The ornamental design for a portion of a patterned film, as shown and described.

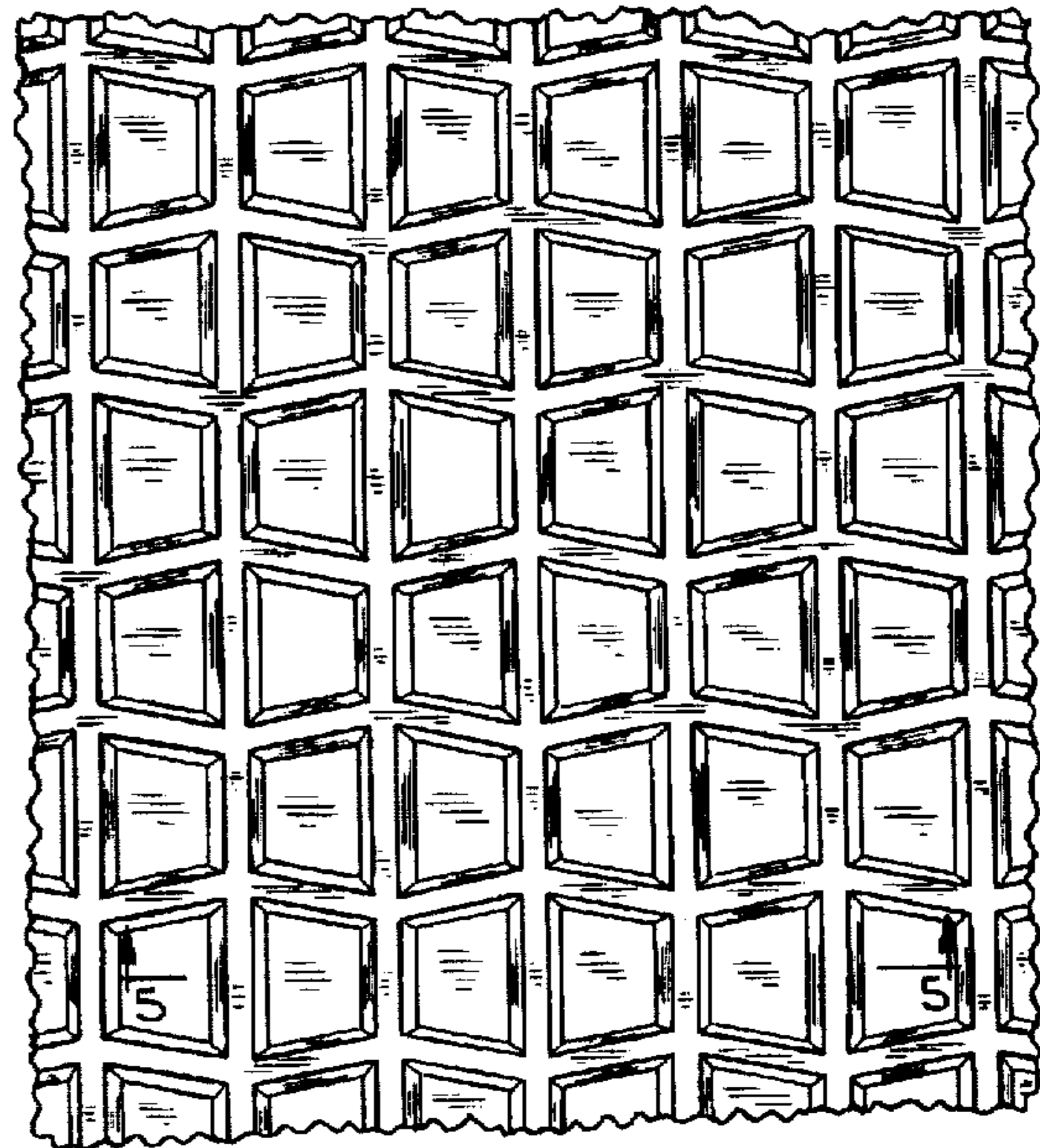
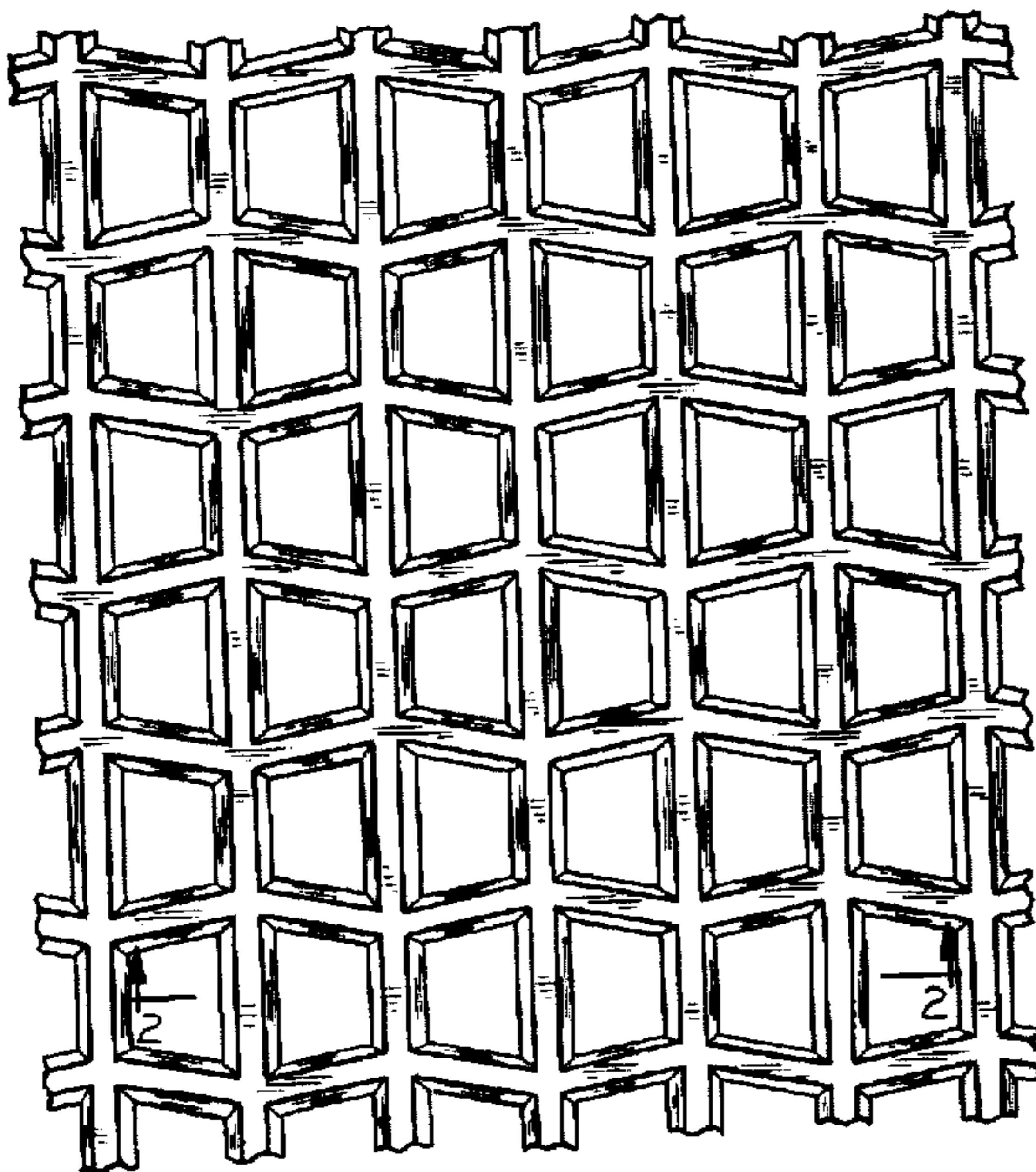
**DESCRIPTION**

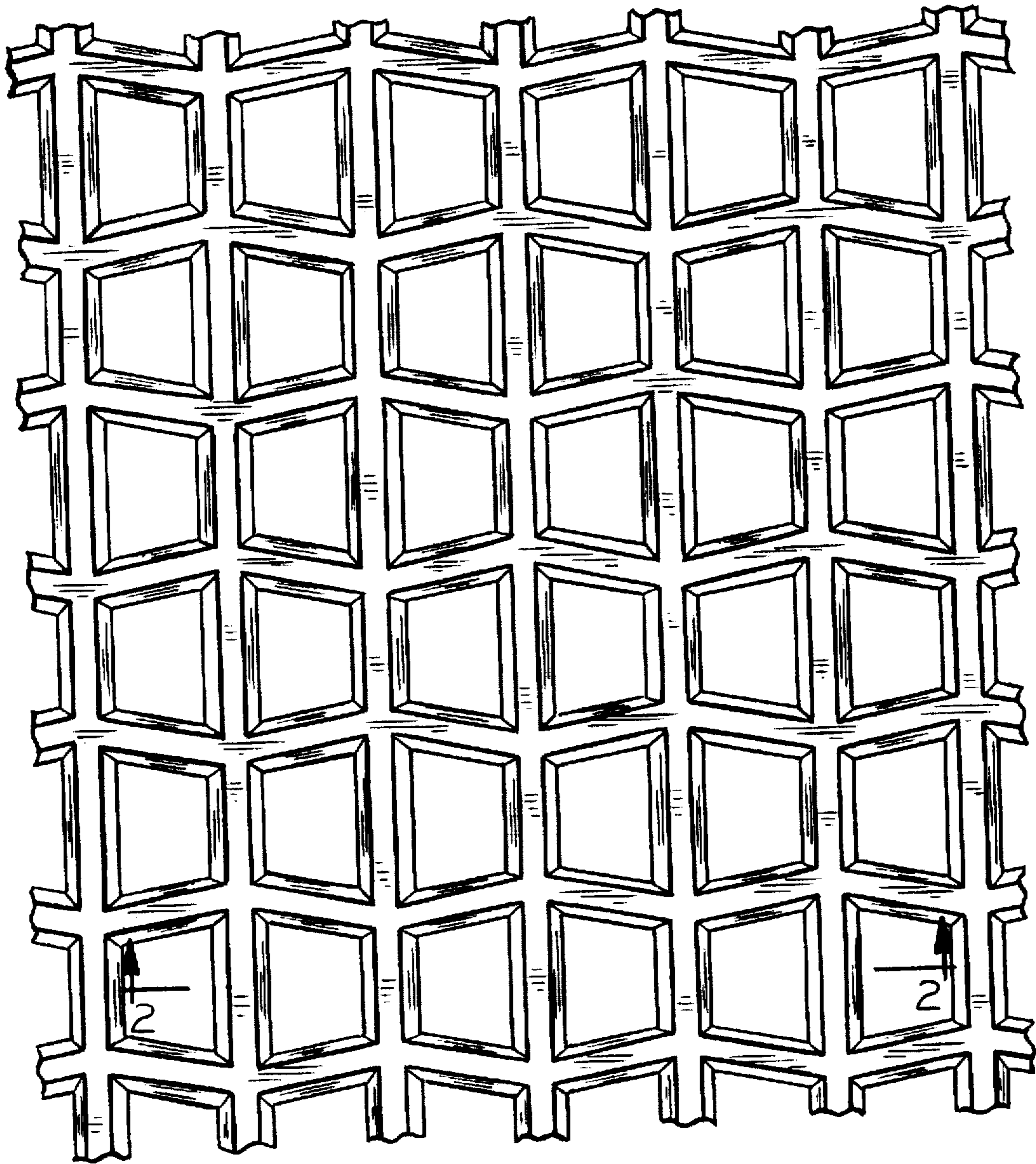
FIG. 1 is a front view of a first apertured embodiment of a portion of a patterned film showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view of the film taken along line 2—2 in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the film of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a top view of a second unapertured embodiment of a film of my portion of a patterned new design;  
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 4; and,  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the film of FIG. 4.

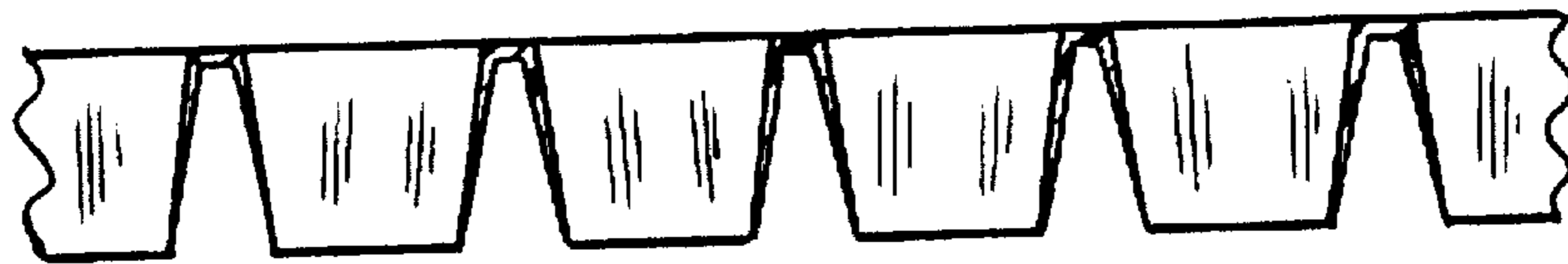

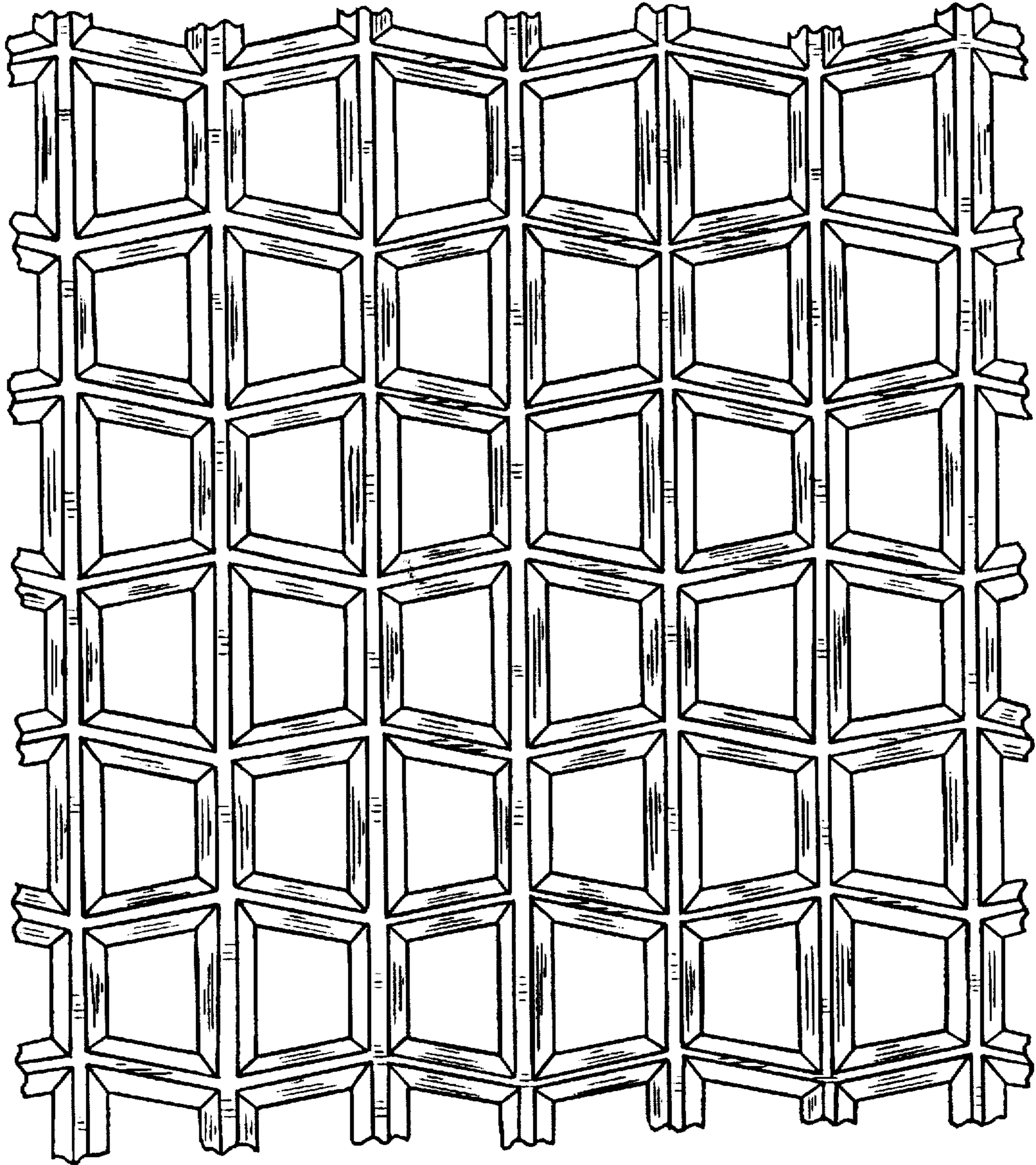




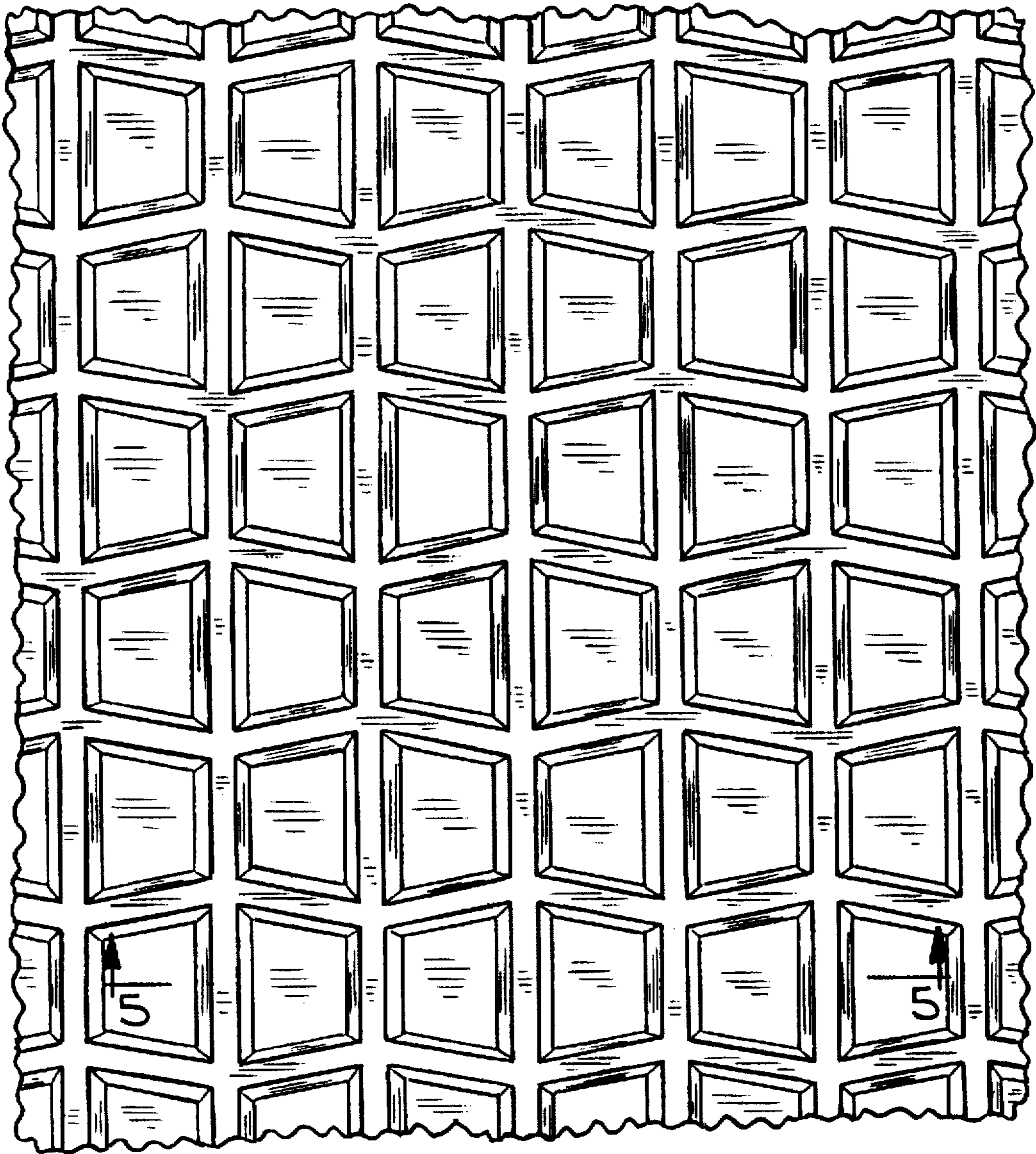

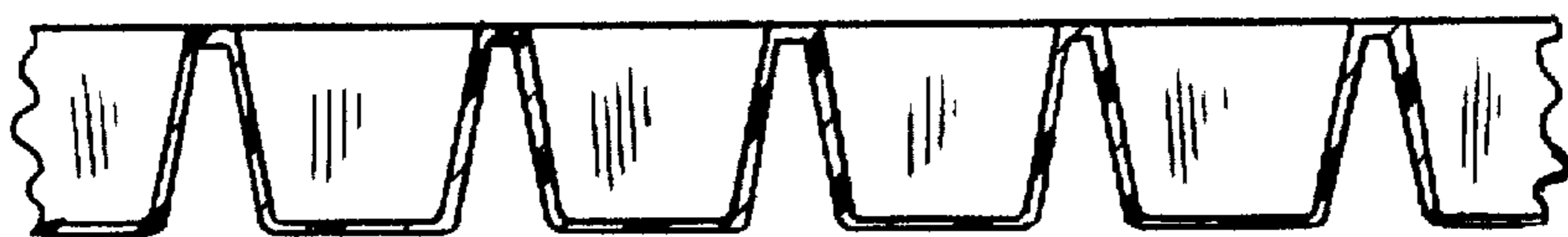

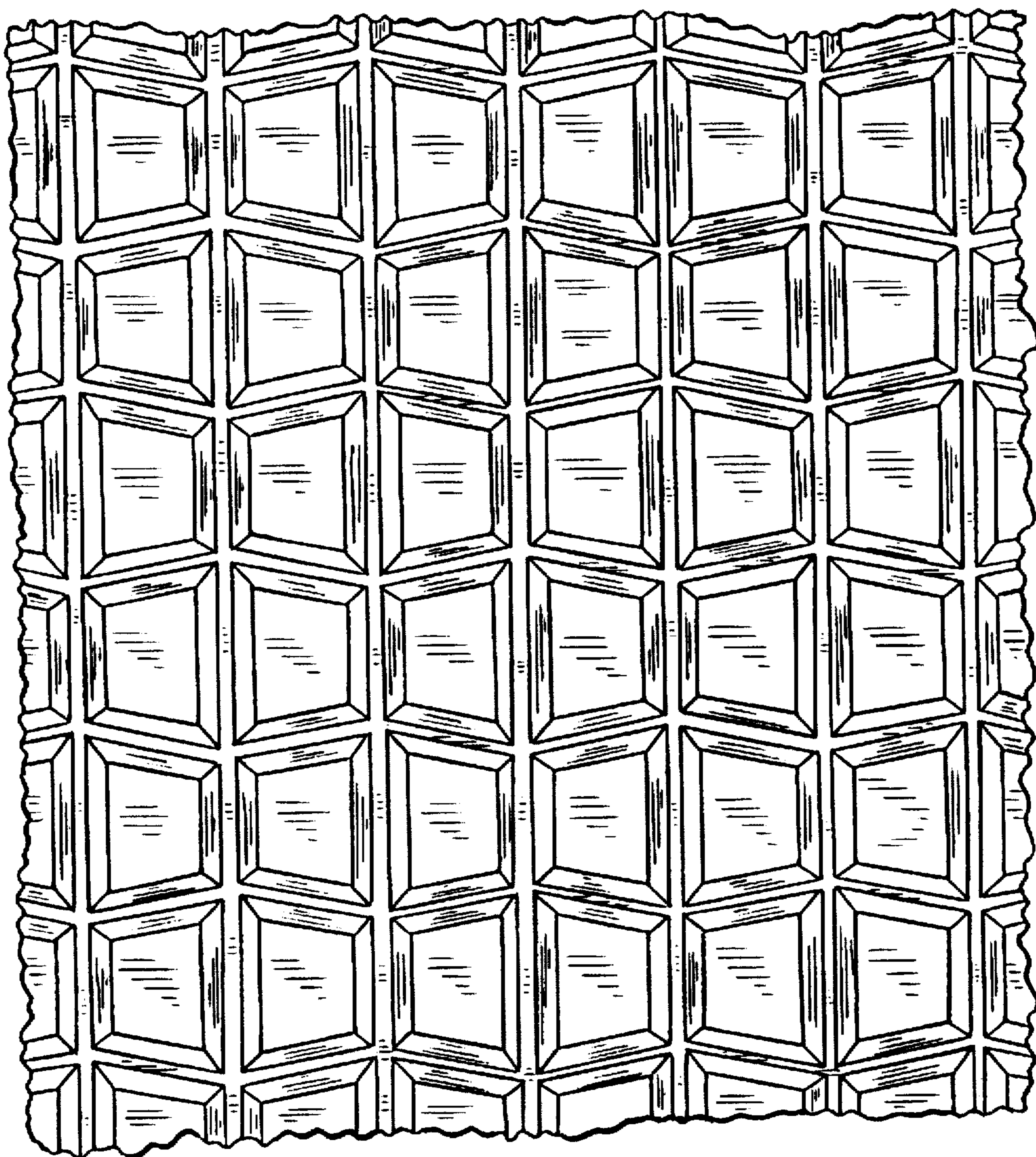
