FIG. 1 is a left side view of a device for an indicator for locating proximity sensors showing my new design, with the wires broken away to indicate indeterminate length;

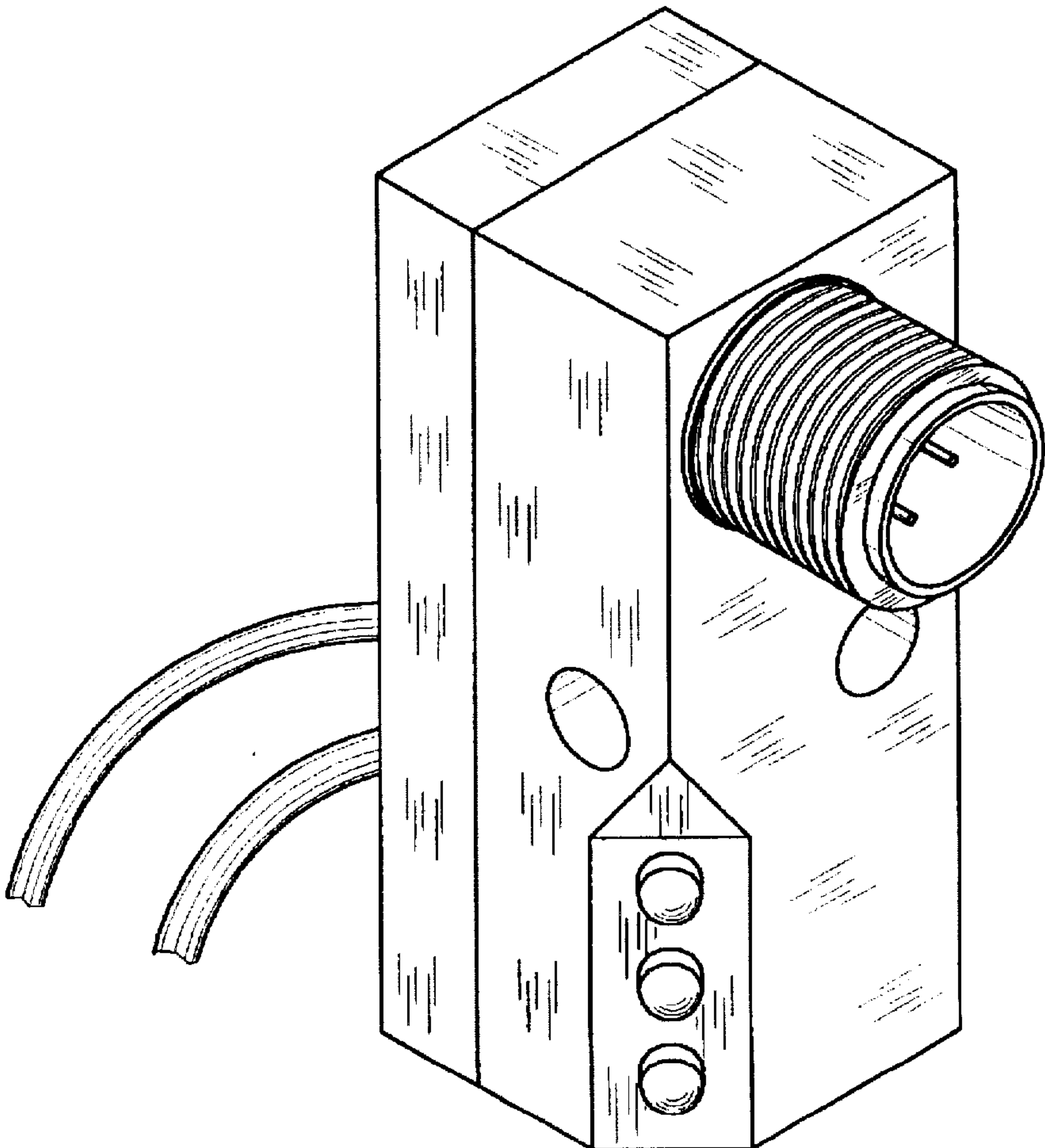

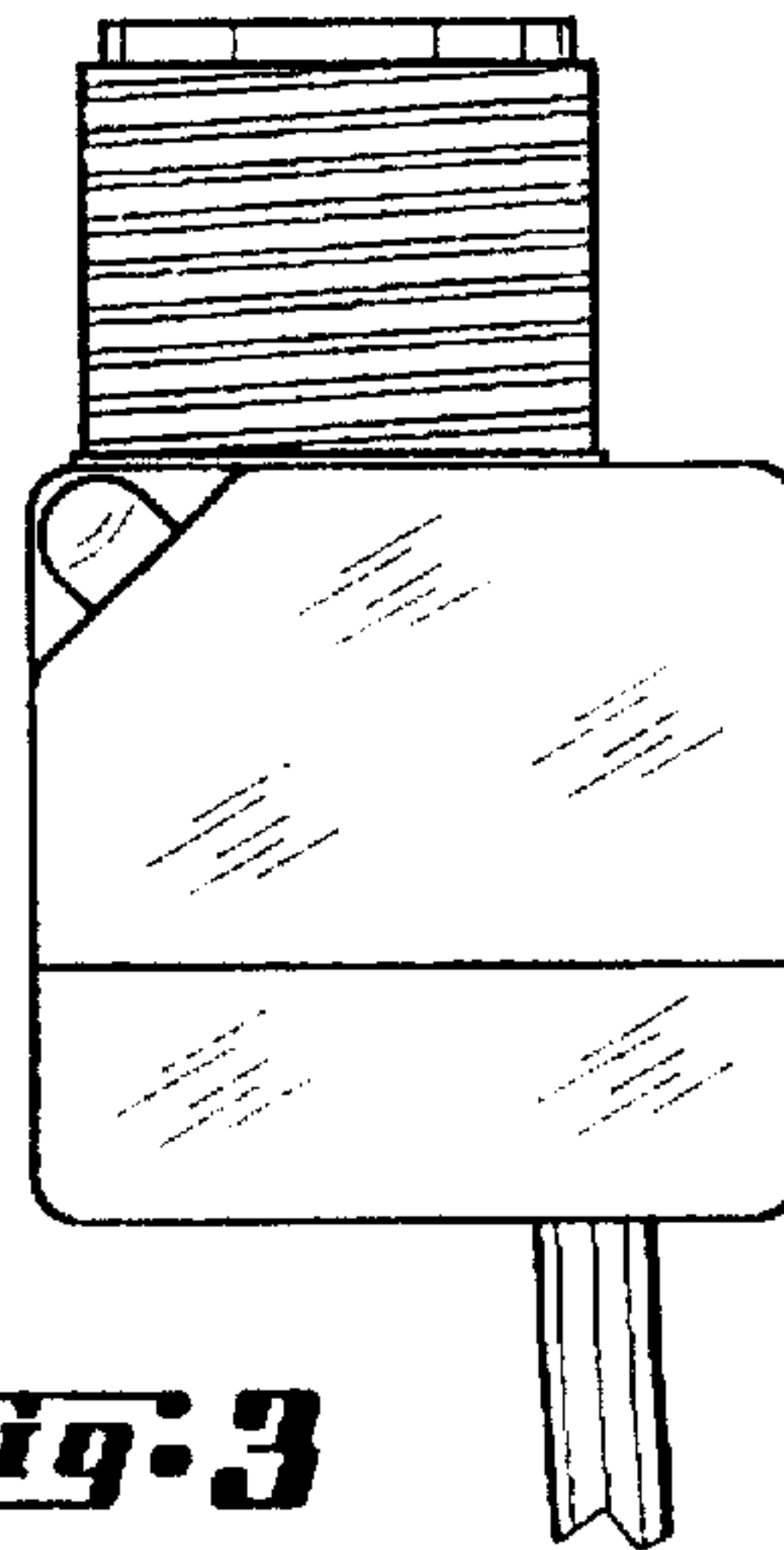

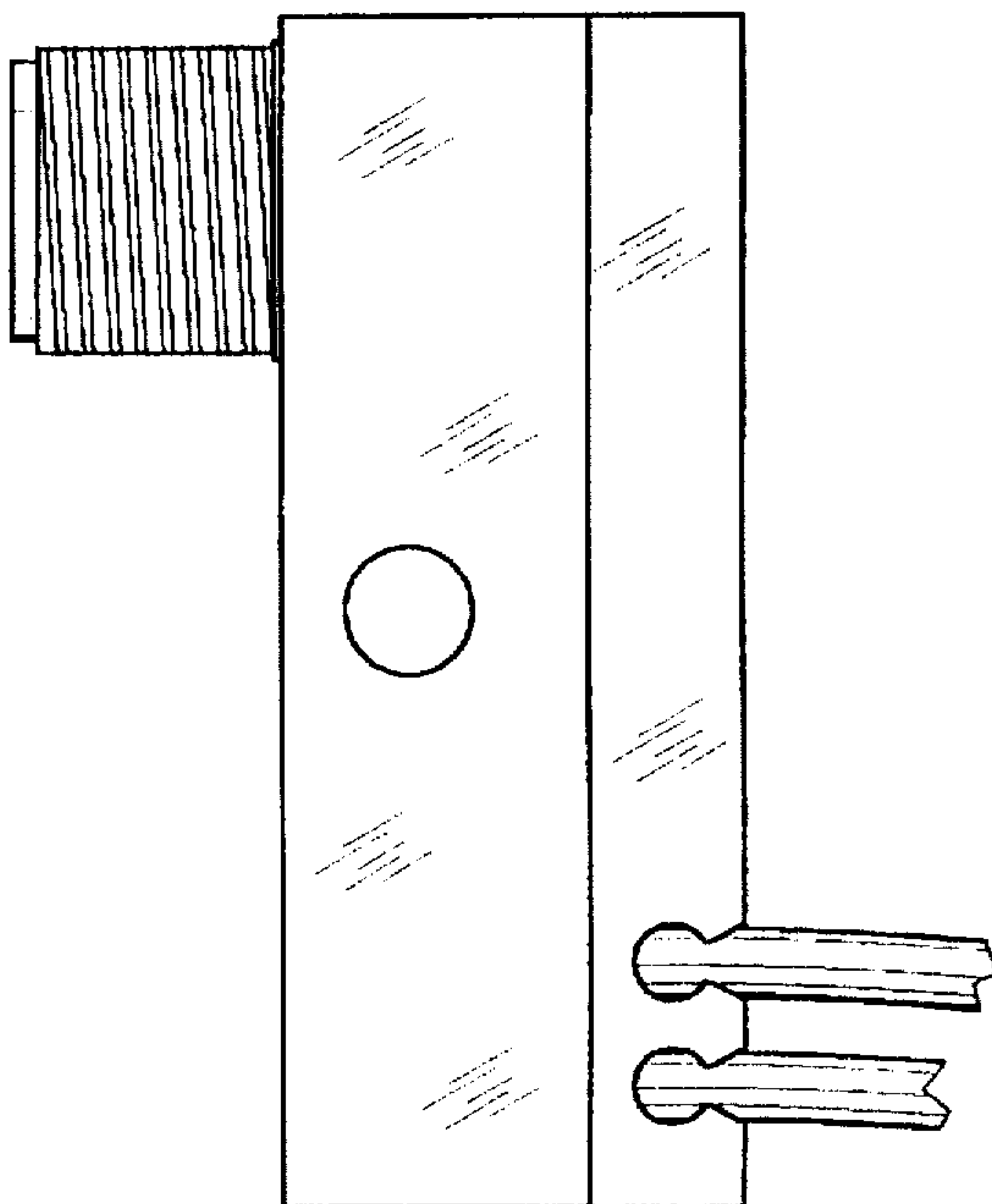

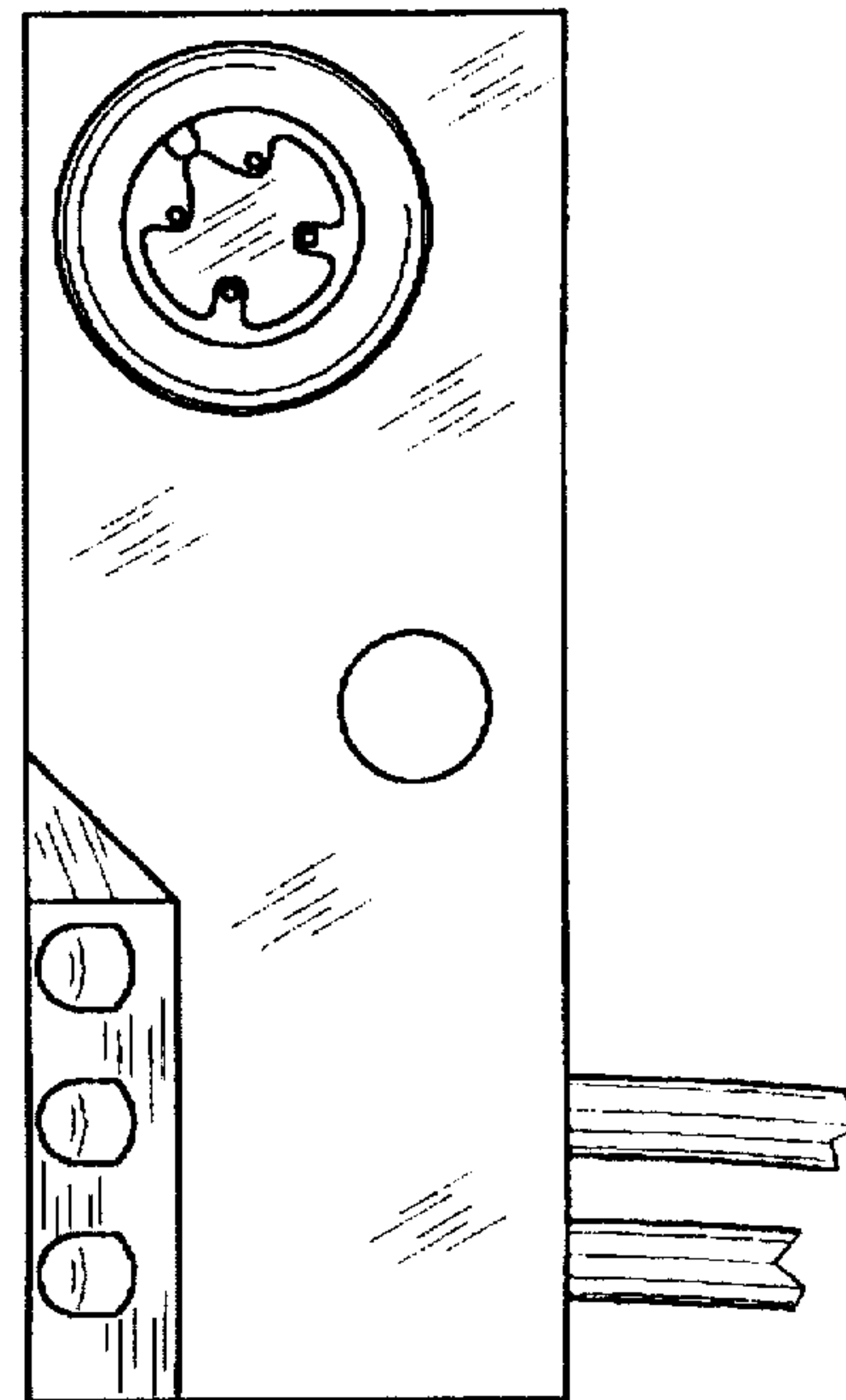

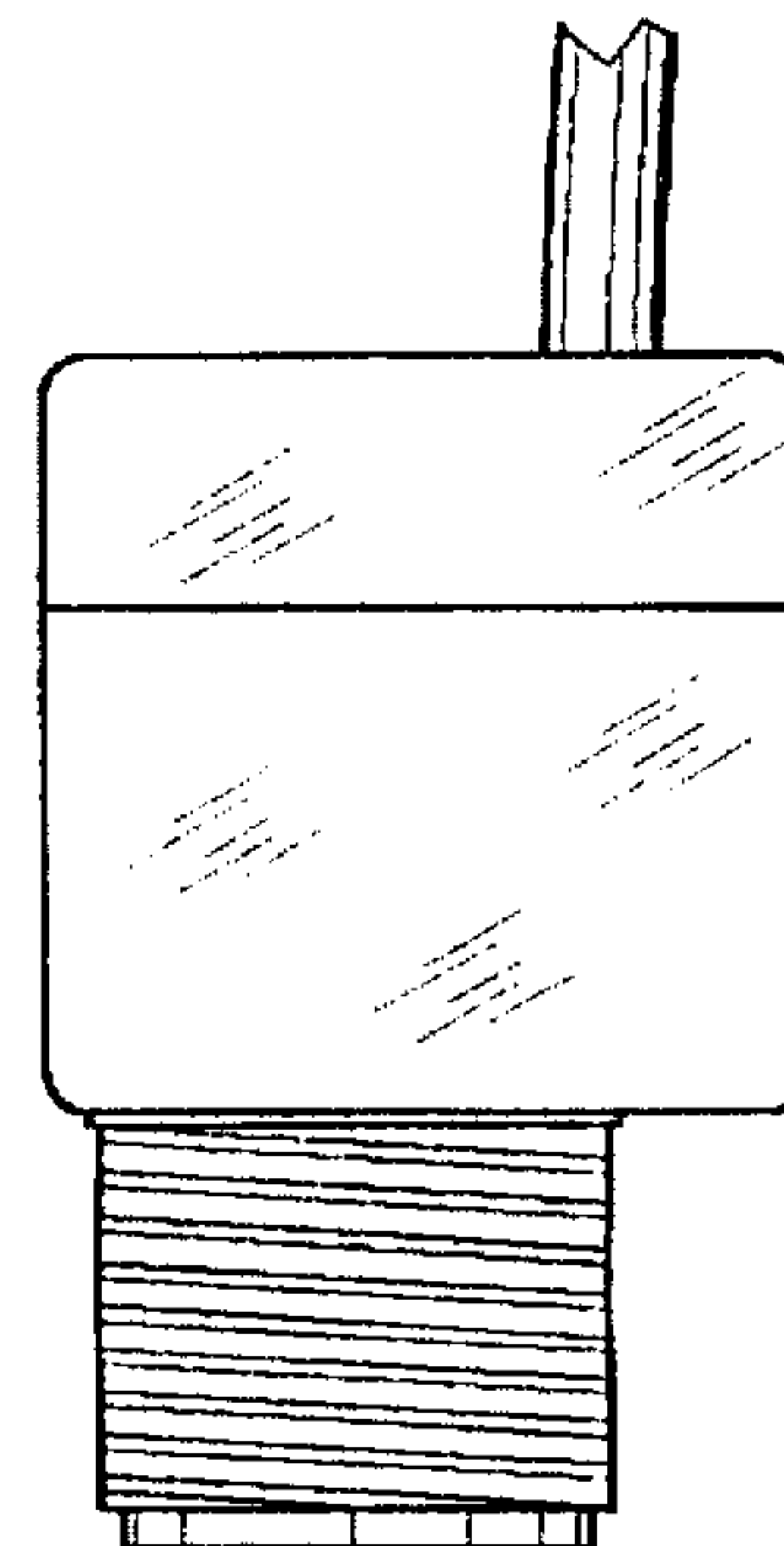

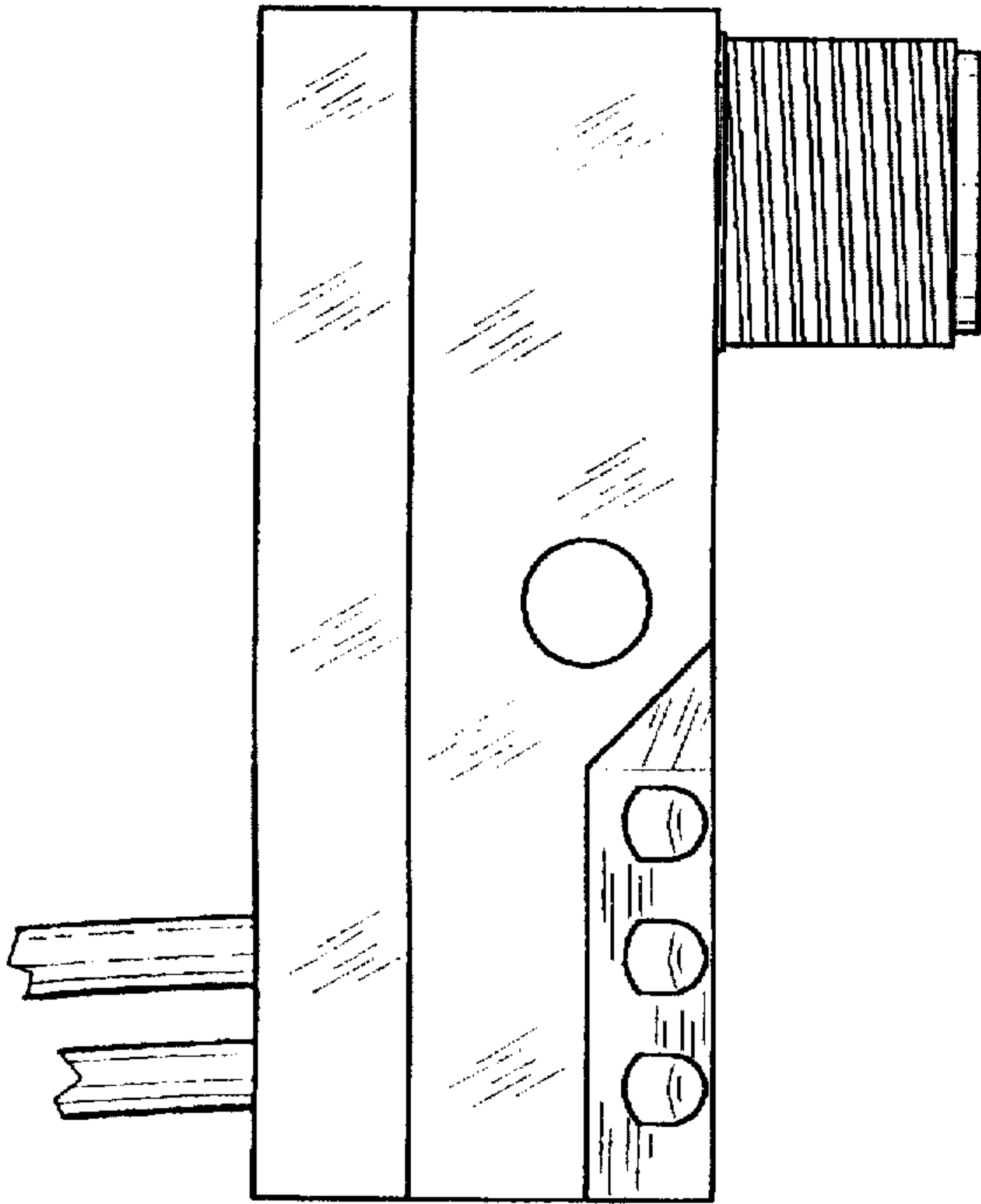

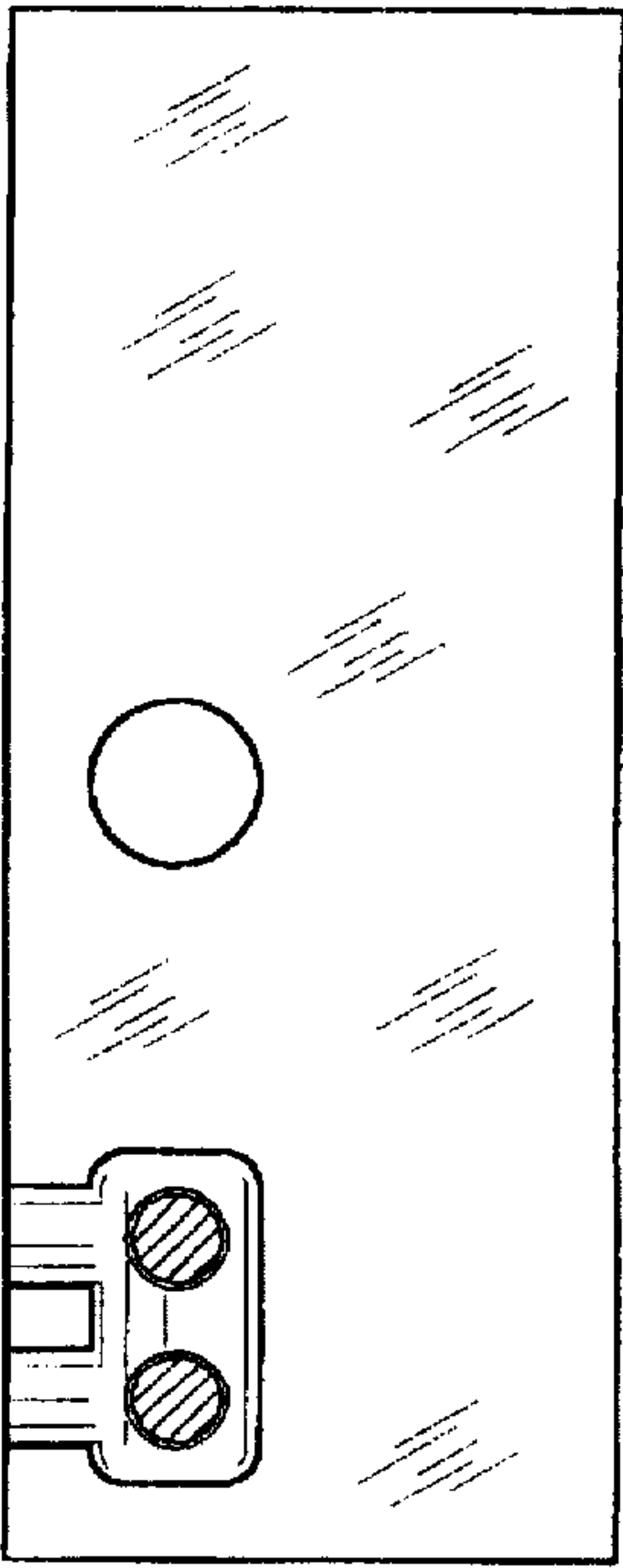
