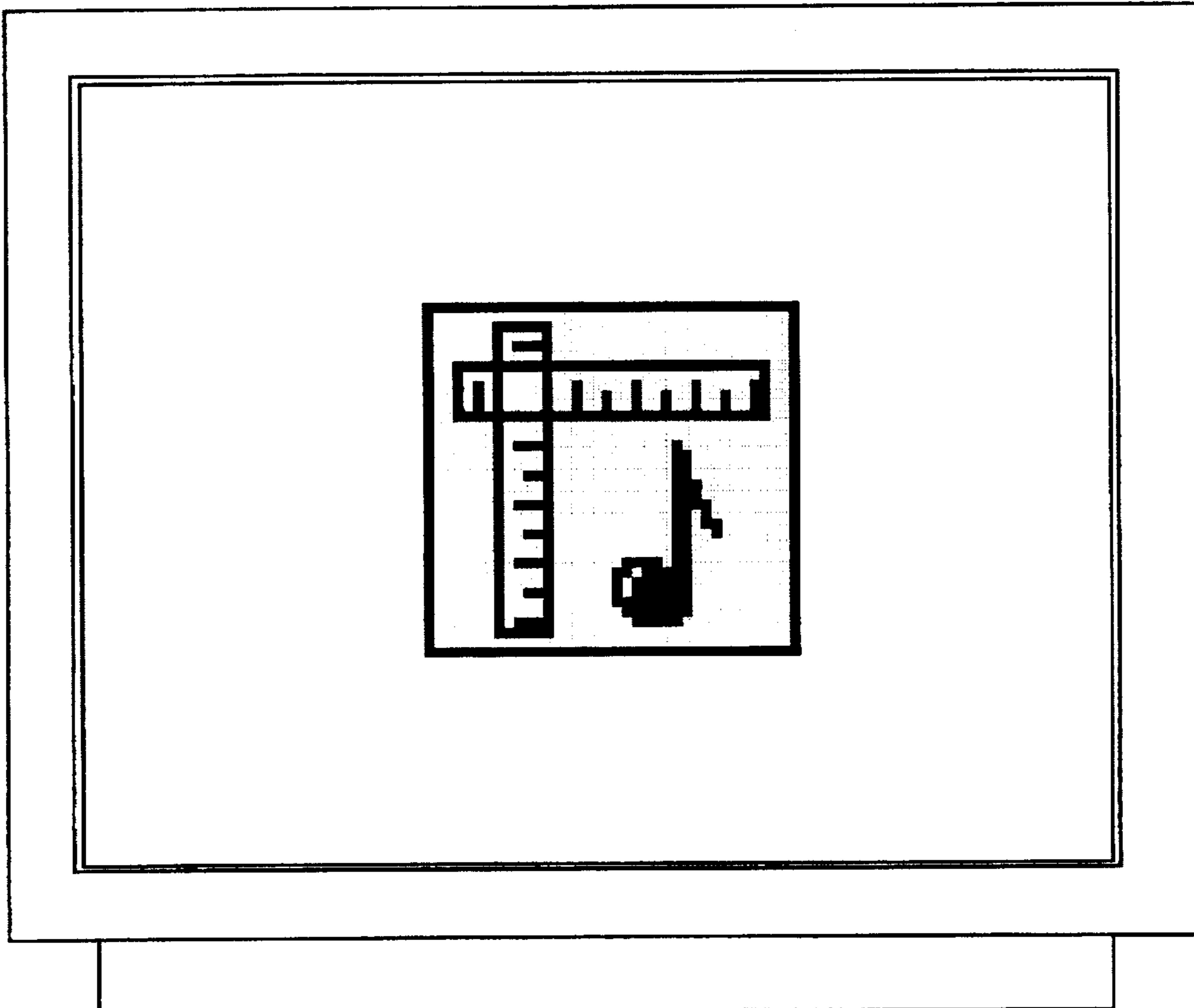
The ornamental design for a computer screen with icon, as shown and described.

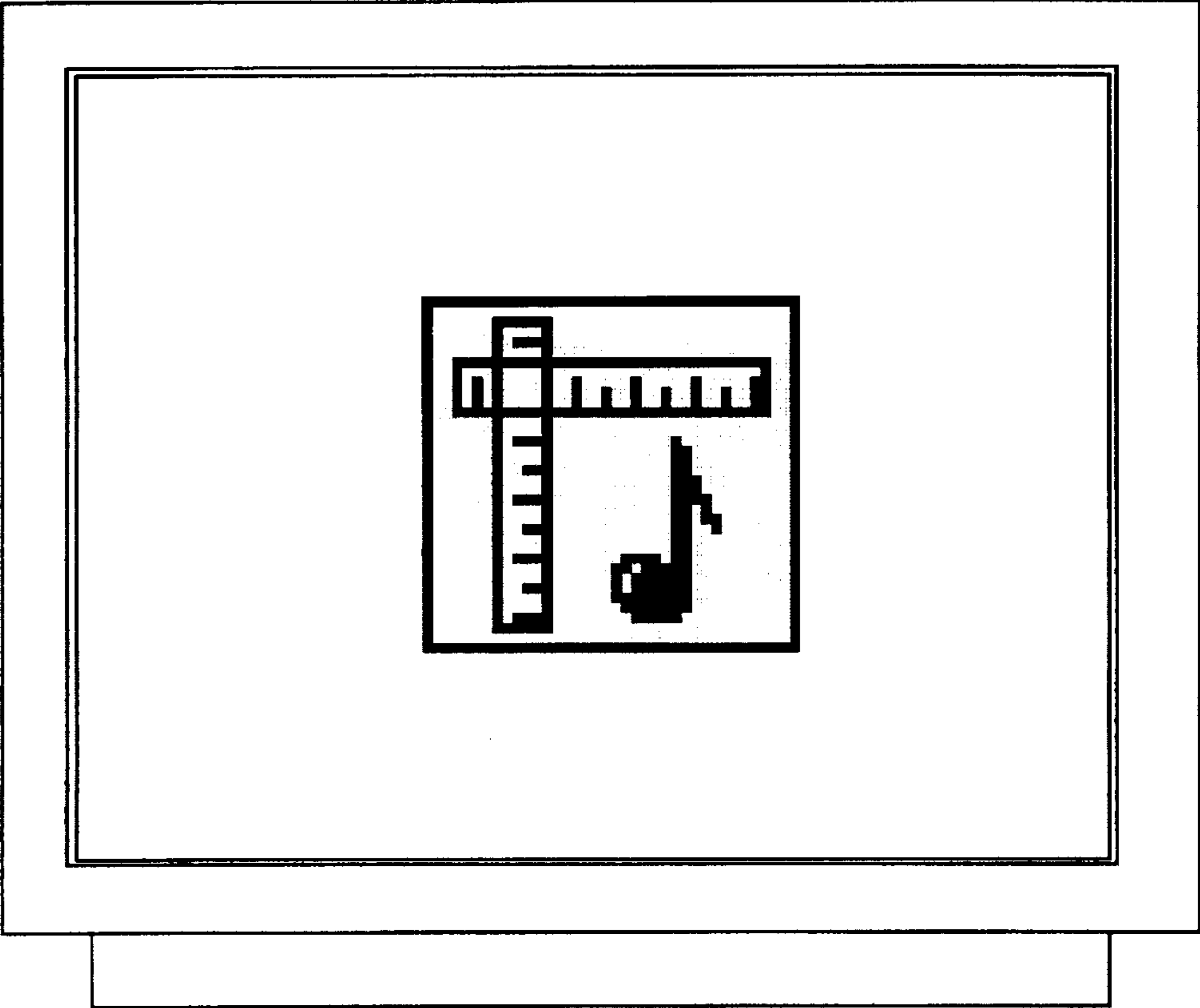

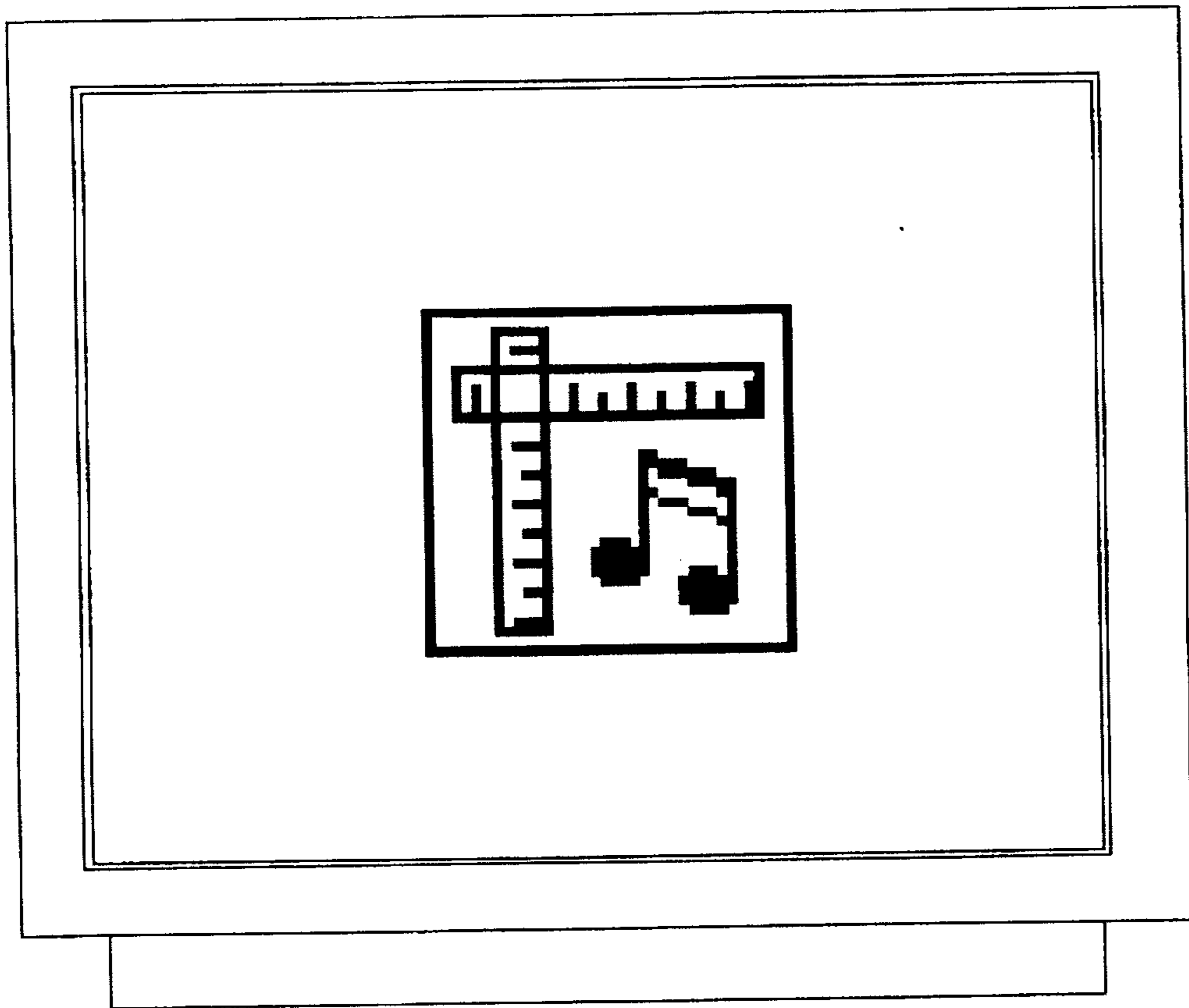
