The ornamental design for a handle end of the carrying case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a handle end of the carrying case showing the new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,

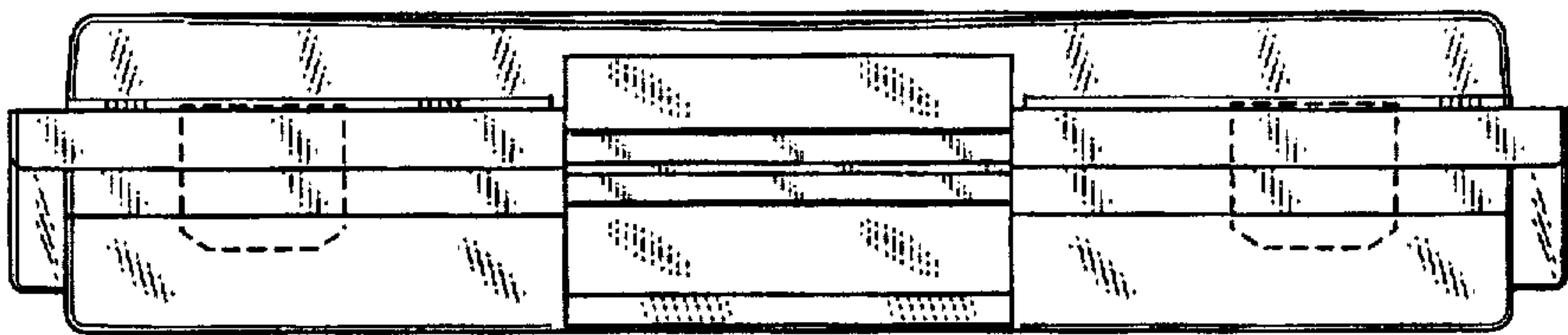


FIG. 5 FIG. 4

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

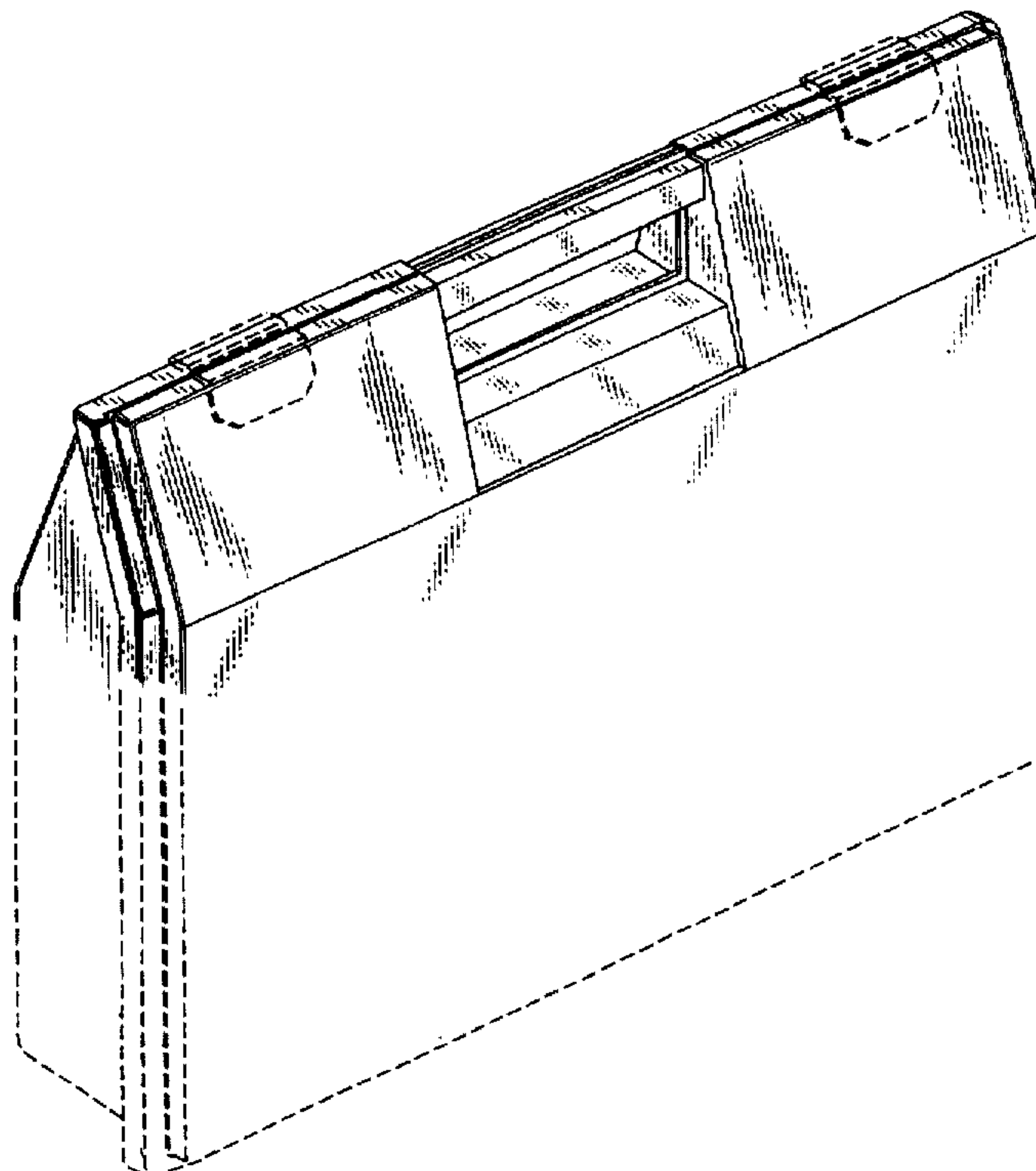

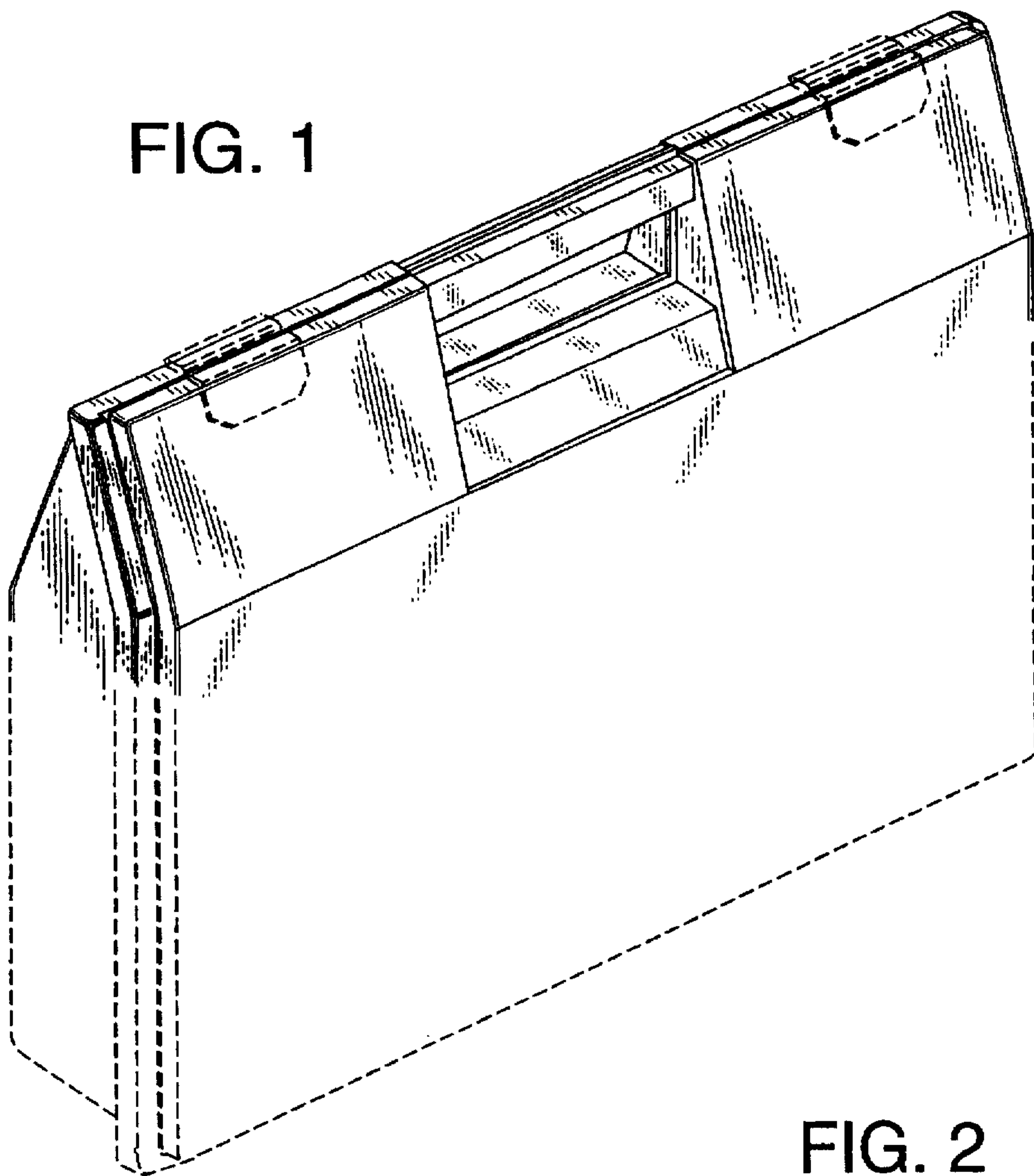

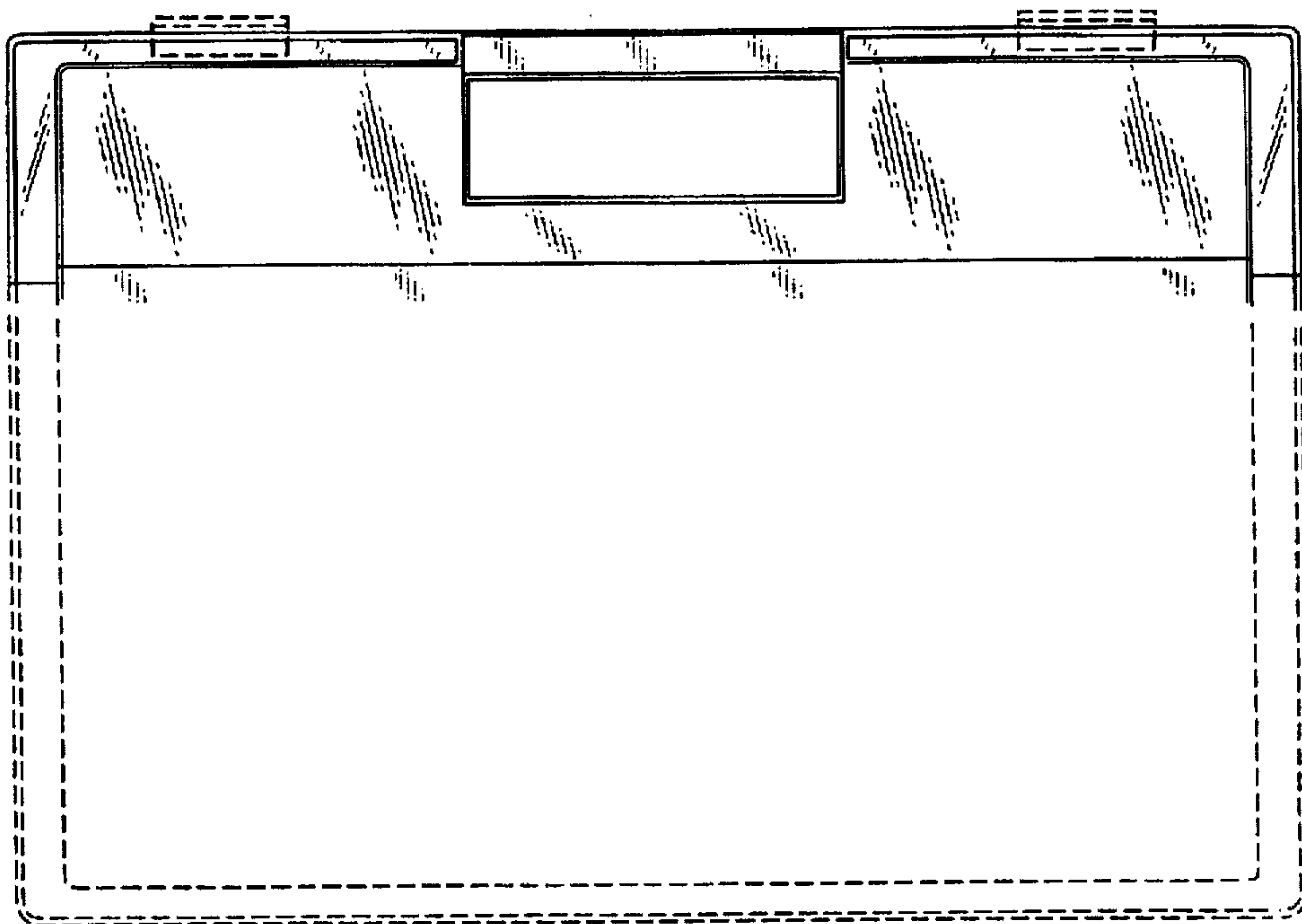
