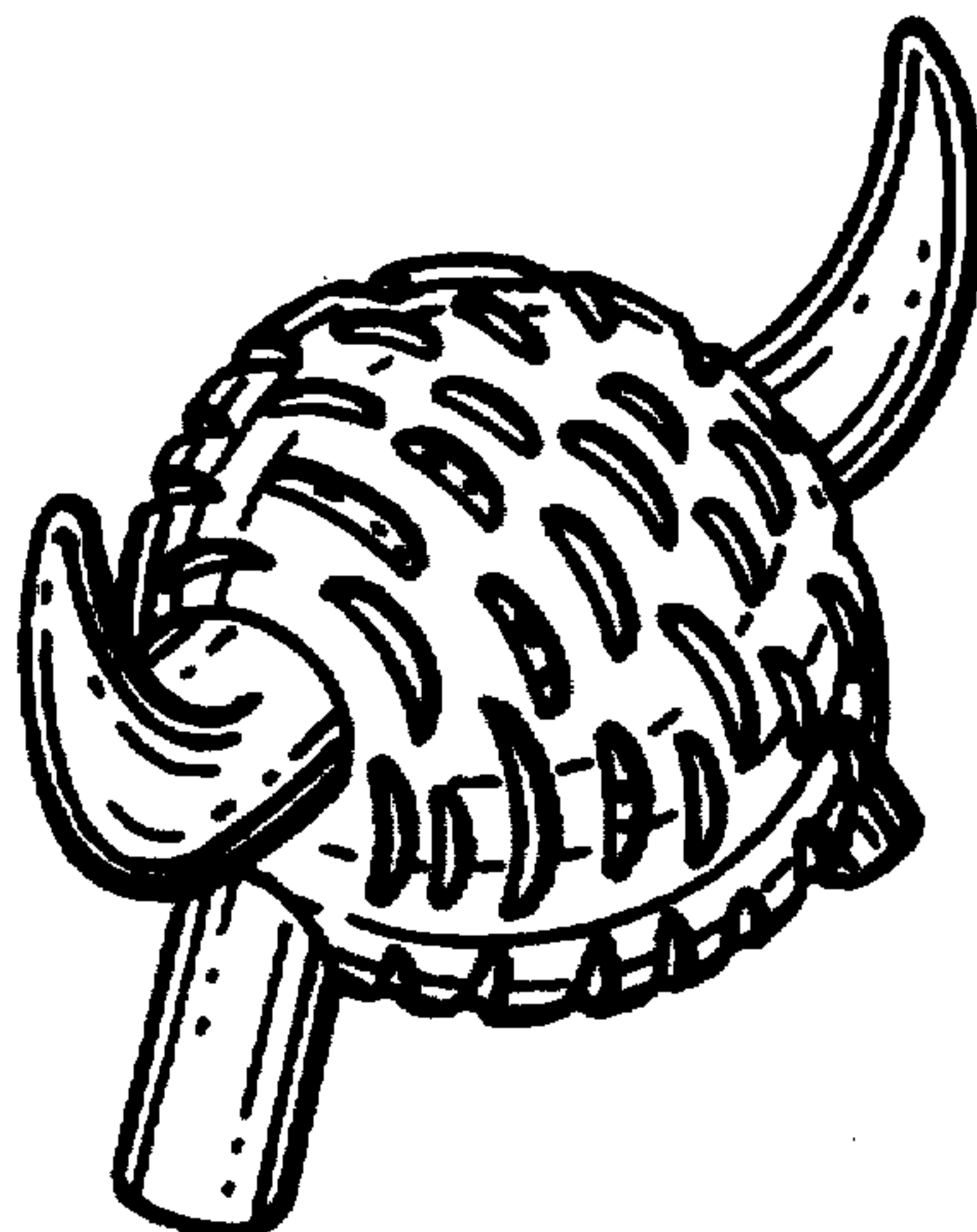
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a headgear for a toy figure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the headgear for a toy figure;
FIG. 2 is a rear bottom perspective thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; the other side being identical;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

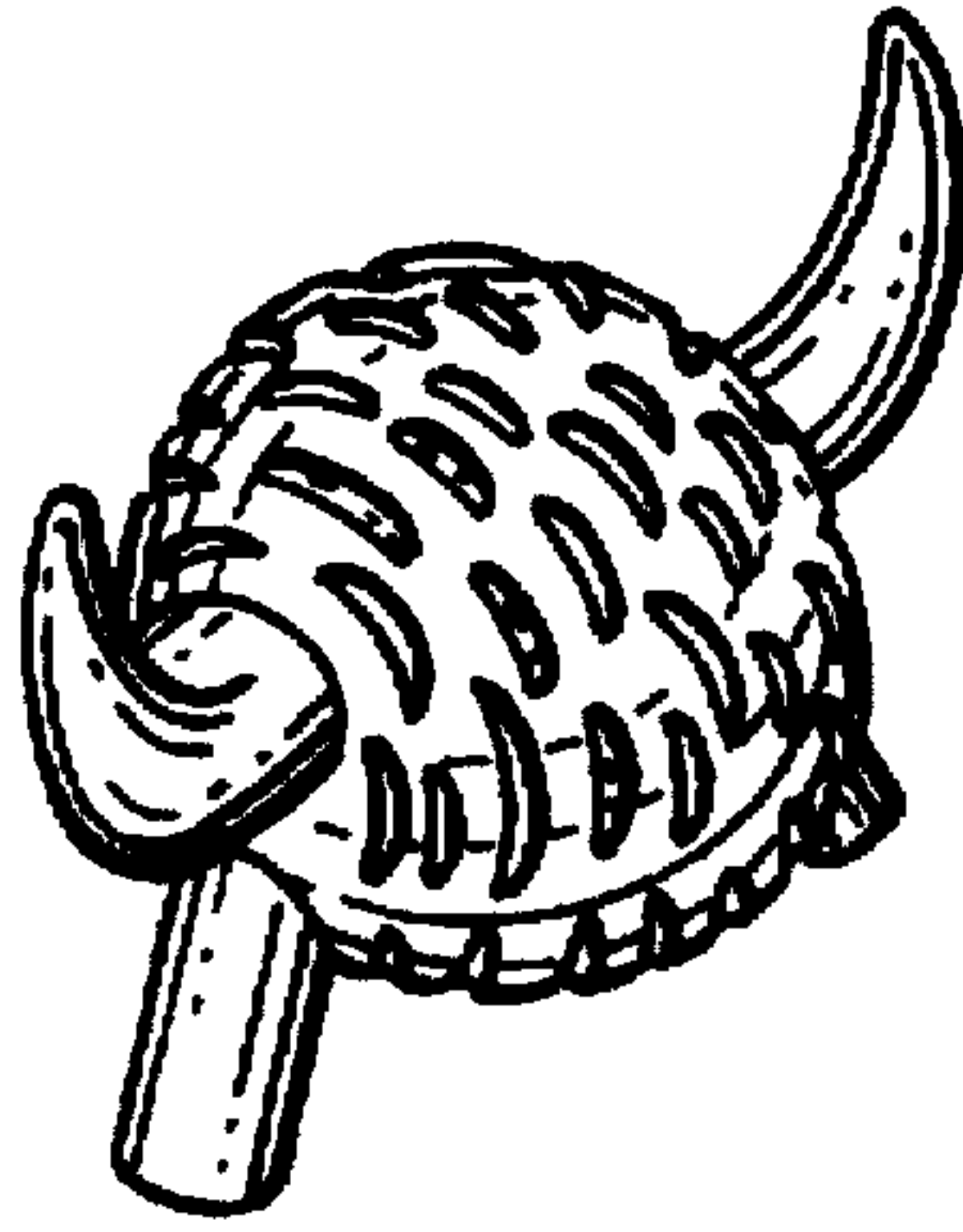

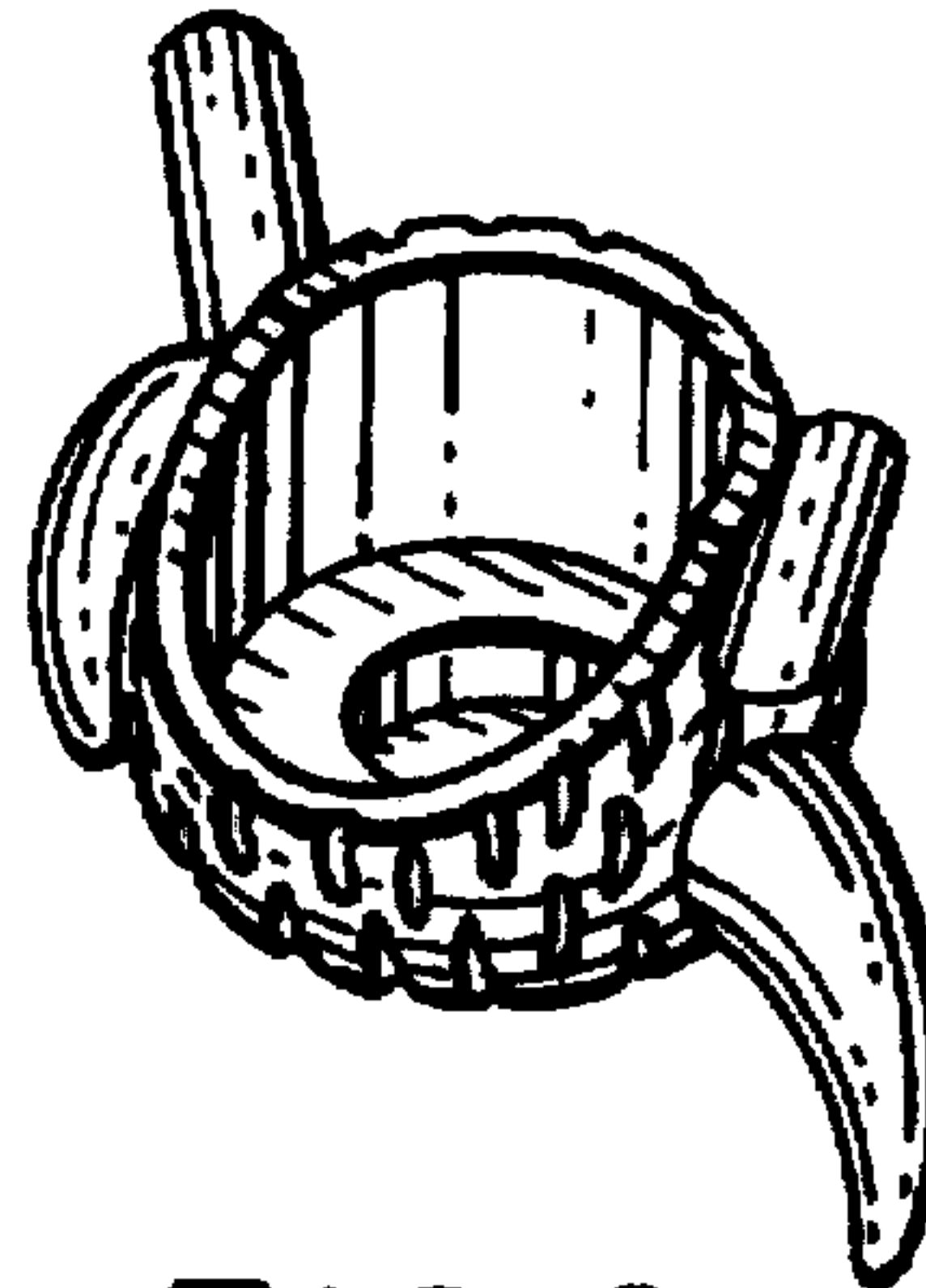

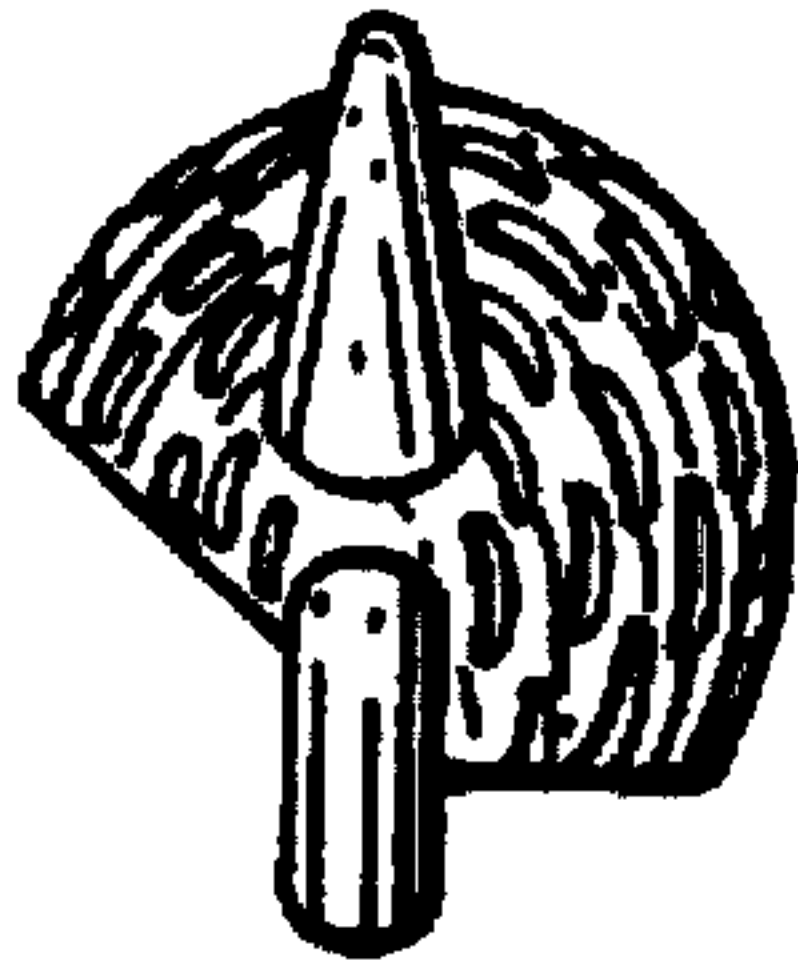

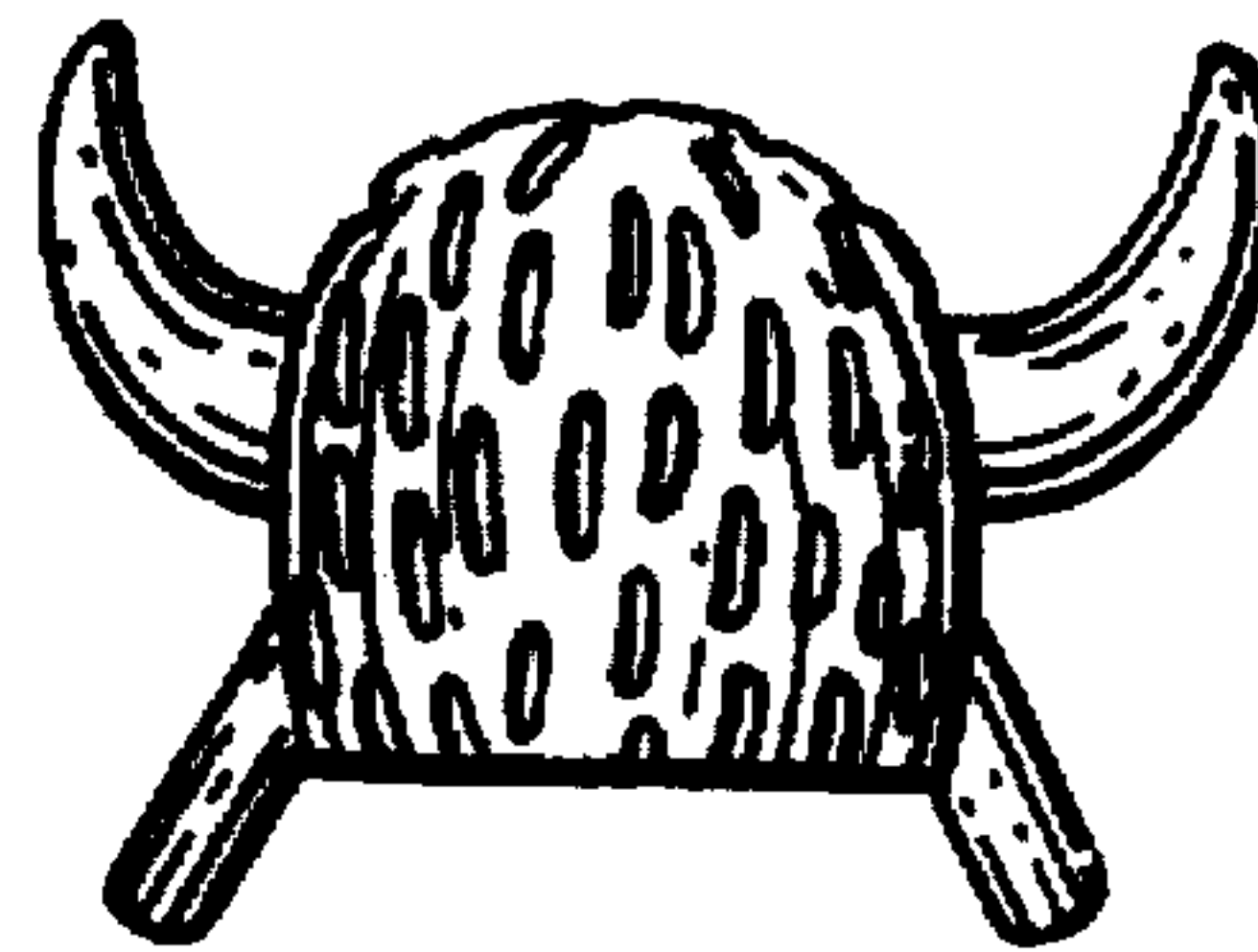

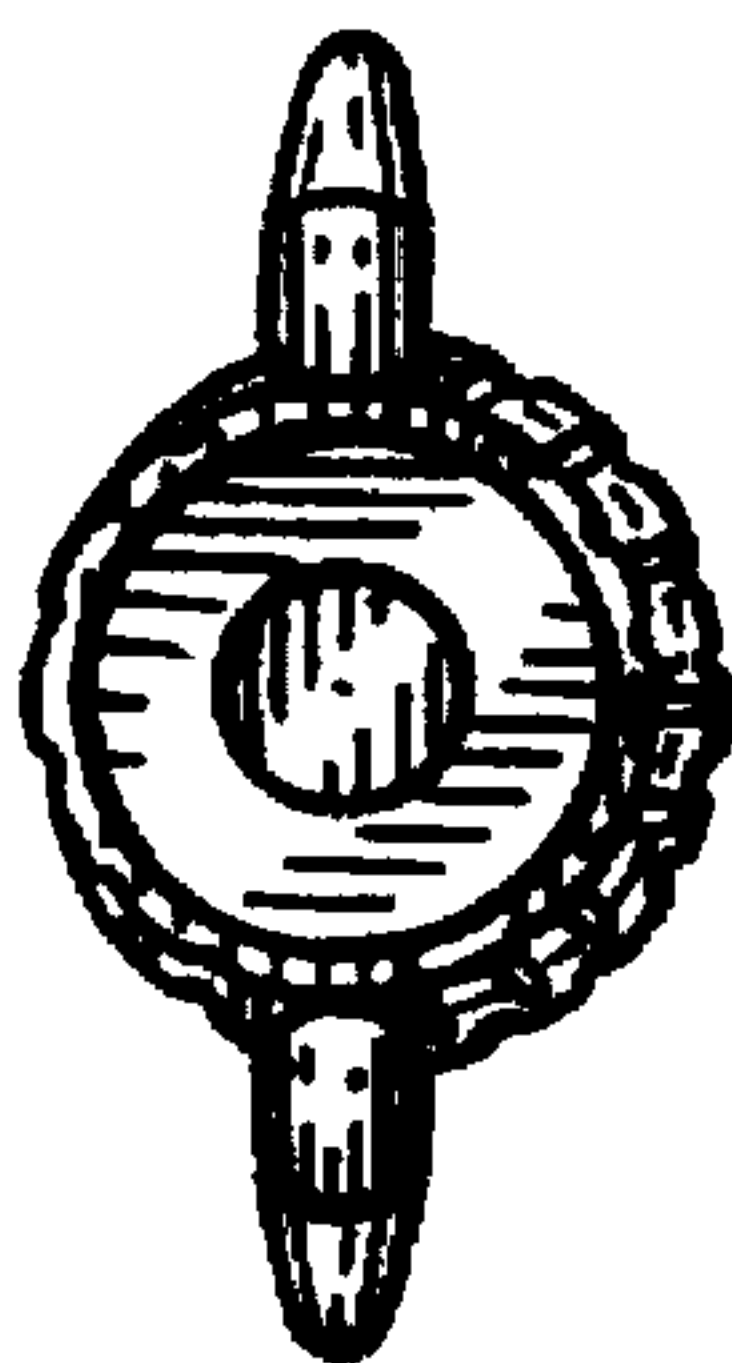

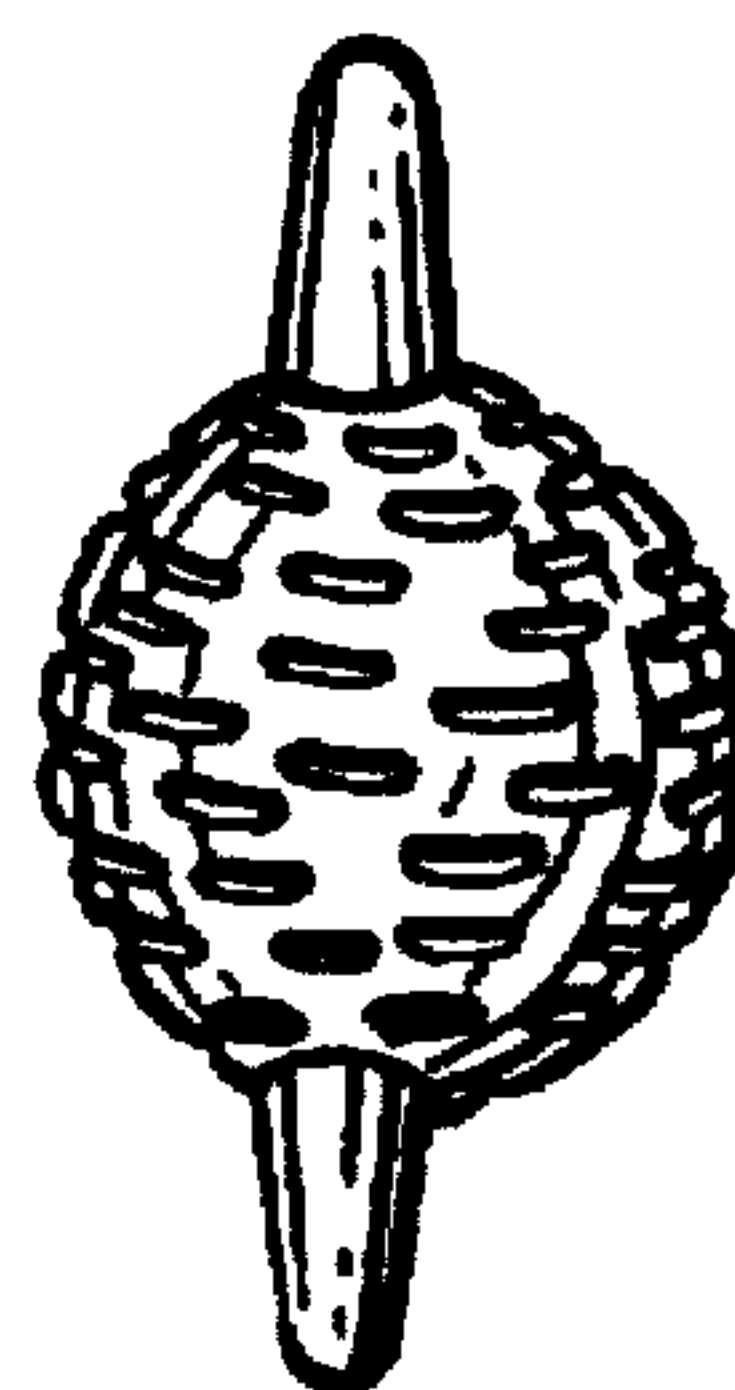
