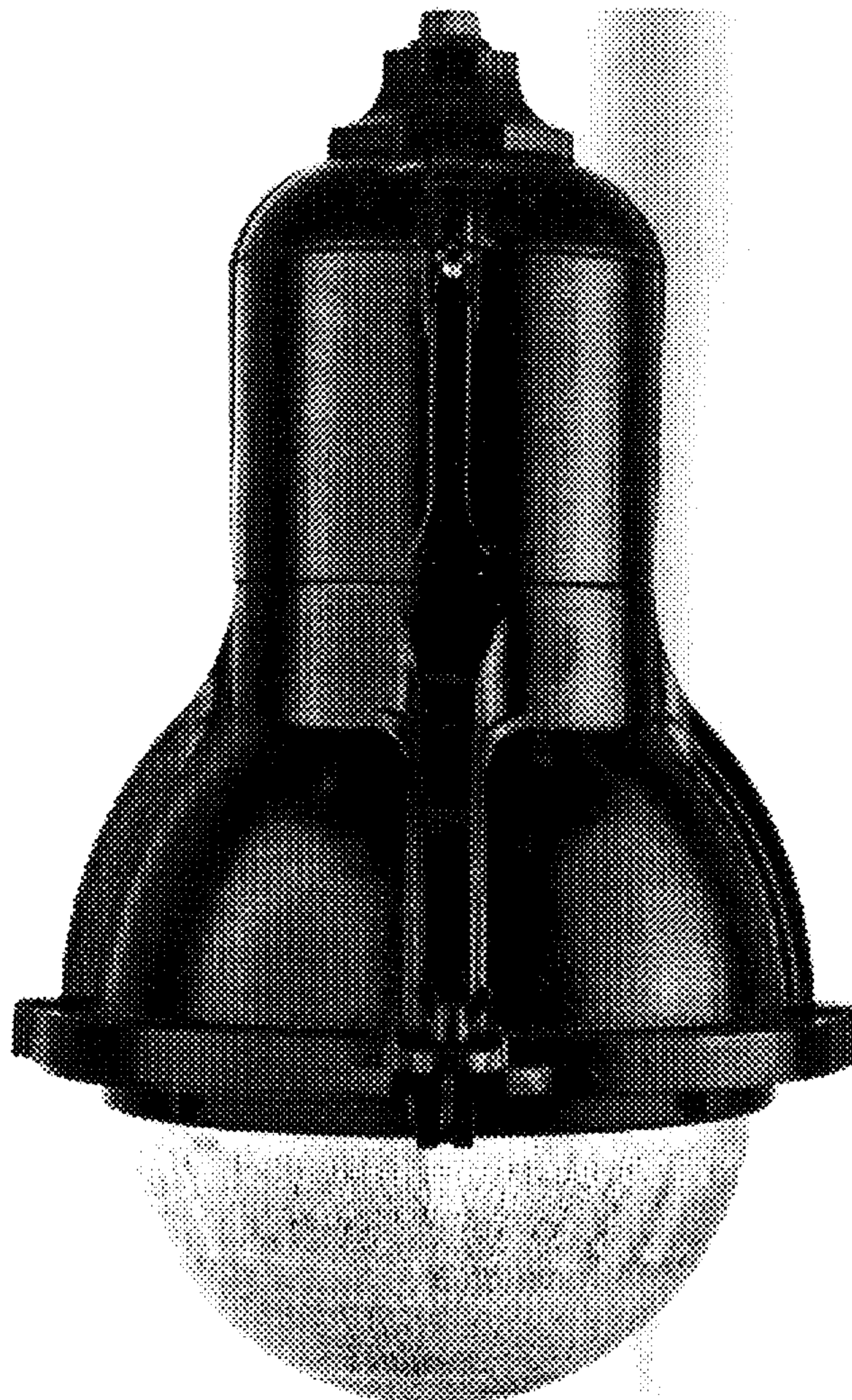
[57] CLAIM

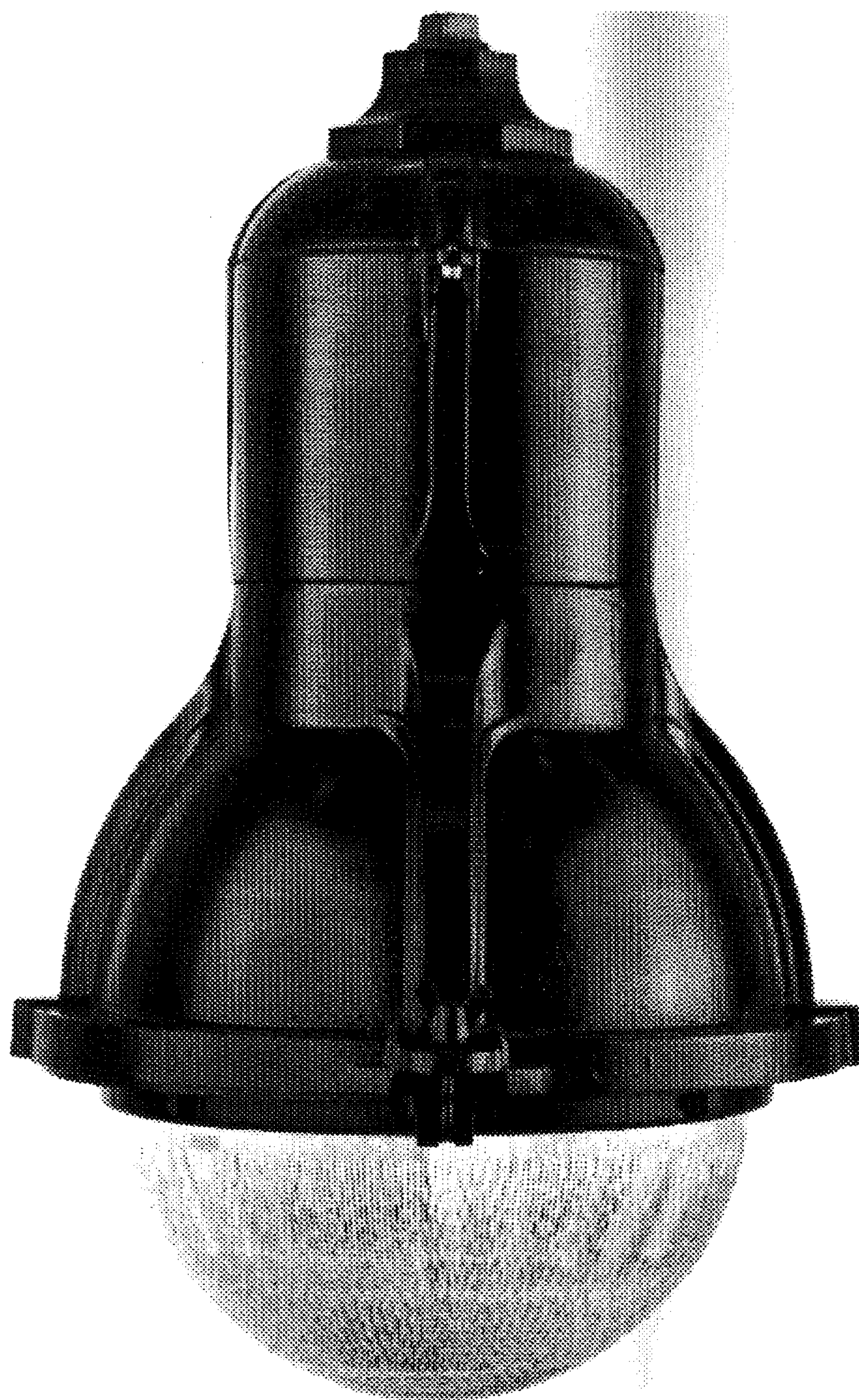

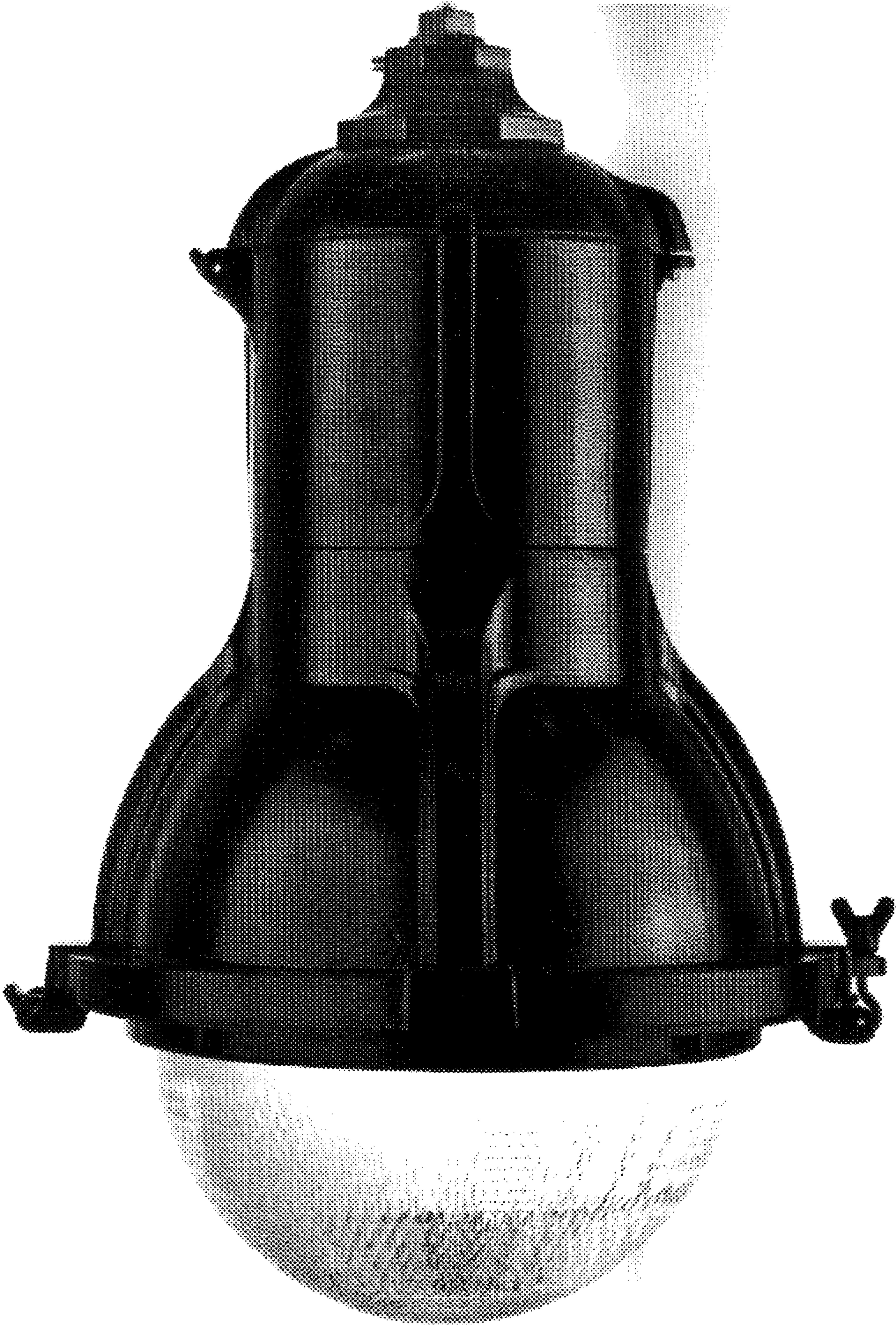

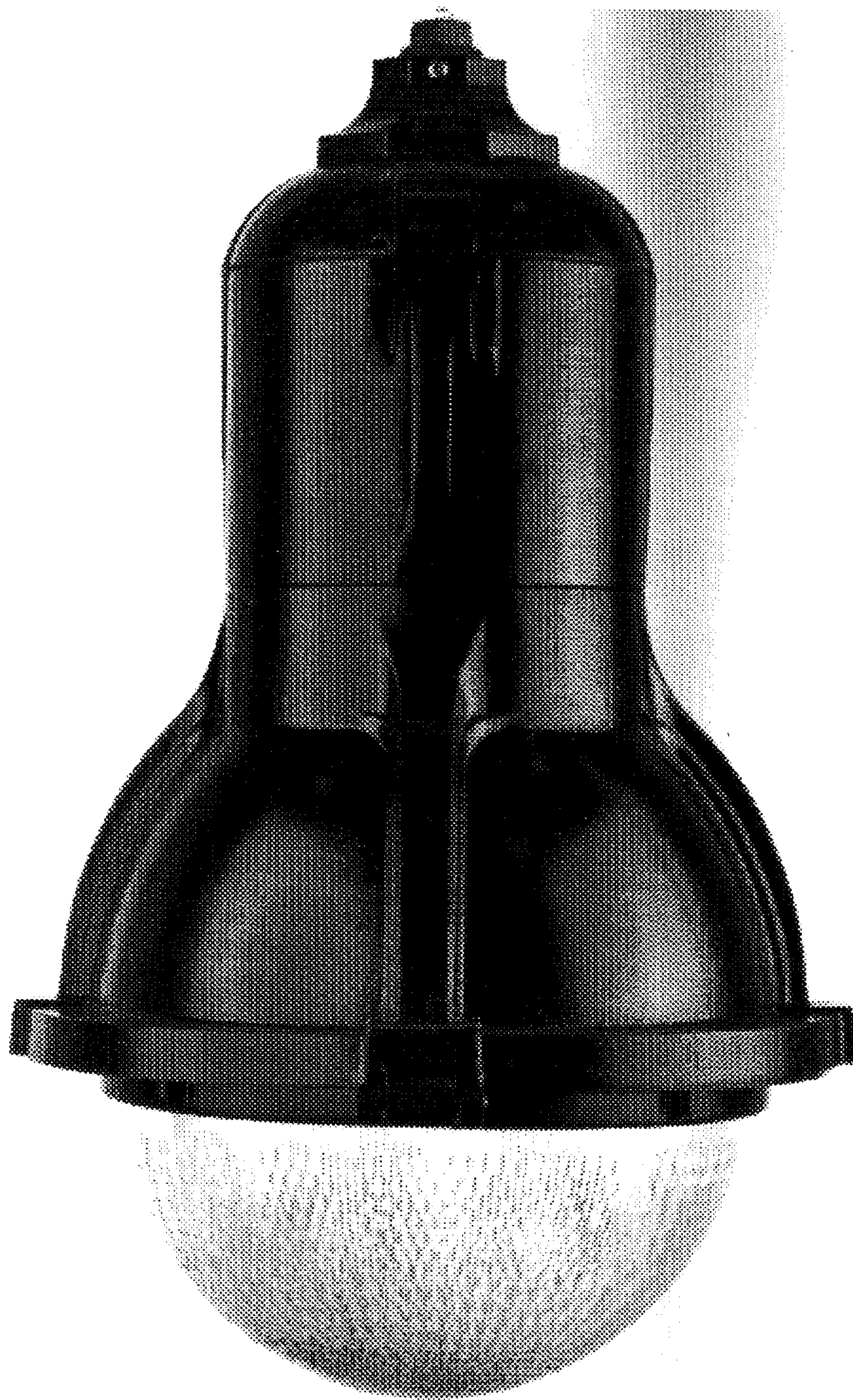

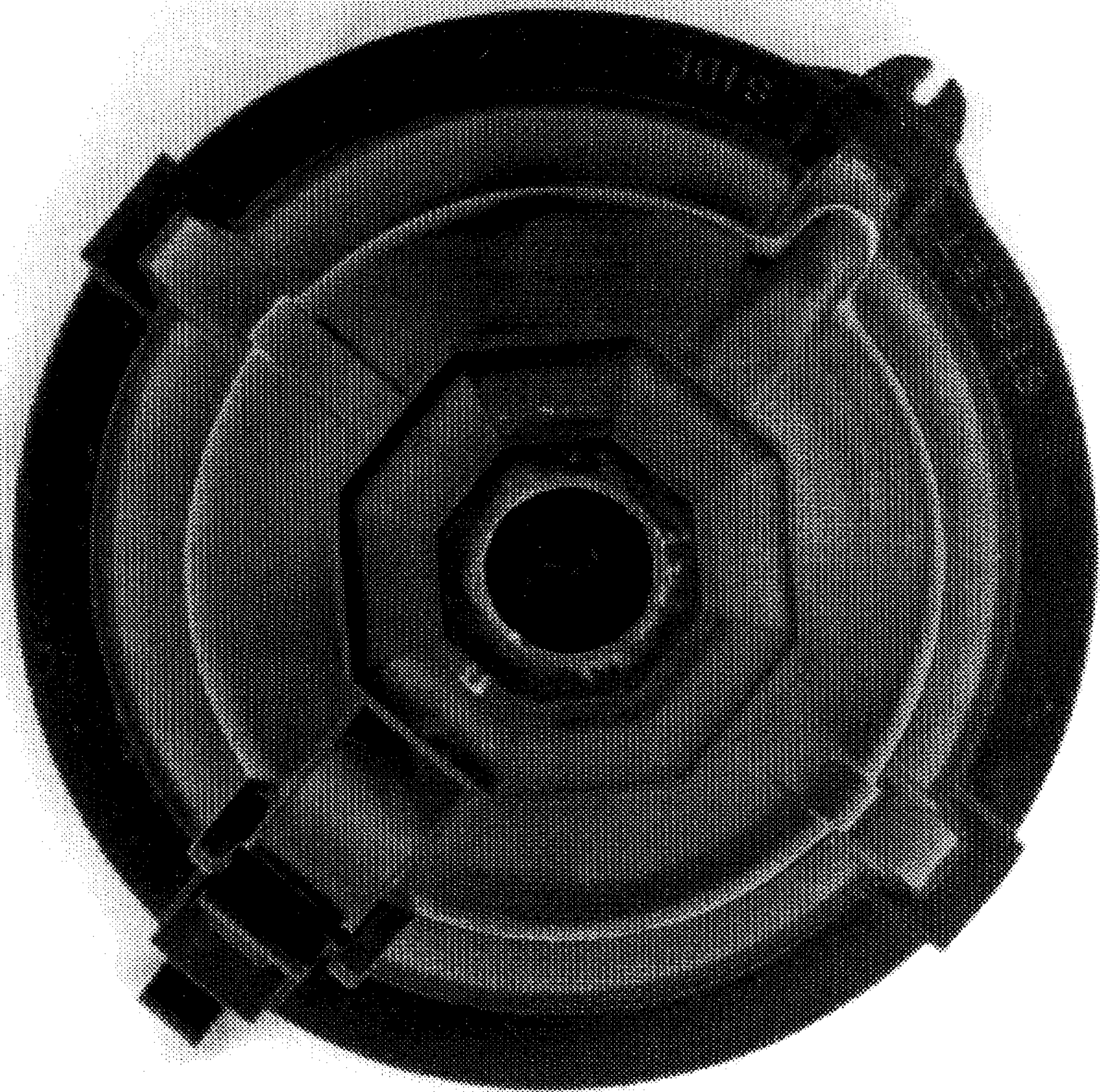
