FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a punch-blade holder

CLAIM

The ornamental design for punch-blade holder, as shown

FIG. 2 is an elevational front view of the punch-blade holder of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right-side view of the punch-blade holder of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the punch-blade holder of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left-side view of the punch-blade holder of FIG.

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the punch-blade holderof FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along 7—7 line in FIG. 4;


FIG. 8 is a reference view showing a state that the punchblade holder is used in a punch; and,

Rear view appears symmetrically with the elevational front view of FIG. 2.


The broken line showing of punches are for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

















