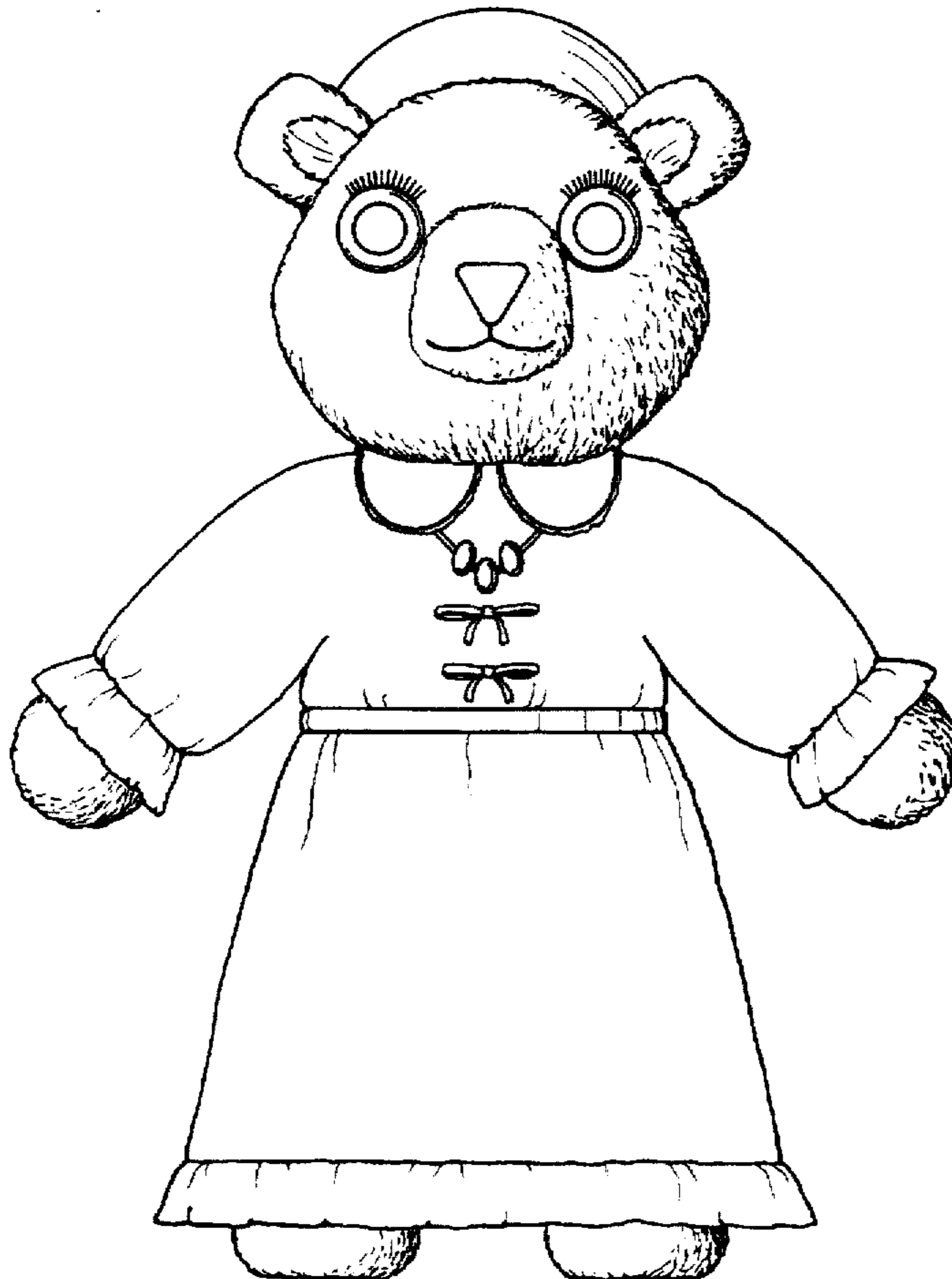
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a female birth stone bear, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the female birth stone bear of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a rear view of the female birth stone bear of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the female birth stone bear of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a right side view of the female birth stone bear of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a top view of the female birth stone bear of FIG. 1; and,

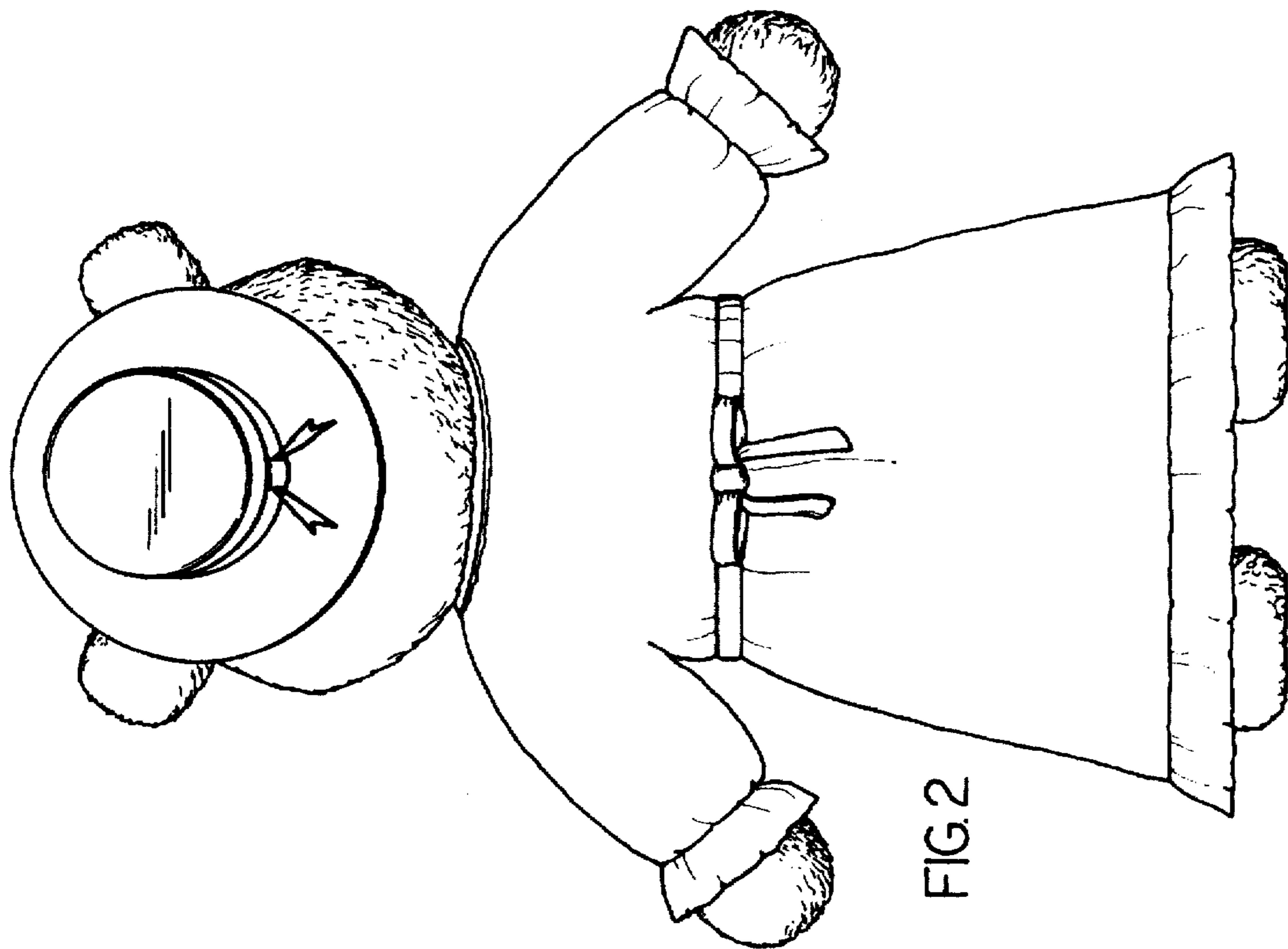

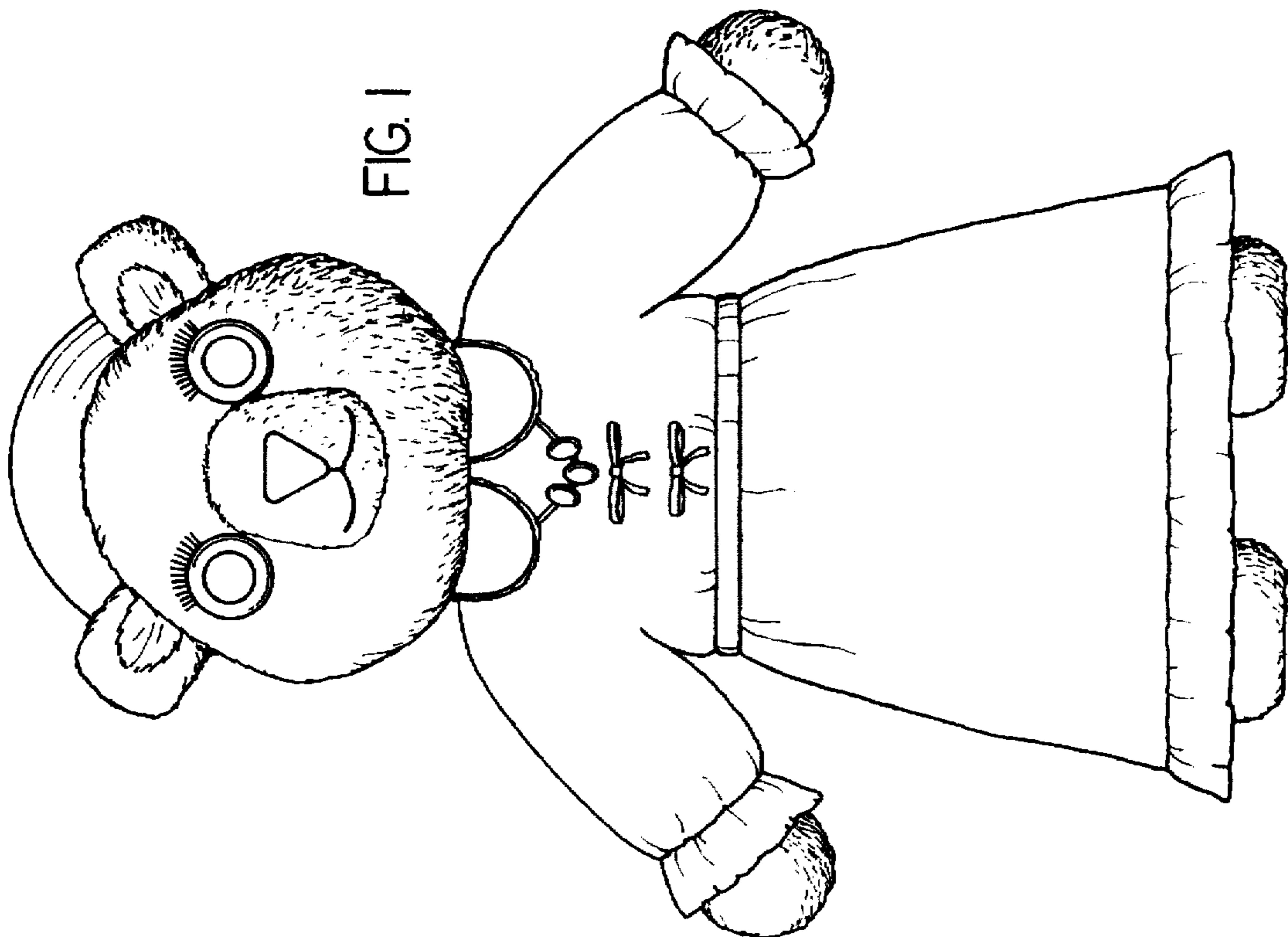

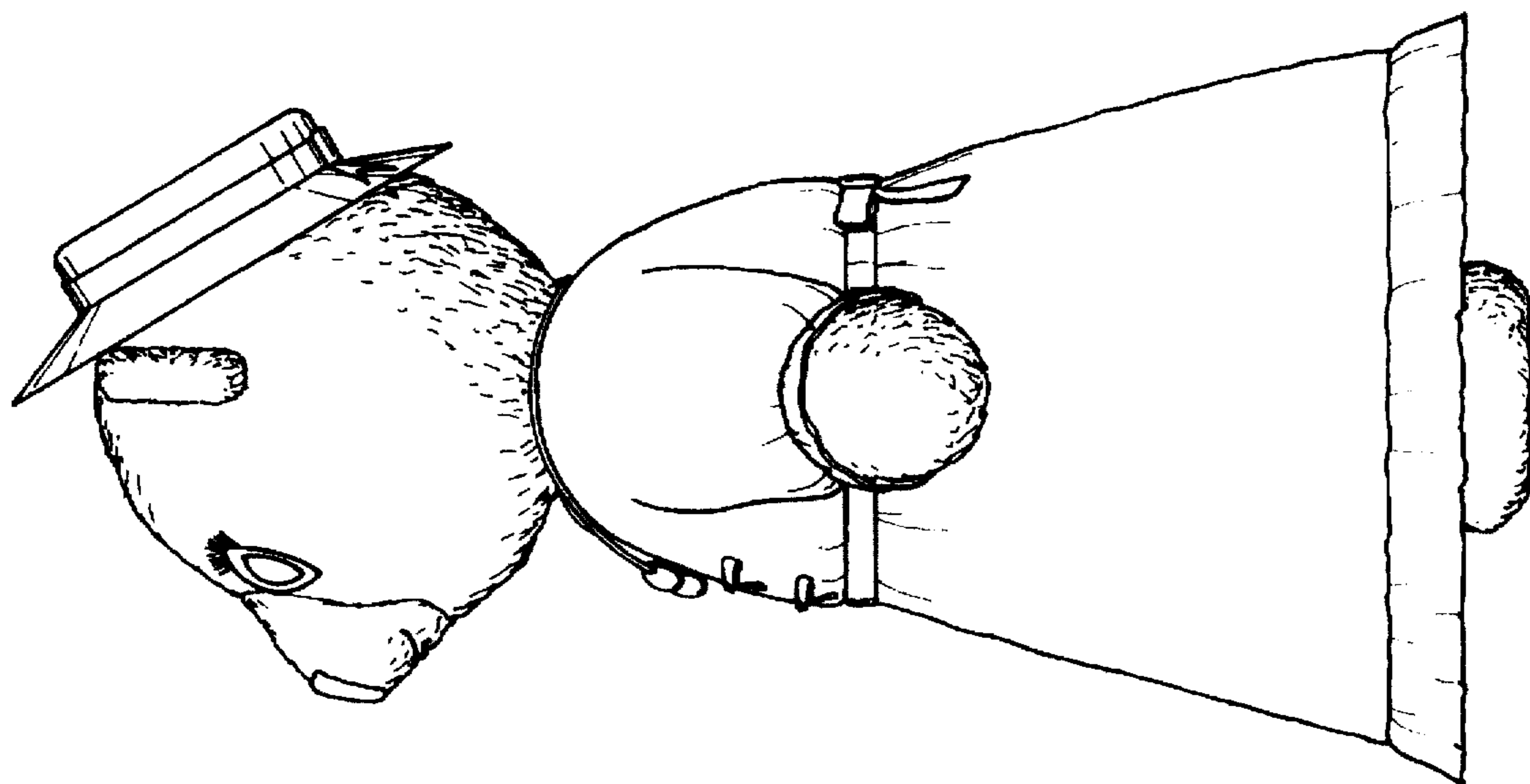

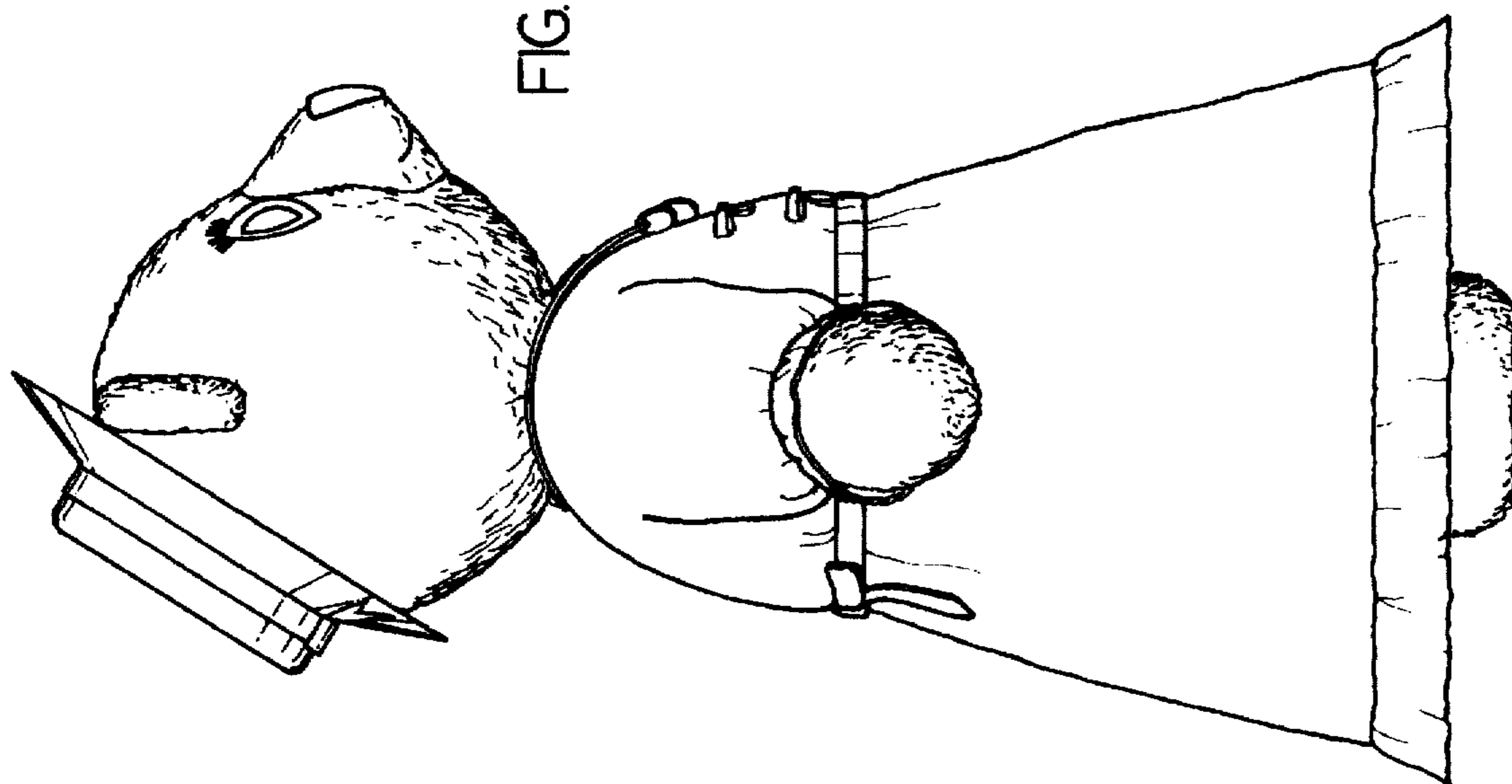

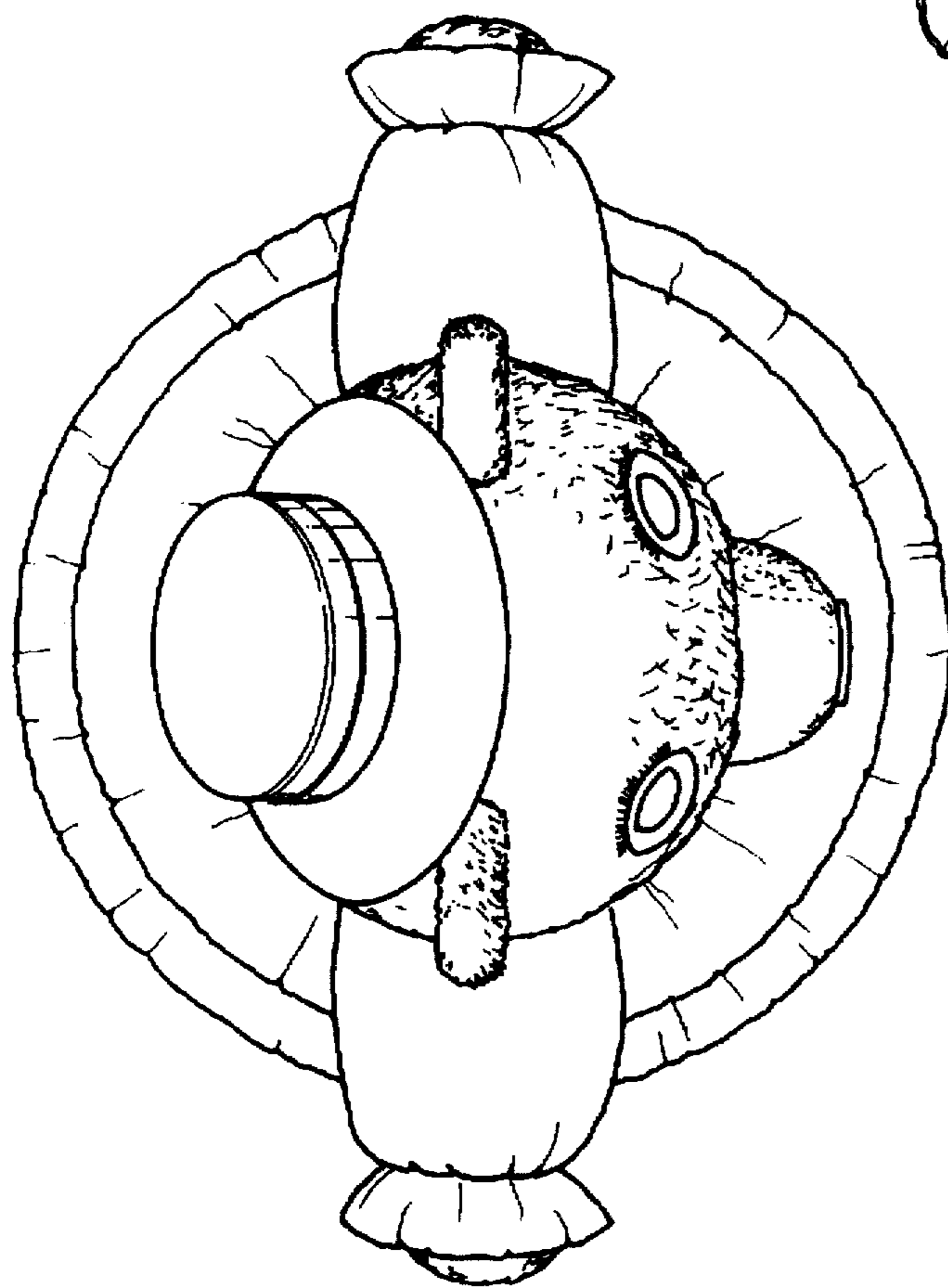
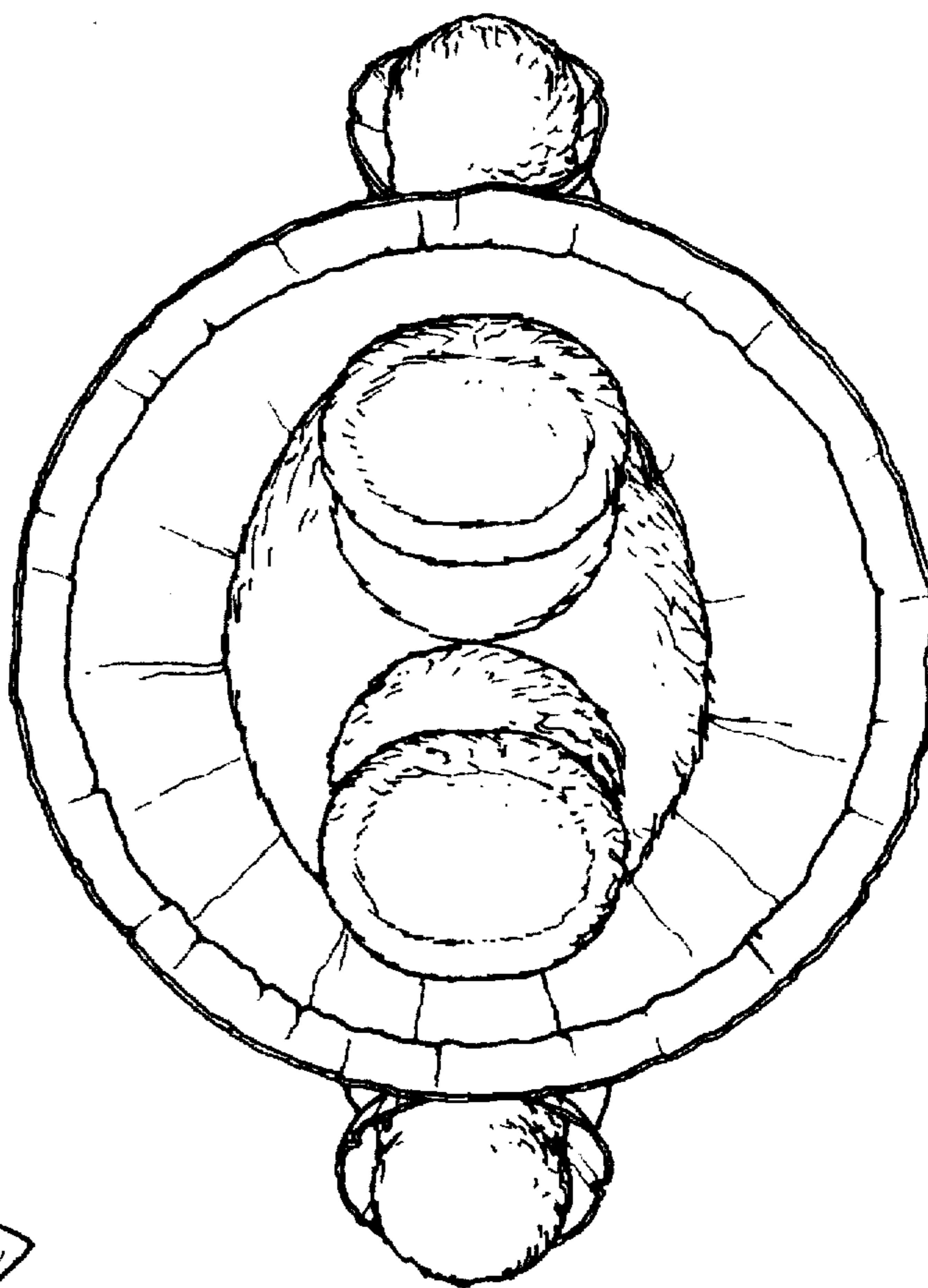
