# [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chess set, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a "King" chess set playing piece embodying the design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a "Queen" chess set playing piece embodying the design;

FIG. 22 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 23 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 24 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being the same;


FIG. 25 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a "bishop's pawn" (left pawn) chess set playing piece emboding the design; and,


FIG. 26 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a "bishop's pawn" (right pawn) chess set playing piece embodying the design.




































Fig.20 Fig.21


