The ornamental design for a tunnel-hull canoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear view of the square stern canoe showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear, bottom and left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

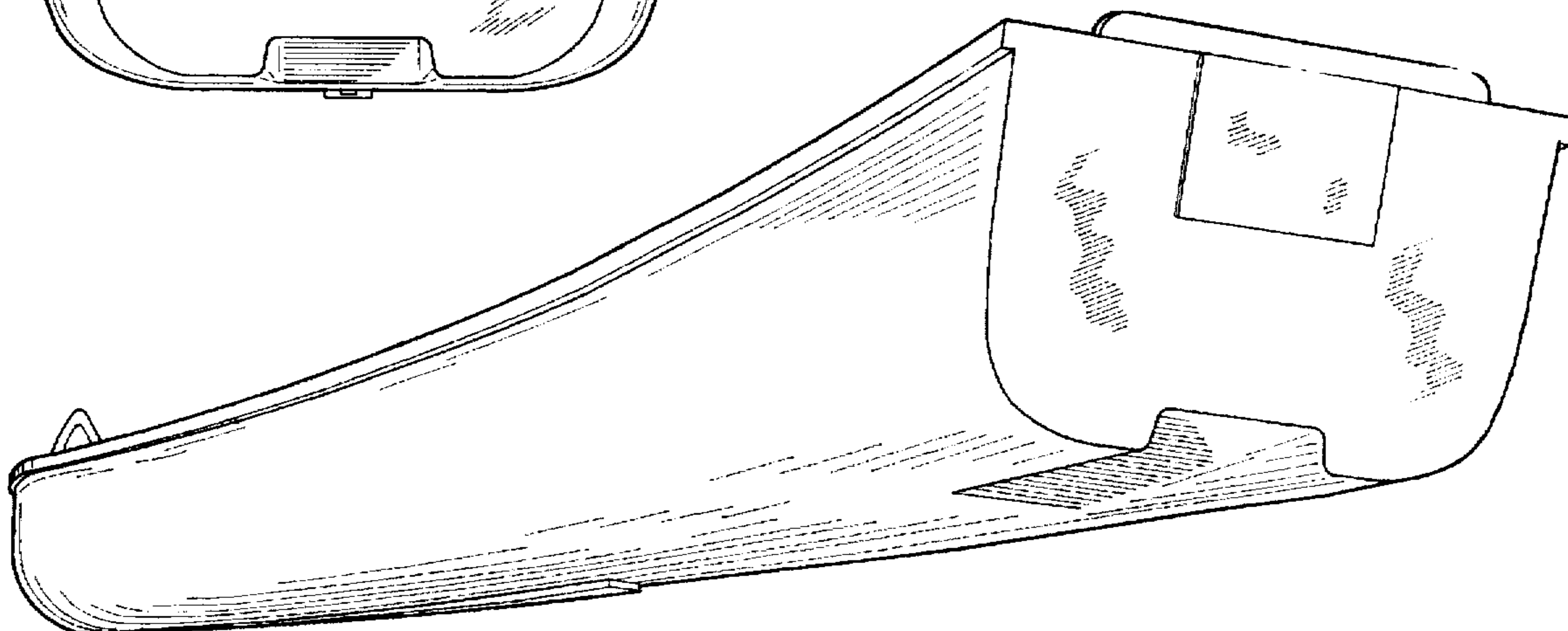
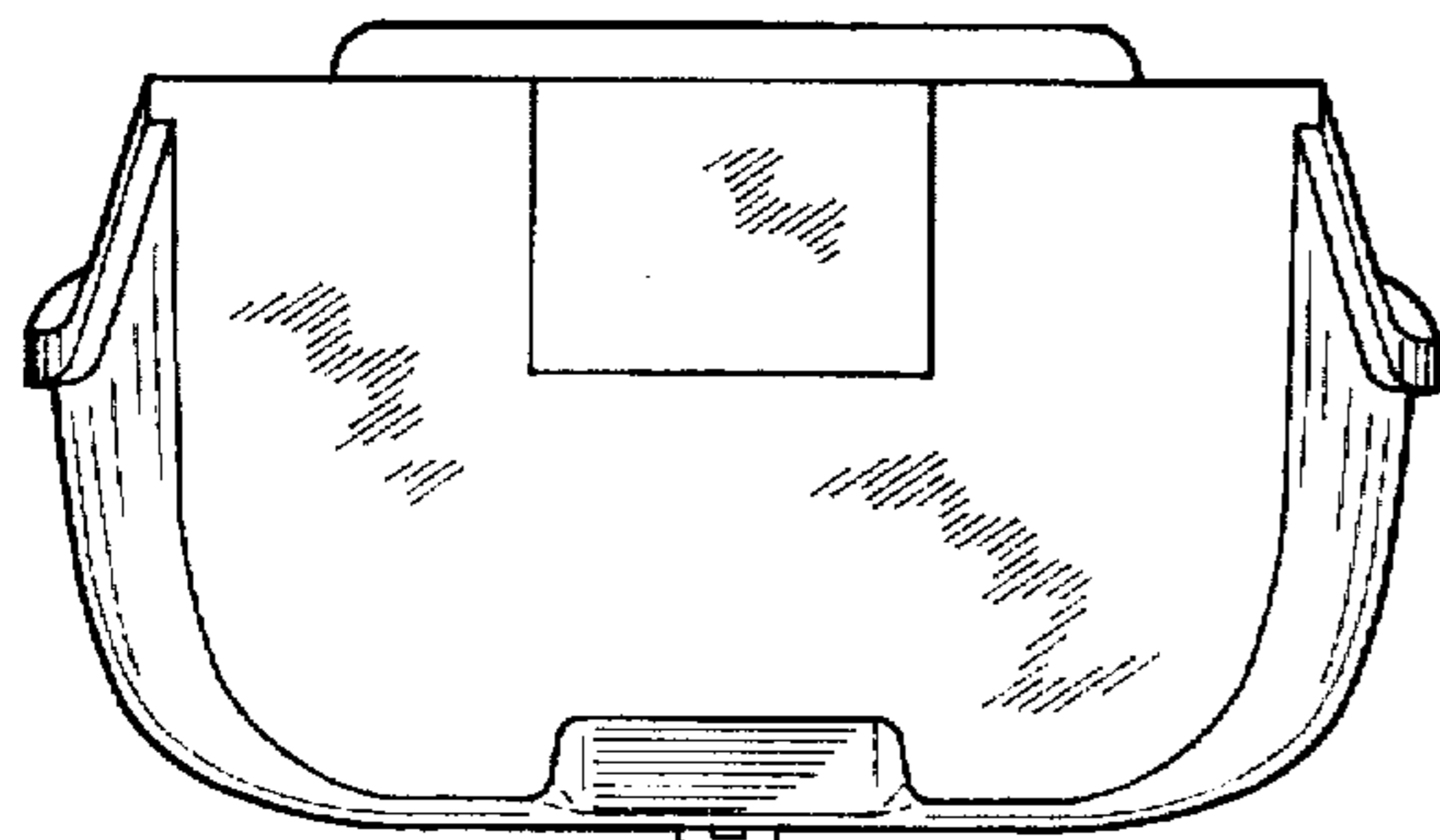
FIG. 4 is a side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is an enlarged view of detail 6 of FIG. 5.

The said design is characterized by an inward recess in the hull of a square stern canoe, along a longitudinal axis thereof. The recess has generally parallel sides, and a depth tapering down from the stern toward the front end of said canoe.

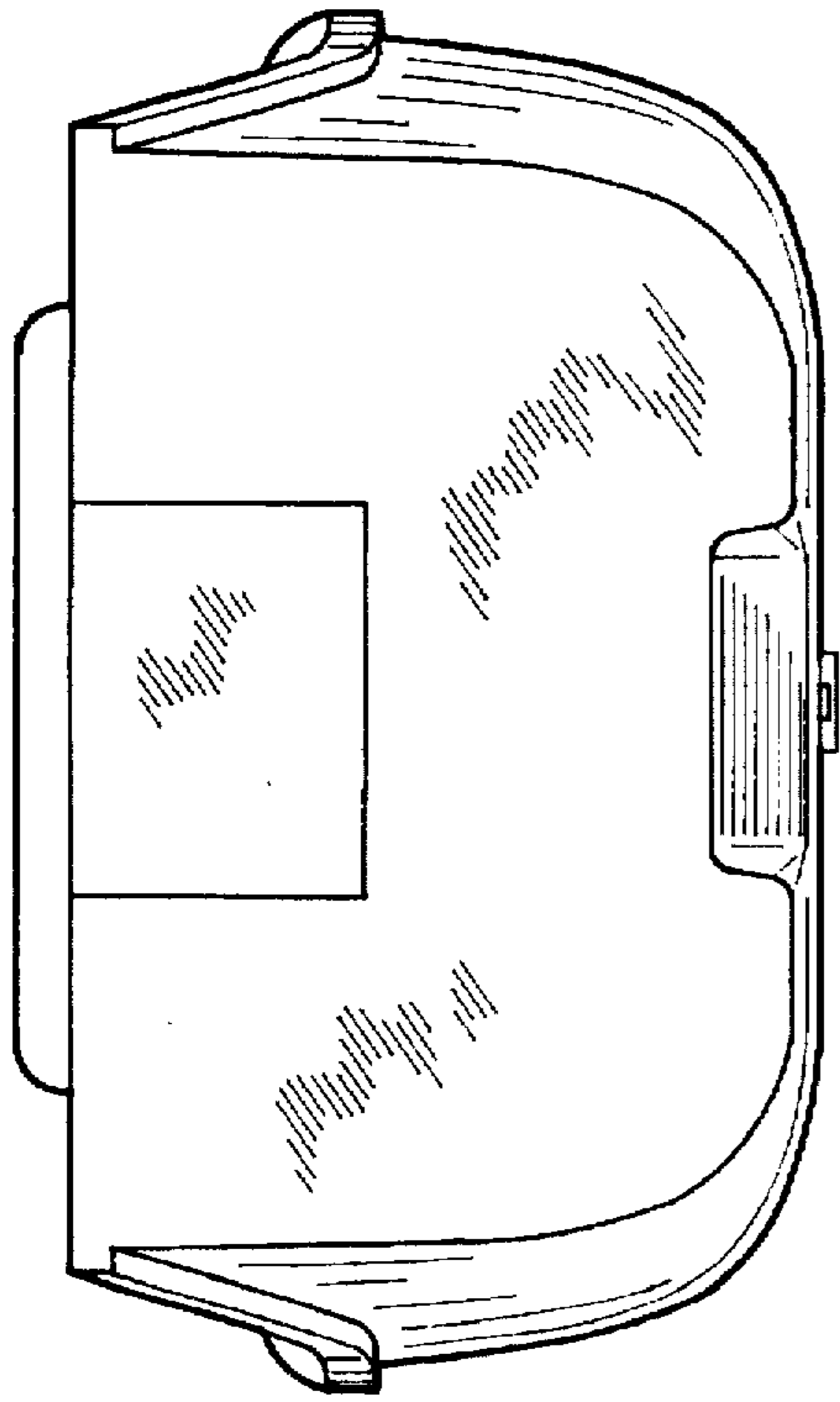

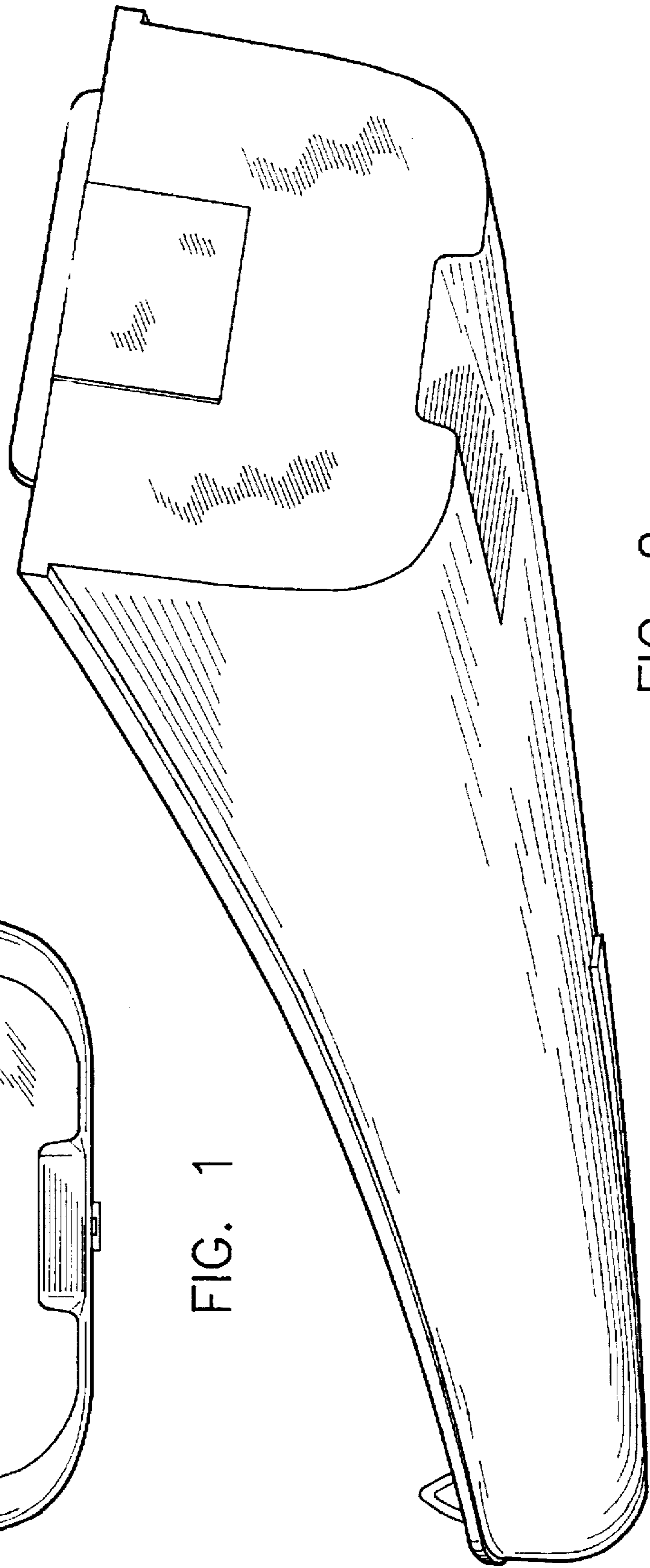

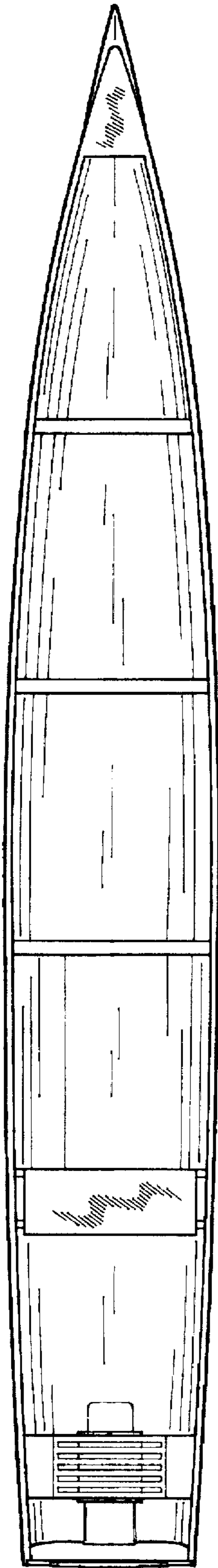

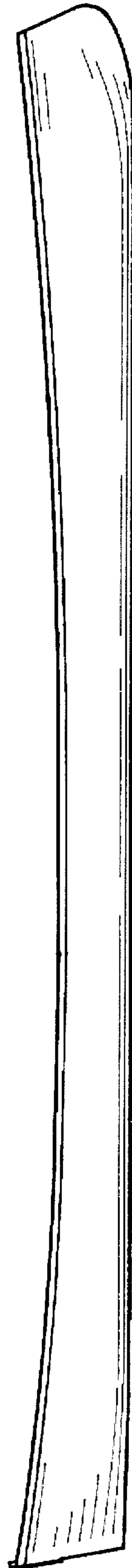
