The rear of the design is flat and unornamented.

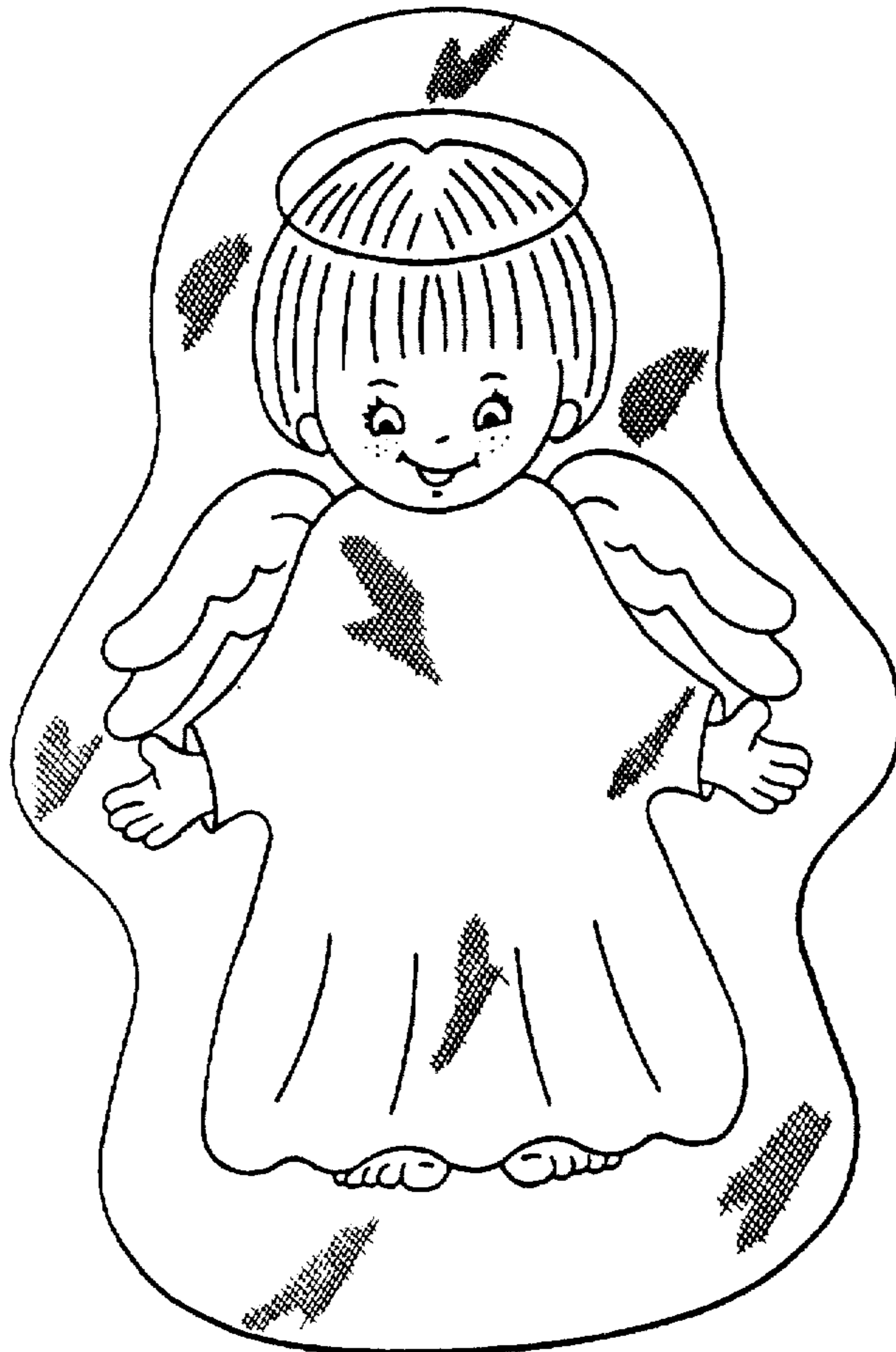
The cross-hatching represents conventional fabric and is understood to extend throughout the areas represented.

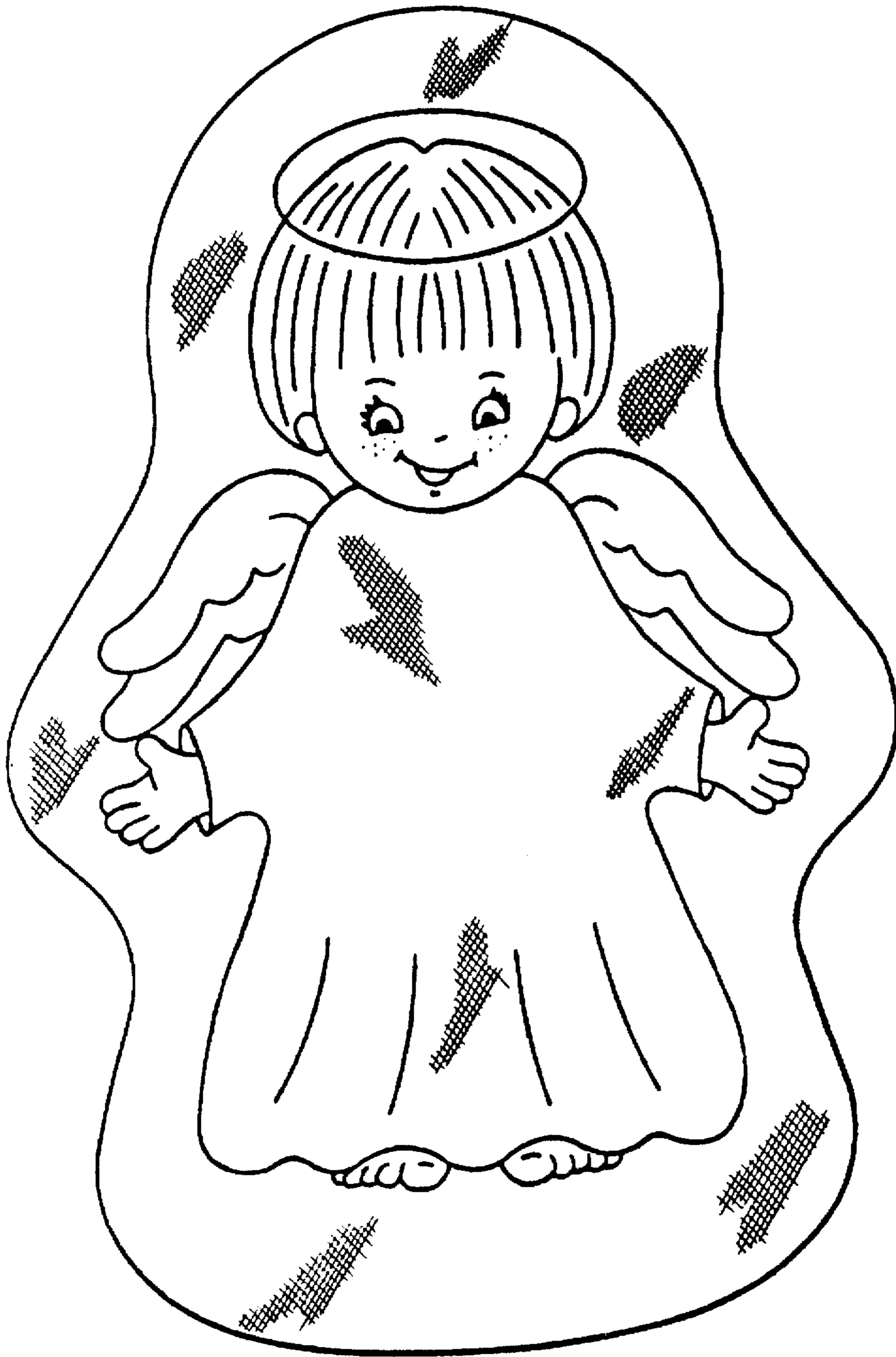

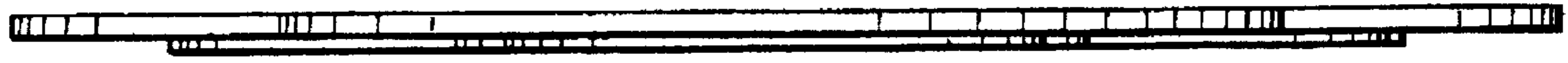
