The ornamental design for a garden ornament, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front-left perspective view of a garden ornament showing our new design;

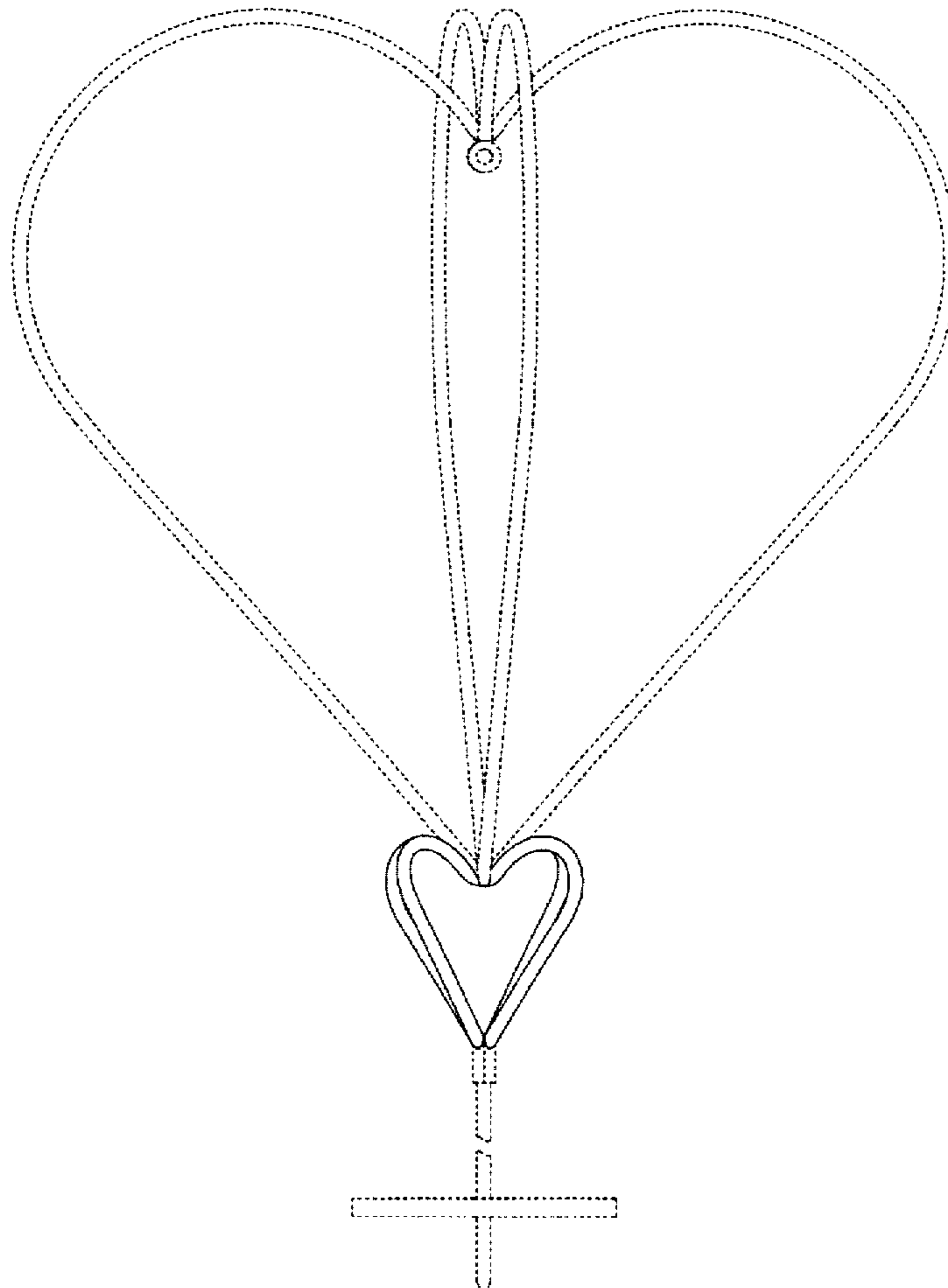
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front-elevational view thereof, and is the same as a rear-elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a right-elevational view thereof, and is the same as a left-elevational view thereof.

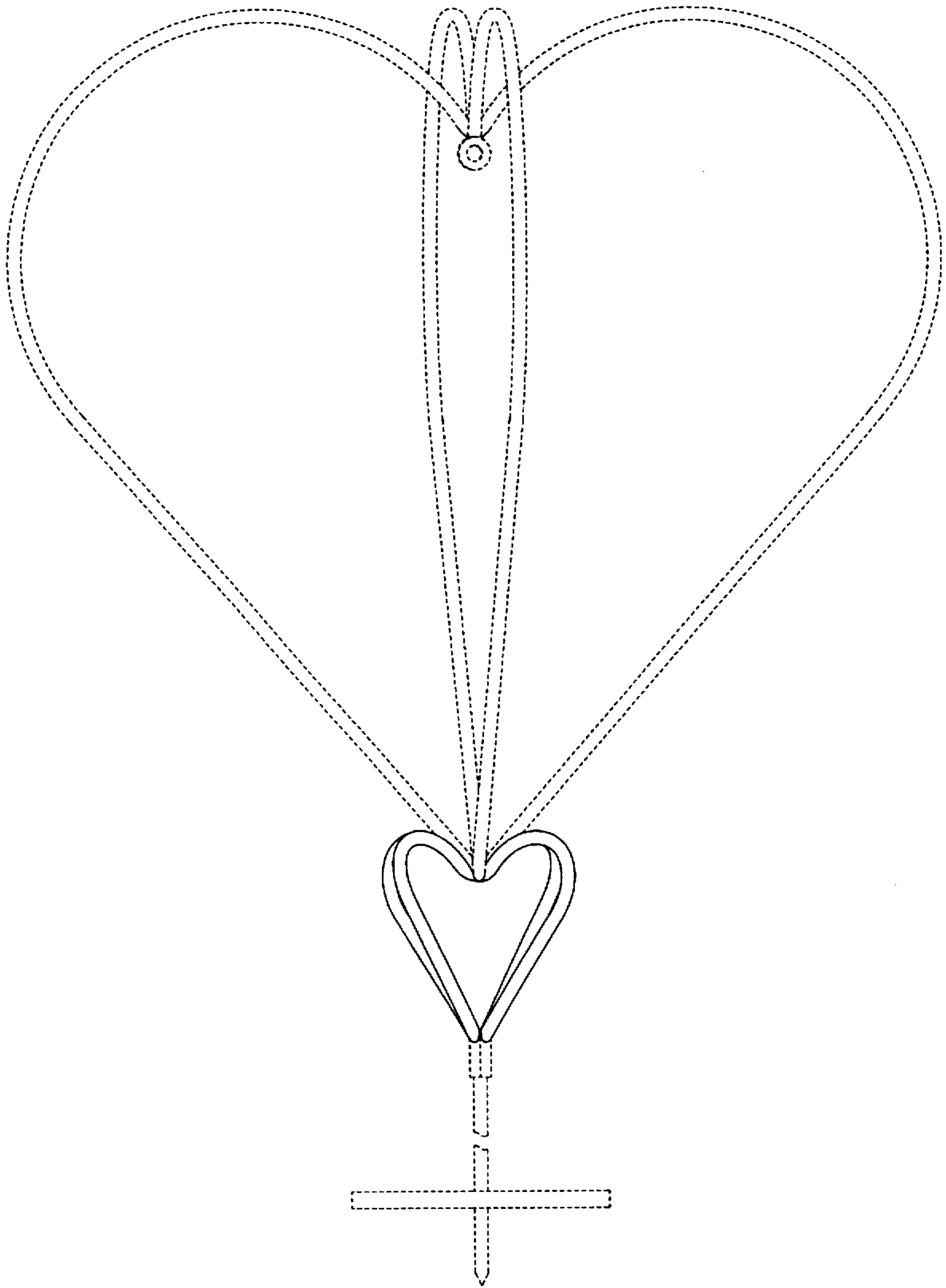

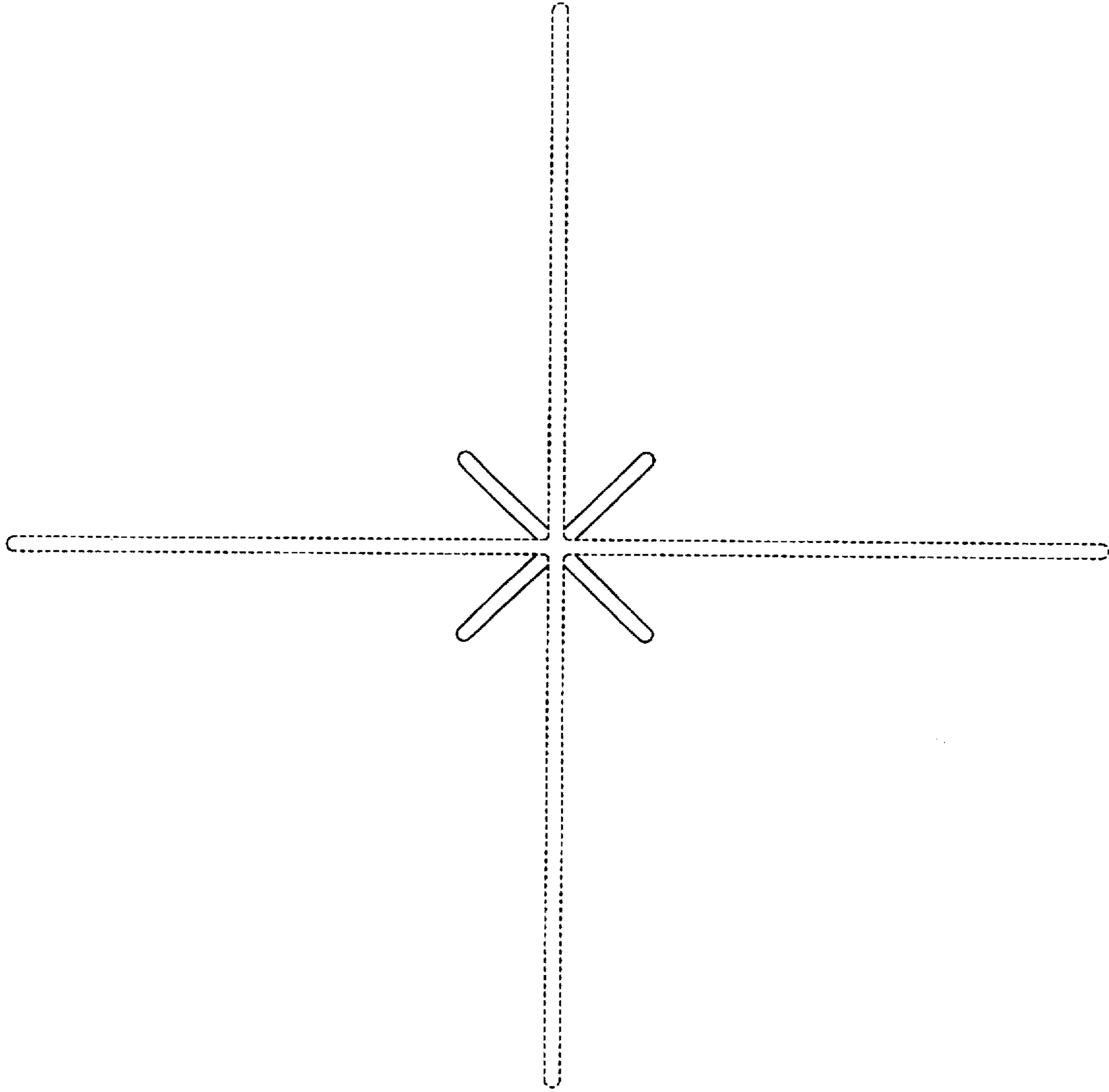

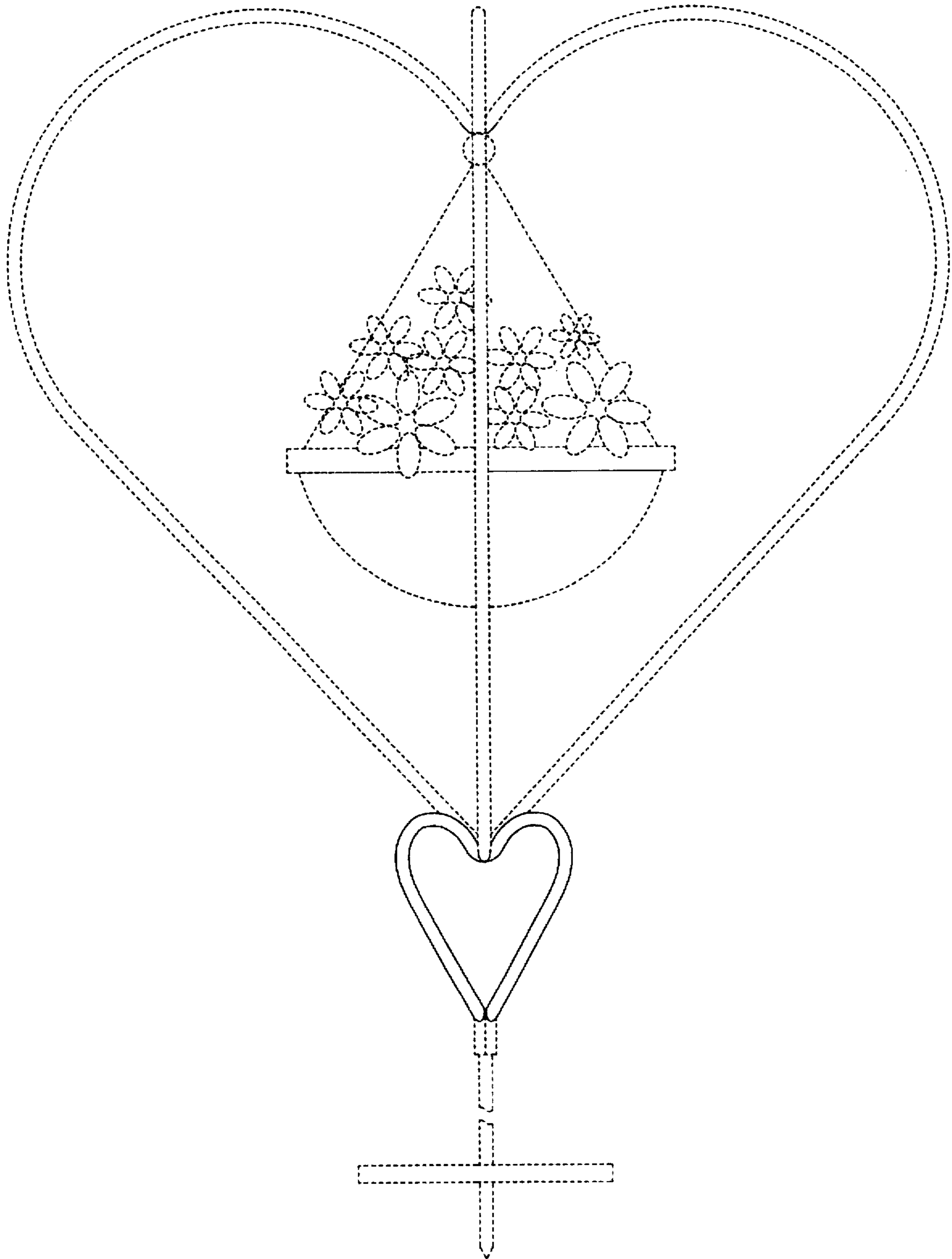

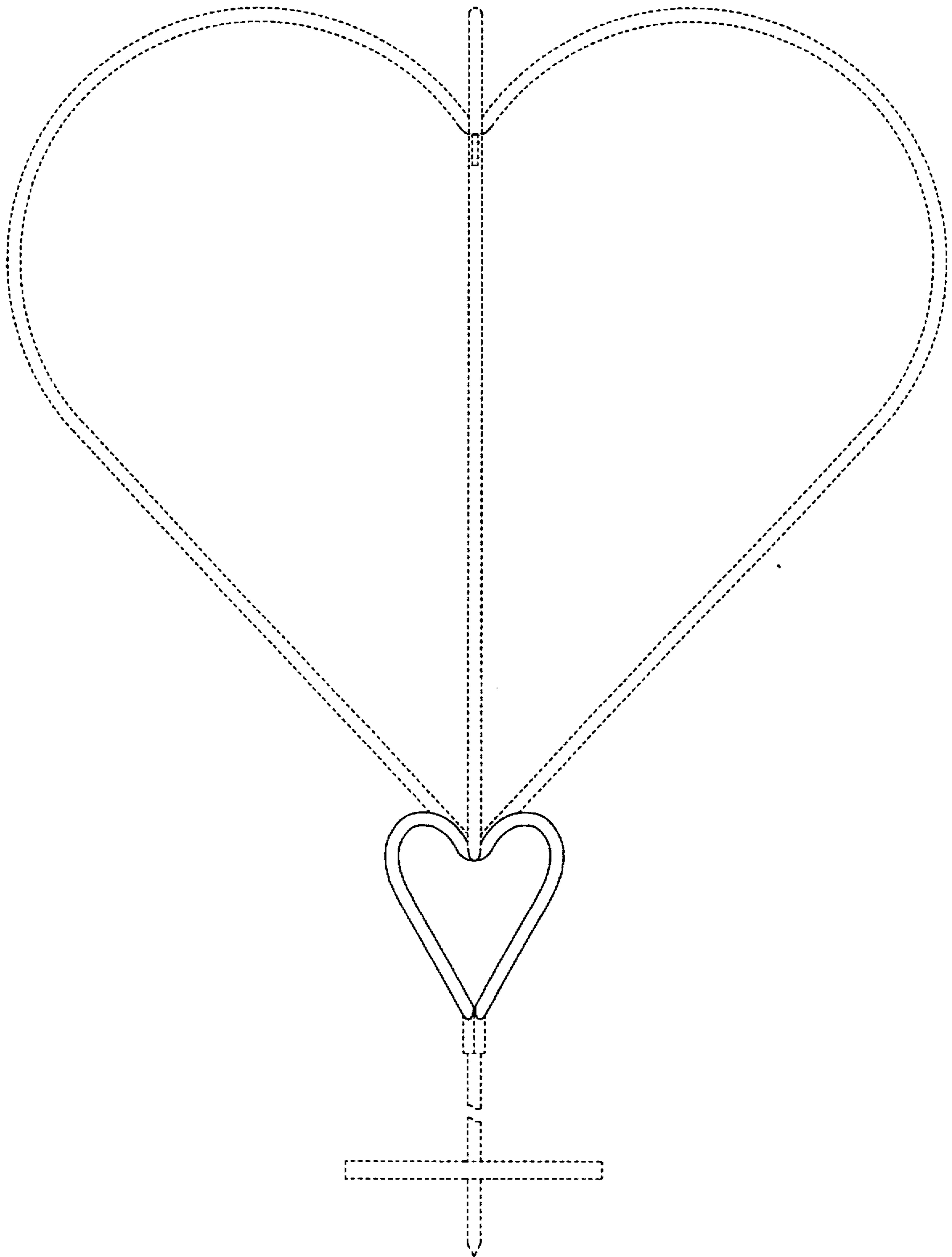
