The ornamental design for an ornamental child's foldable seat cushion in the fanciful form of a Dalmatian dog, as shown and described.

CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the cushion taken from above the left front corner with the back portion folded over the seat portion;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view similar to that of FIG. 1, but showing the back portion swung up and back from the seat portion;

FIG. 3 is a top view of the cushion with the back folded over the seat cushion as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front view of the cushion with the back and seat portions disposed as shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the cushion with the back and seat portions disposed as shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 6 is a view taken of the left side of the cushion as shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a rear view taken of the cushion as shown in FIG. 1.

The stippled shading represents conventional fabric and is understood to extend uniformly throughout the areas represented.
