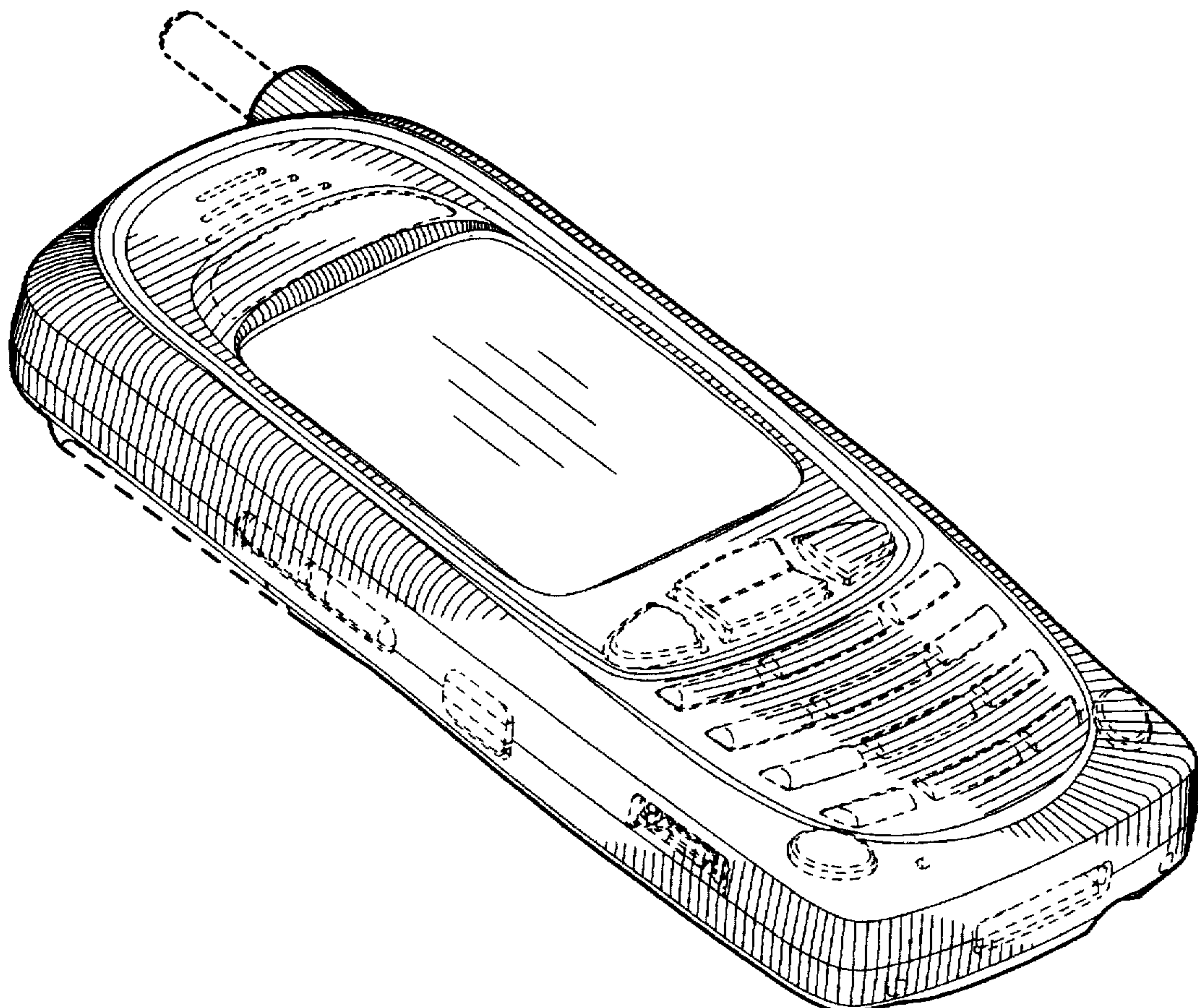
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, bottom, and right side perspective view showing our new design for a portable telephone with broken line matter being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the portable telephone with broken line matter being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of the portable telephone with broken line matter for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; and,
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the portable telephone with broken line matter being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design.

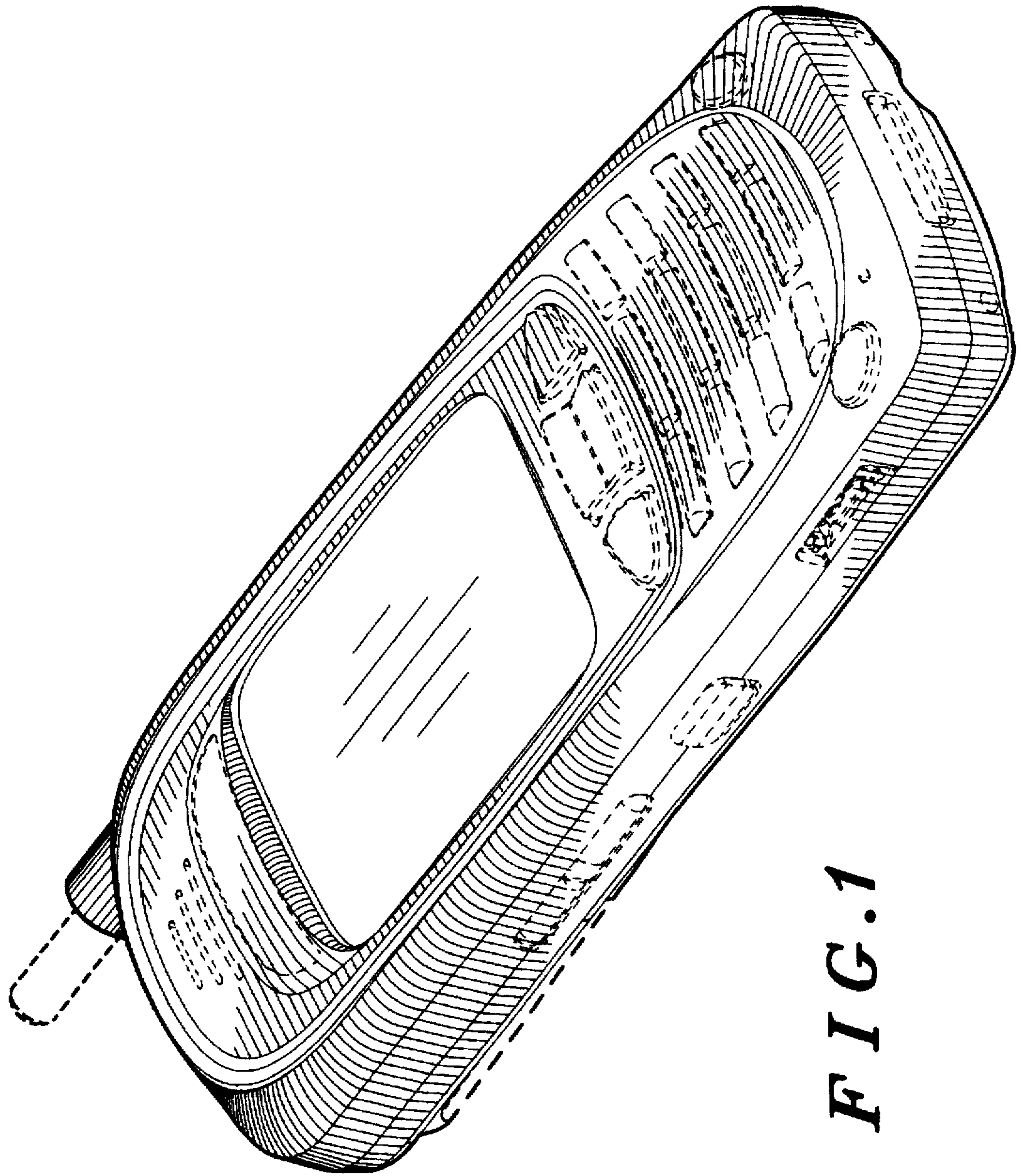

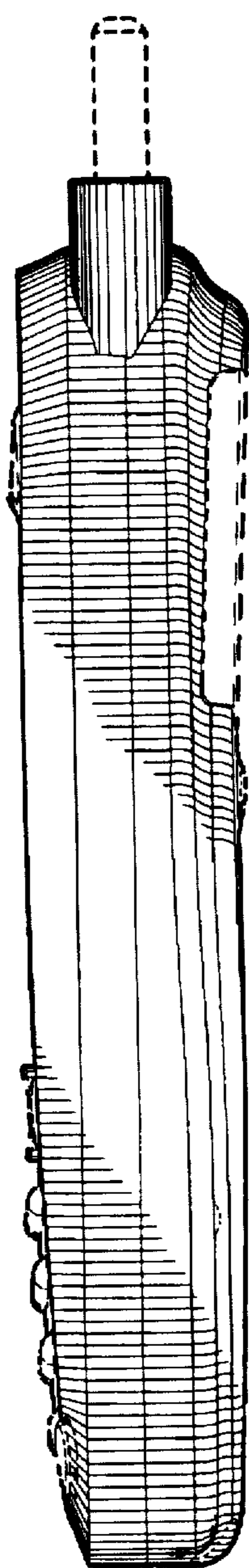
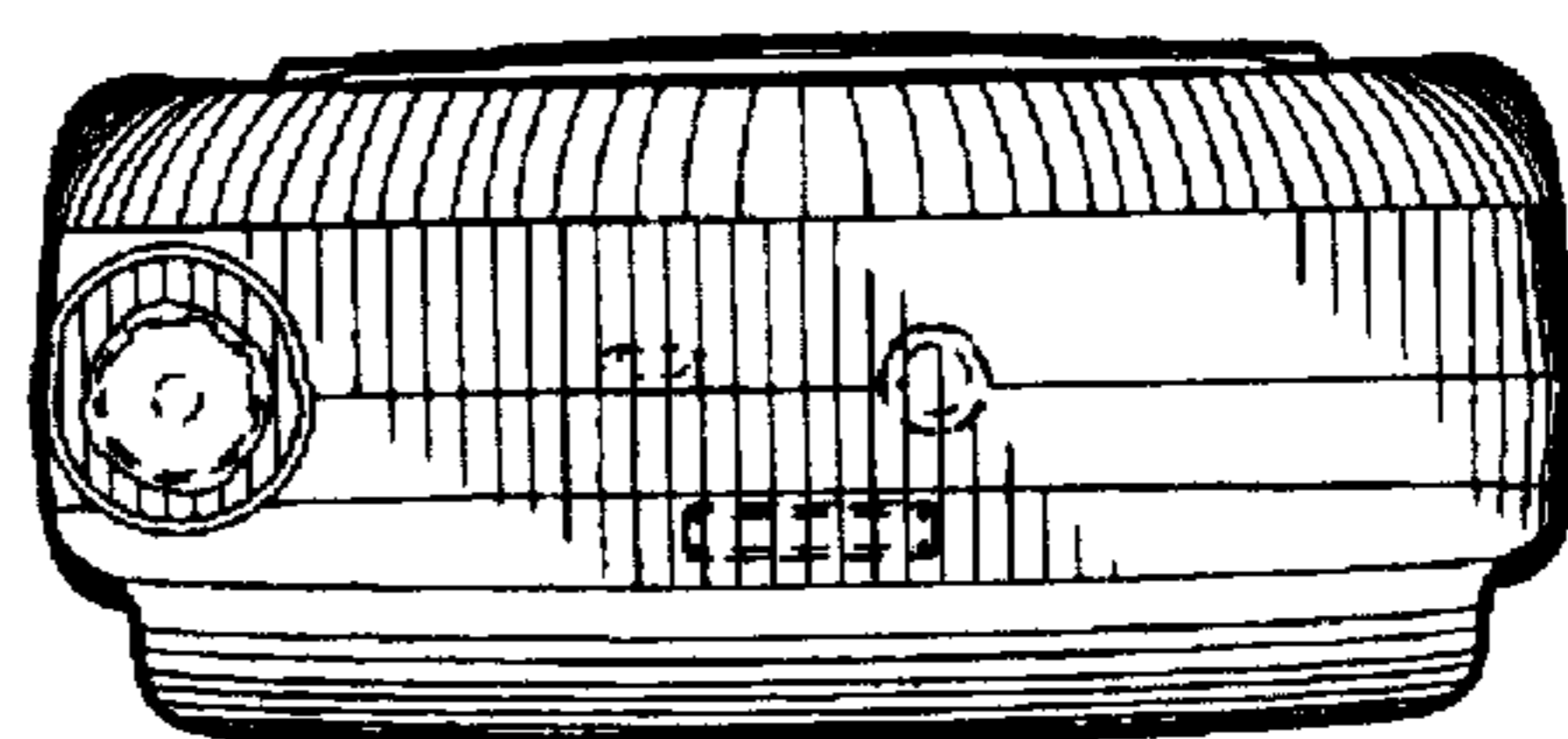

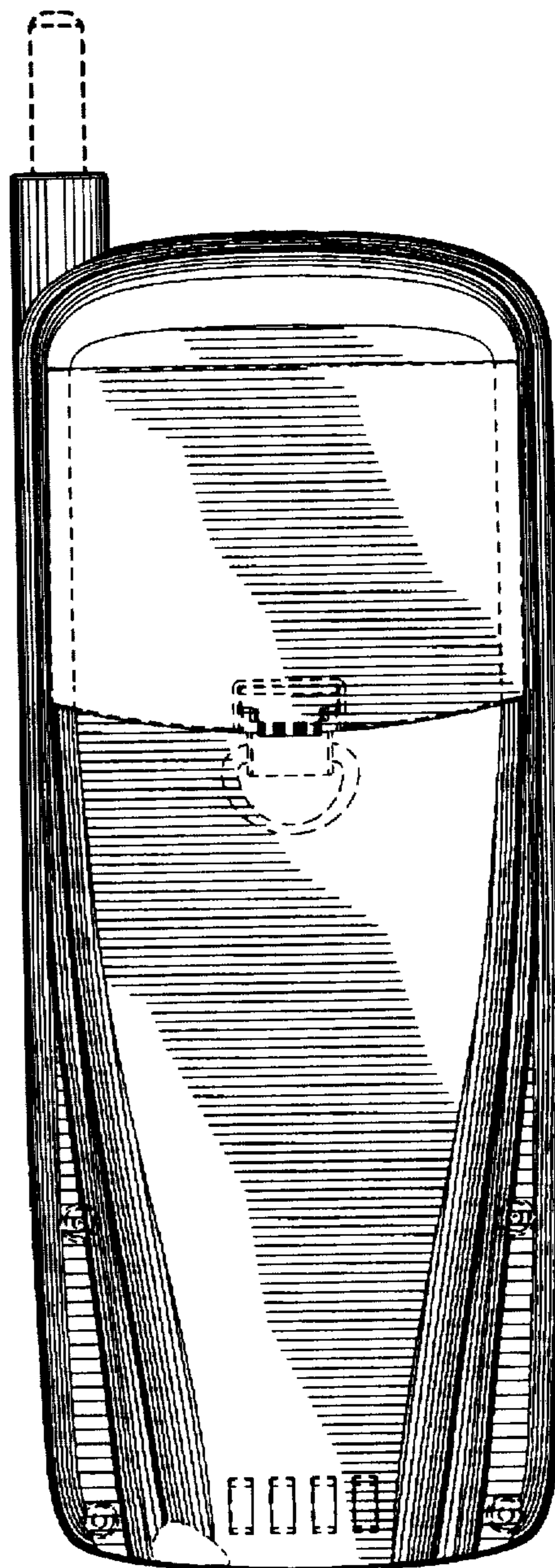
