FIG. 6 is a profile view of the portion of a shoe outsole of


FIG. 1 taken along the line 6—6 of FIG. 2; and,


FIG. 7 is a profile view of the portion of a shoe outsole of


FIG. 1 taken along the line 7—7 of FIG. 2.






