The ornamental design for a stepped pool cue, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a stepped pool cue, embodying my new design, all other side being identical; FIG. 2 is an enlarged left end elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmented side elevational view of the tip portion of the sectioned pool cue for clarity of illustration; and, FIG. 4 is an enlarged right end elevational view thereof.

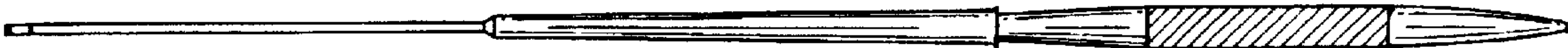

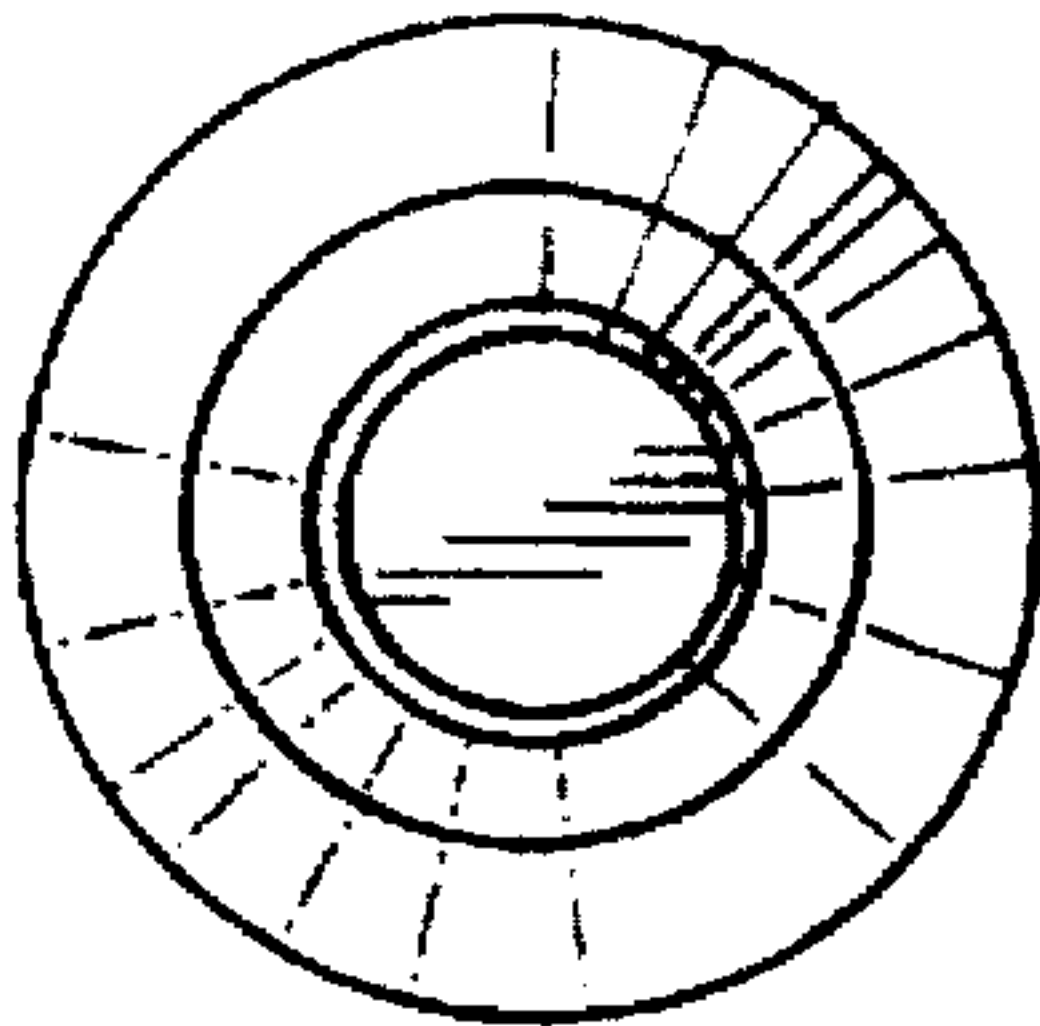

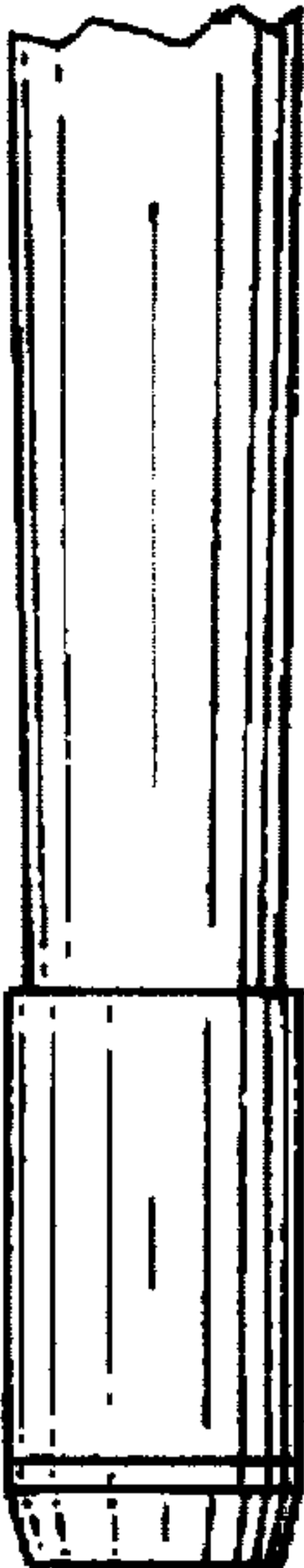

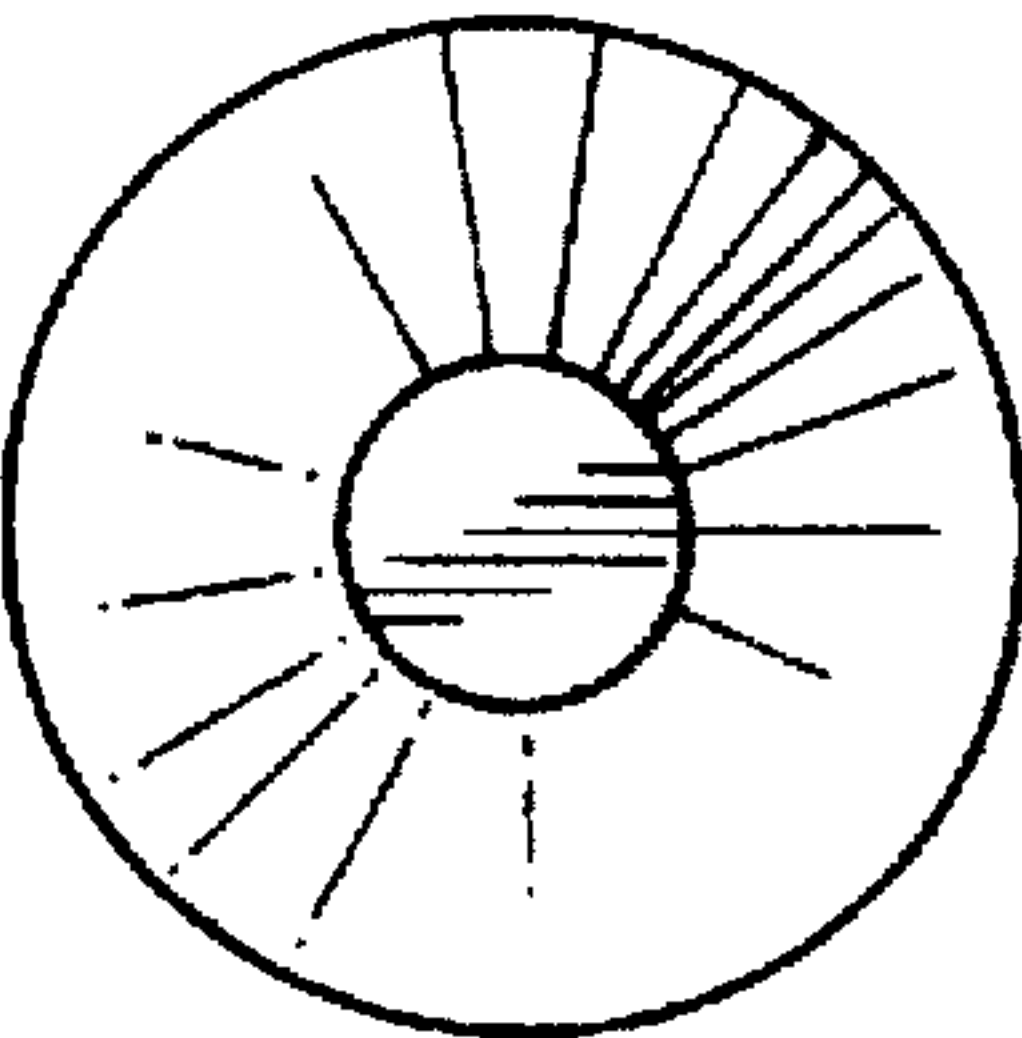
