FIG. 3 is a top view of a steering wheel for a motor vehicle according to our novel design;

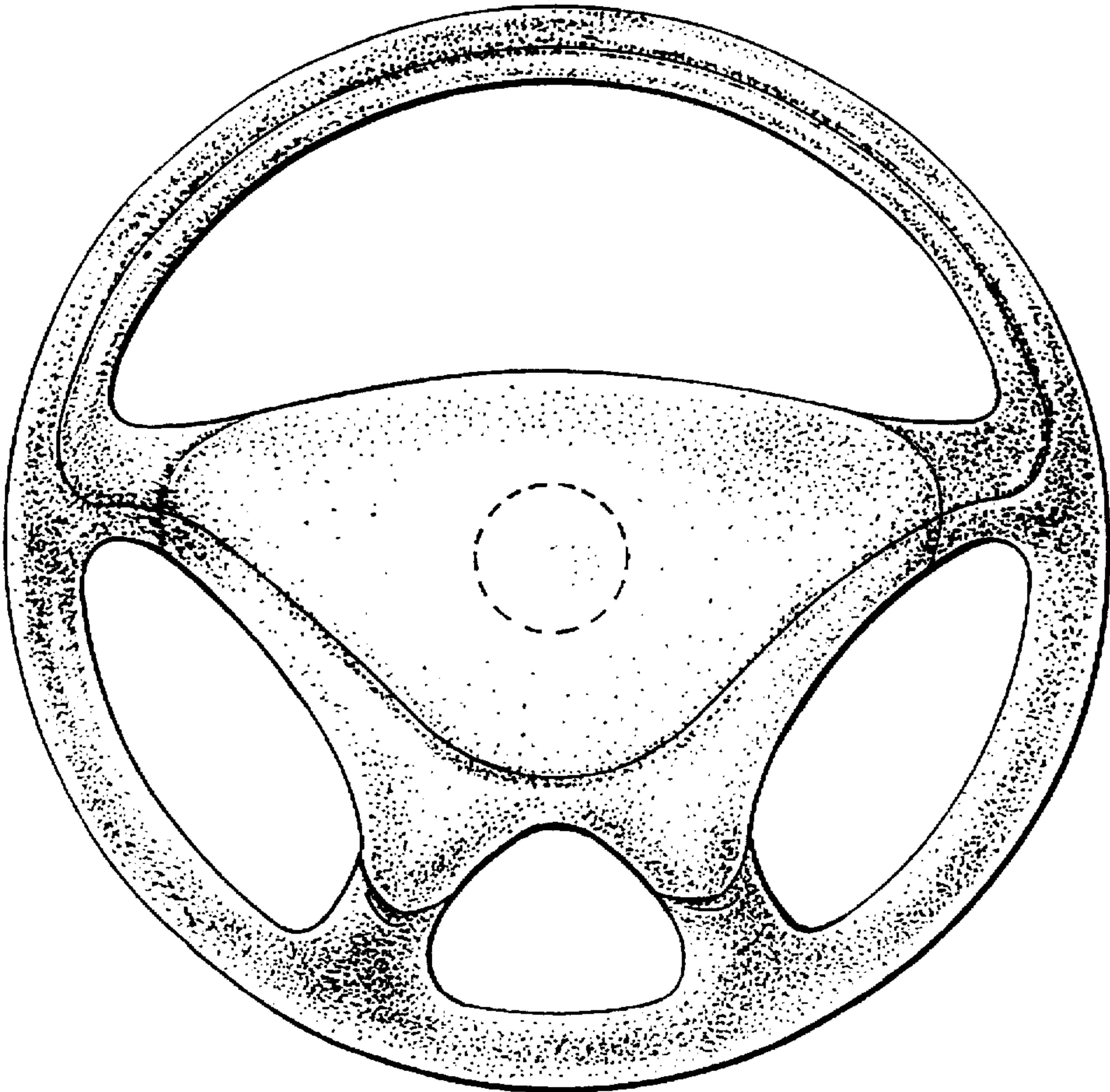
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of a steering wheel for a motor vehicle according to our novel design;

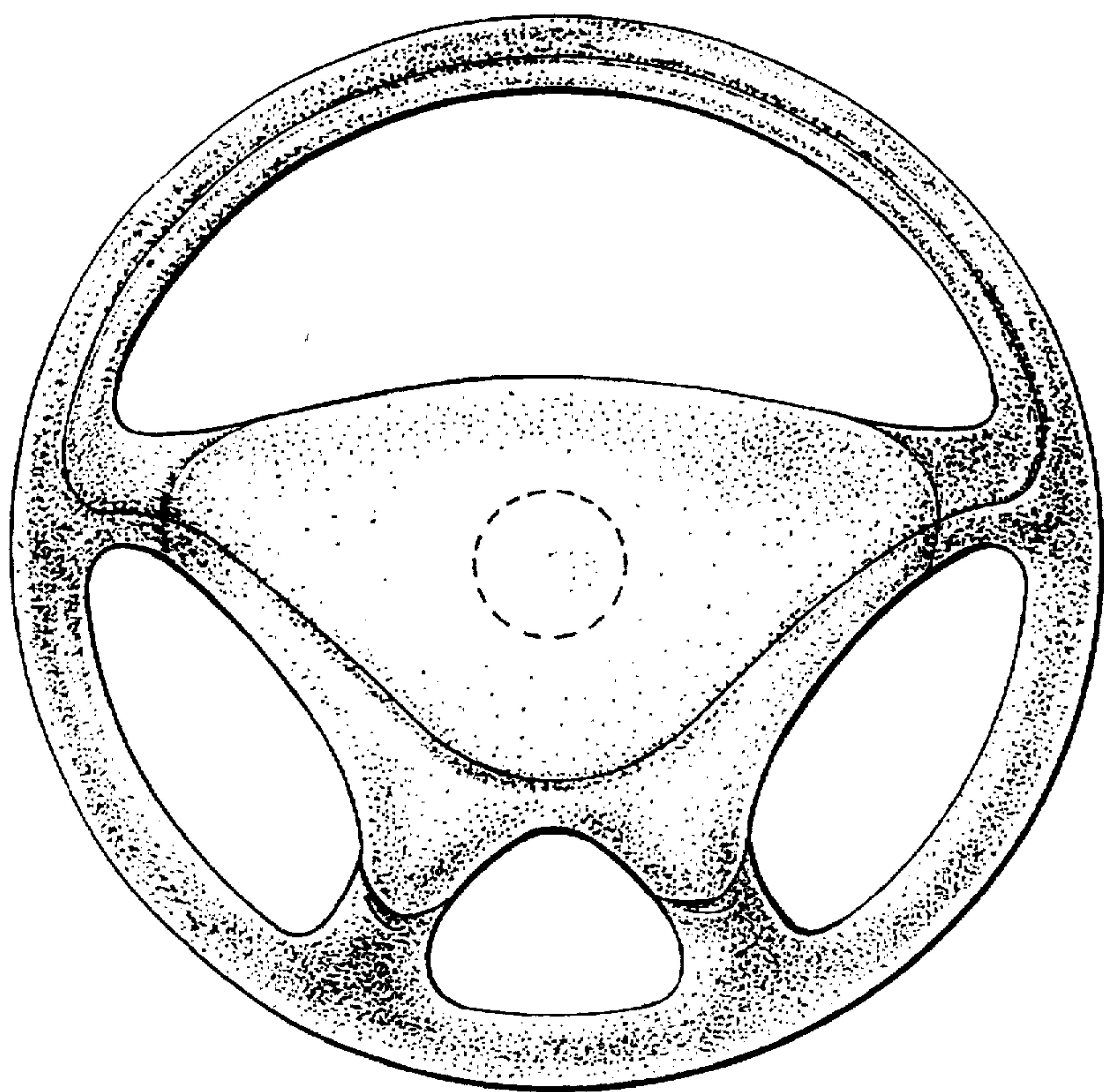

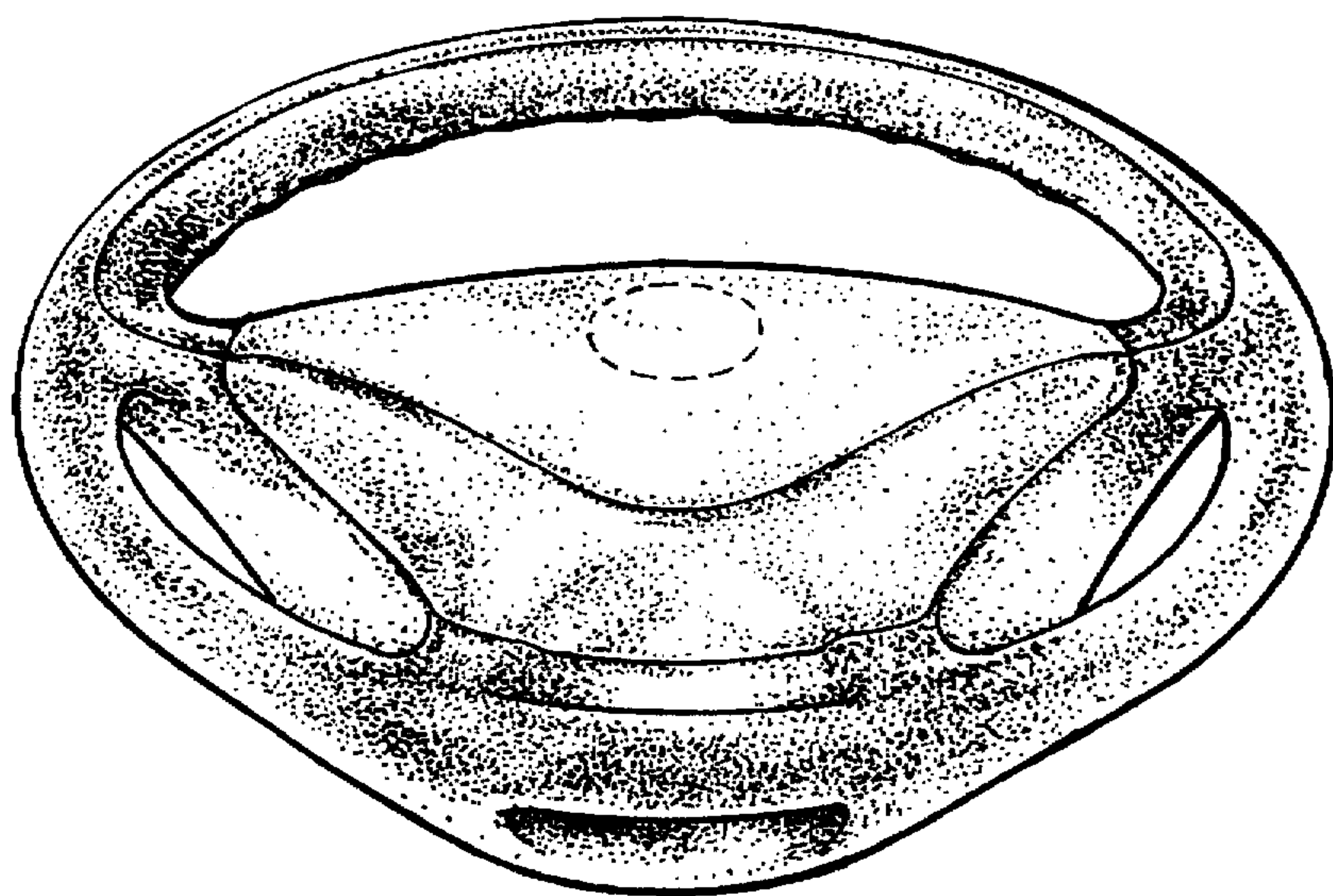

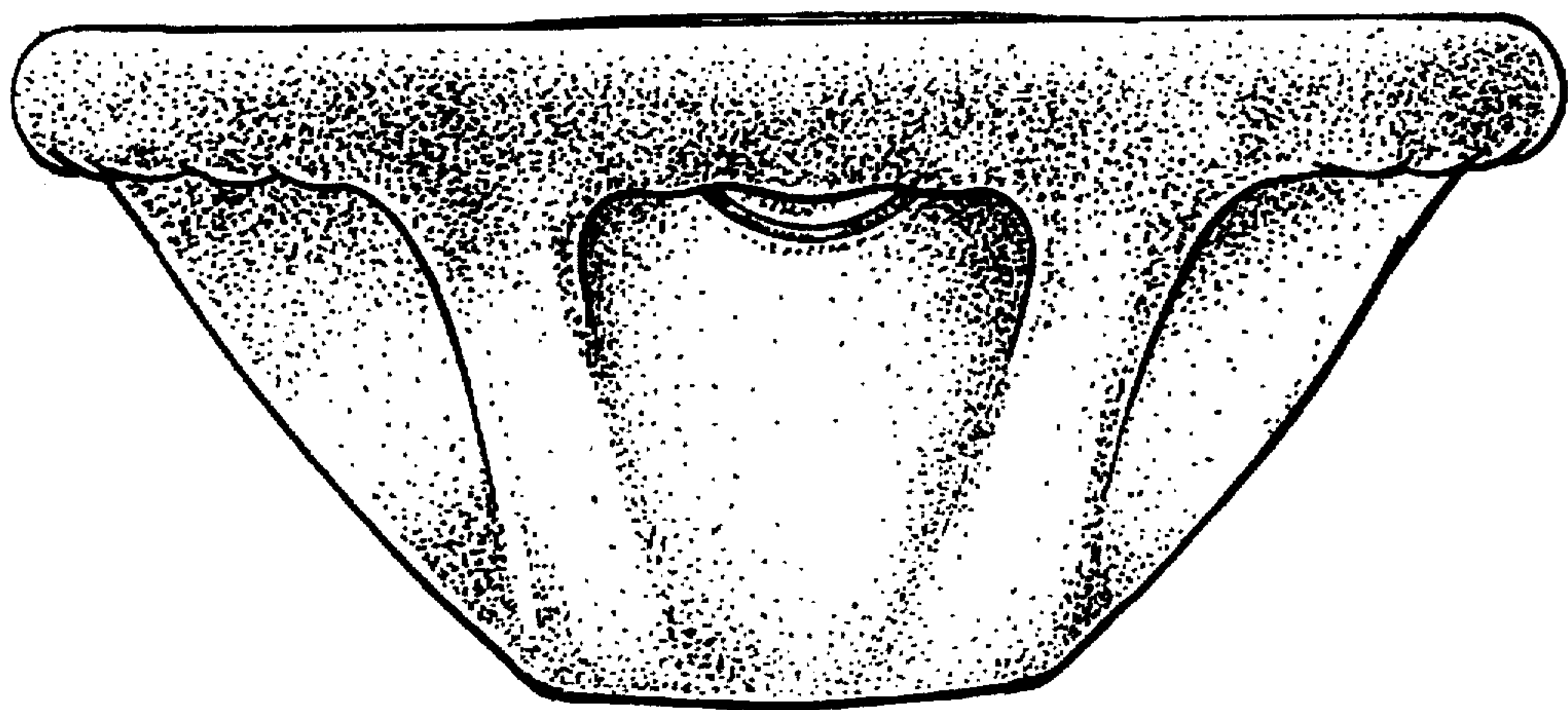

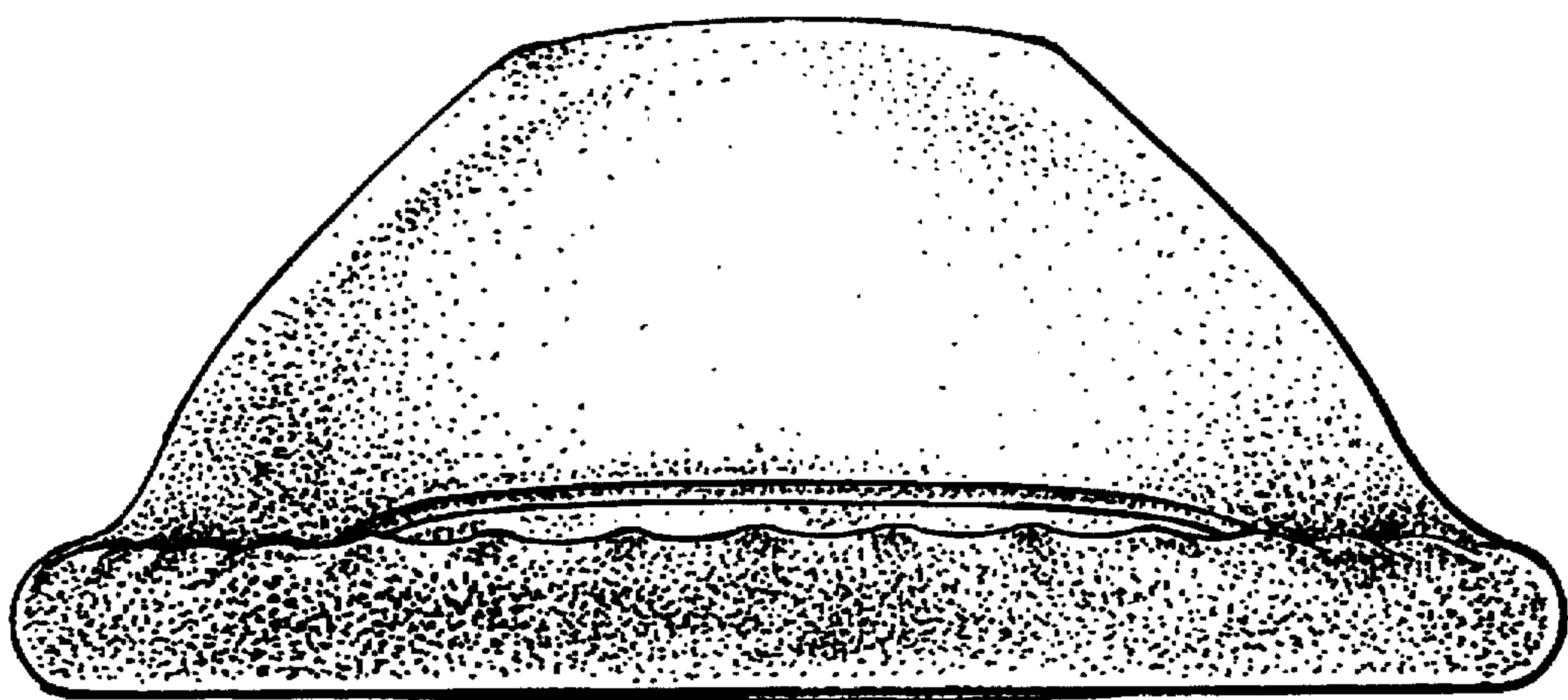

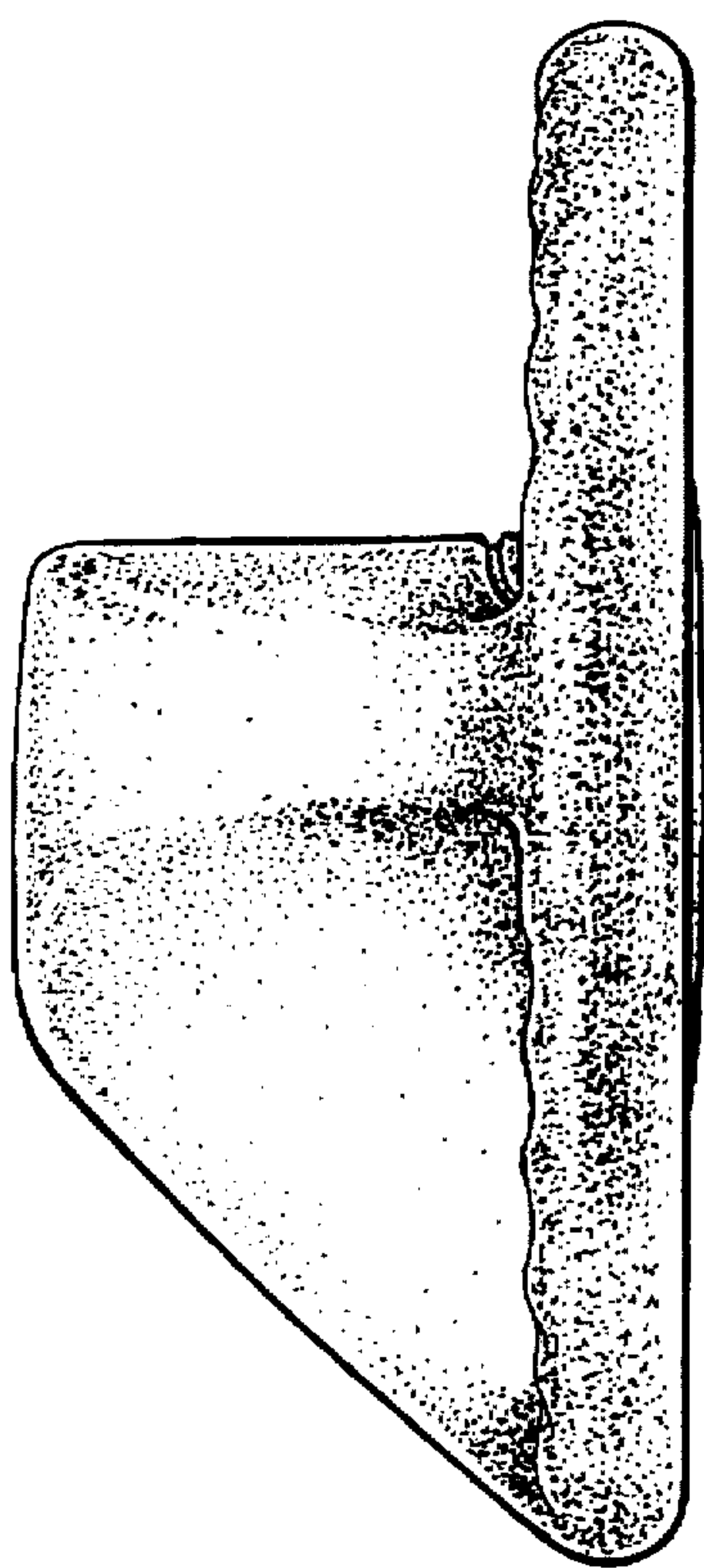

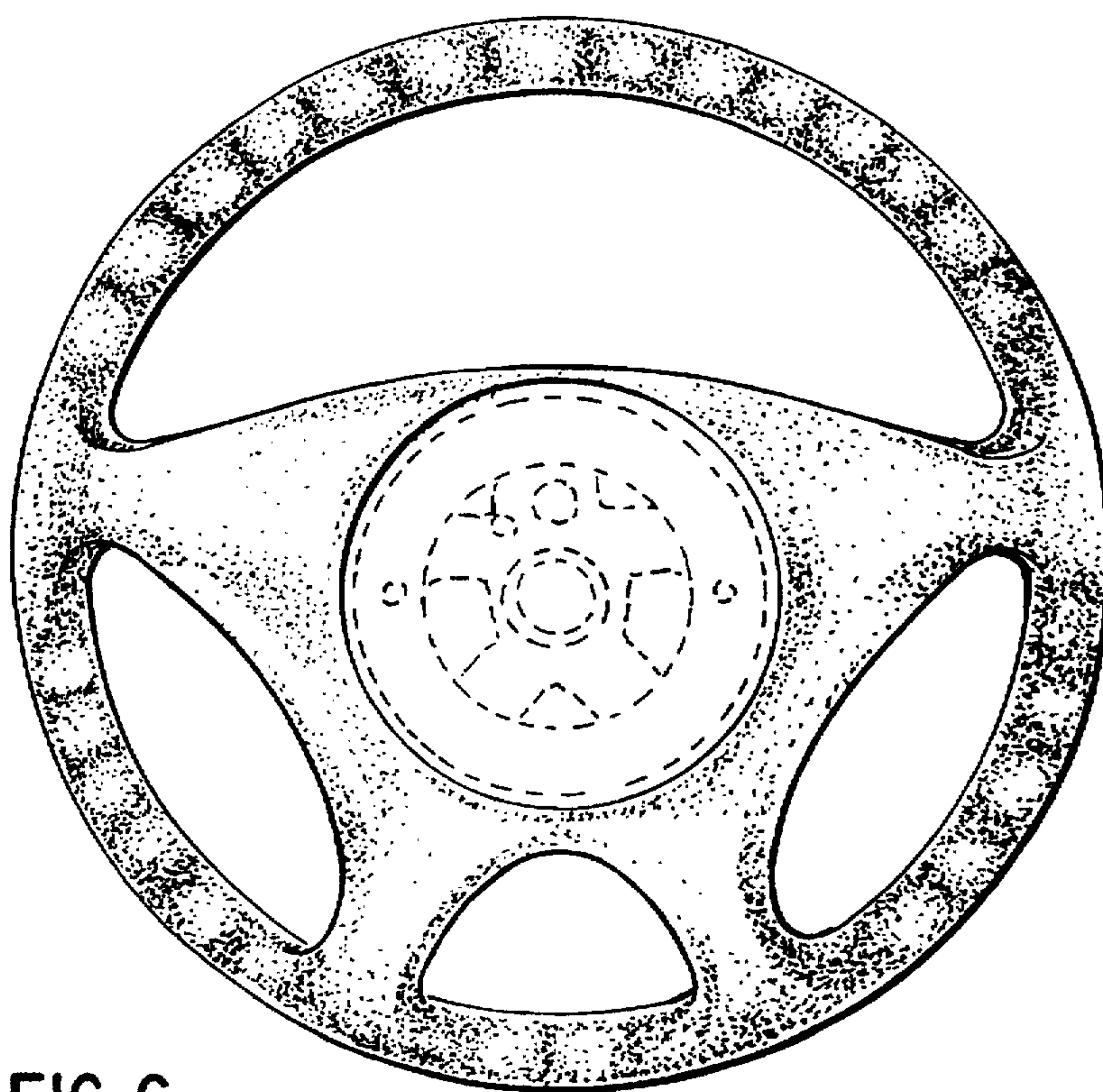
