DESCRIPTION

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of ceiling lighting fixture; the broken lines showing a fan and blades are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;


FIG. 3 is a front view of ceiling lighting fixture; the broken lines showing a fan and blades are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; and,


FIG. 4 is a rear view of ceiling lighting fixture; the broken lines showing a fan and blades are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;




