FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the boot of FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the other side of the boot of FIG. 1;


FIG. 4 is a rear elevational of the boot of FIG. 1; and,


FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the boot of FIG. 1.


