FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a base for a reciprocating food slicer showing our new design;

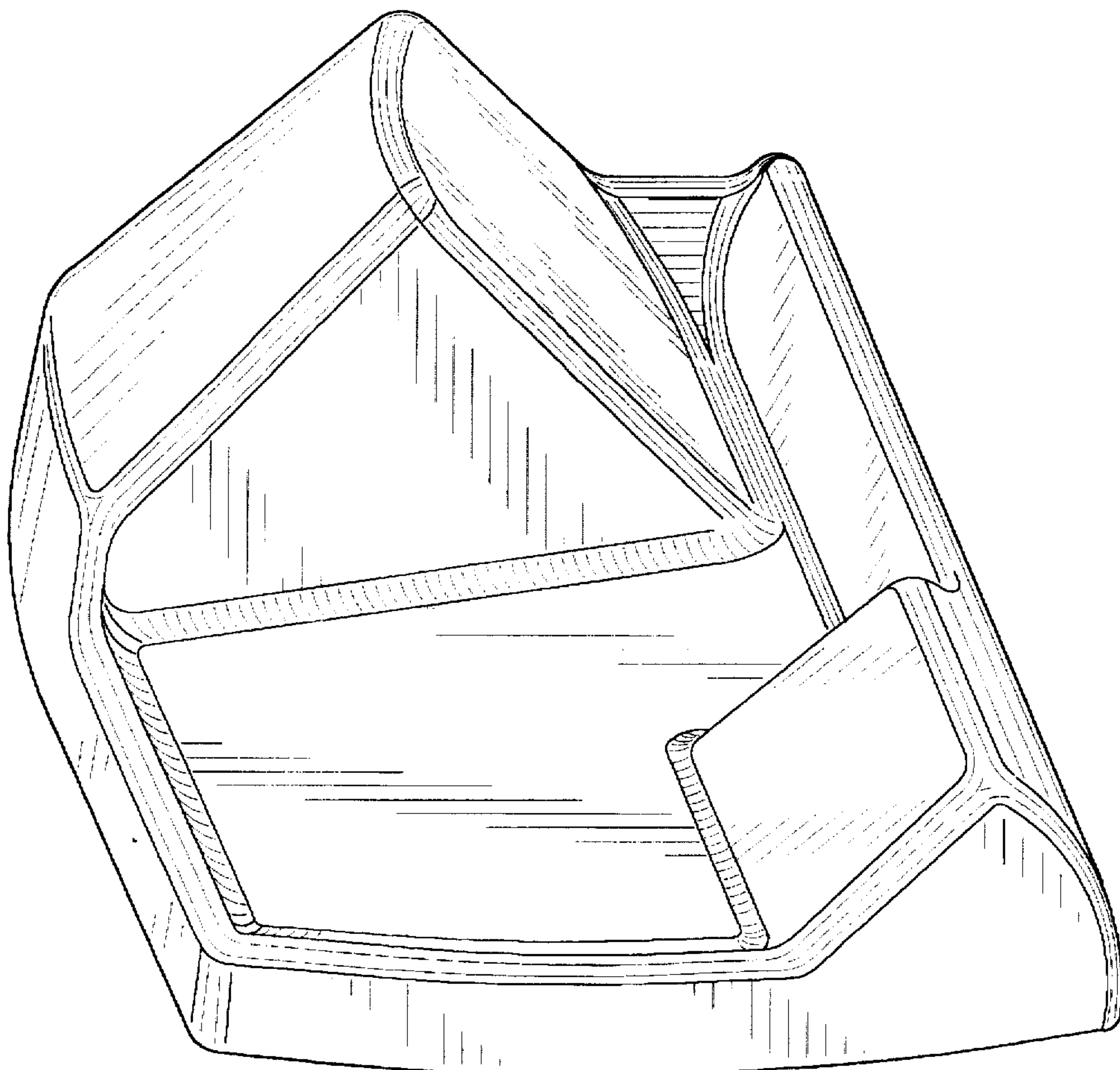
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

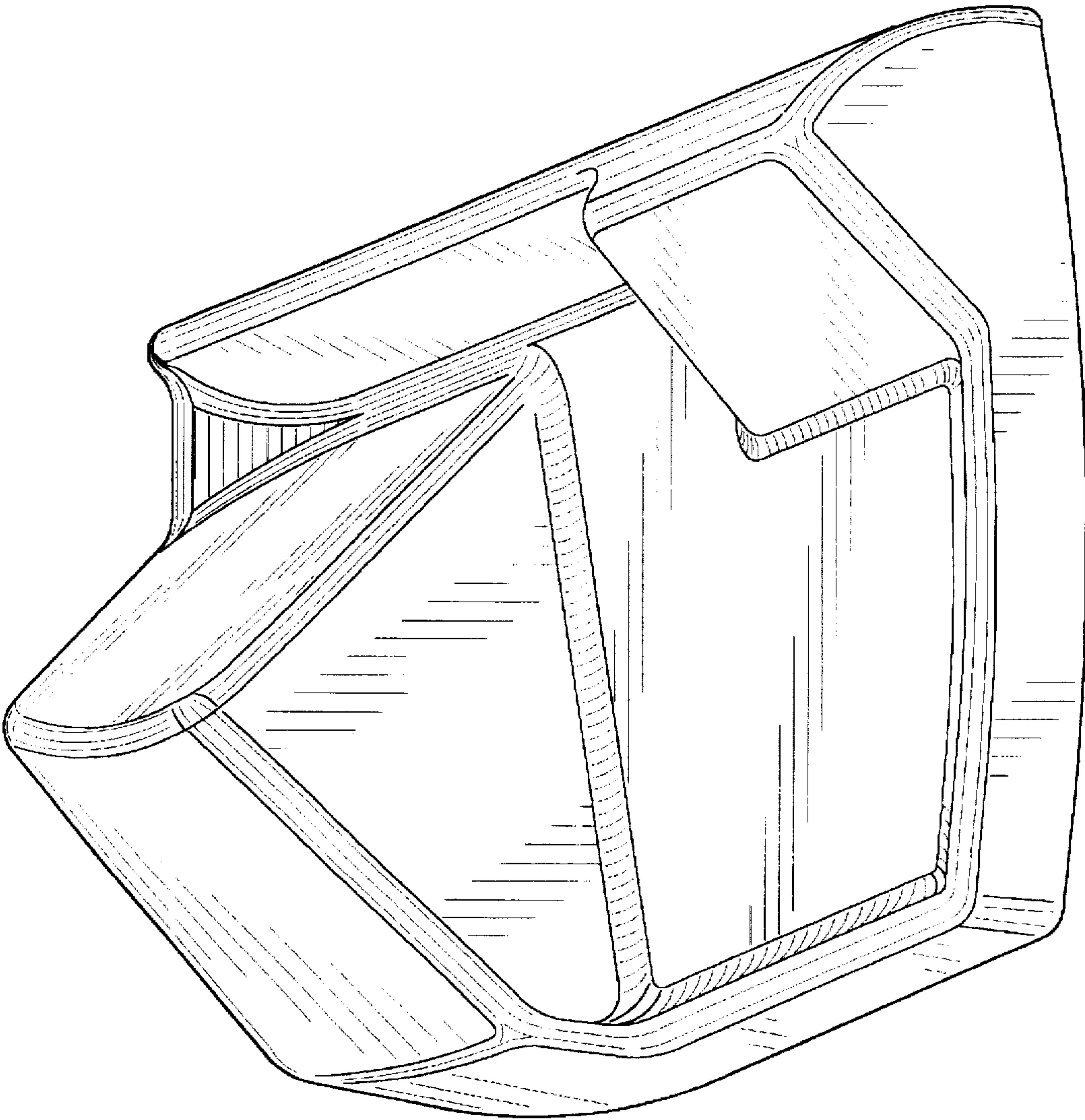

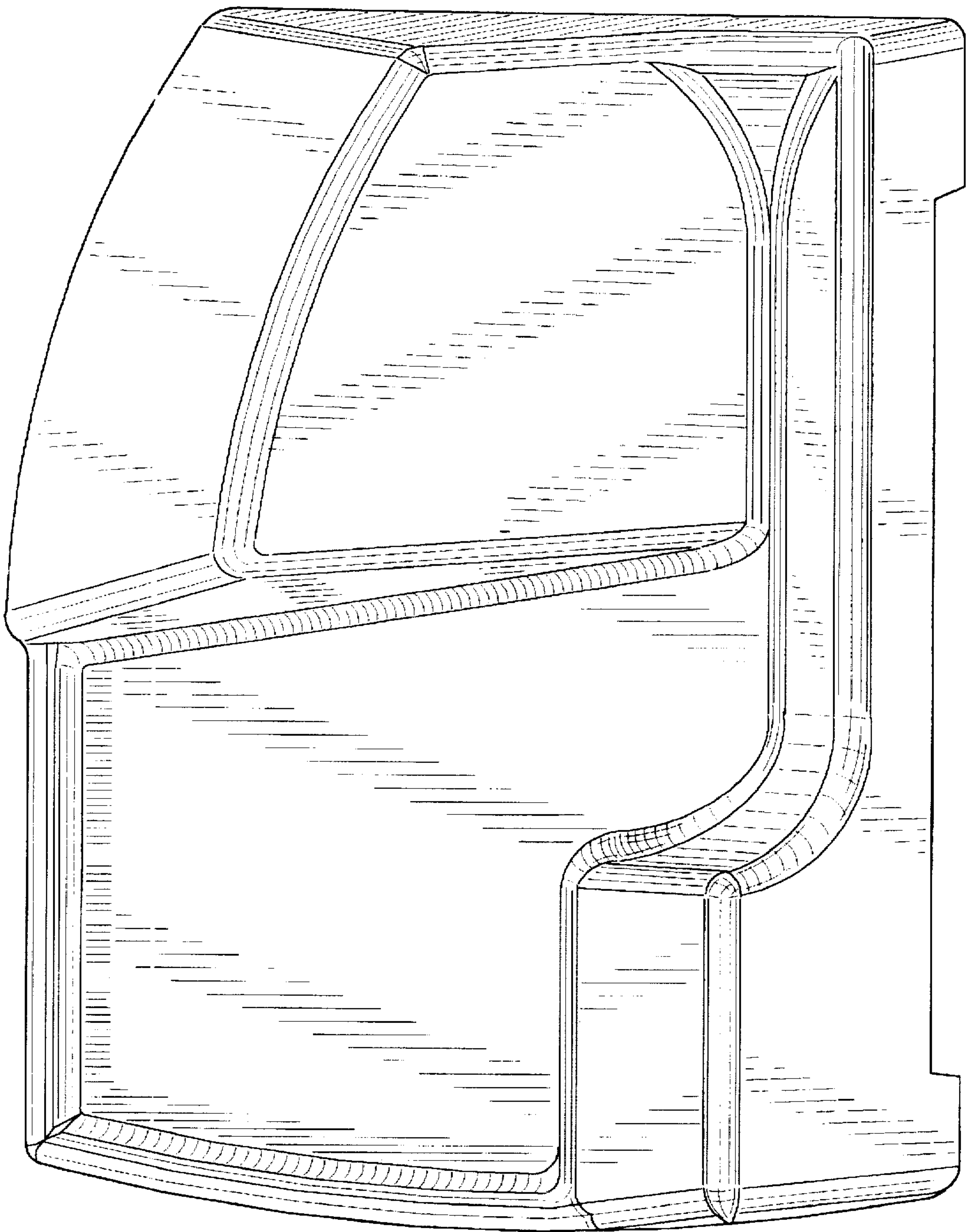

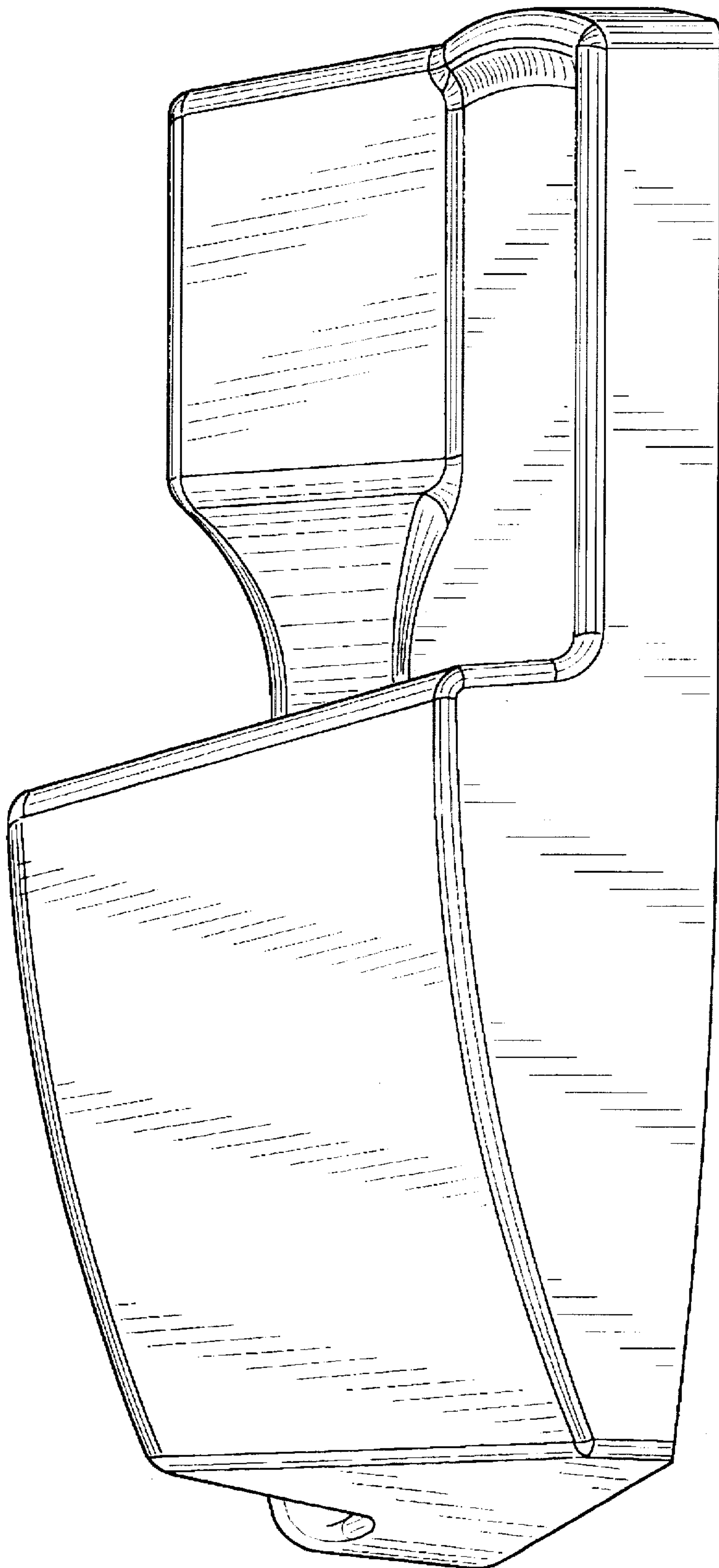
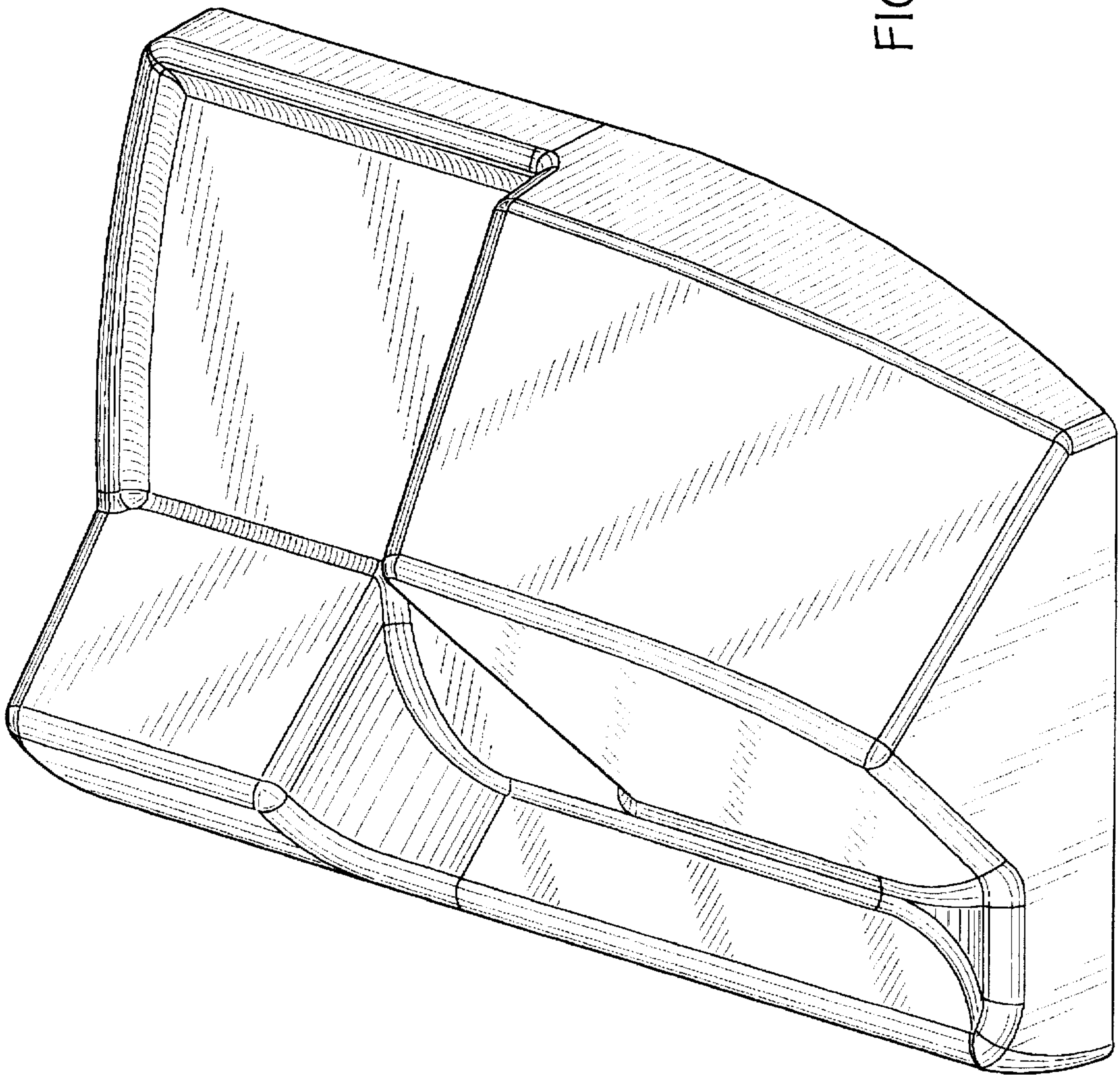

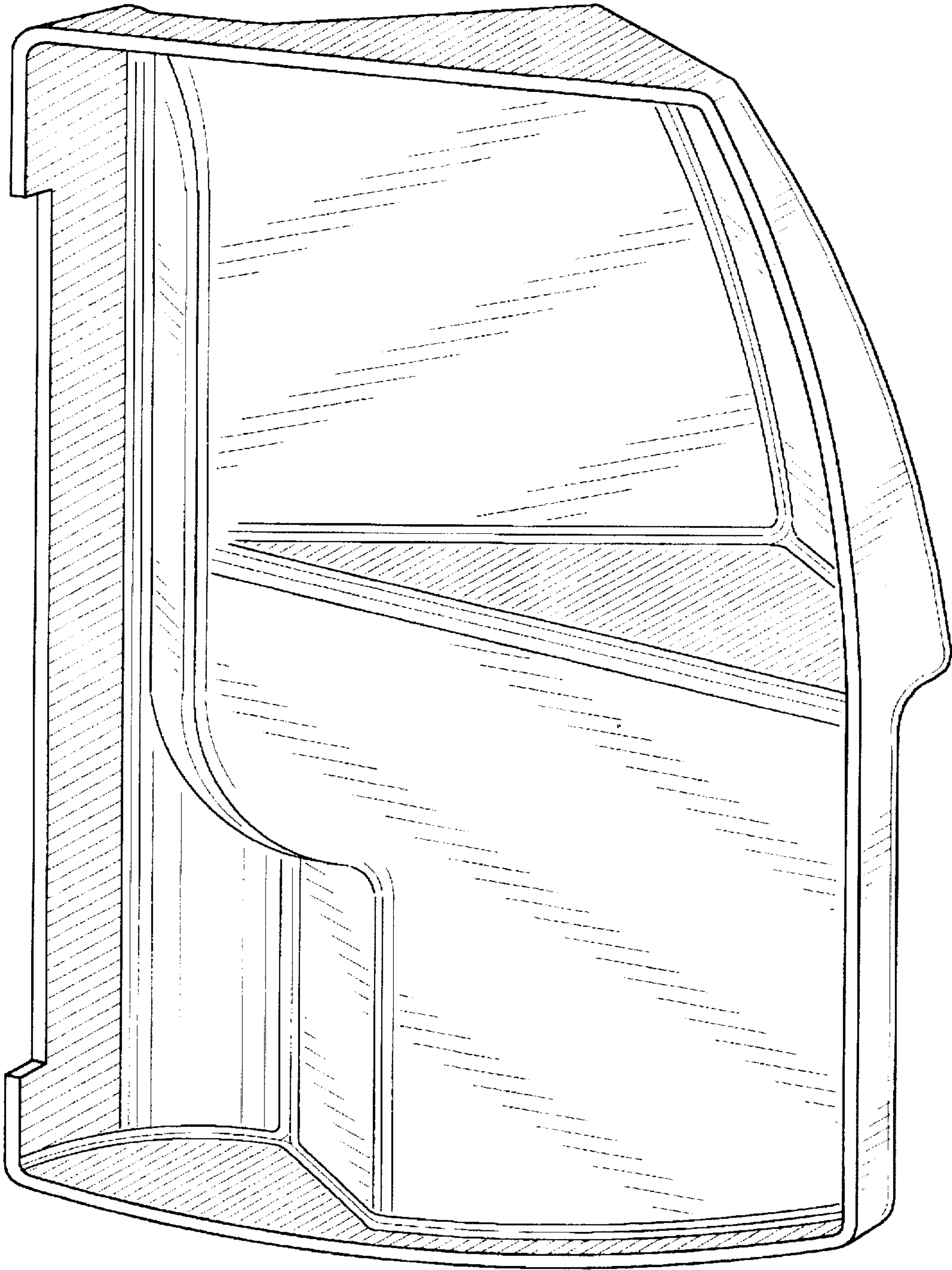
