[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pizza container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a pizza container showing my new design;

FIG. 22 is a top plan view thereof;




FIG. 23 is a front elevational view thereof with the cover removed for ease of illustration;

FIG. 29 is a top plan view thereof with the cover removed for ease of illustration;


FIG. 30 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 31 is a front elevational view thereof with the cover removed for ease of illustration; and.

FIG. 32 is a rear elevational view thereof with the cover removed for ease of illustration.


The bottom plan view in all four embodiments is plain and unornamented.





















































