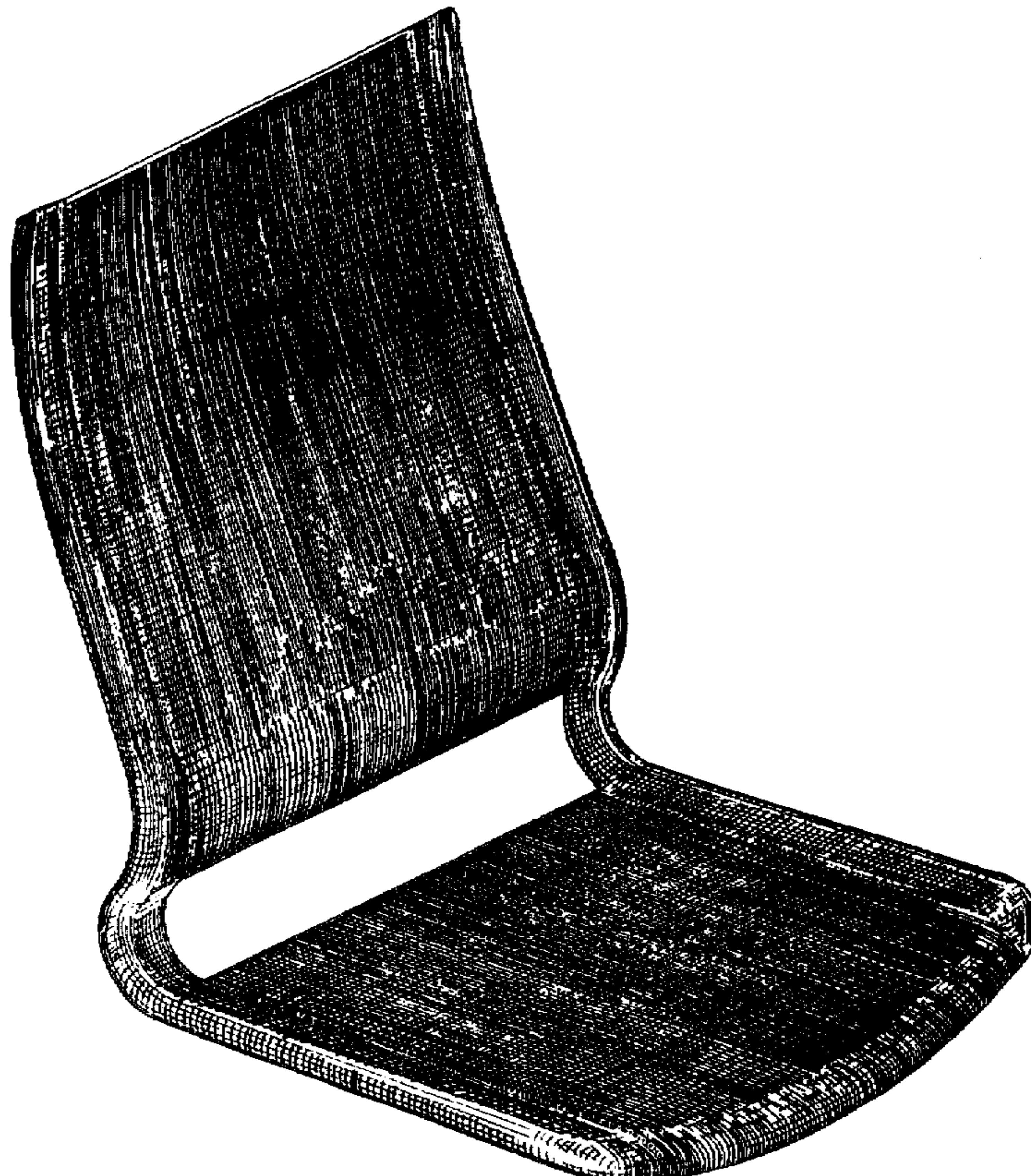
OTHER PUBLICATIONS

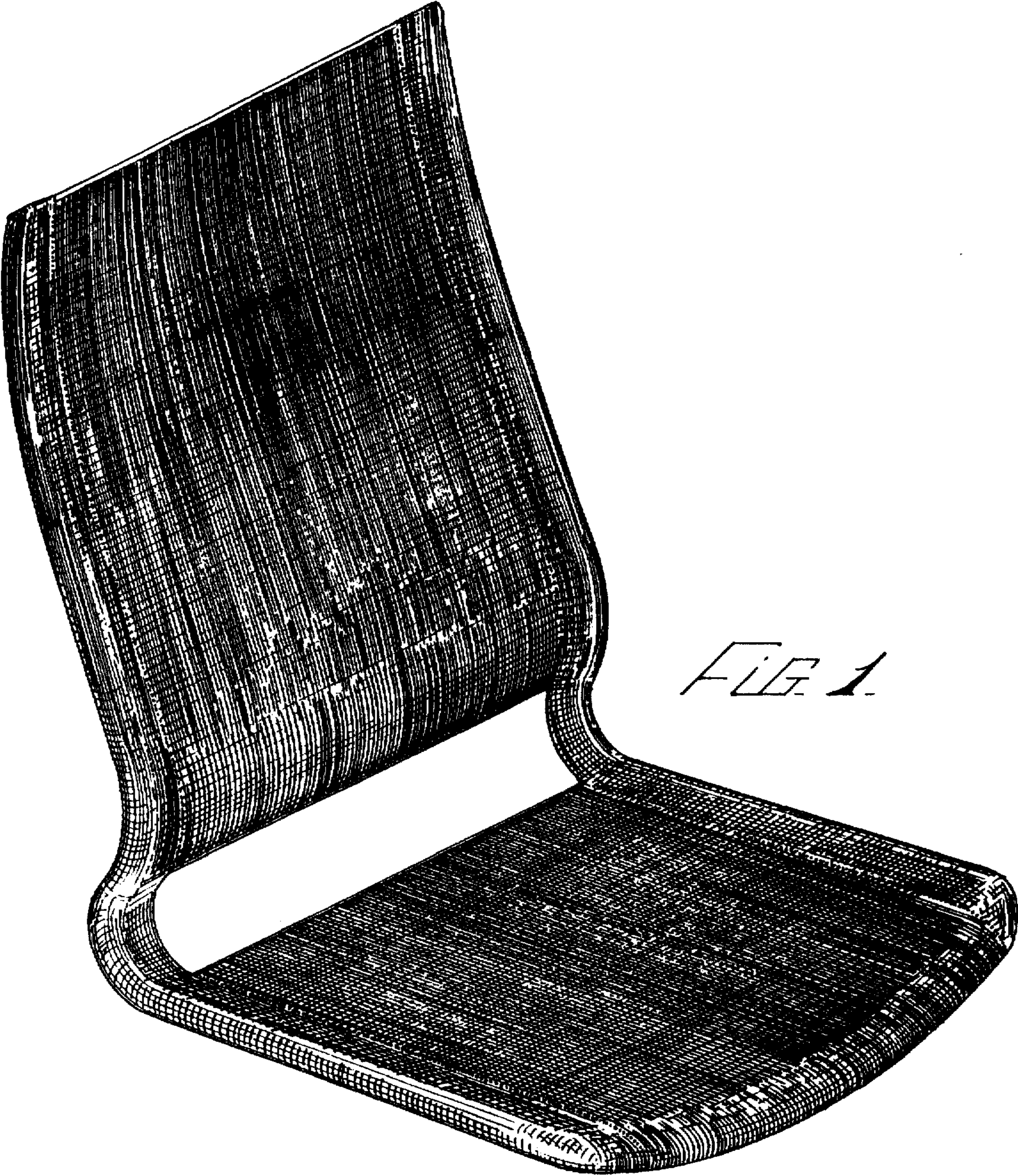

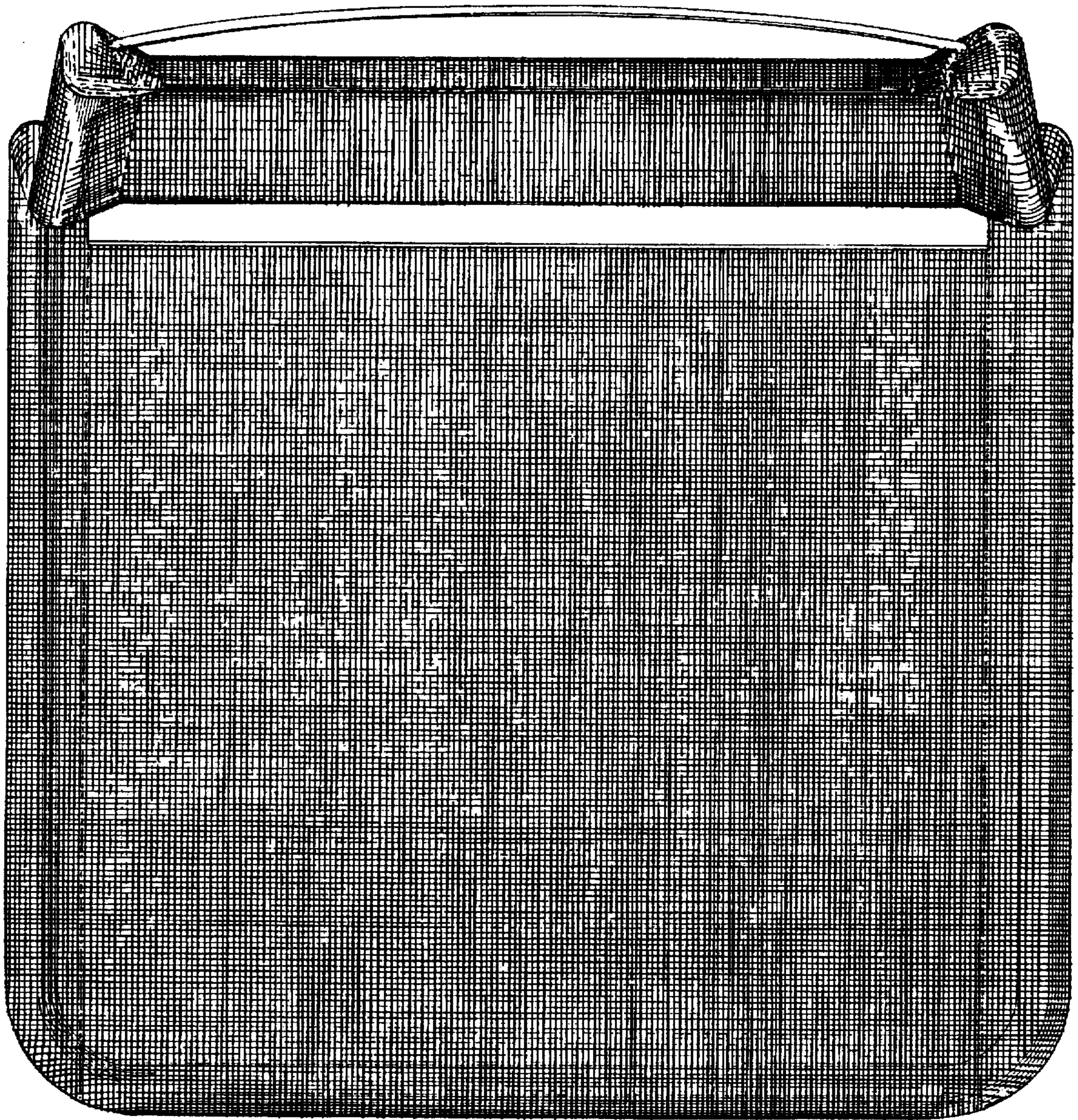

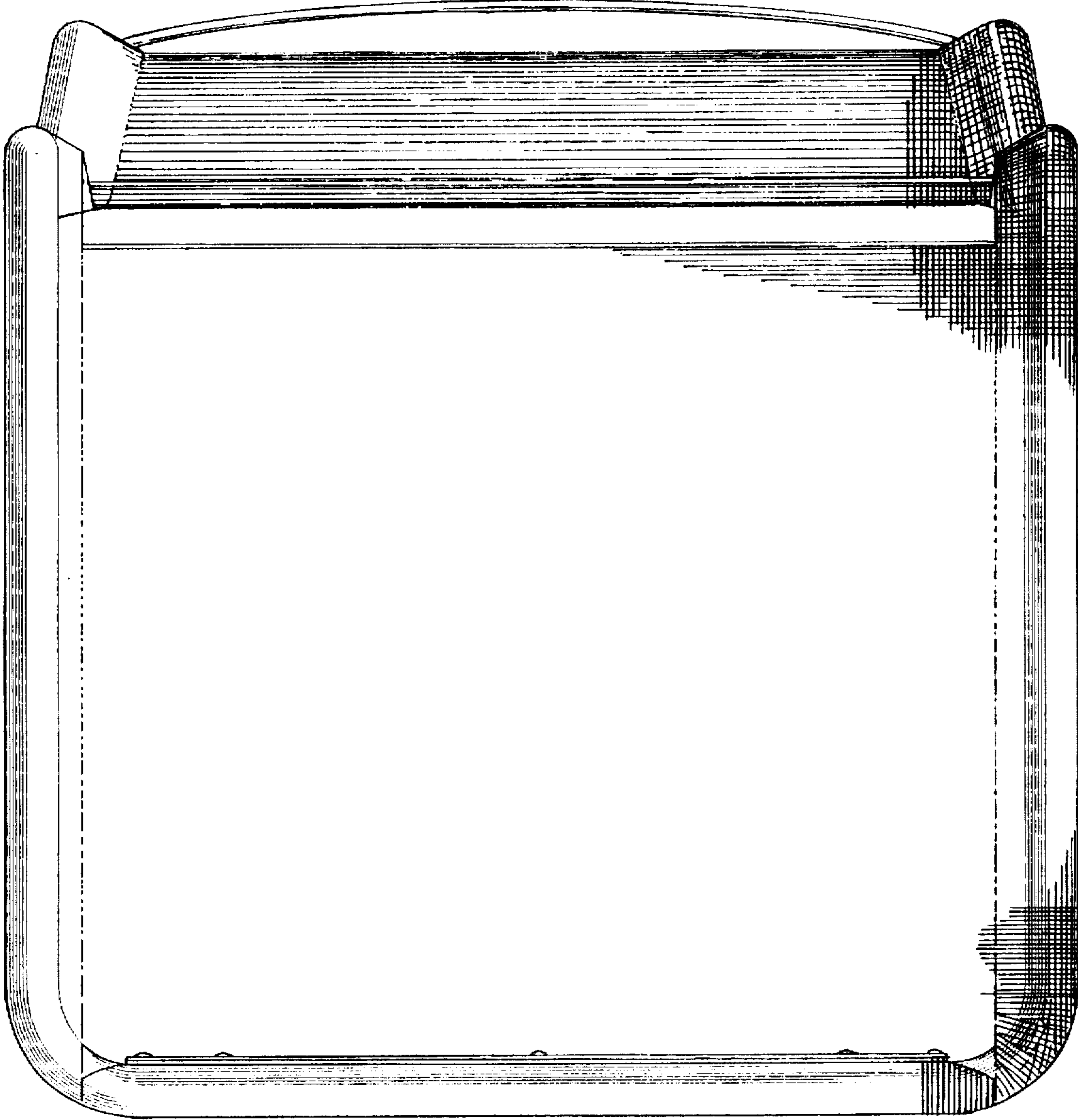

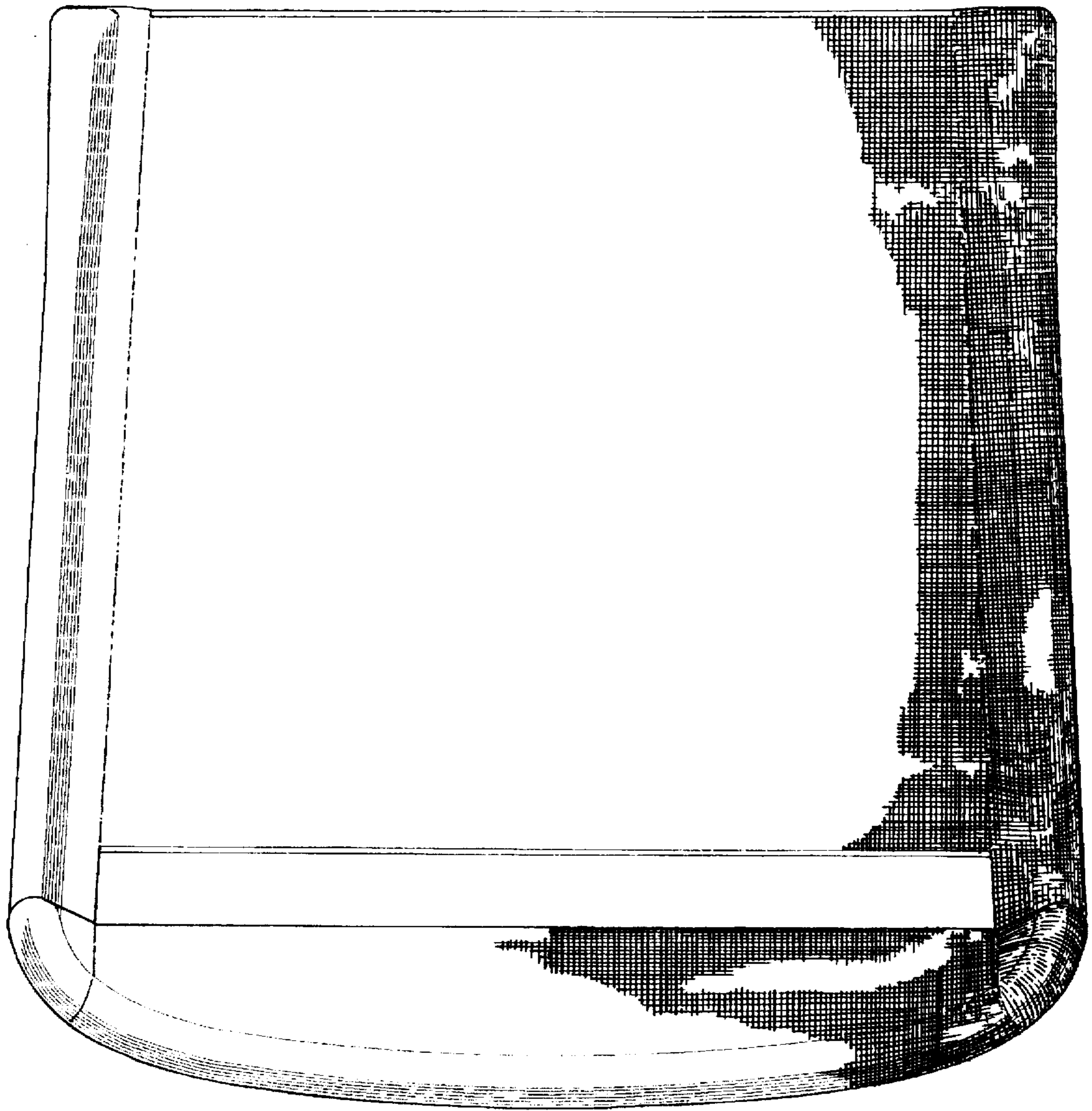
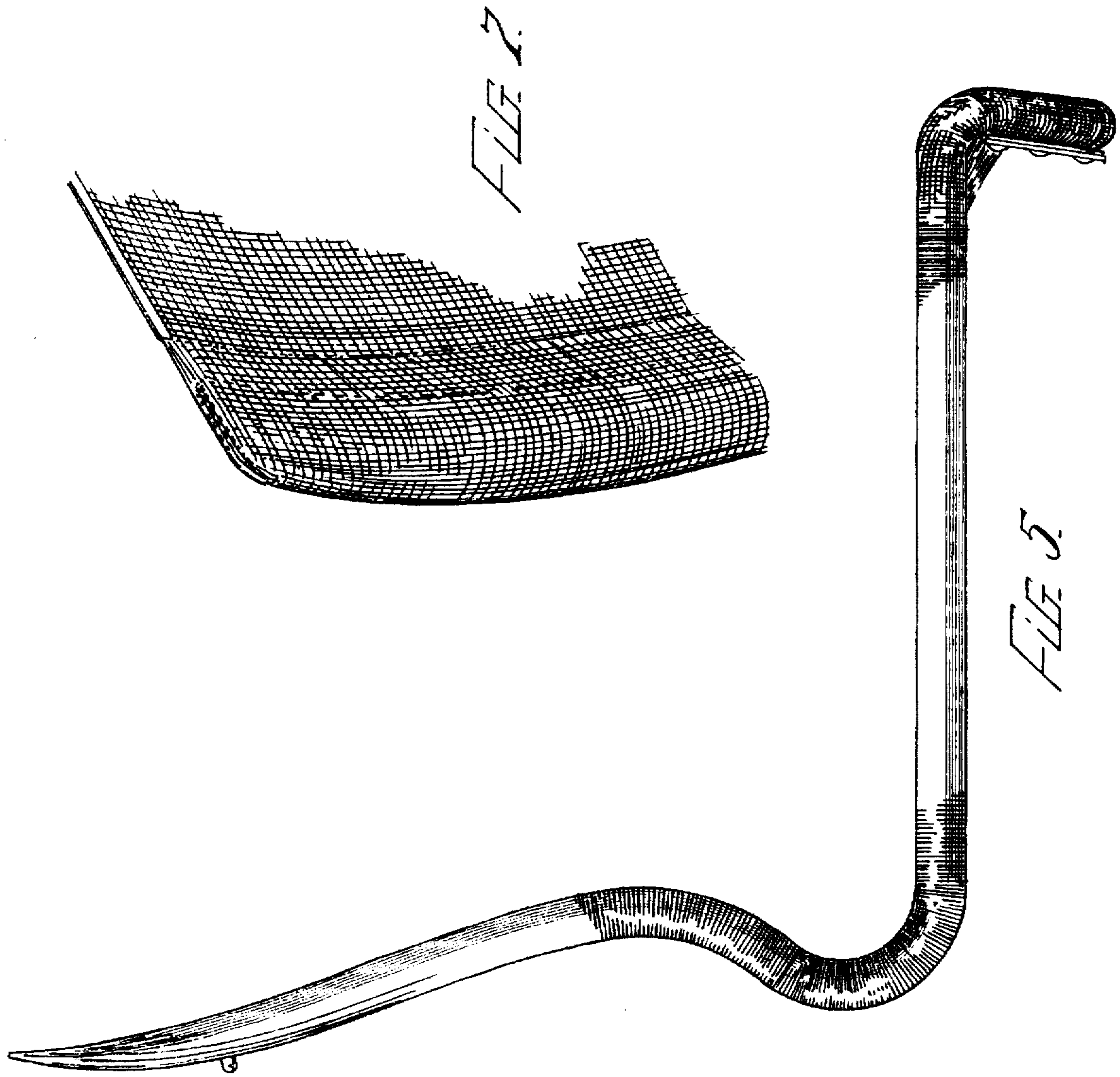

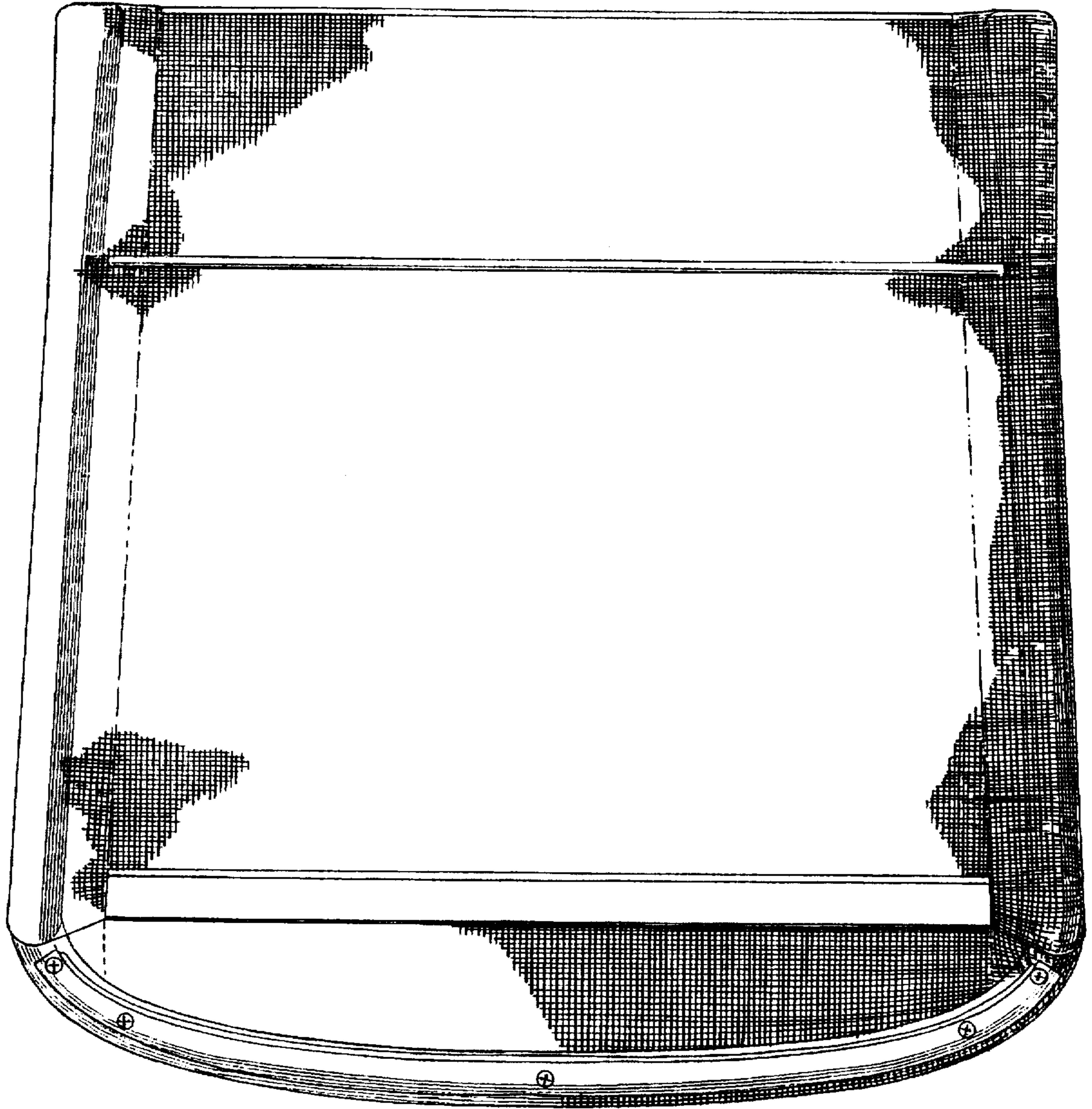
