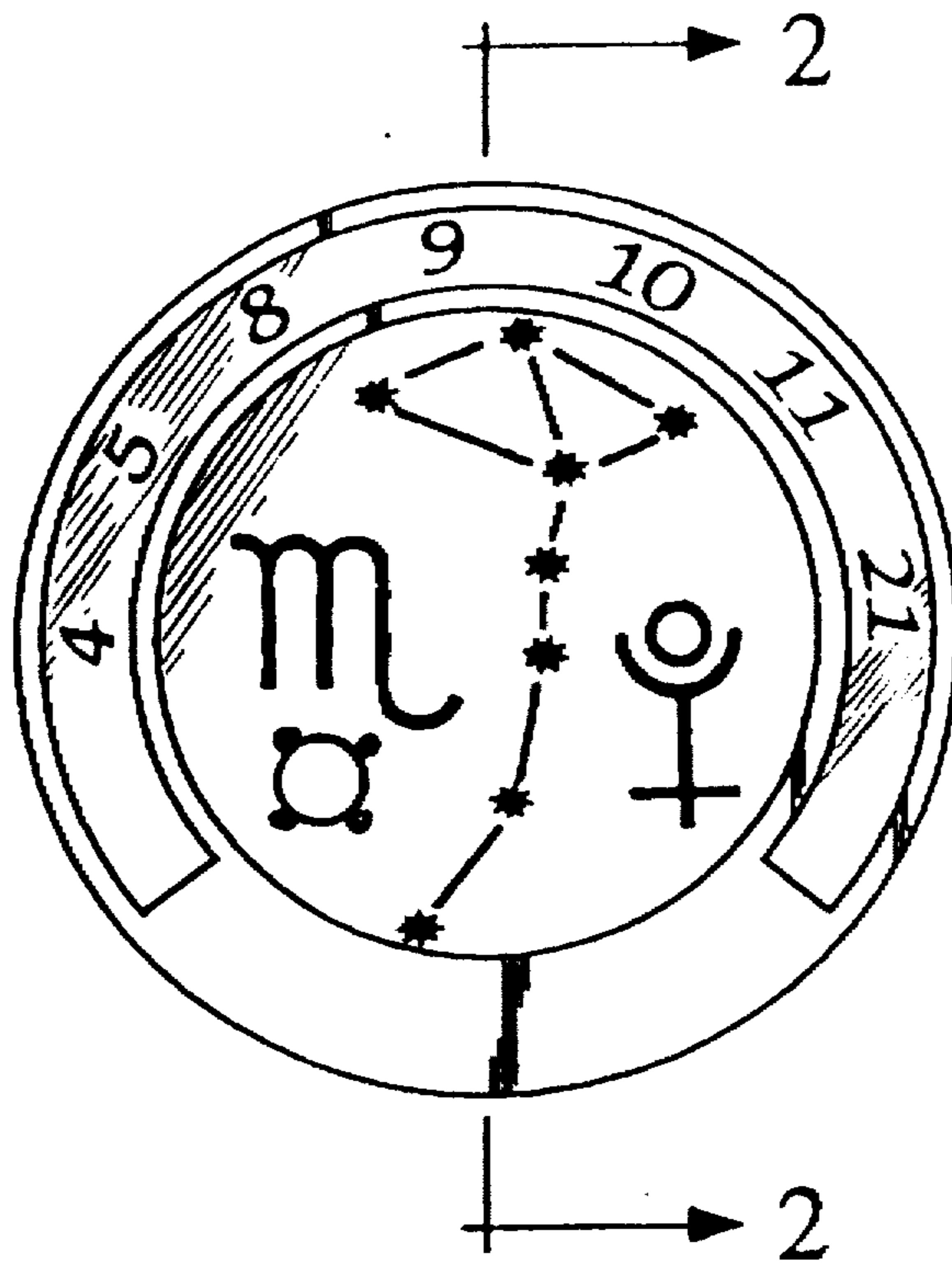
FIG. 1 is a front elevation of the talisman;

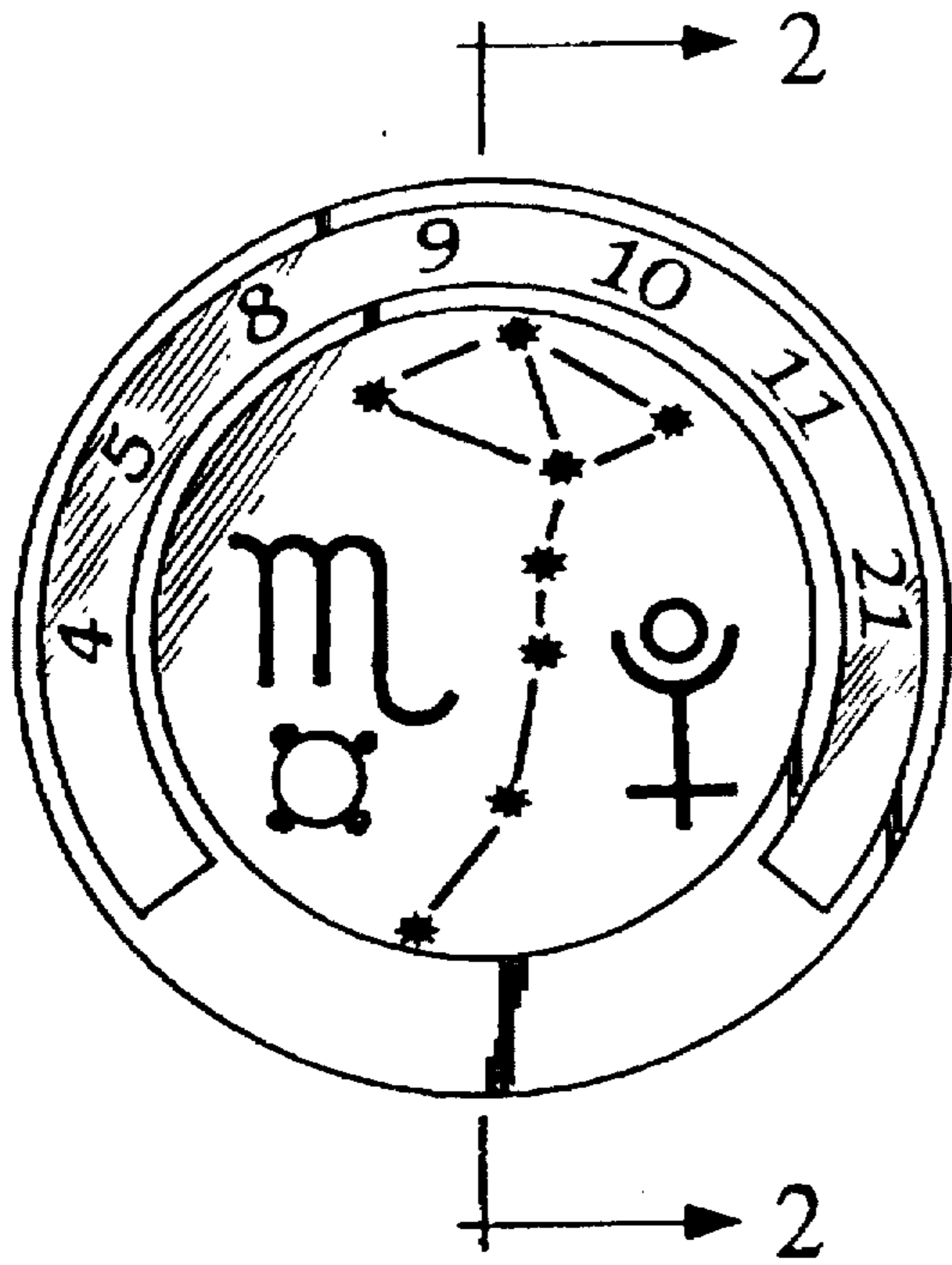

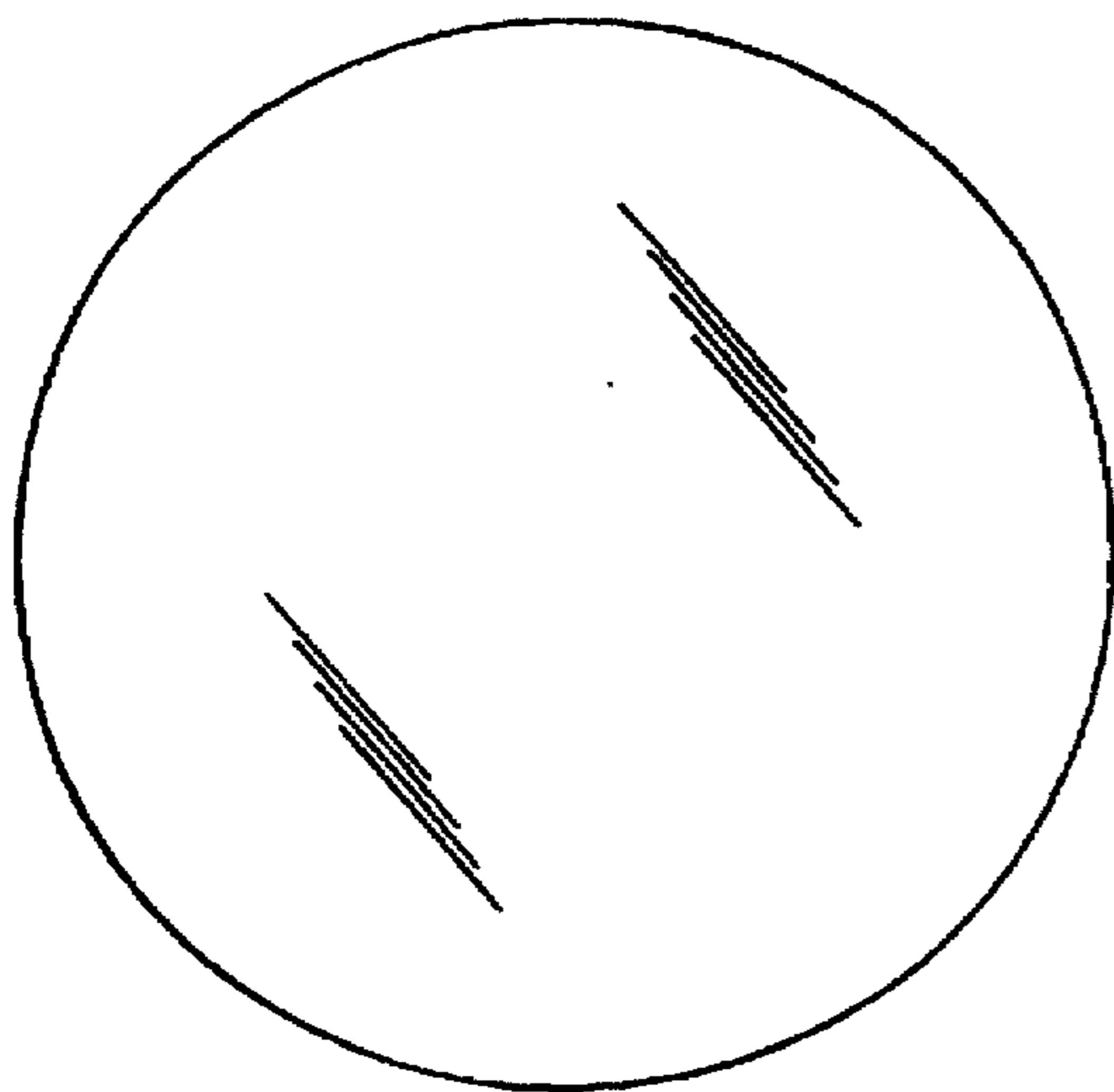
