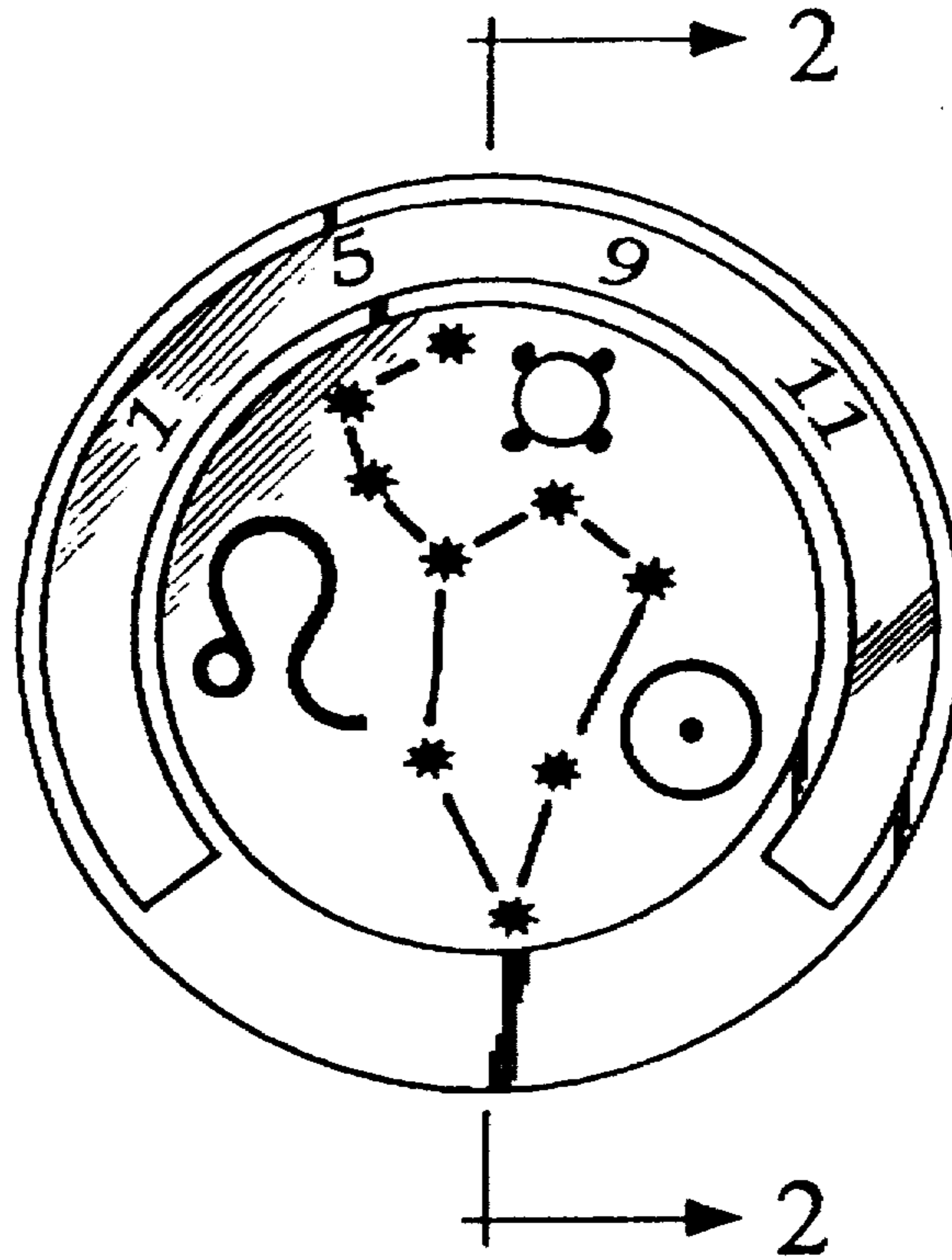
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a talisman, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of the talisman;  
FIG. 2 is a cross section taken along line 2—2 in FIG. 1;

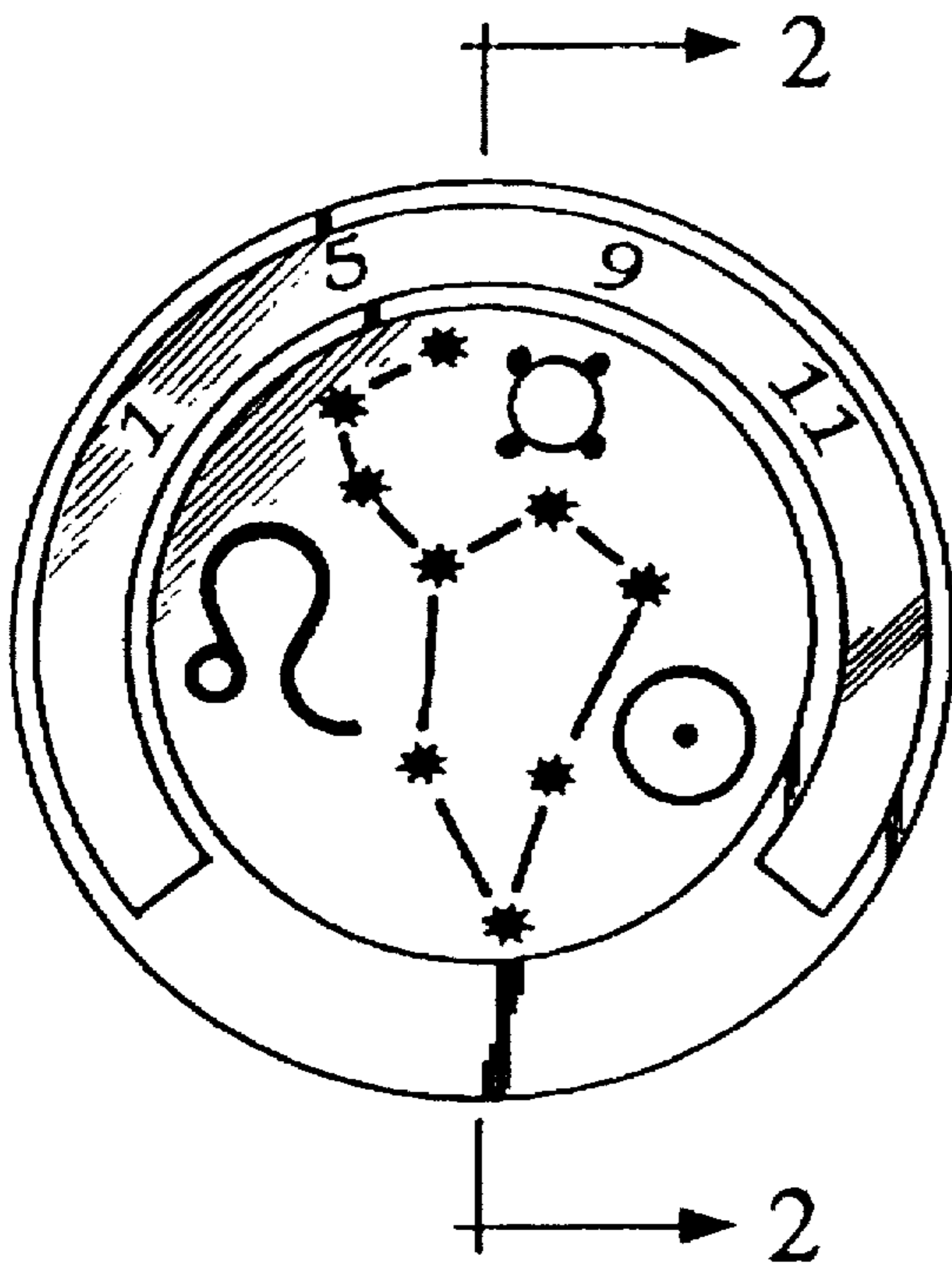

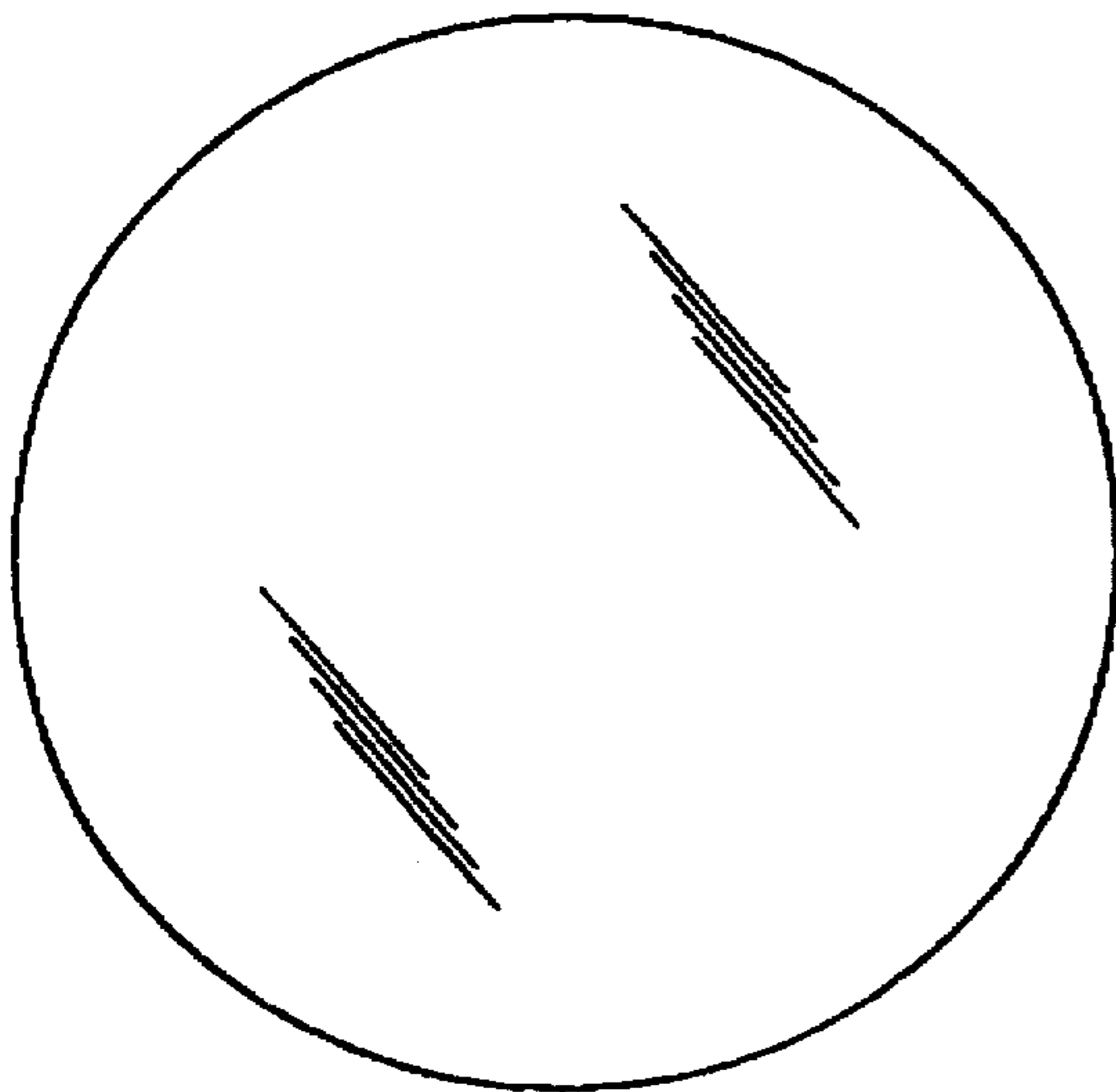
