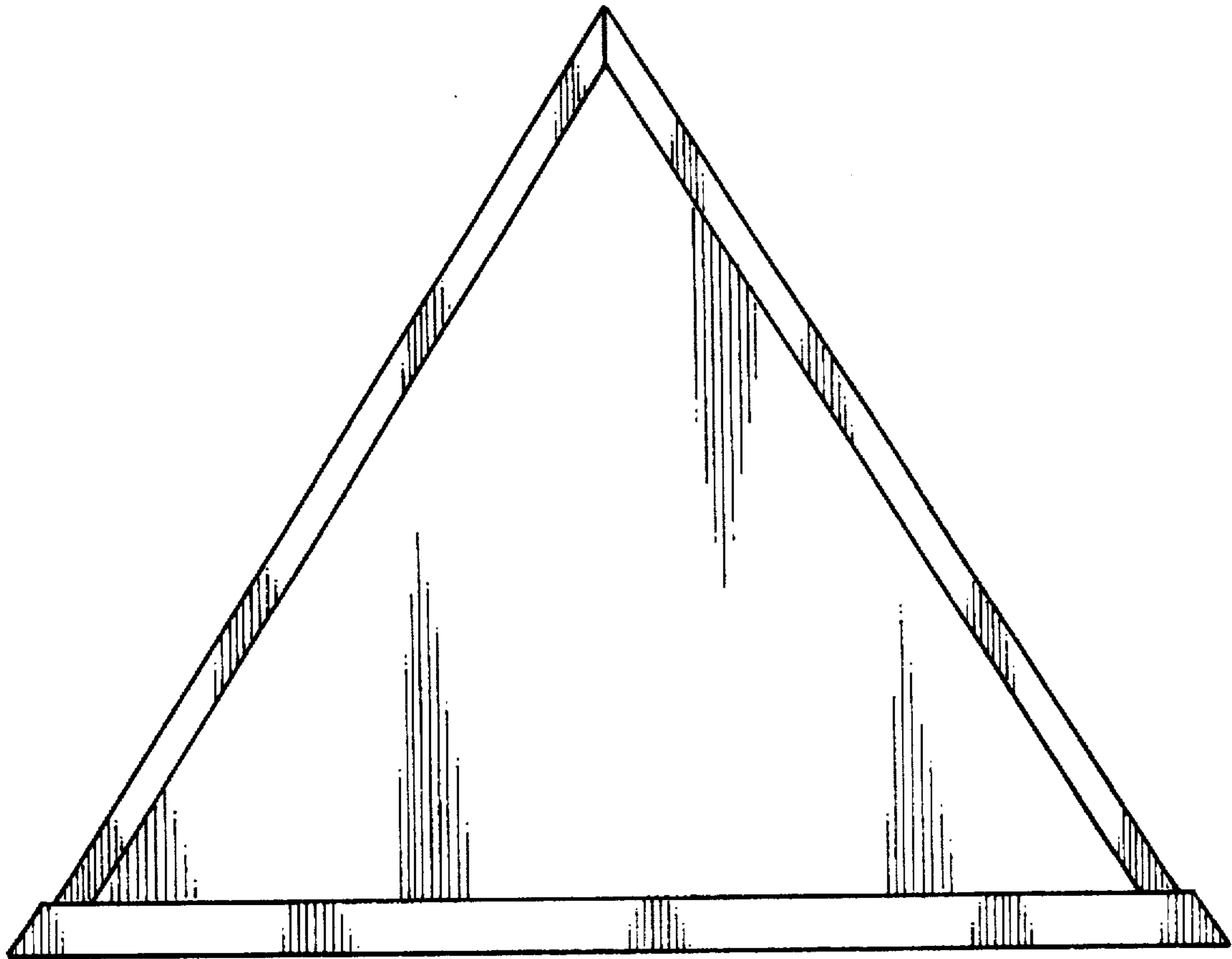
