FIG. 2 is a top view thereof with the top edge facing the rear side;

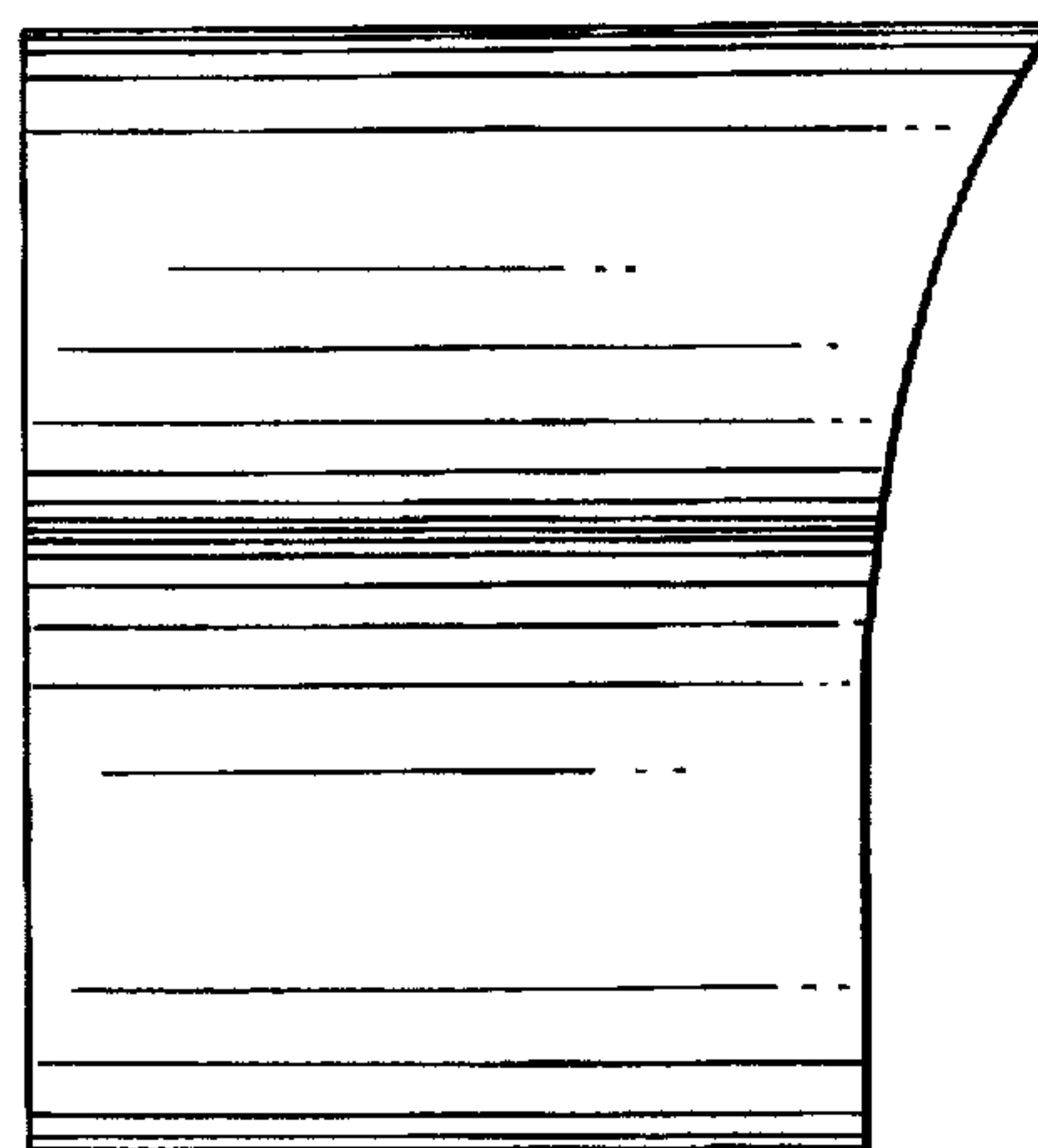
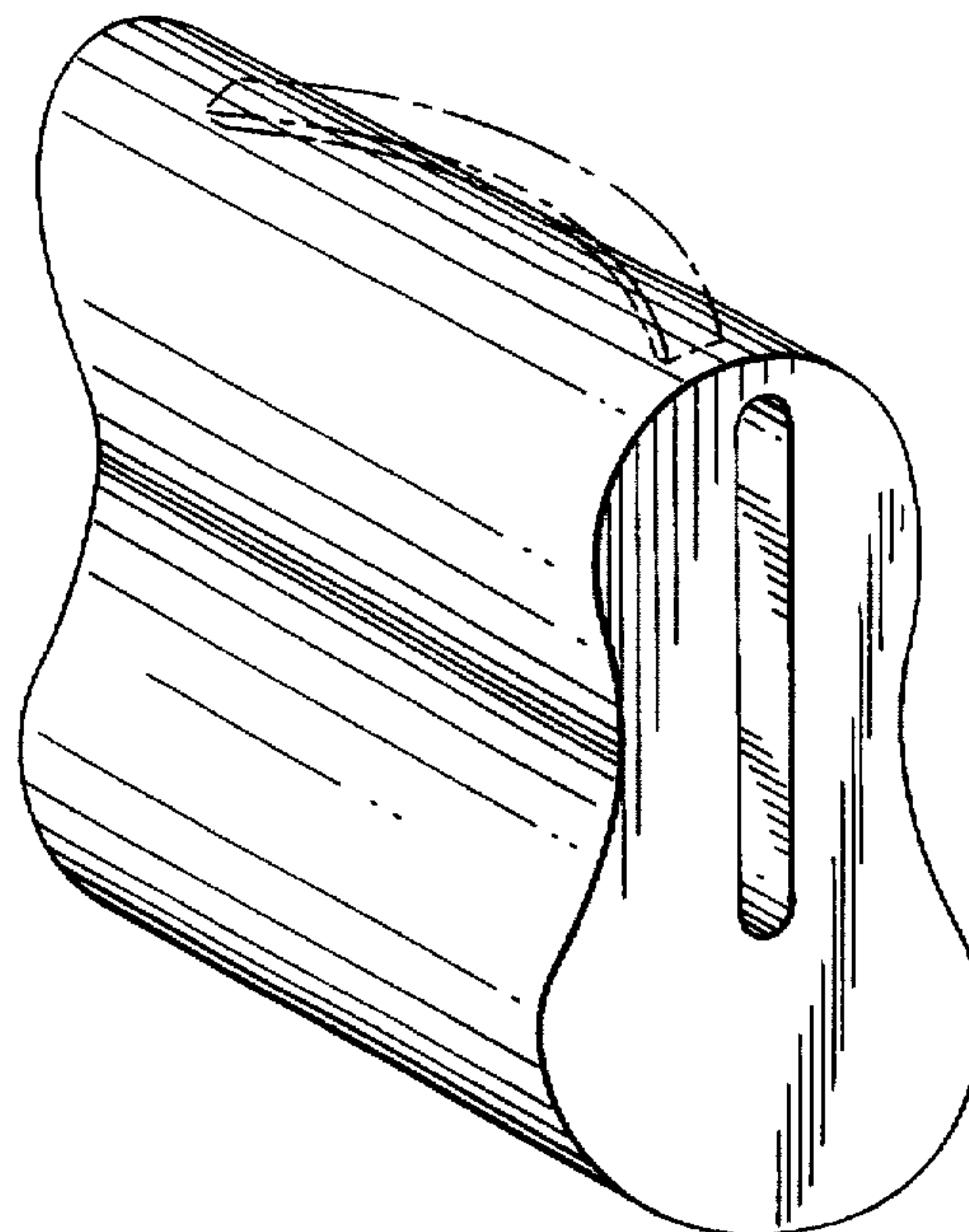
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

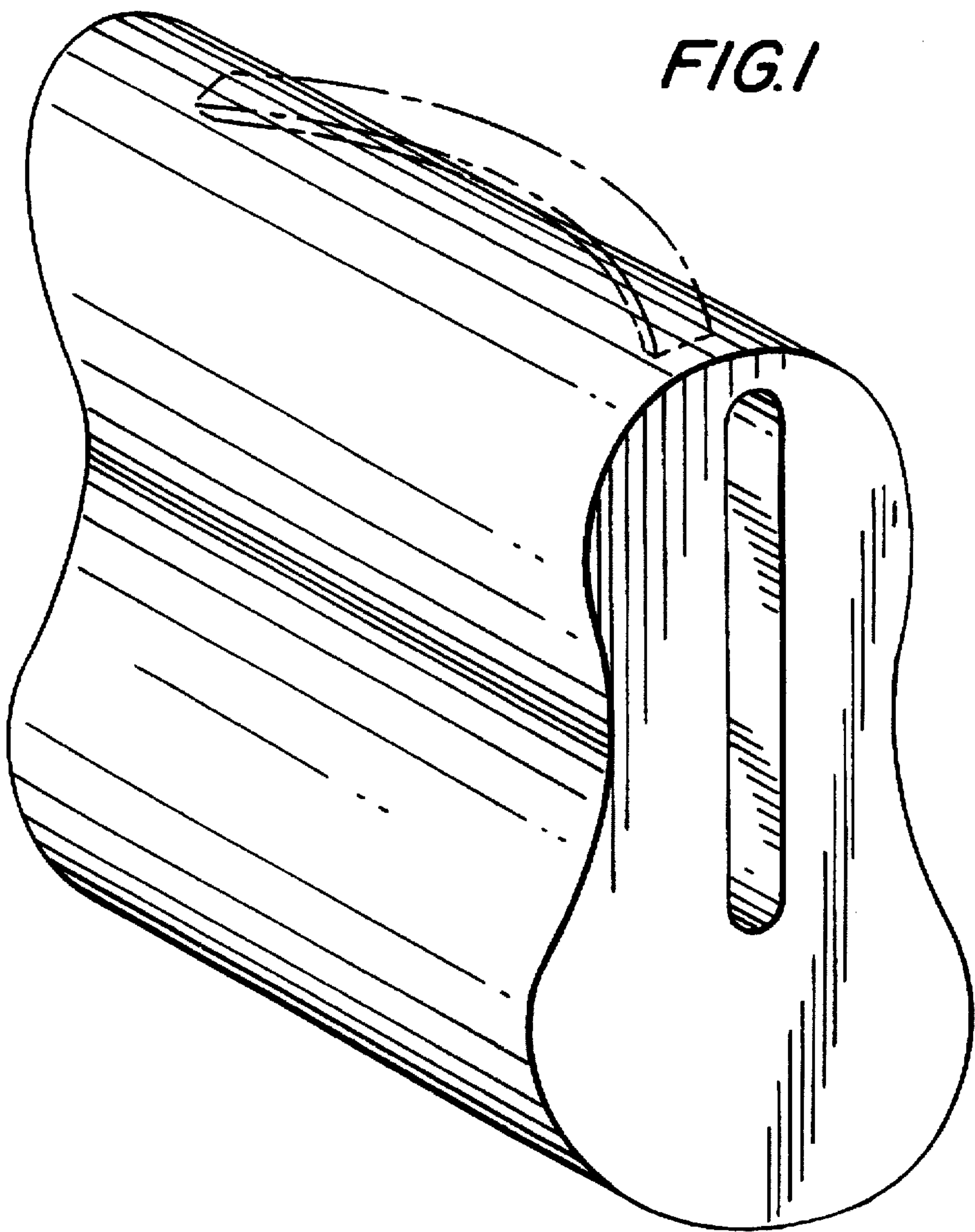

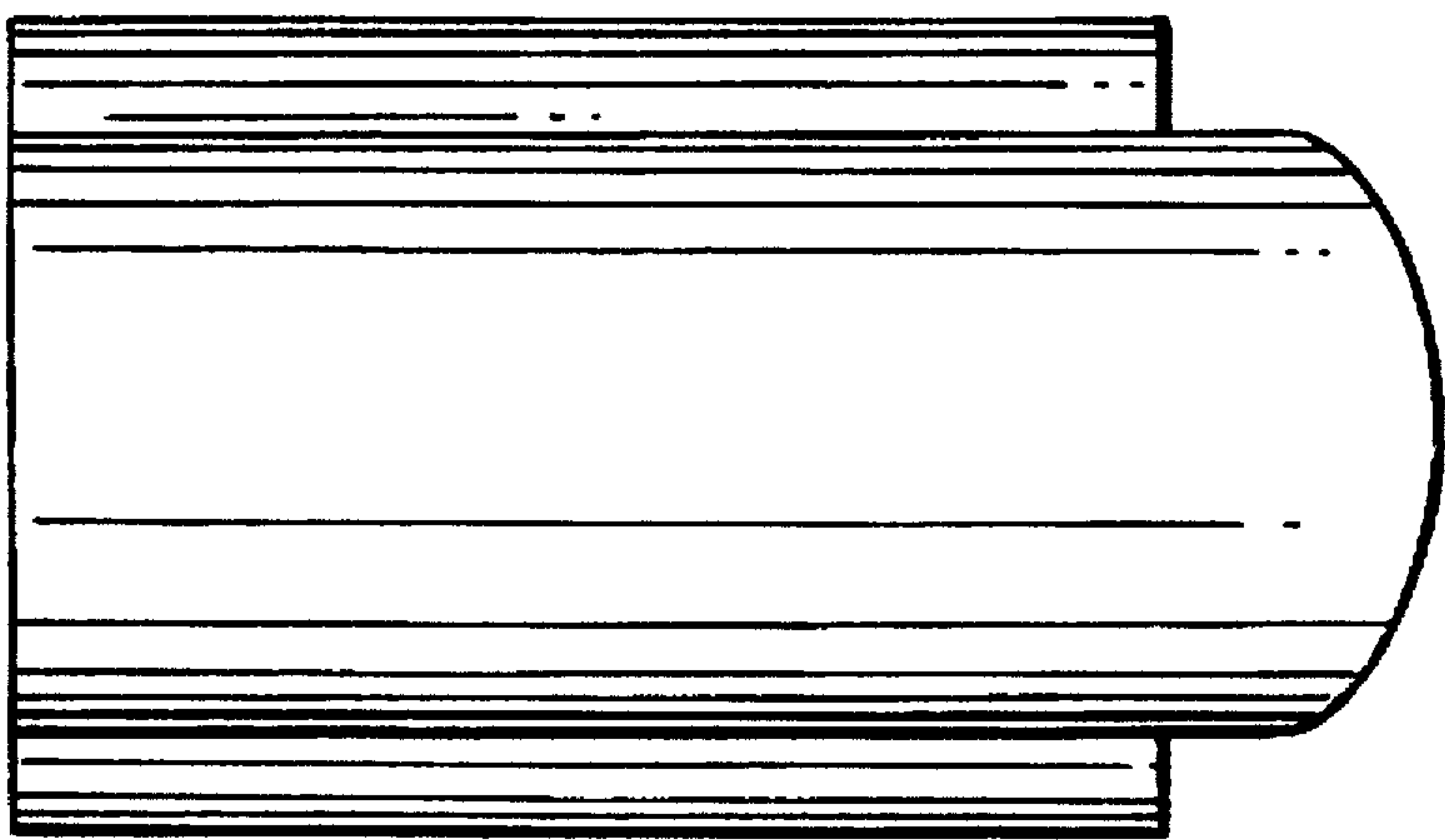

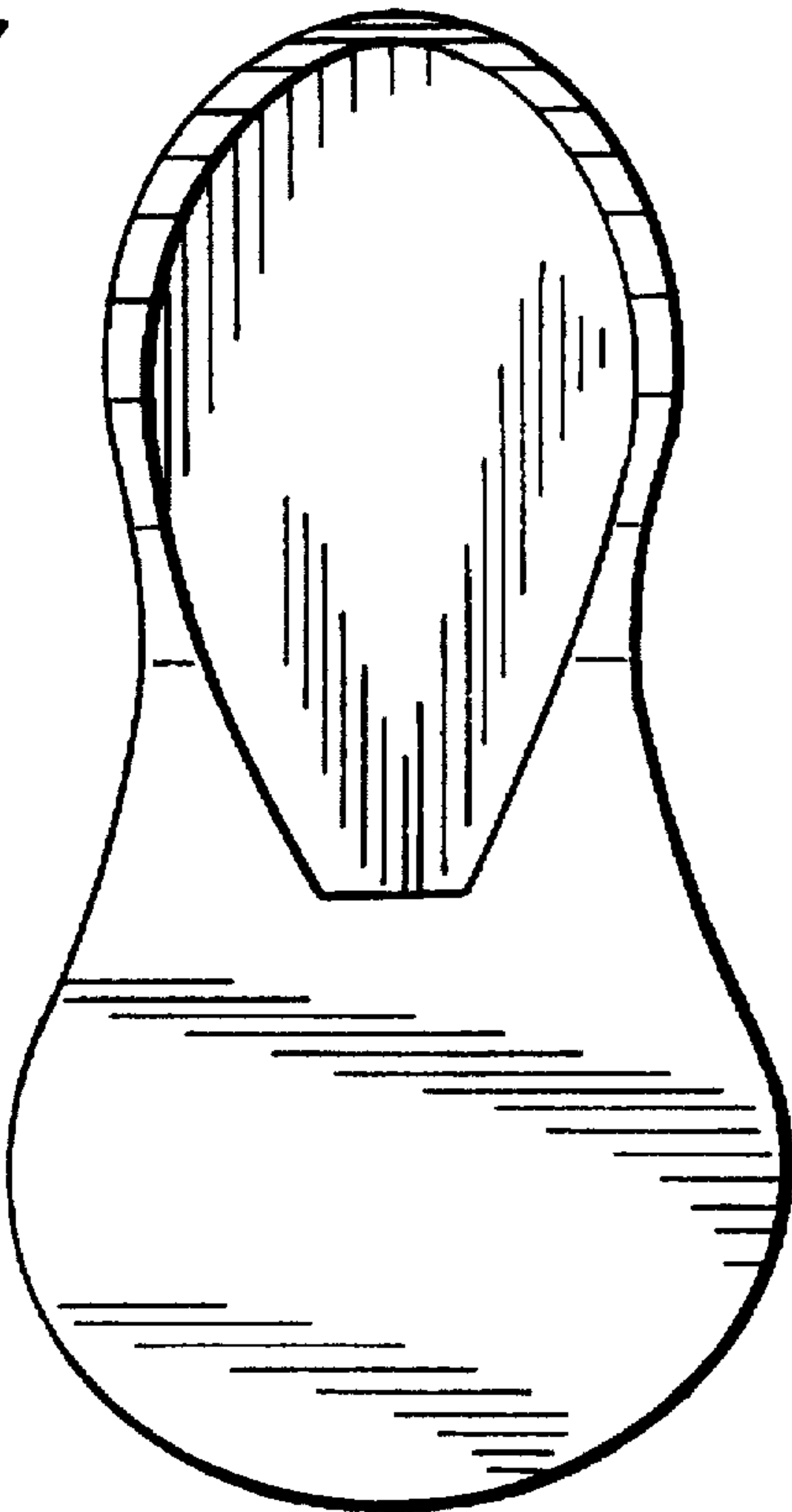
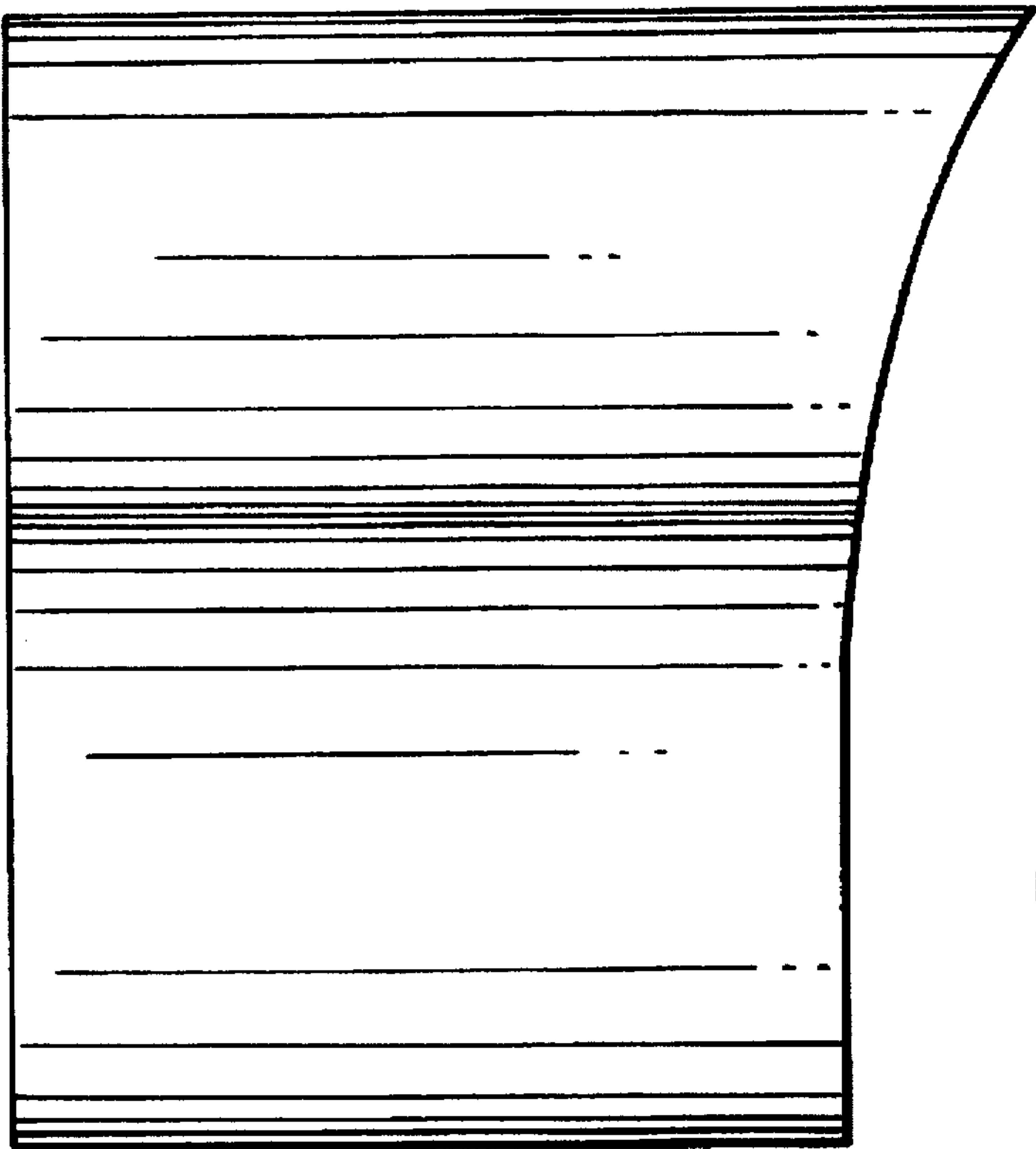

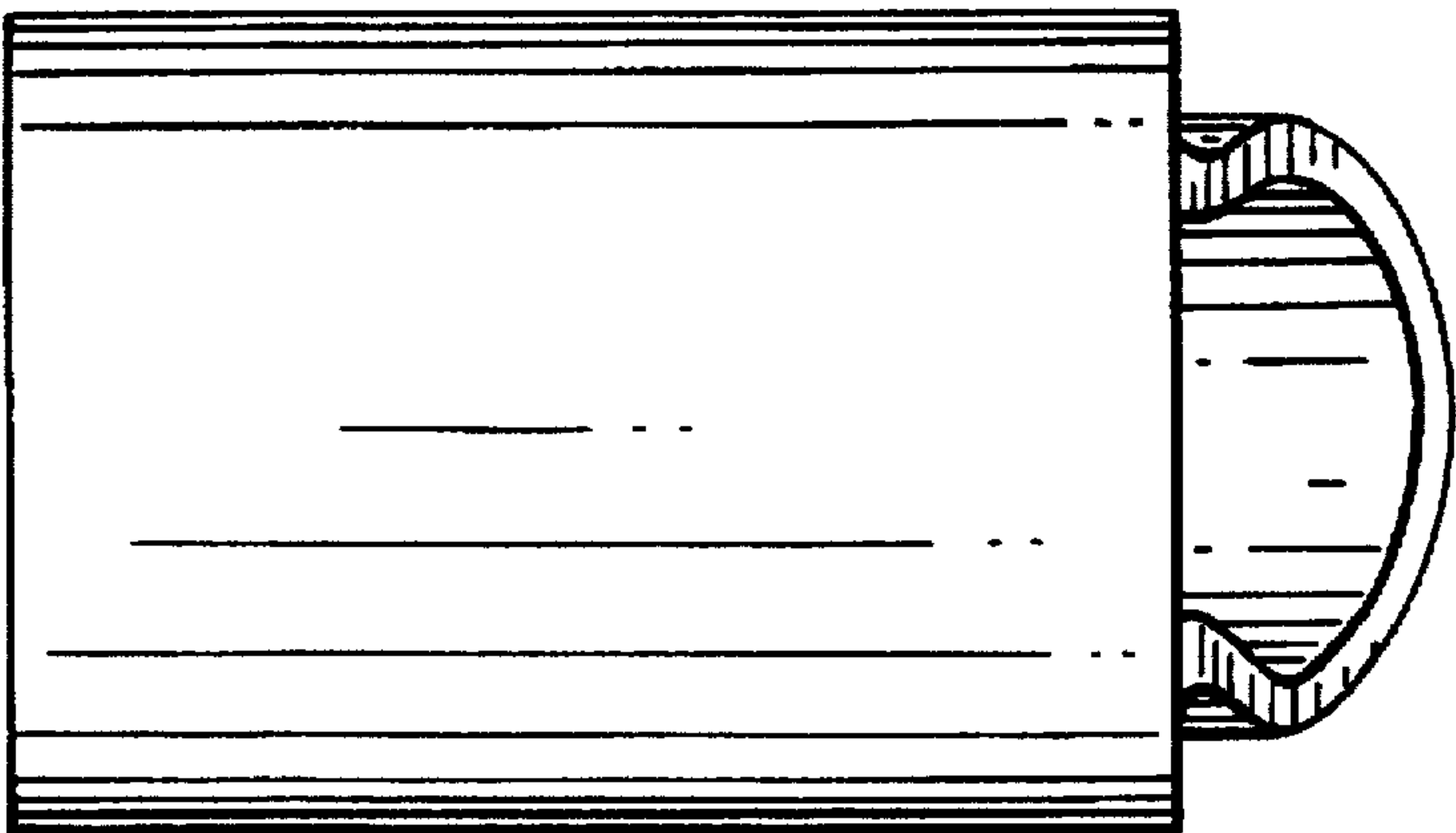
