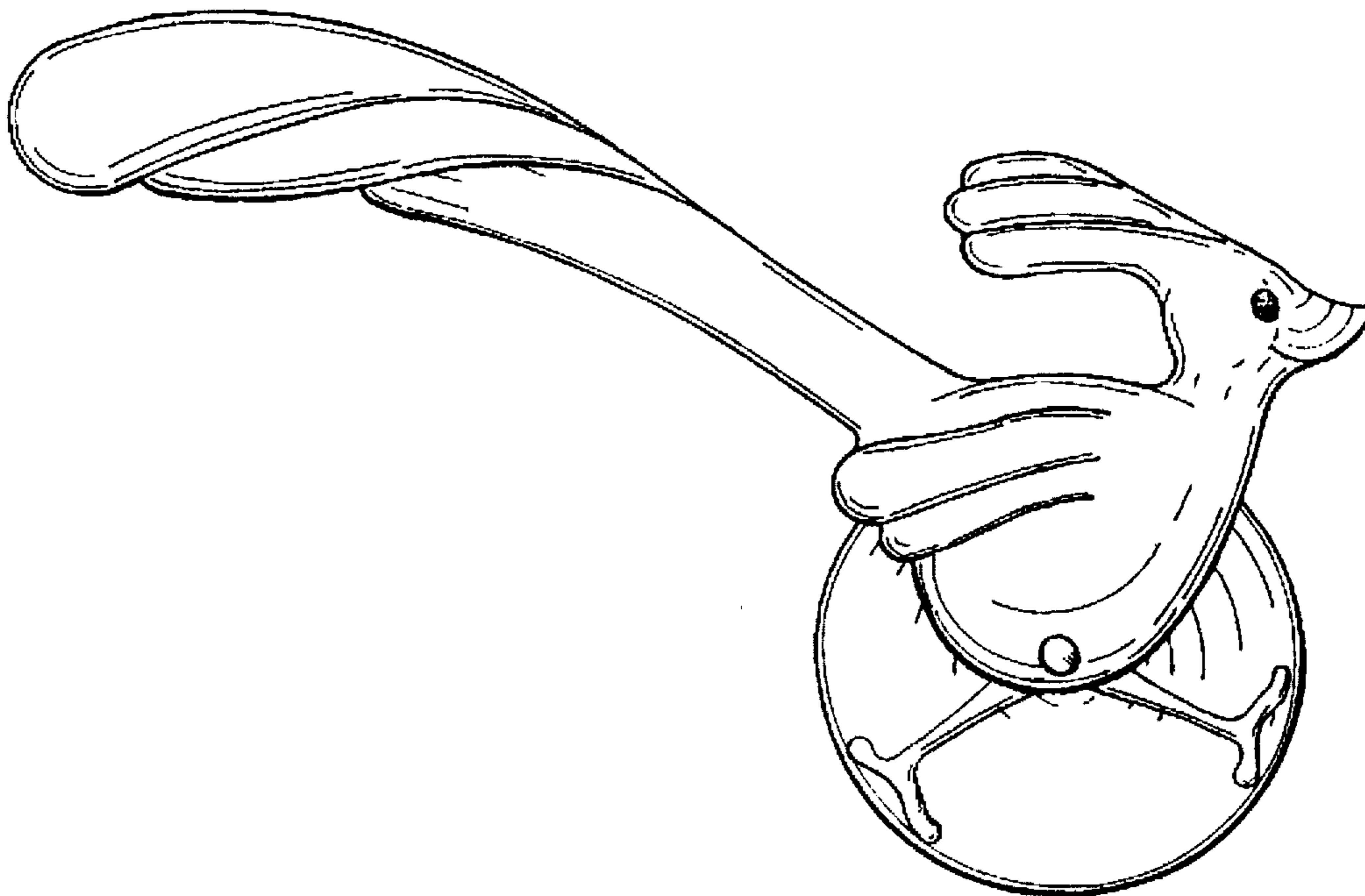
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a roadrunner shaped pizza cutter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side, front perspective view of a roadrunner shaped pizza cutter showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevation view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view thereof.

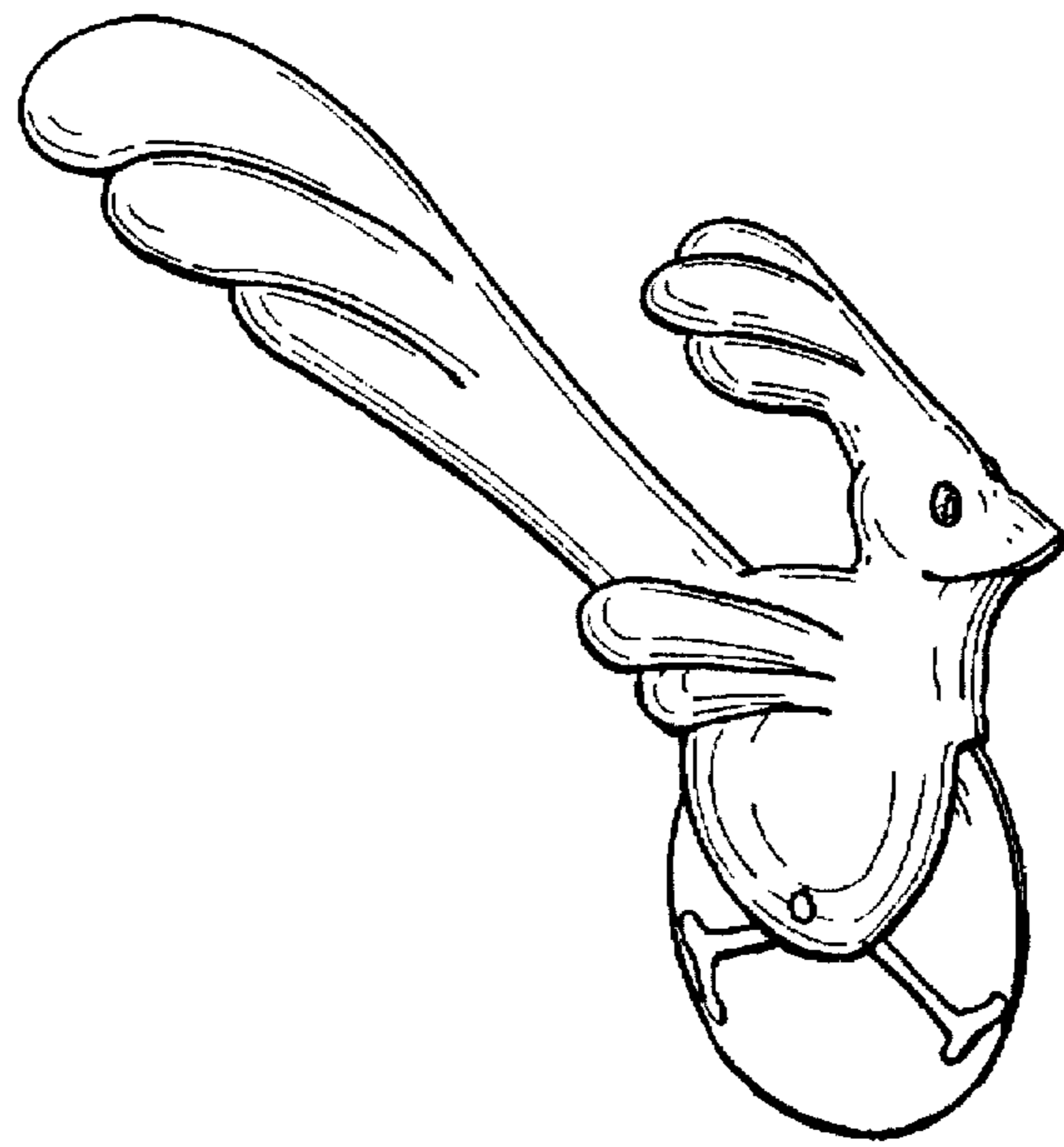

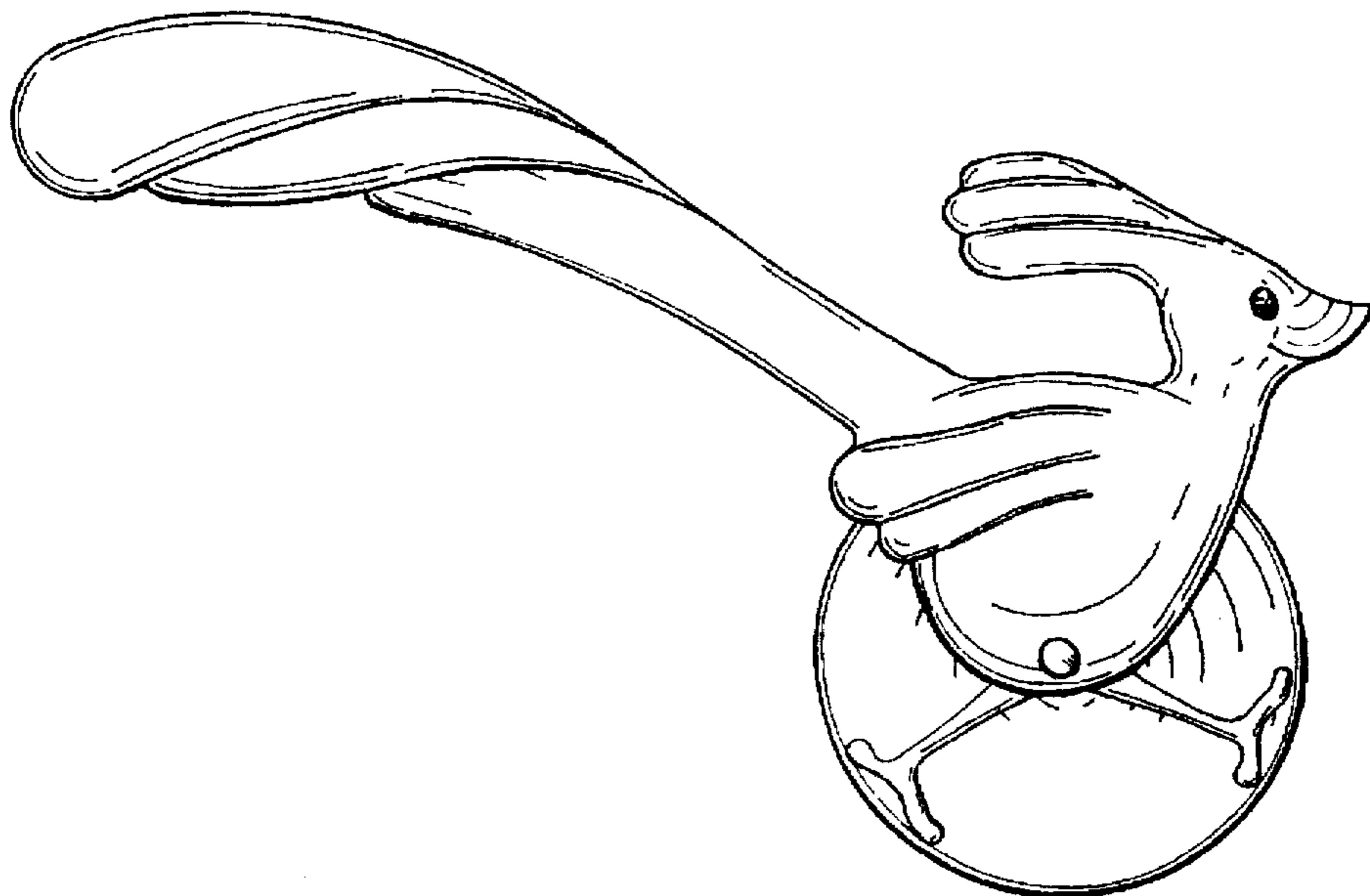

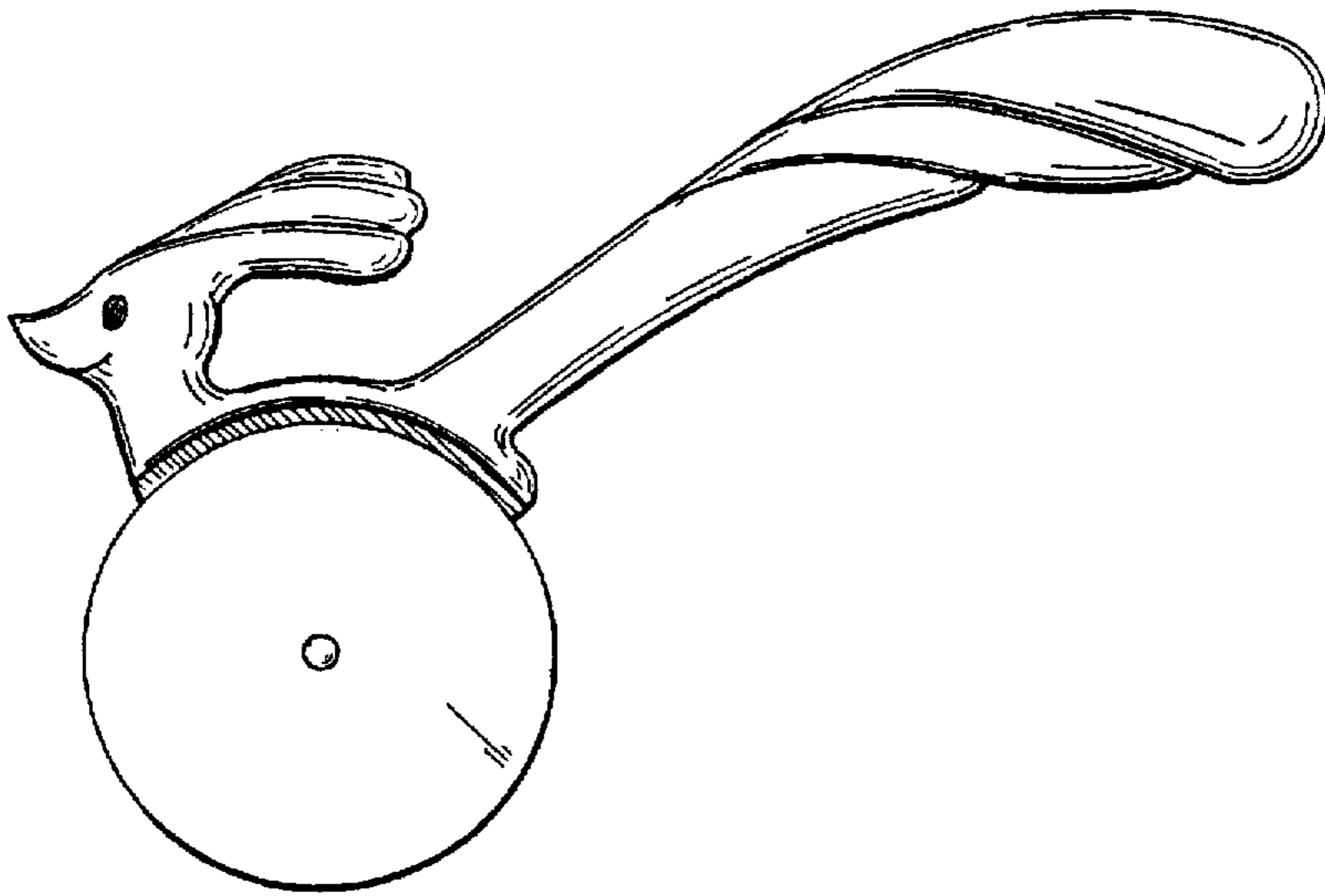

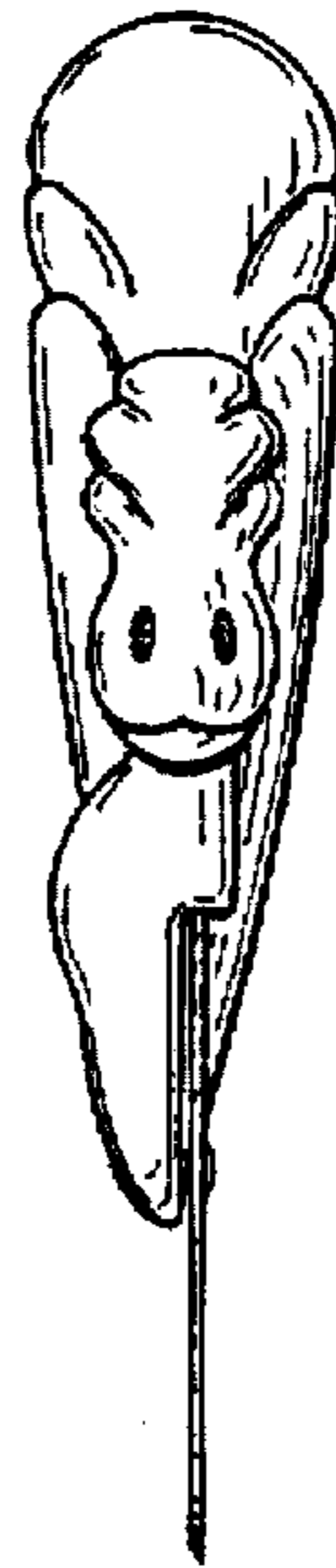

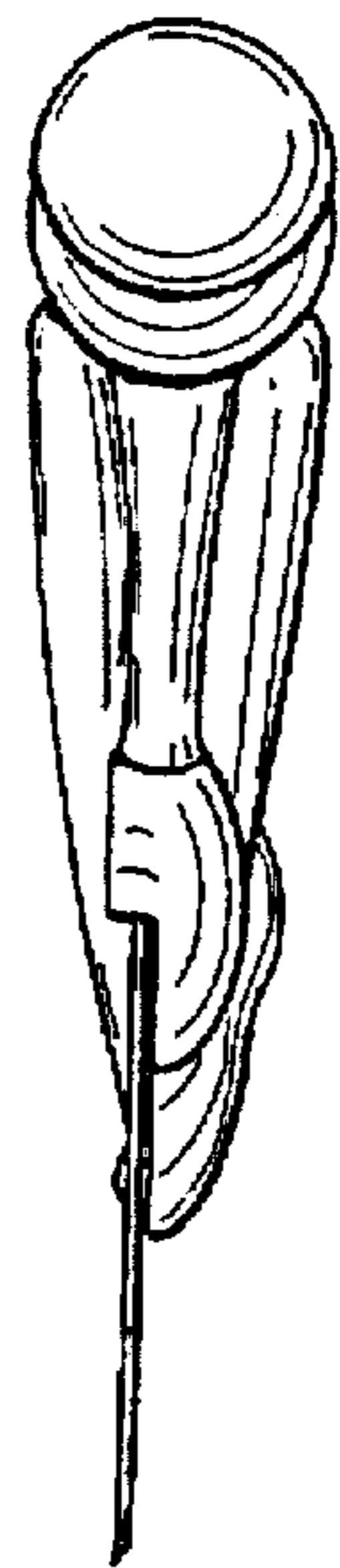
