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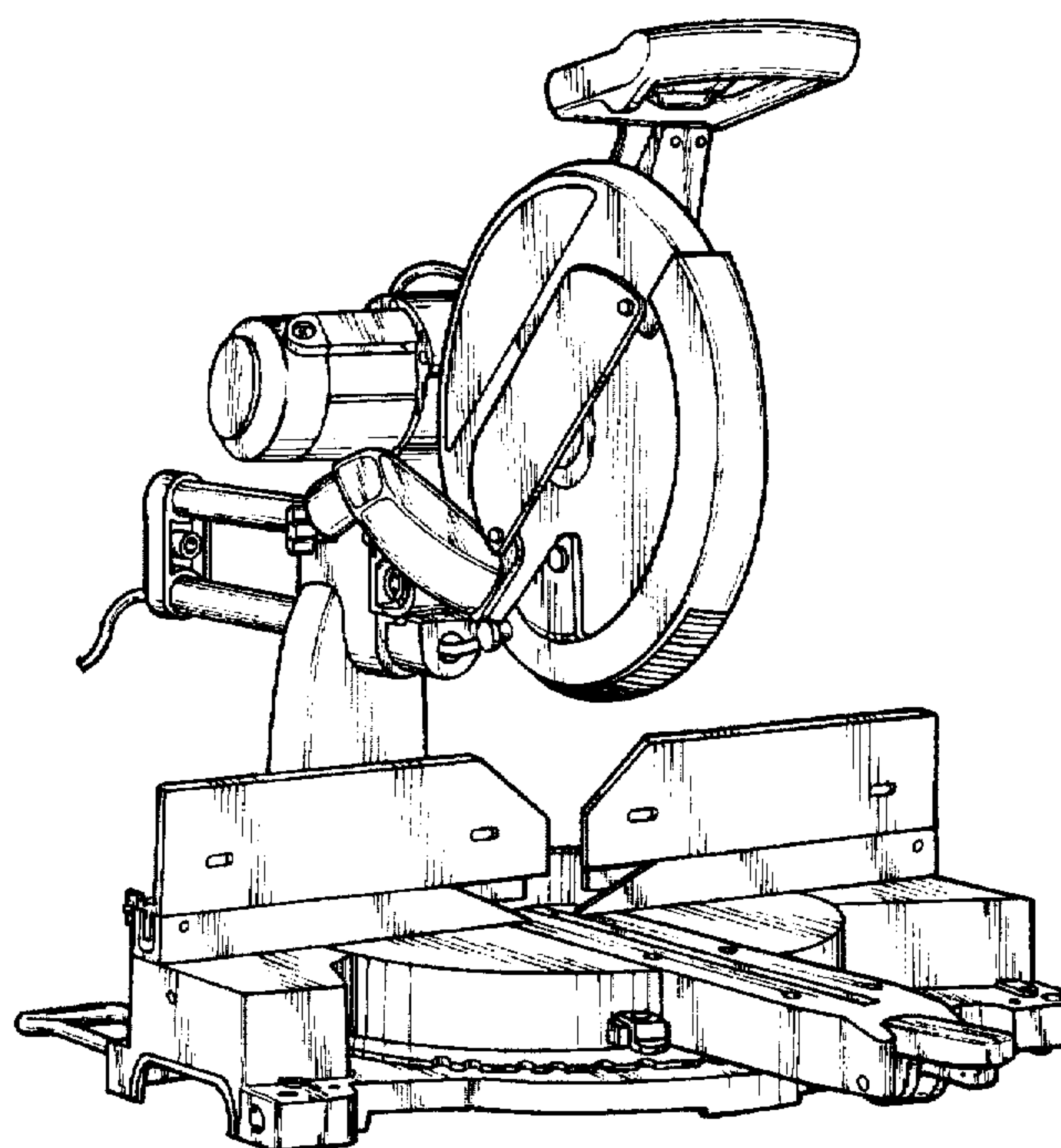

The ornamental design for a sliding compound miter saw, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the design for a sliding compound miter saw according to the present invention; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the sliding compound miter saw shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the sliding compound miter saw shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the sliding compound miter saw; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the sliding compound miter saw shown in FIG. 1; and FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the sliding compound miter saw shown in FIG. 1.

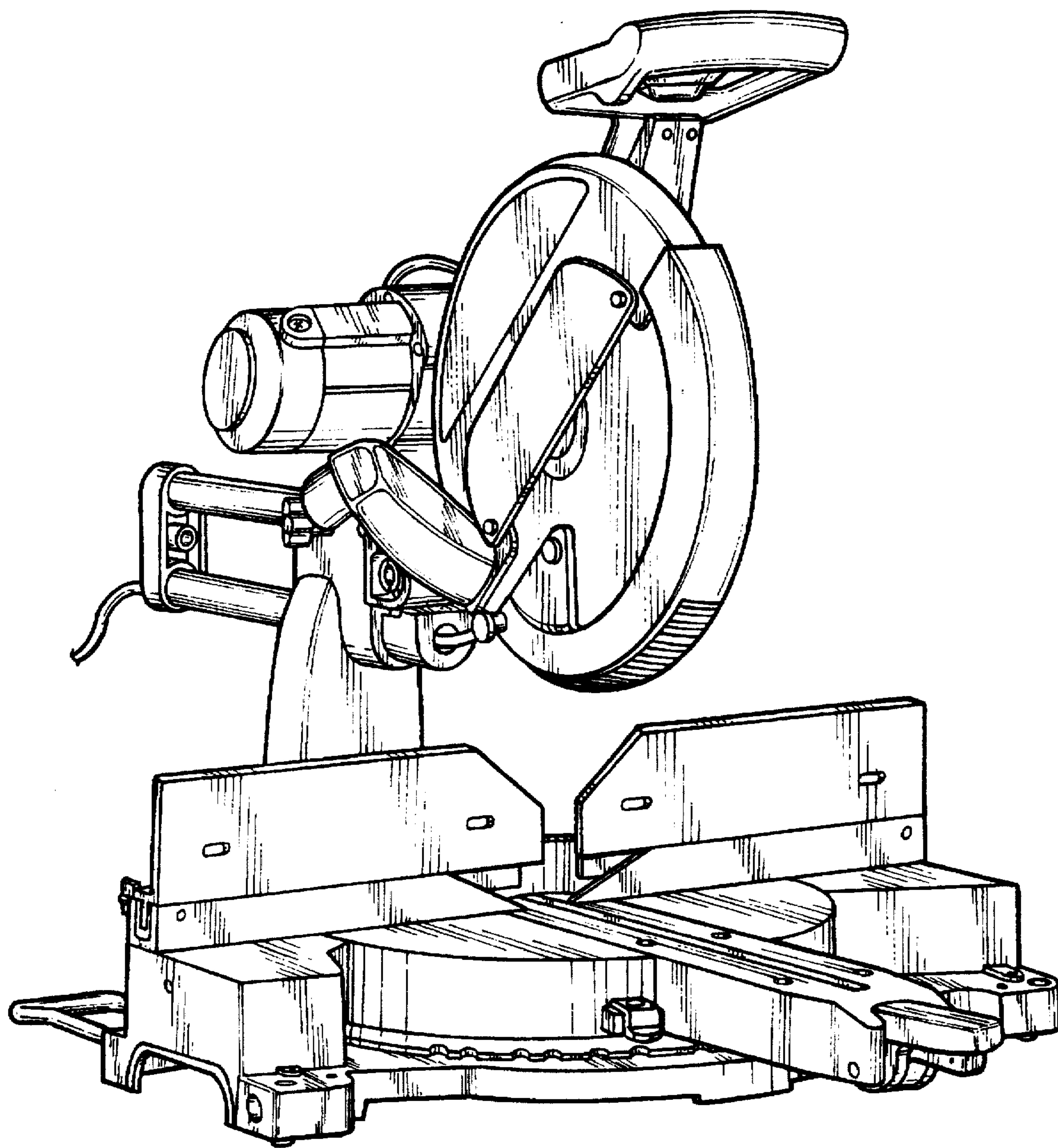

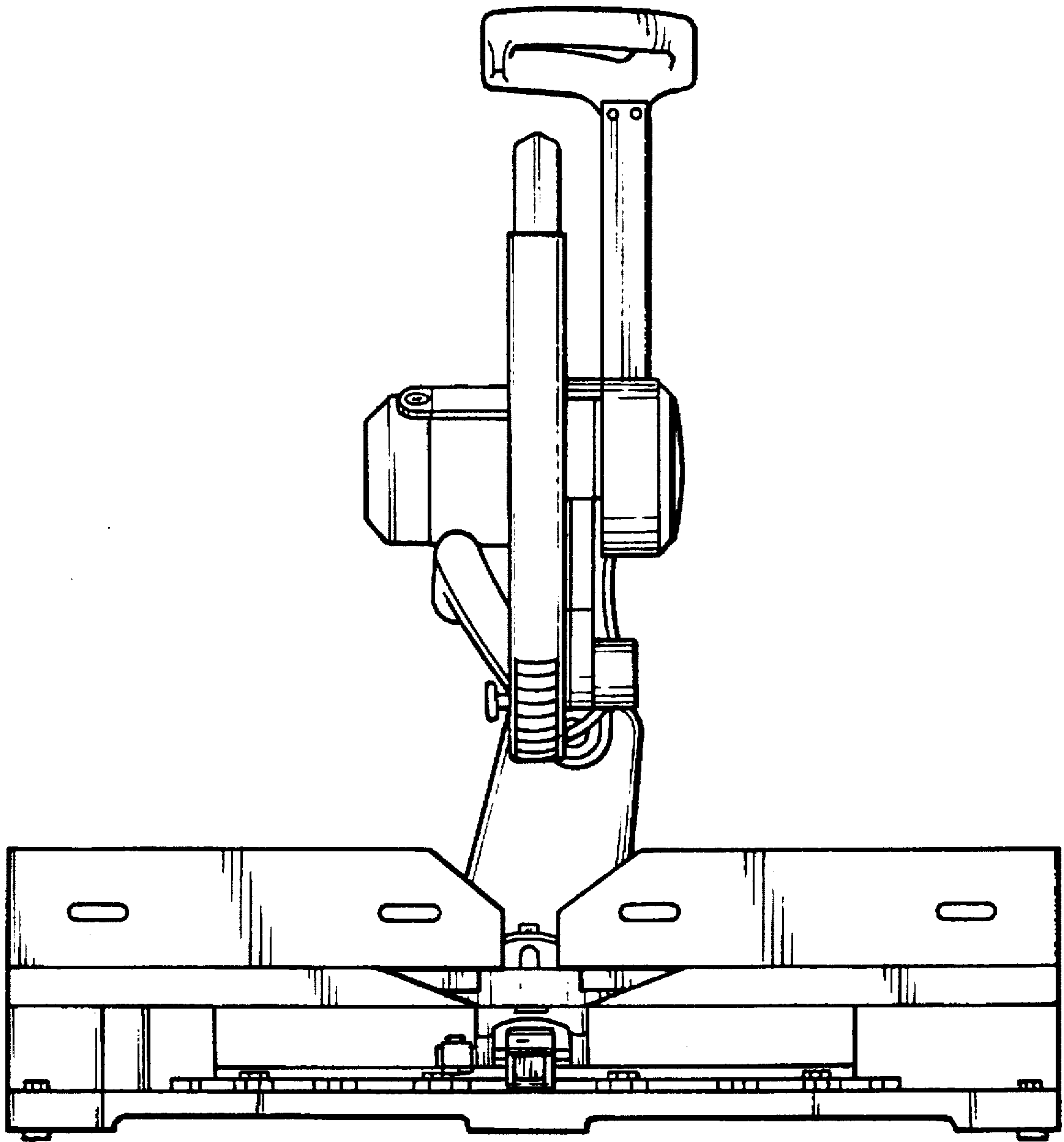
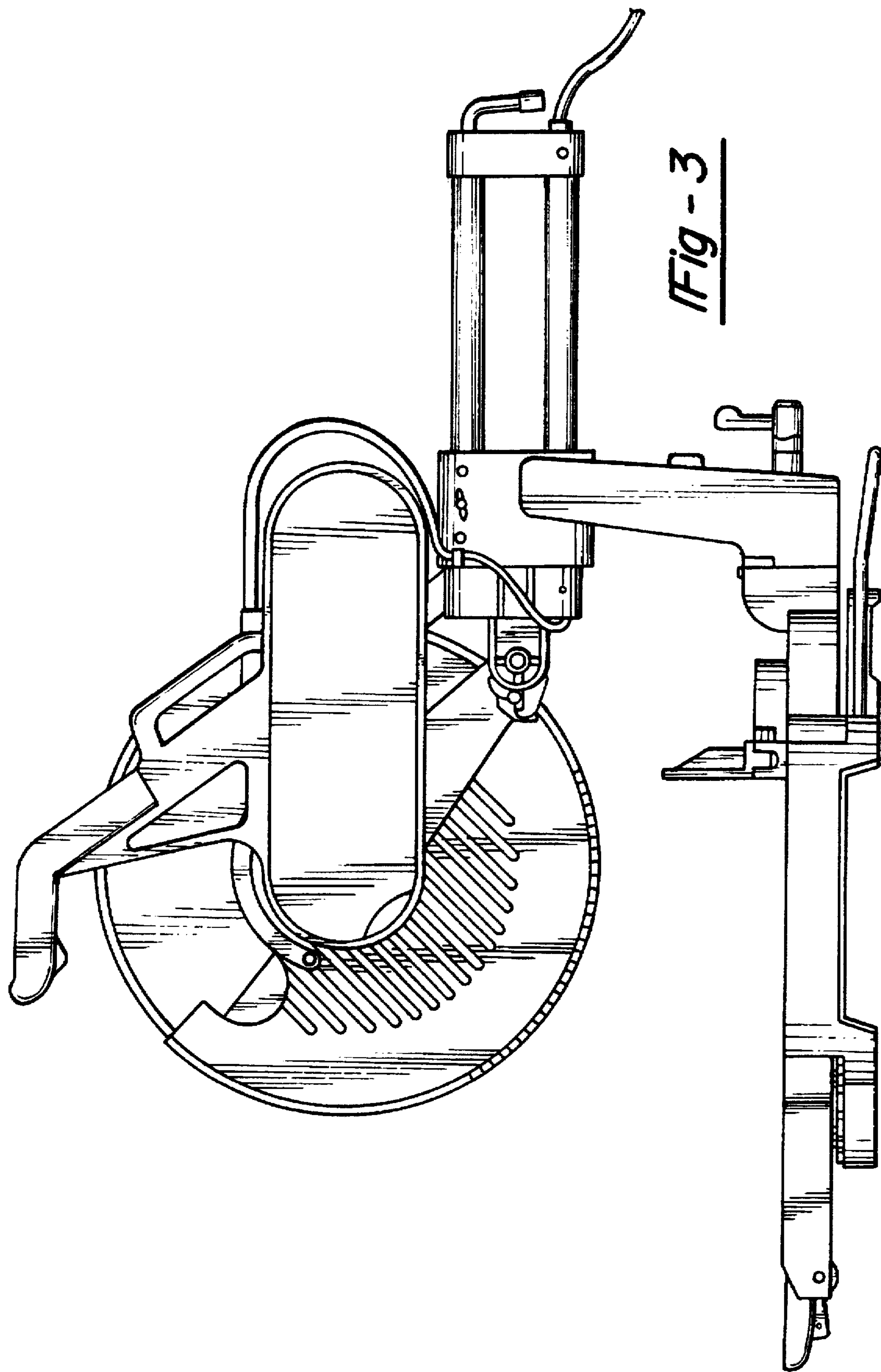

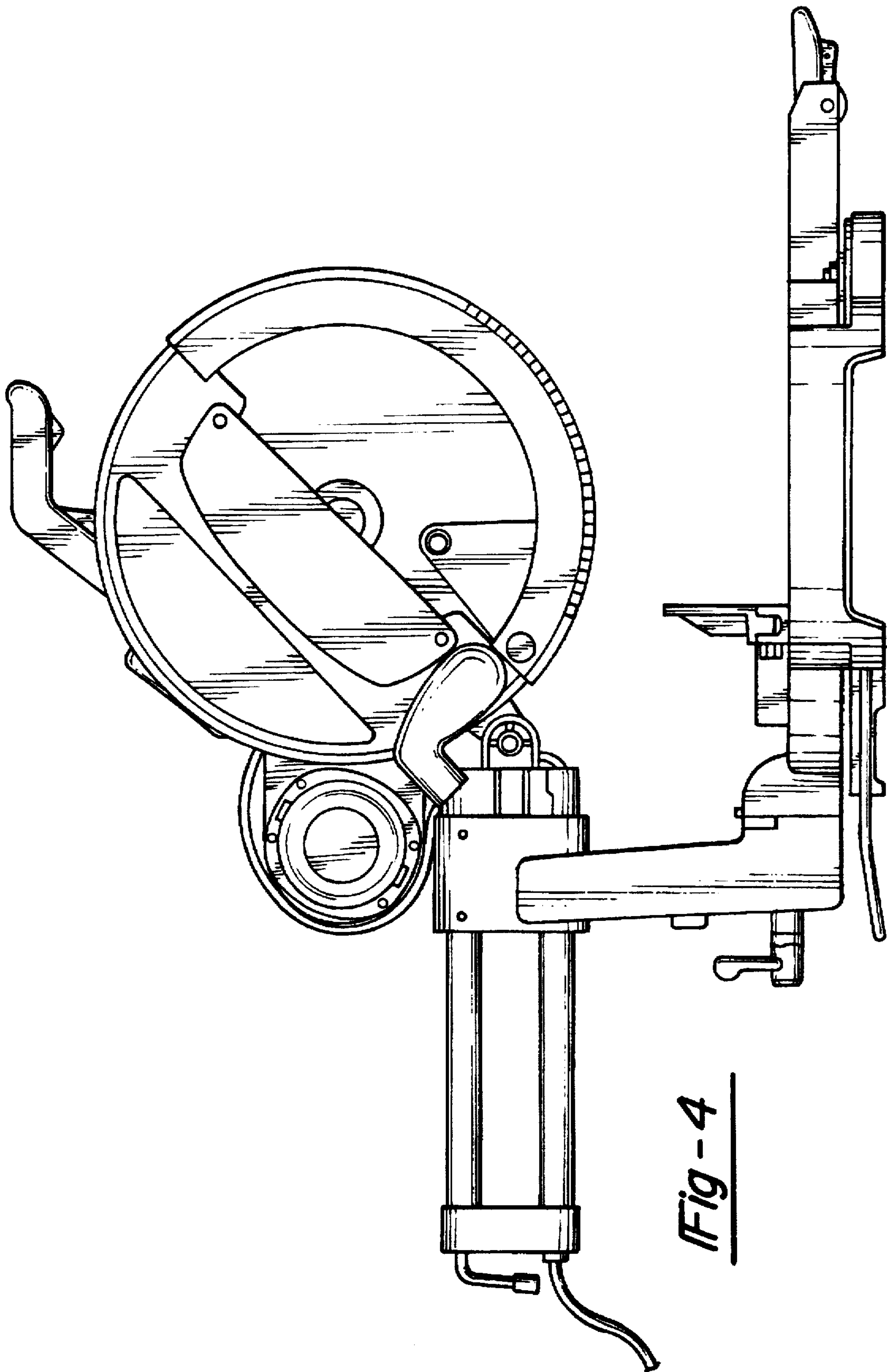

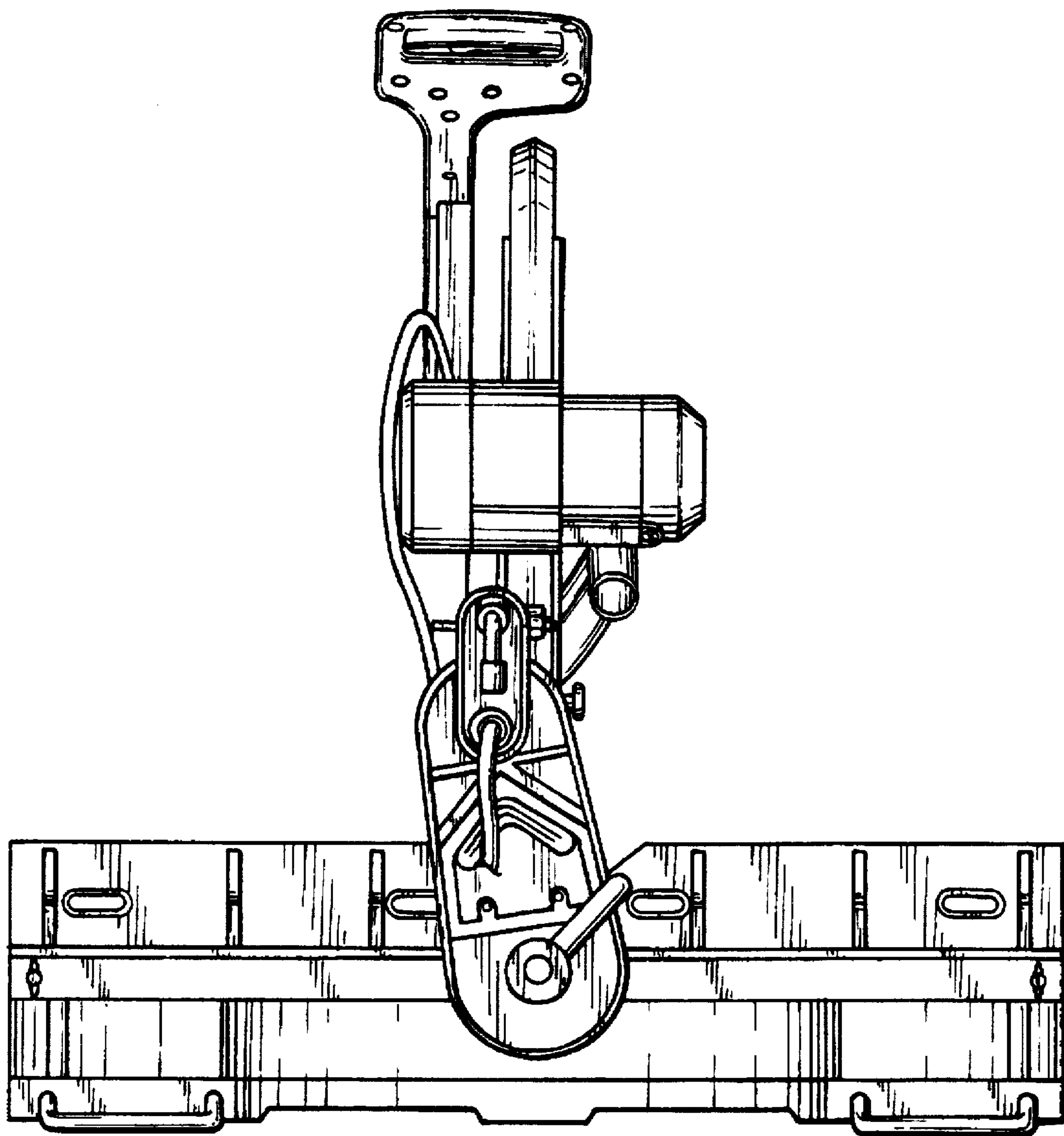
