FIG. 1 is a front view of a bath towel showing our new design;

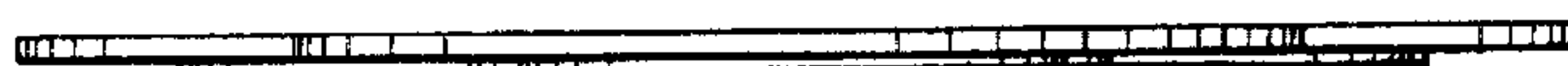
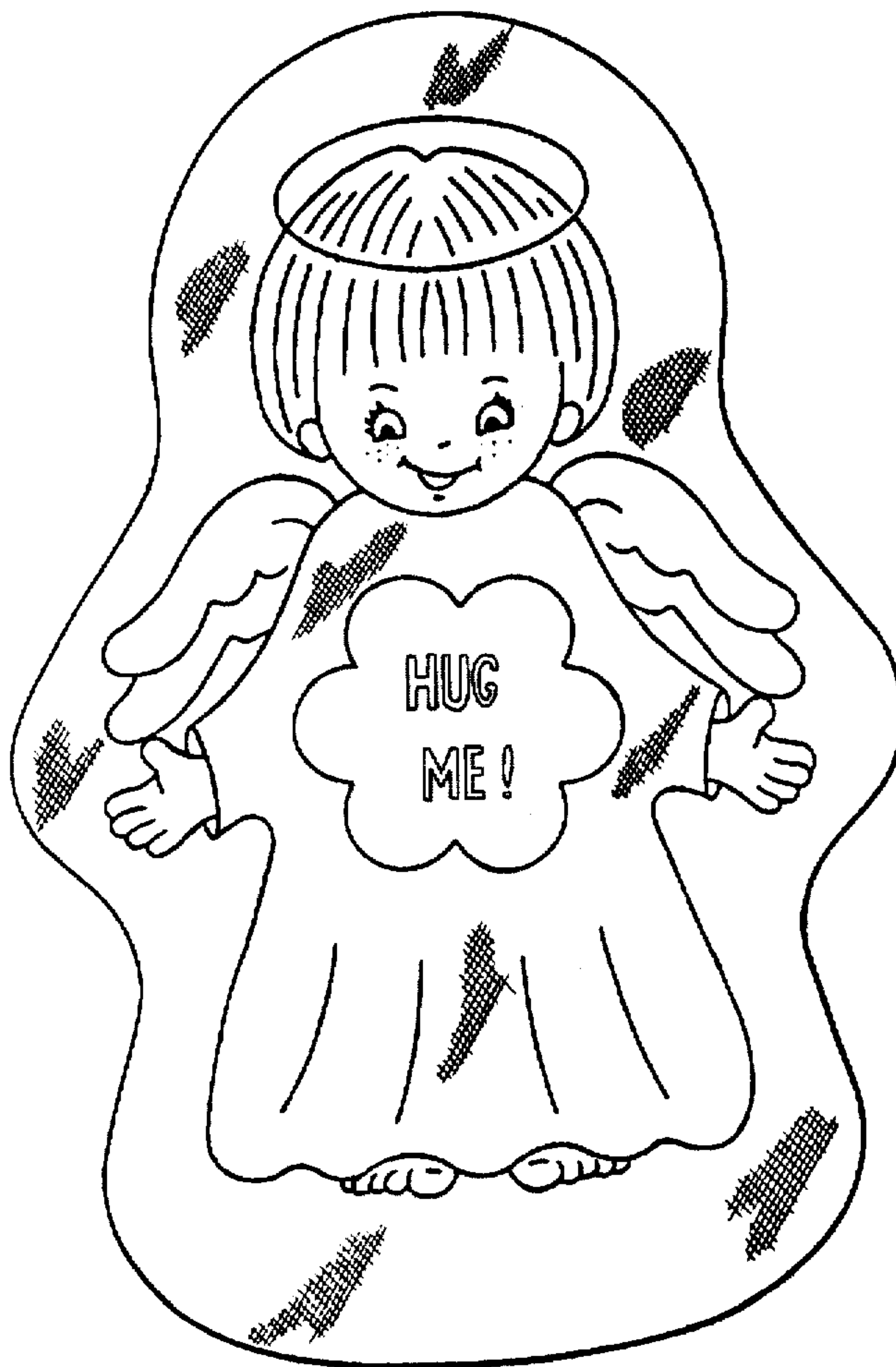
FIG. 2 is a side view of a bath towel showing our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;

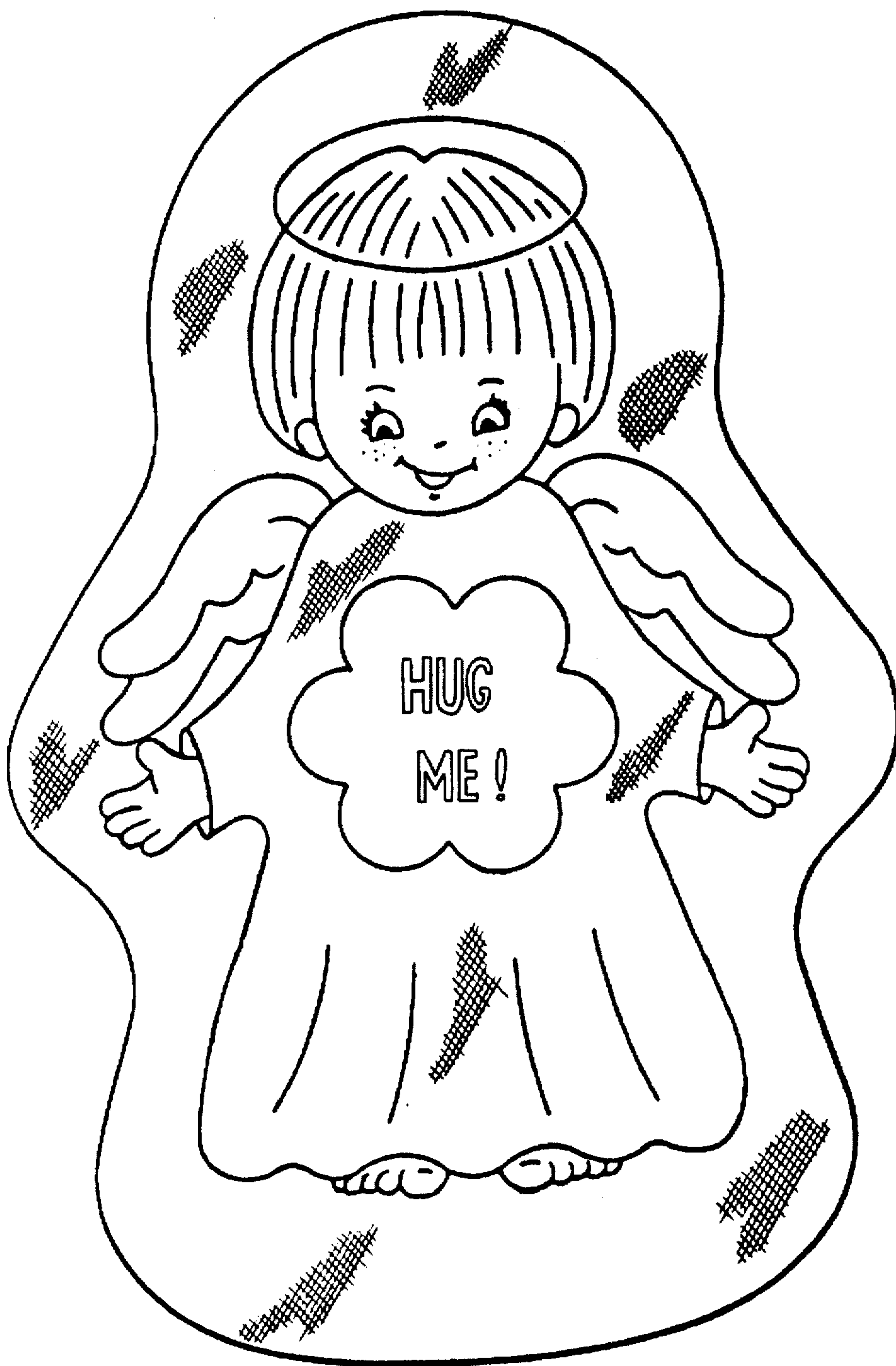

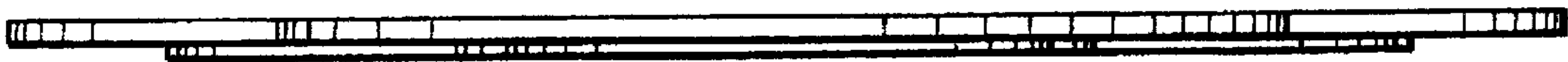
