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[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a molded bottle having integral pouring spout, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a molded bottle having integral pouring spout of the invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the molded bottle having integral pouring spout of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation of the molded bottle having integral pouring spout of FIGS. 1 and 2;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the molded bottle having integral pouring spout of FIGS. 1–3;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation of FIG. 1, the left side elevation is a mirror image thereto except for the conventional screw threading on the bottle neck;

FIG. 6 is a front elevation of a modified molded bottle having integral pouring spout, having a cylindrical neck portion, constituting another embodiment of the invention;

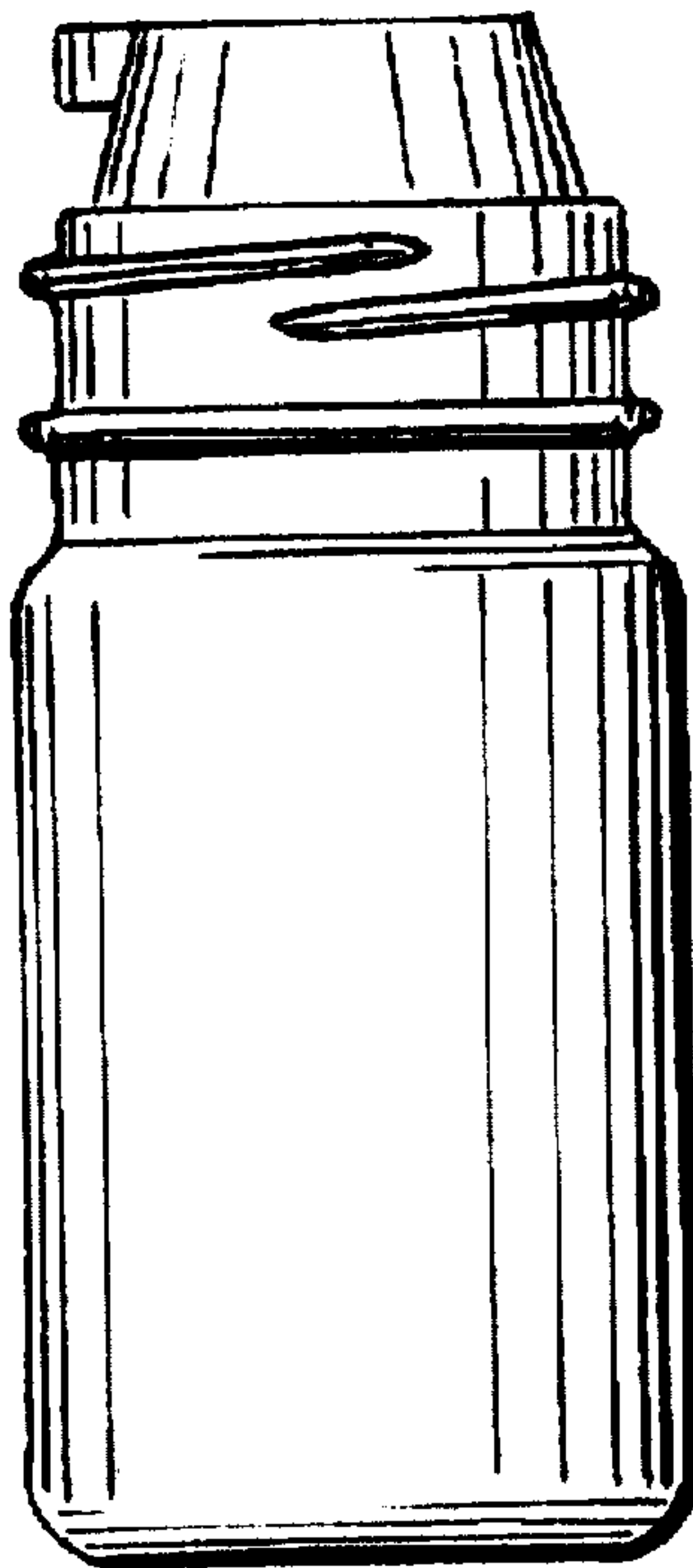
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the molded bottle having integral pouring spout of FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevation of the molded bottle having integral pouring spout of FIGS. 6 and 7;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the molded bottle having integral pouring spout of FIGS. 6–8; and,

FIG. 10 is a right side elevation of FIG. 6, the left side elevation is a mirror image thereto except for the conventional screw threading on the bottle neck.

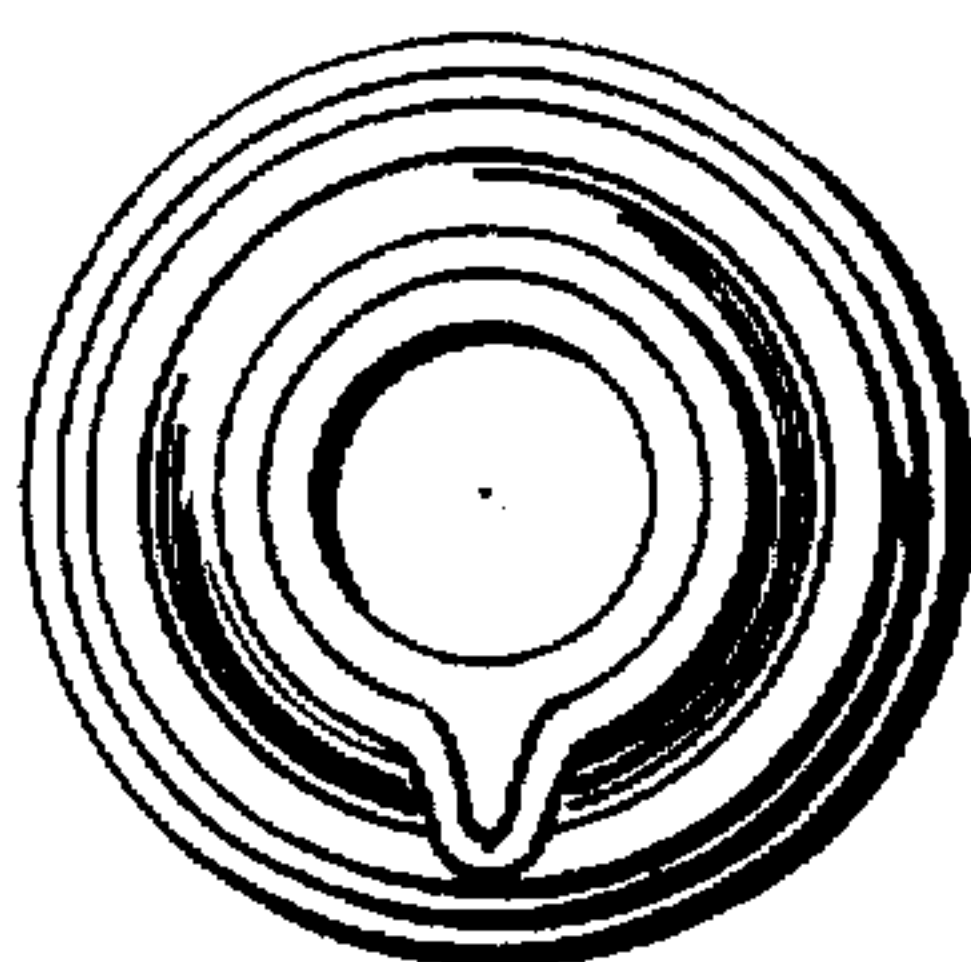

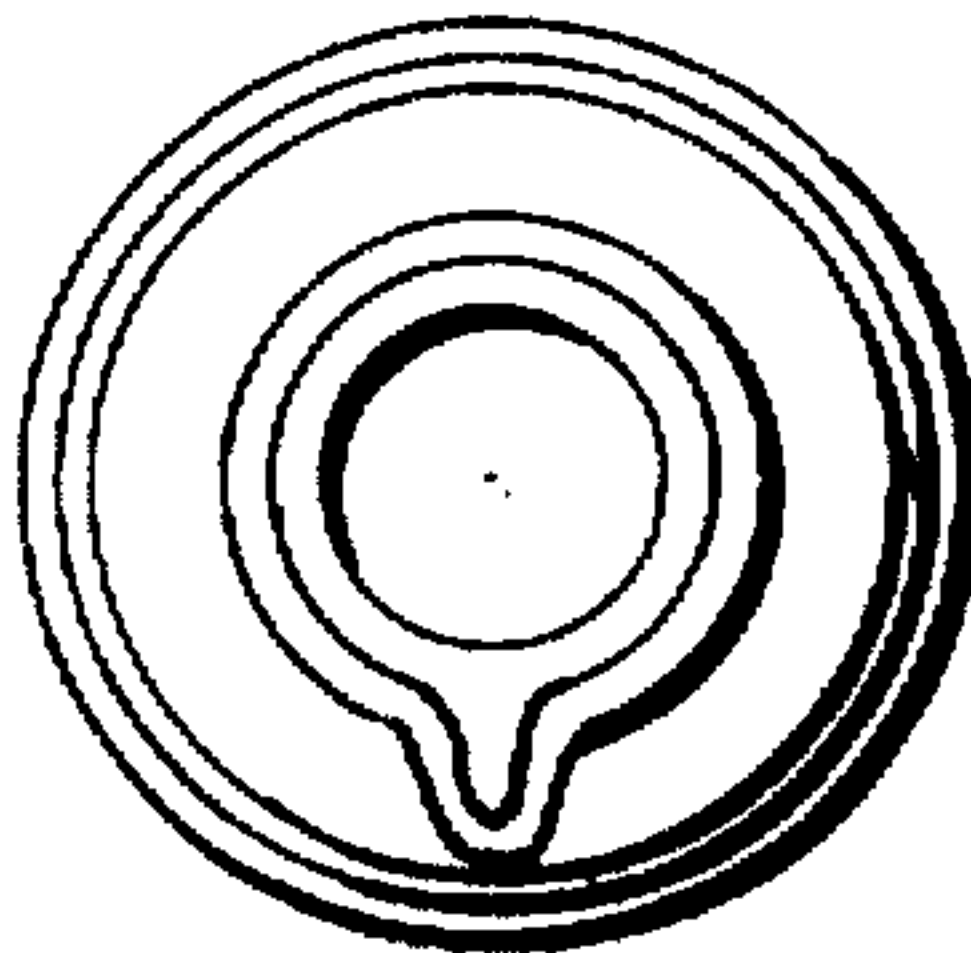

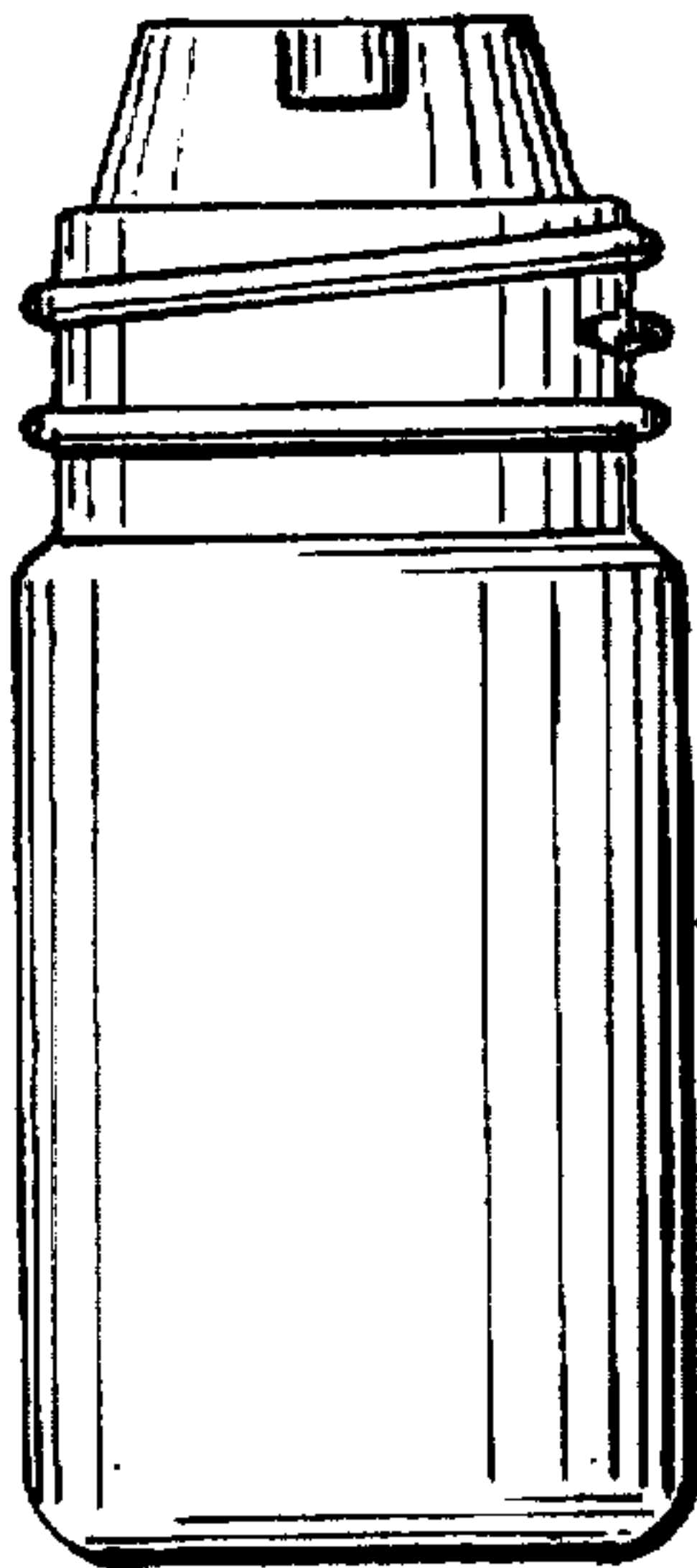

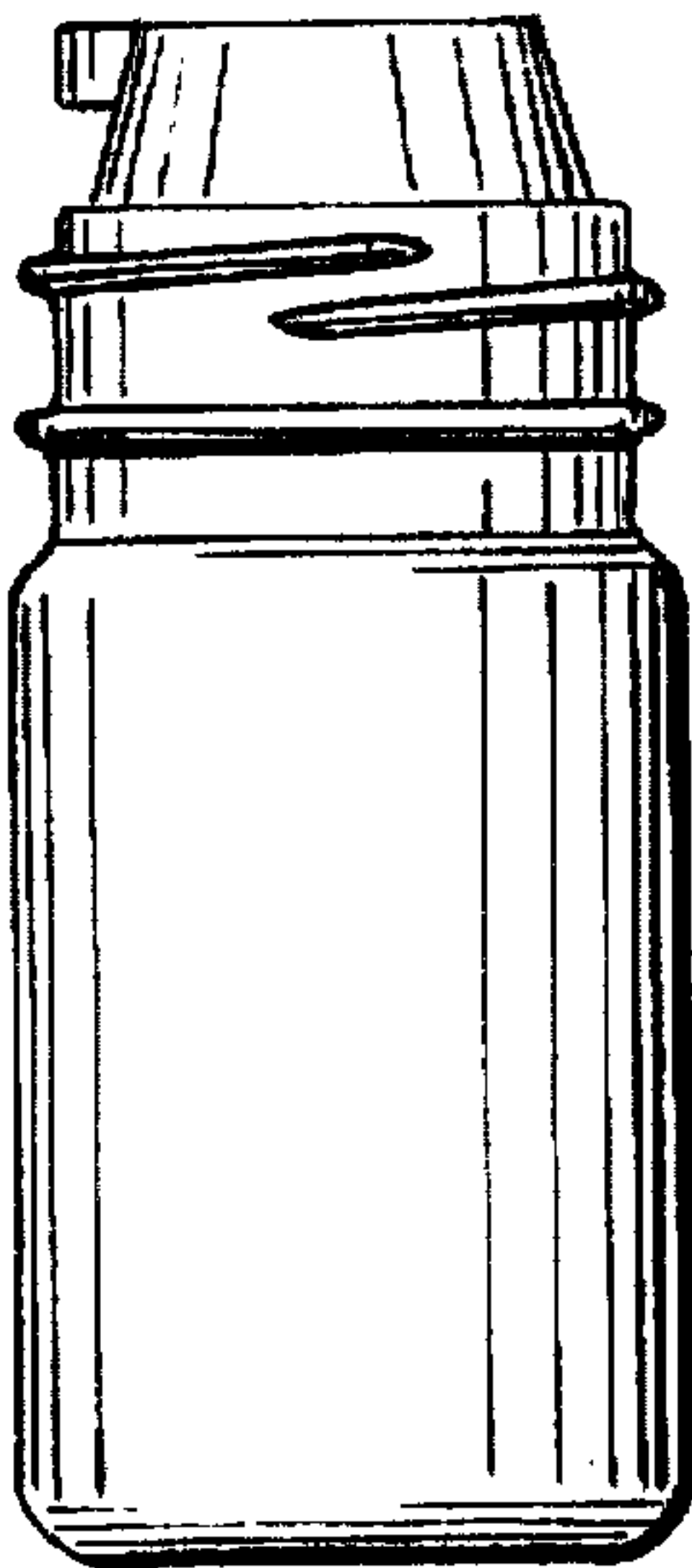

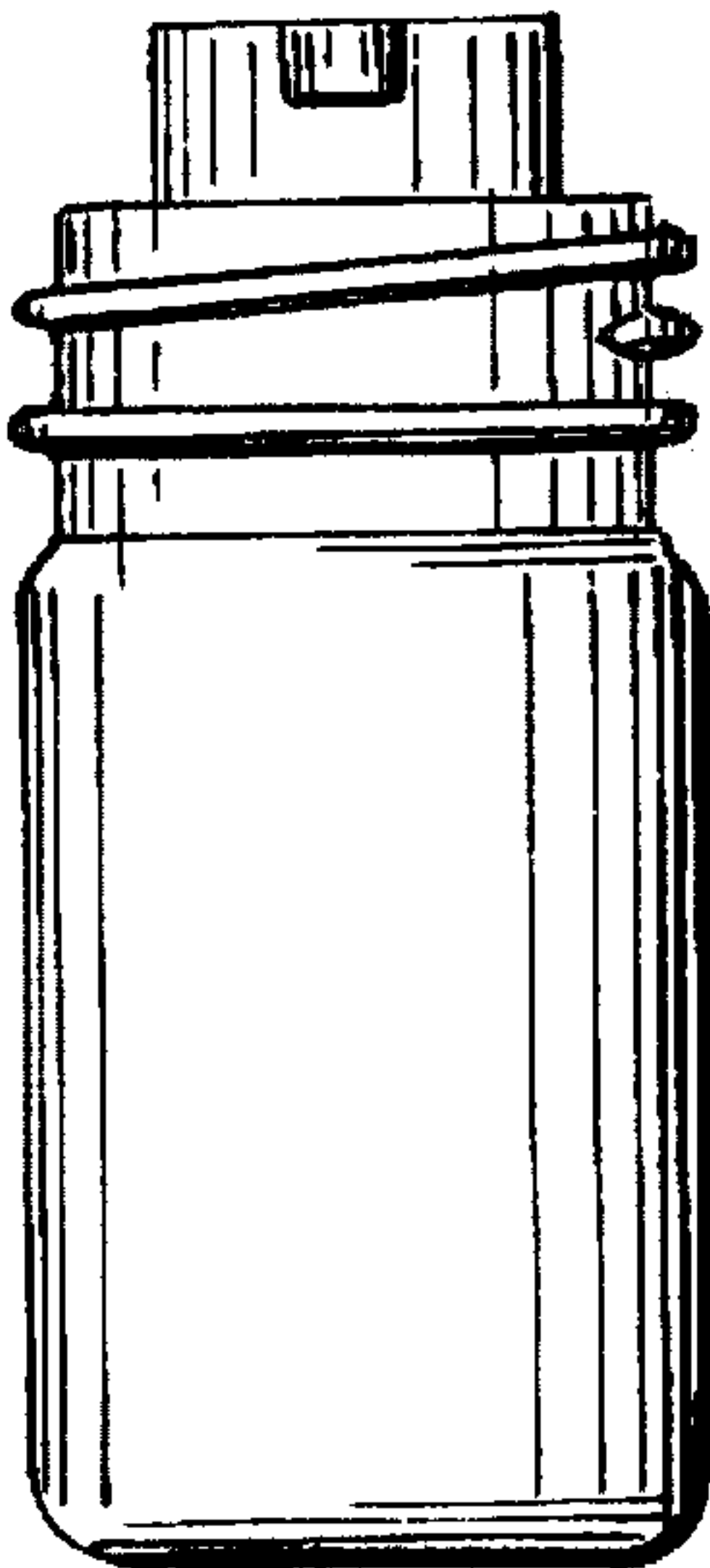

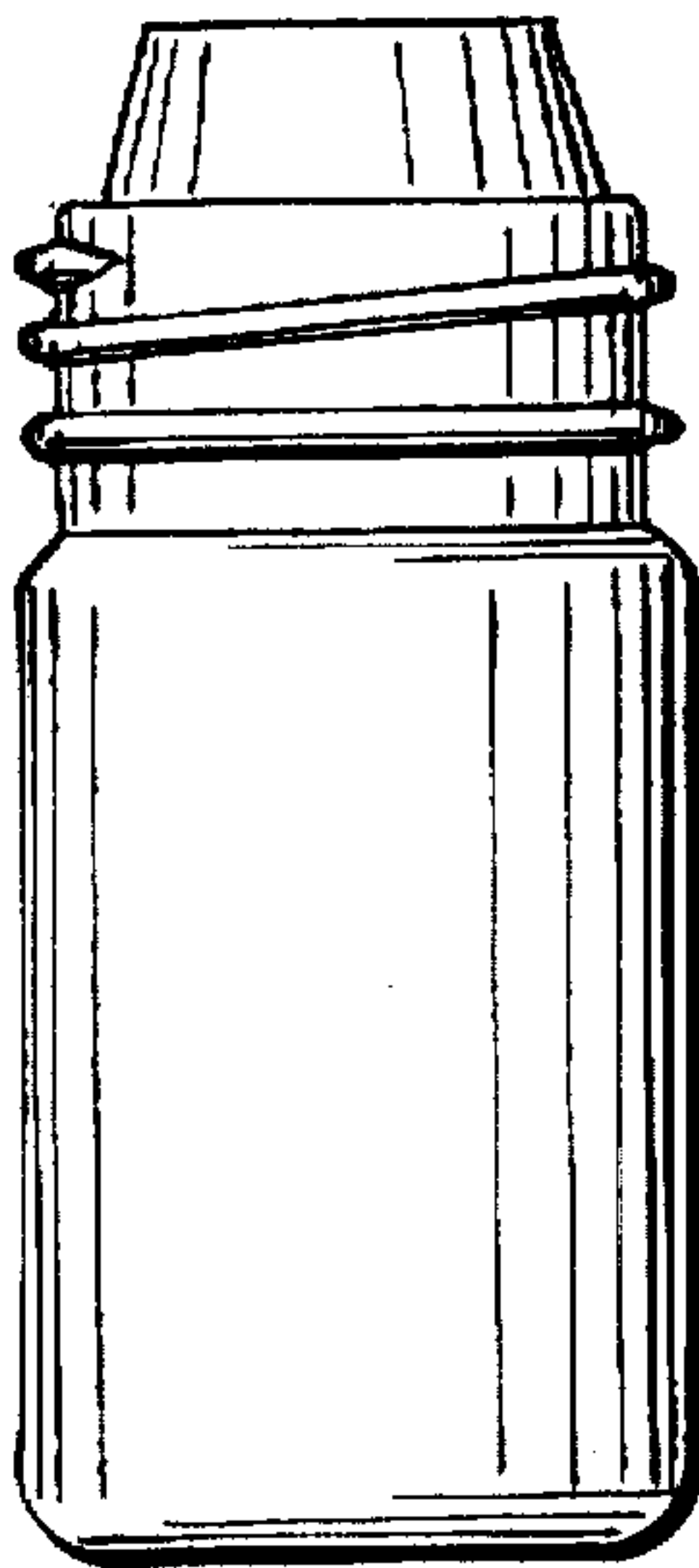

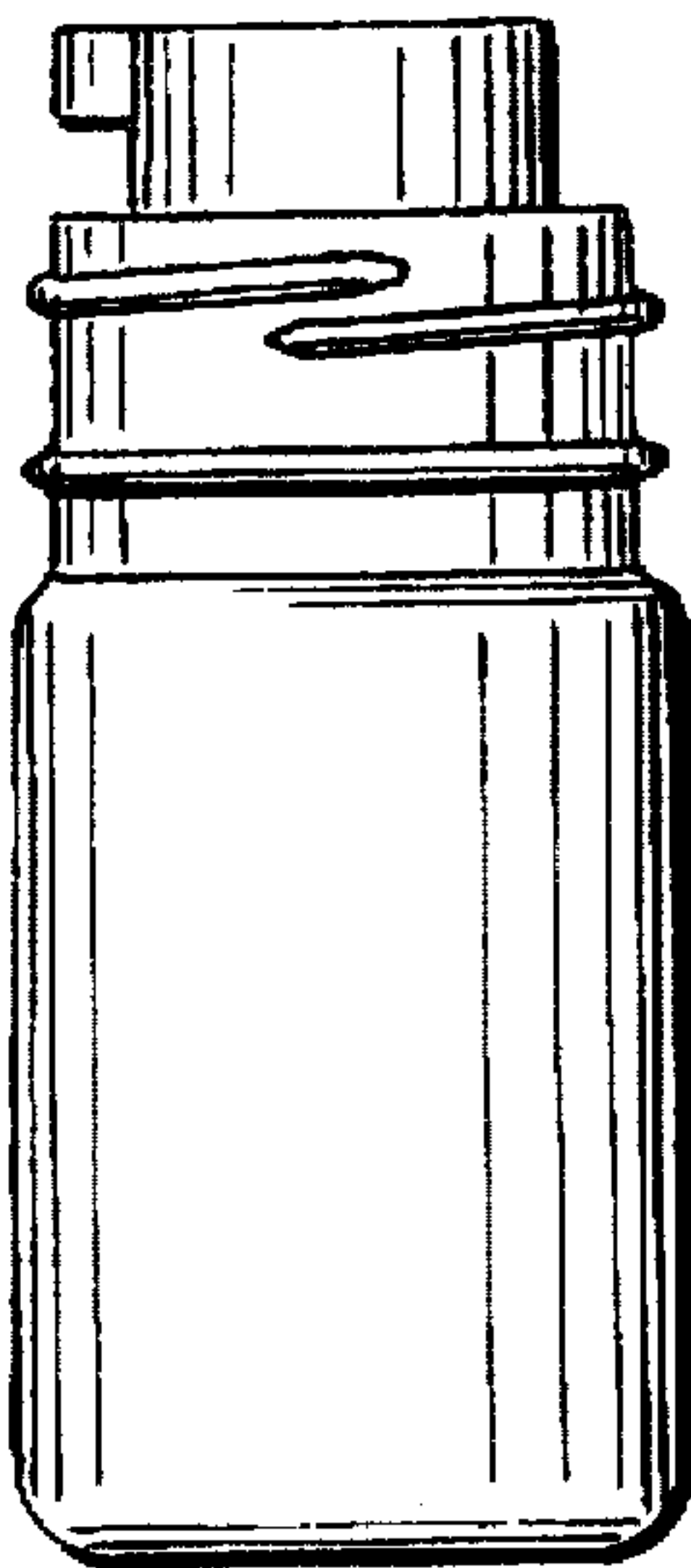

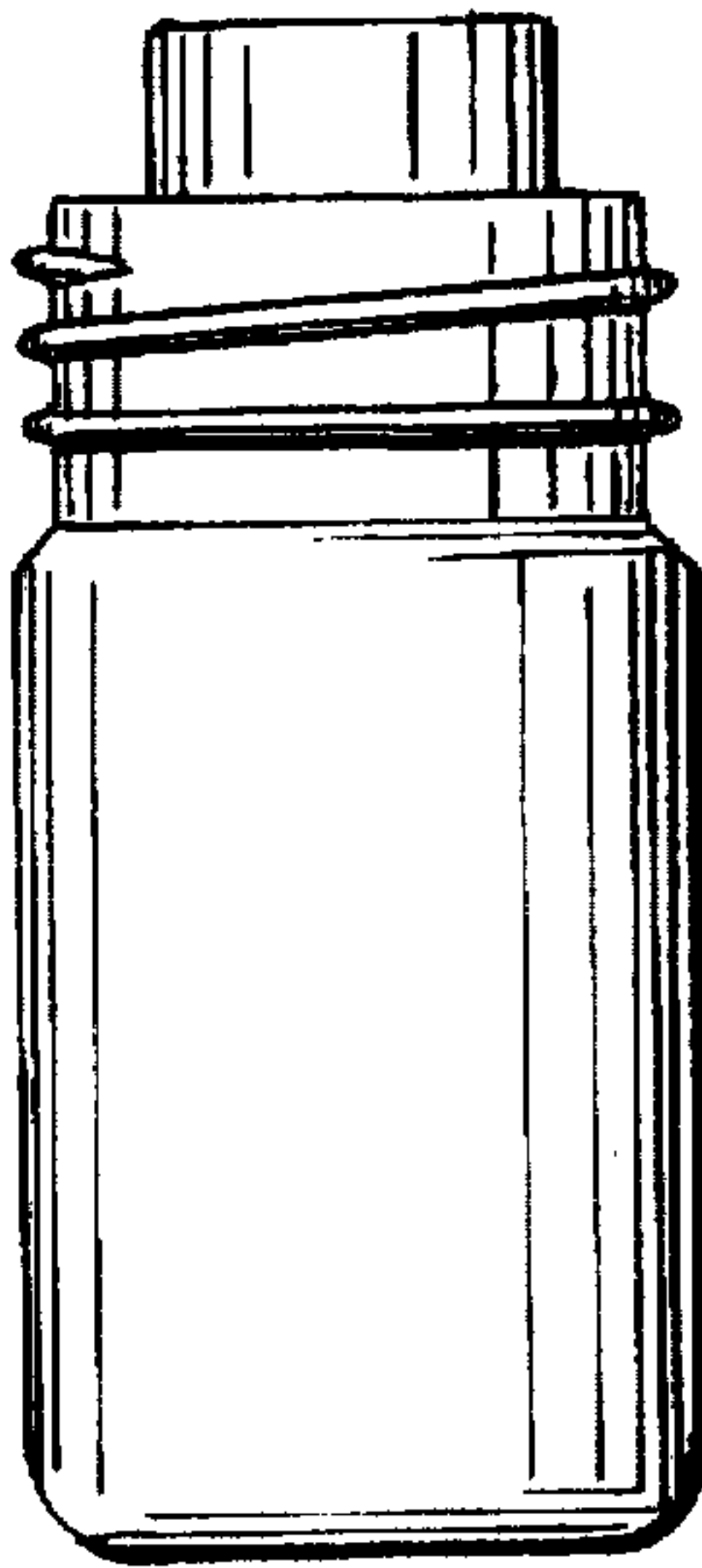

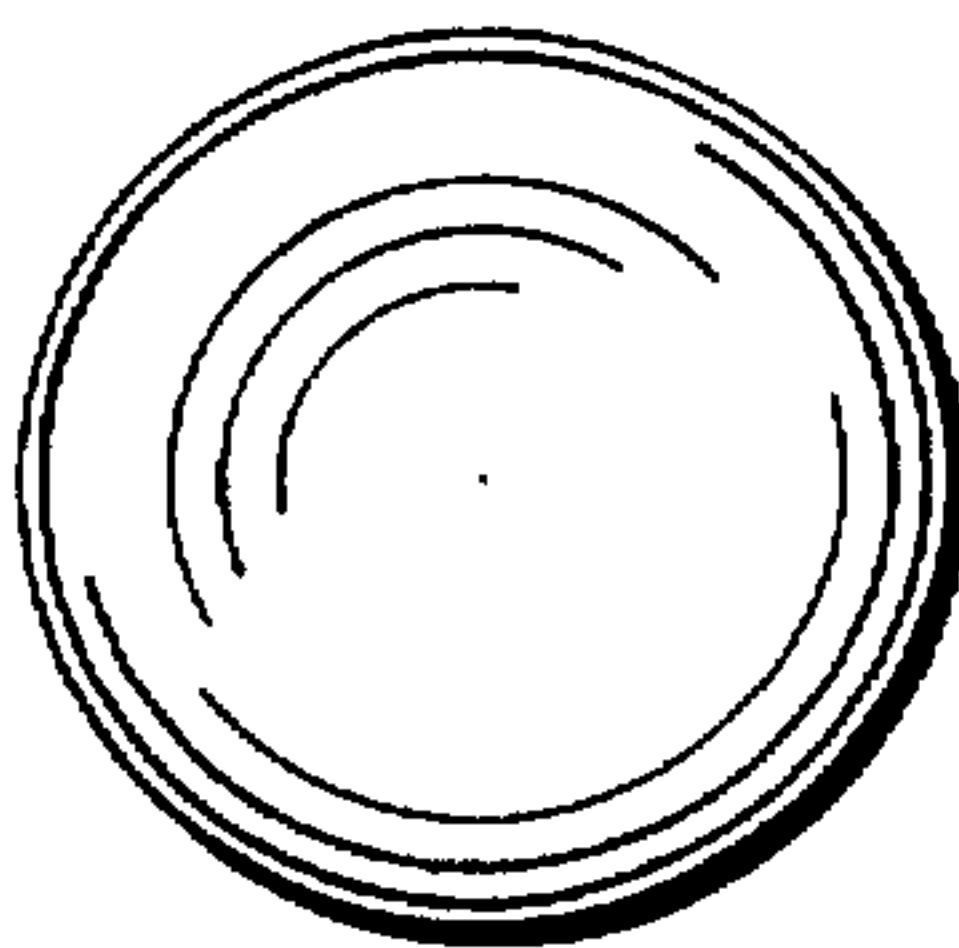

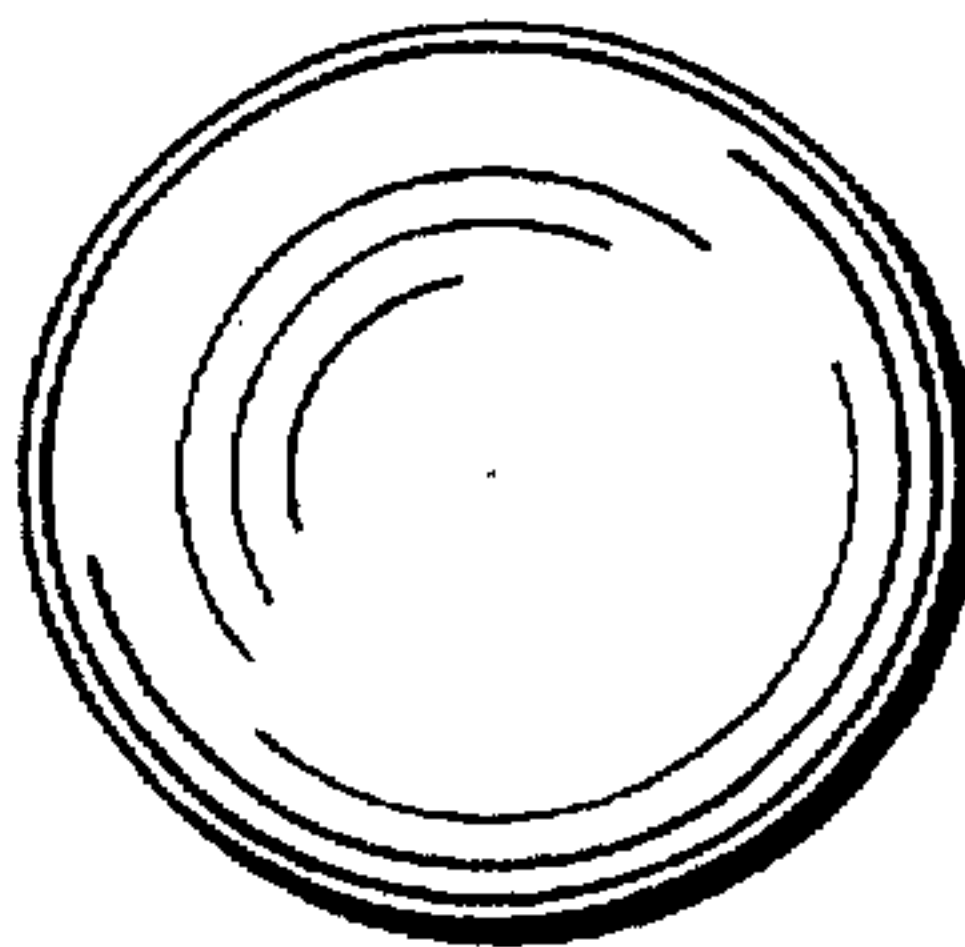
