[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a display stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view from the front, top and one side of a display stand showing my new design, with the movable shelves in a position of use, with the bottles and logo shown in broken lines for purposes of illustration only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged isometric view of FIG. 1 from the other side with the moveable shelves in a position of non-use;

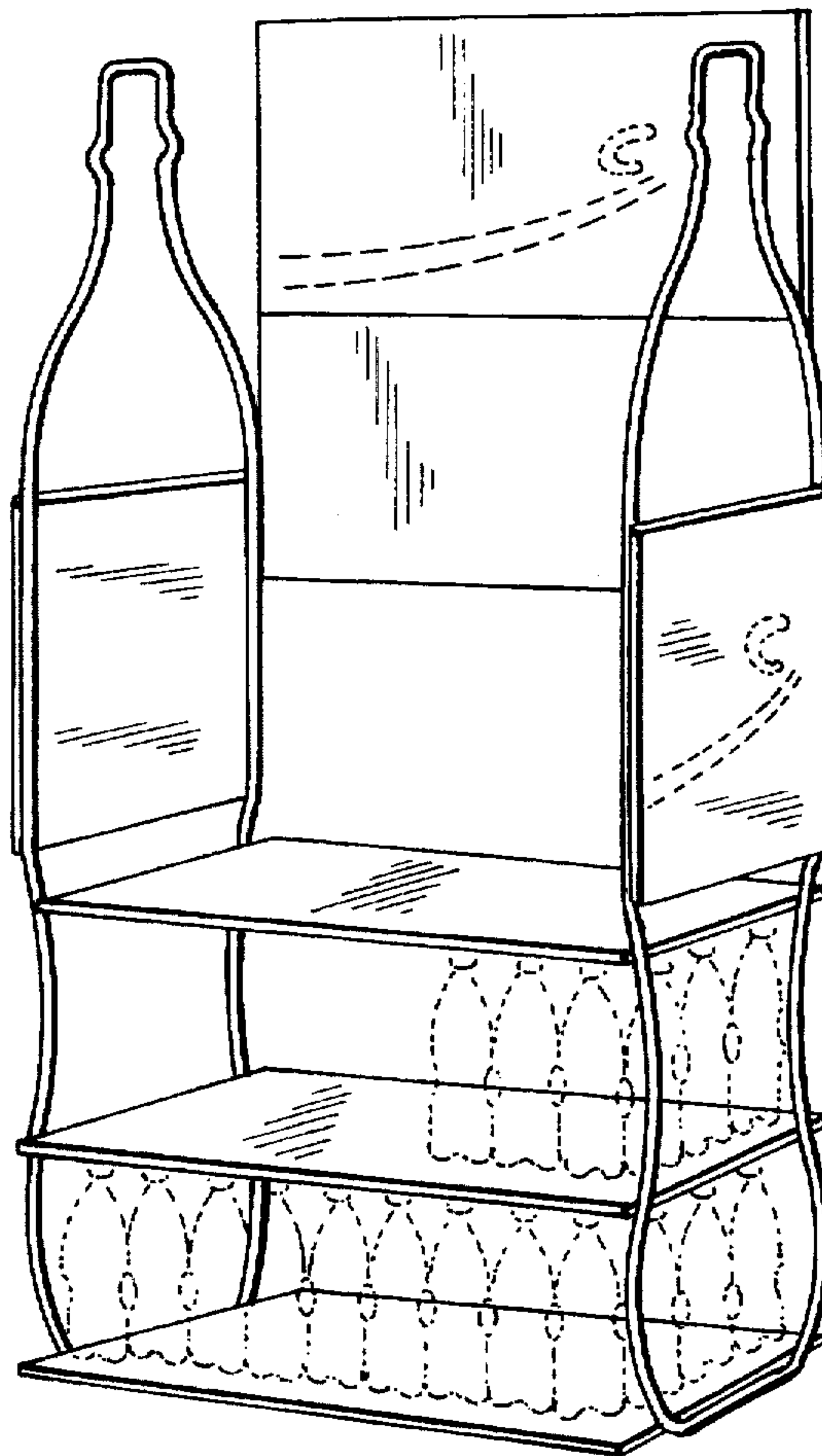
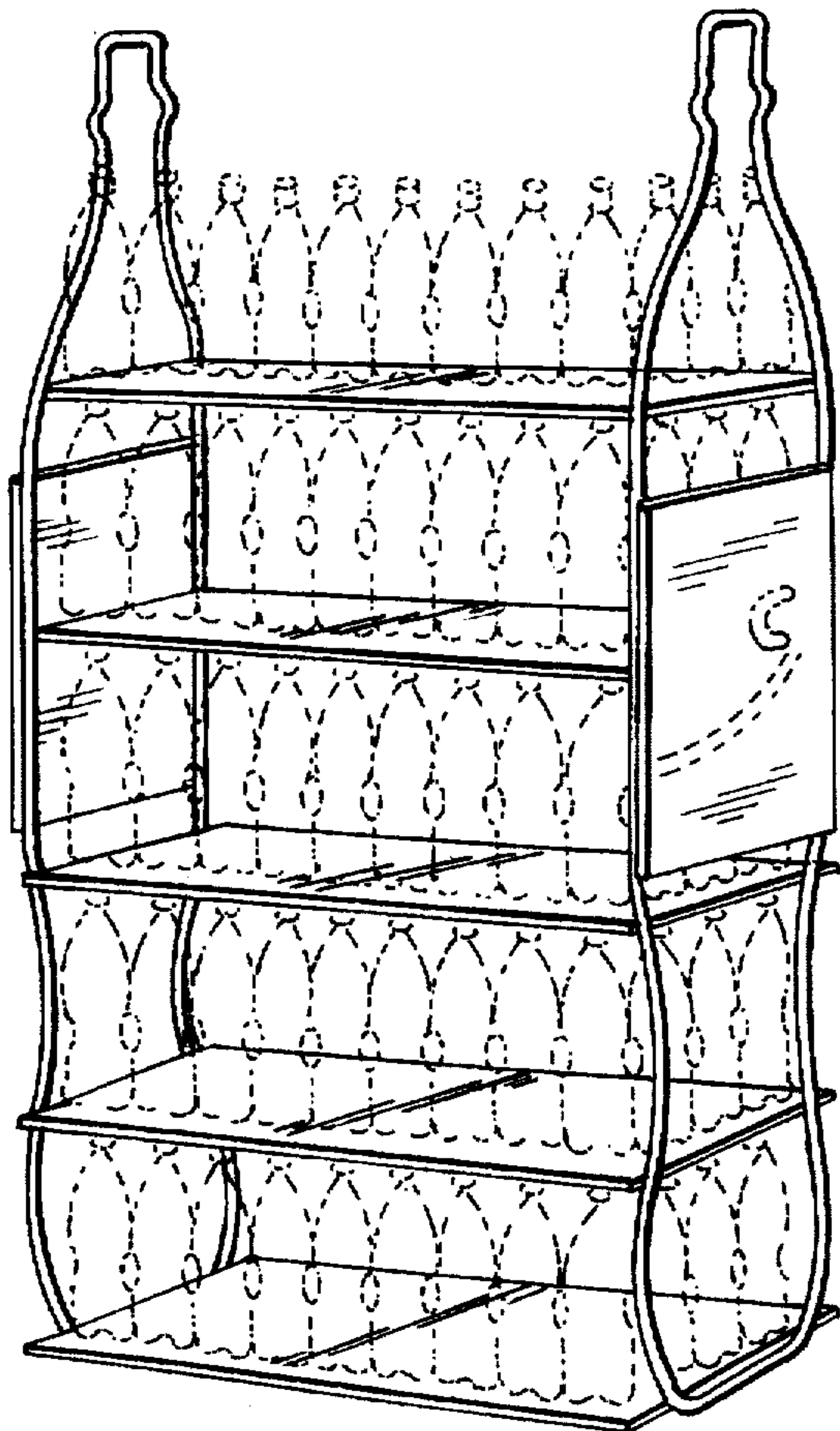
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2 on a reduced scale;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1; and,

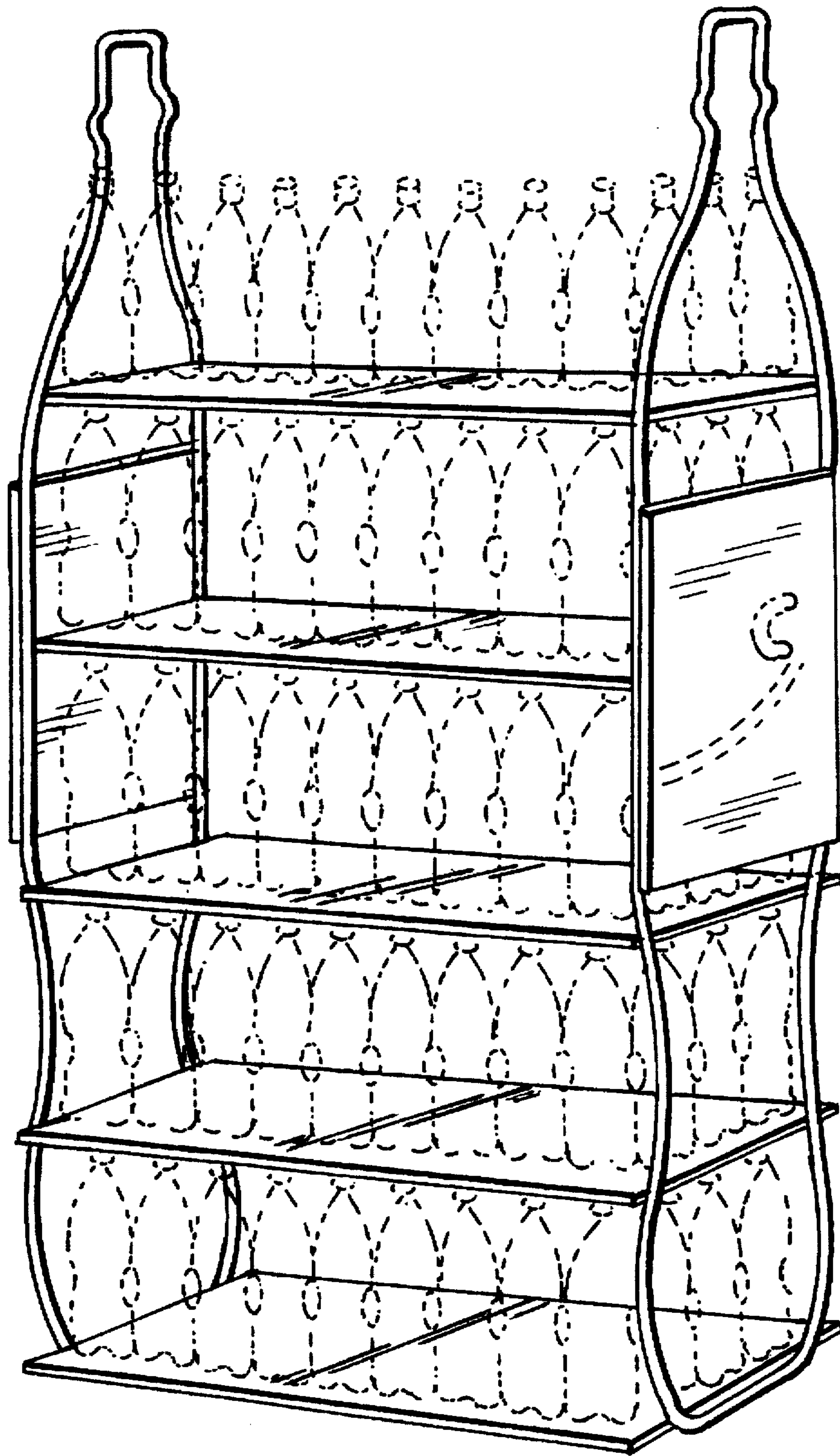

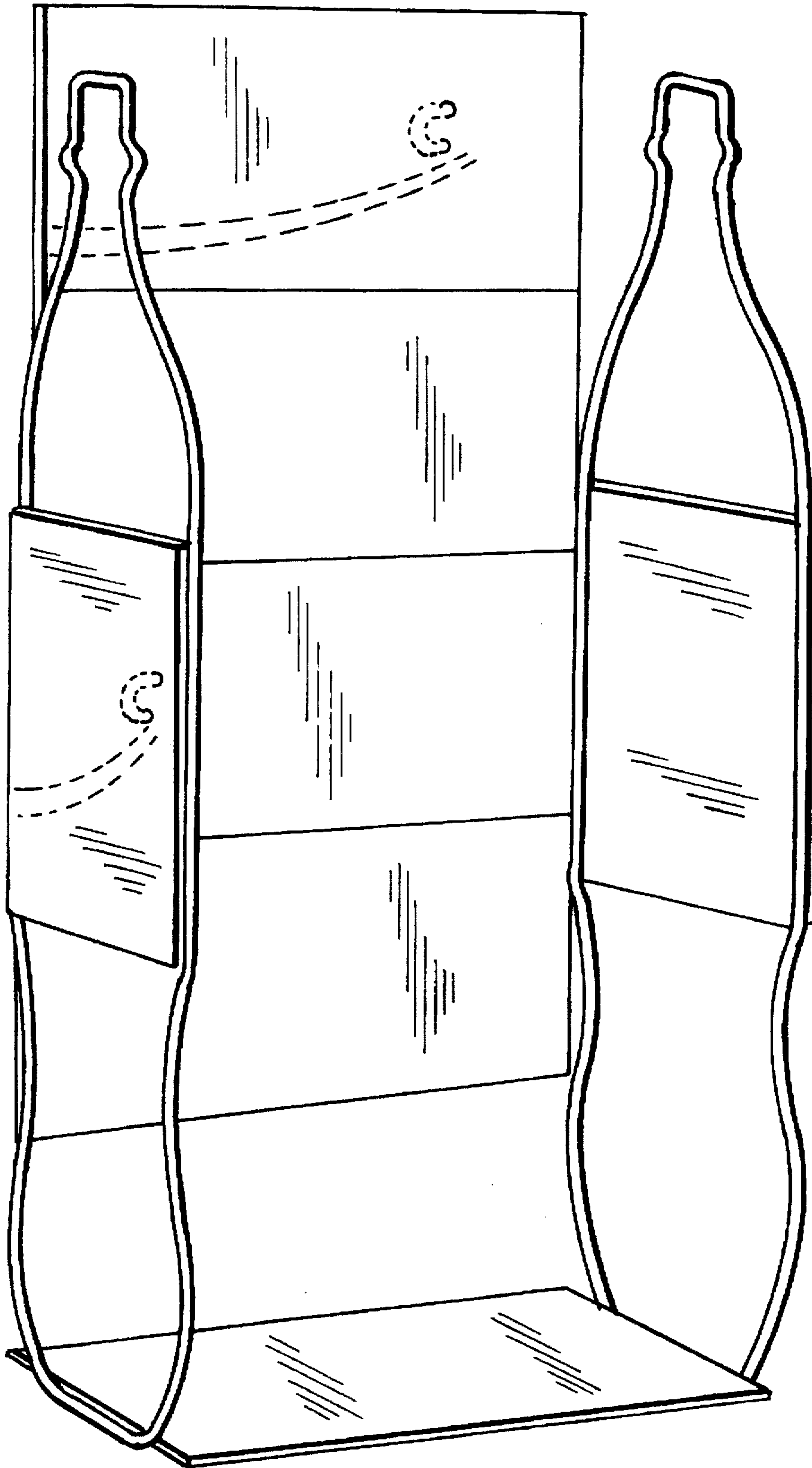

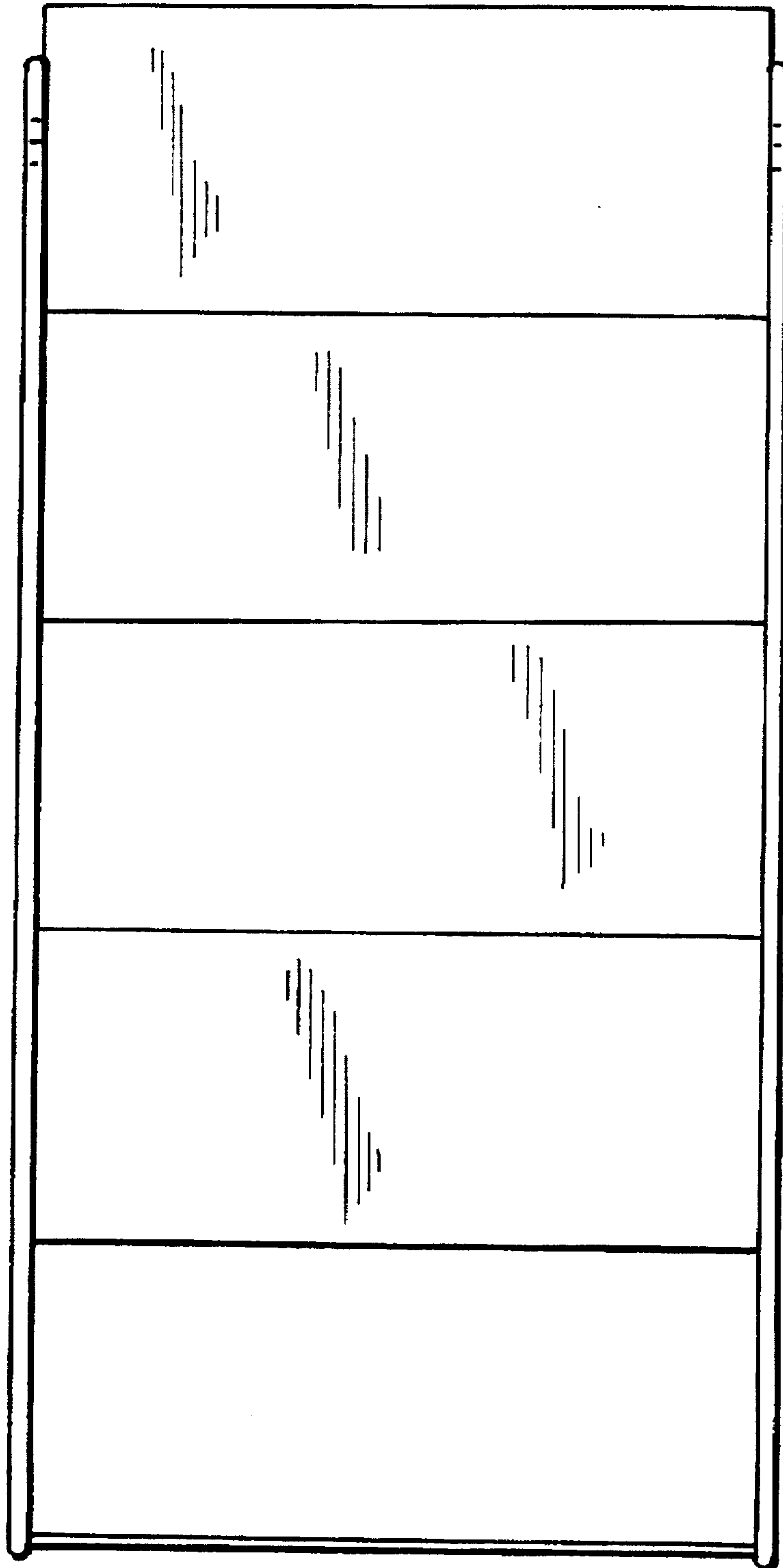

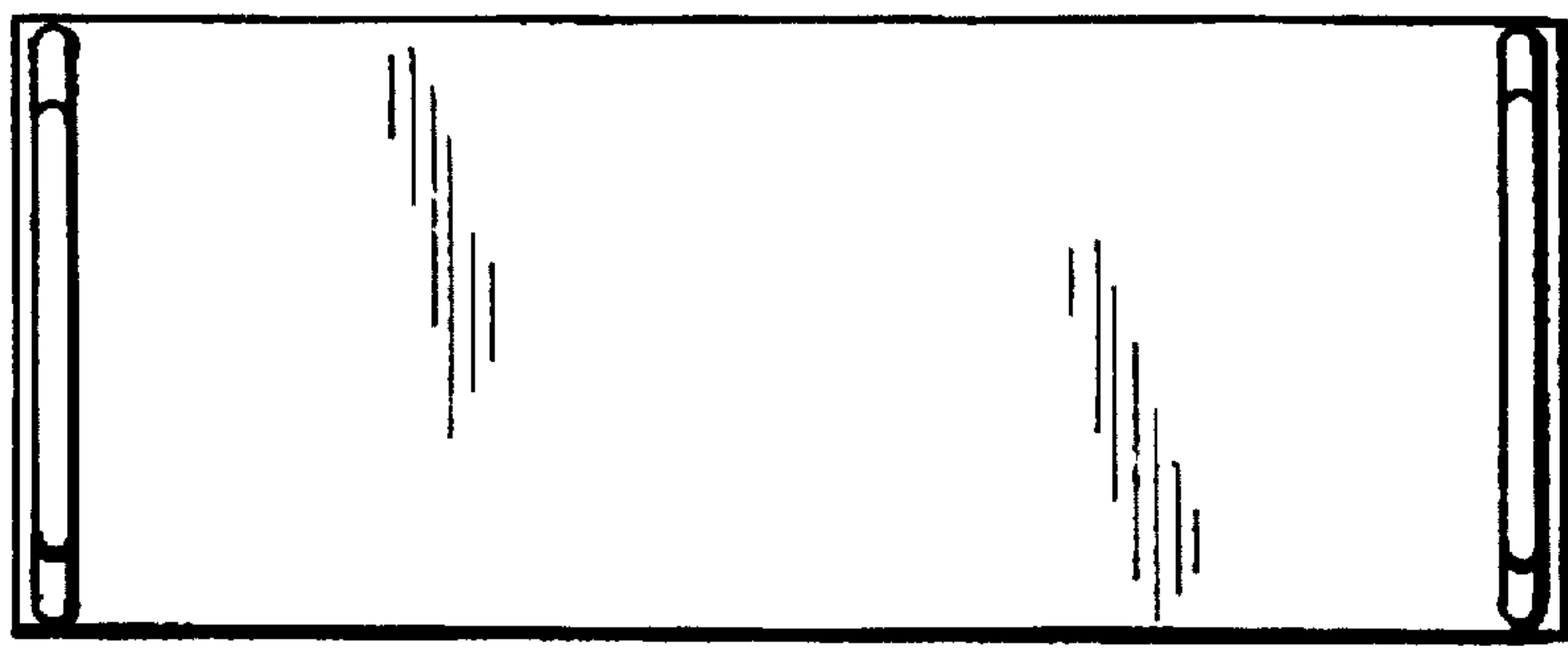
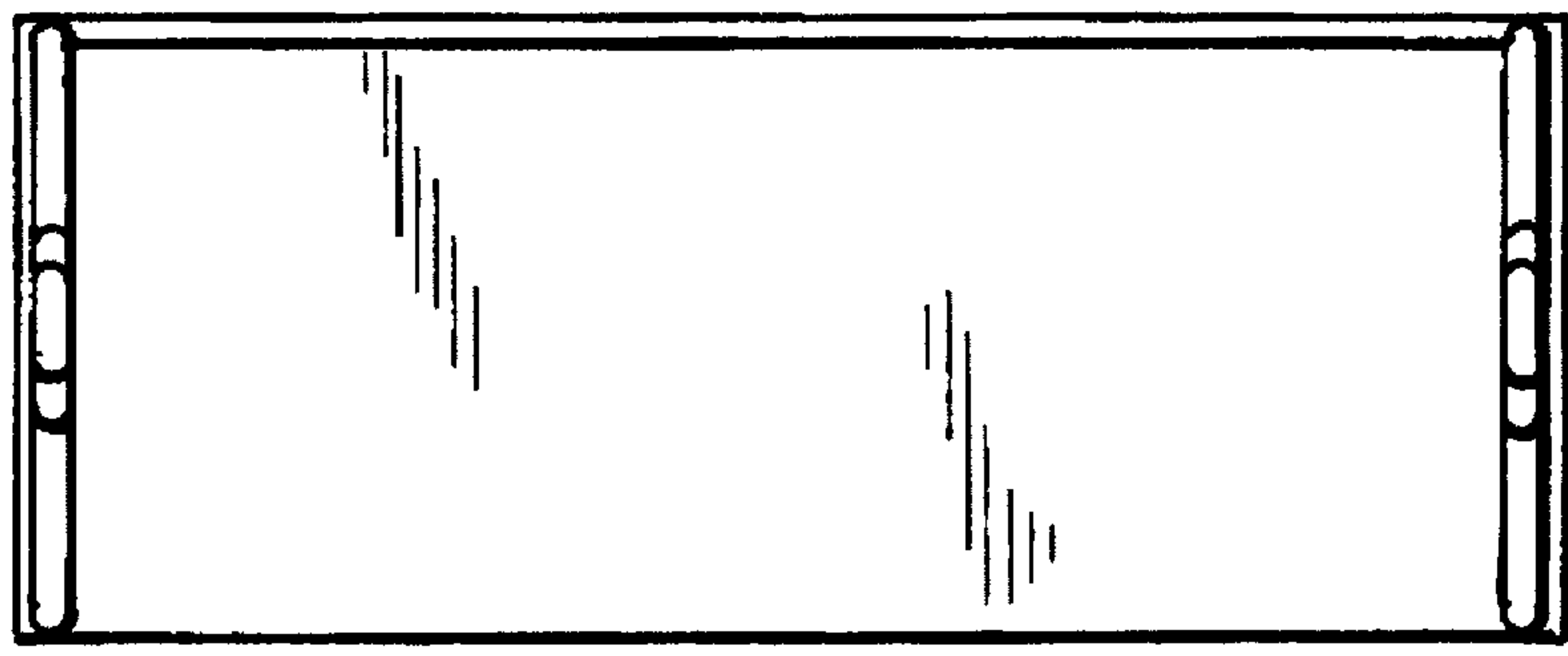

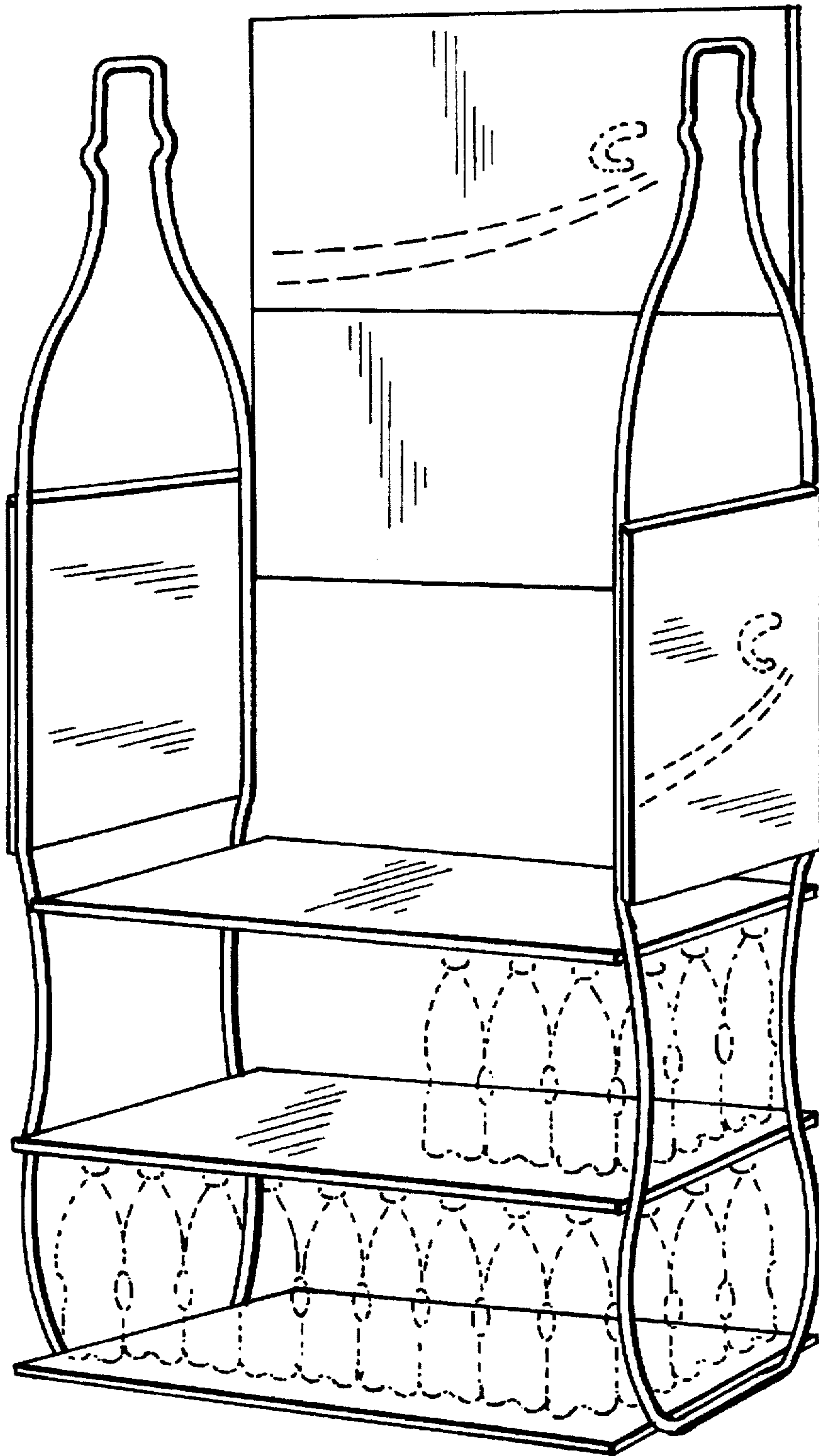
