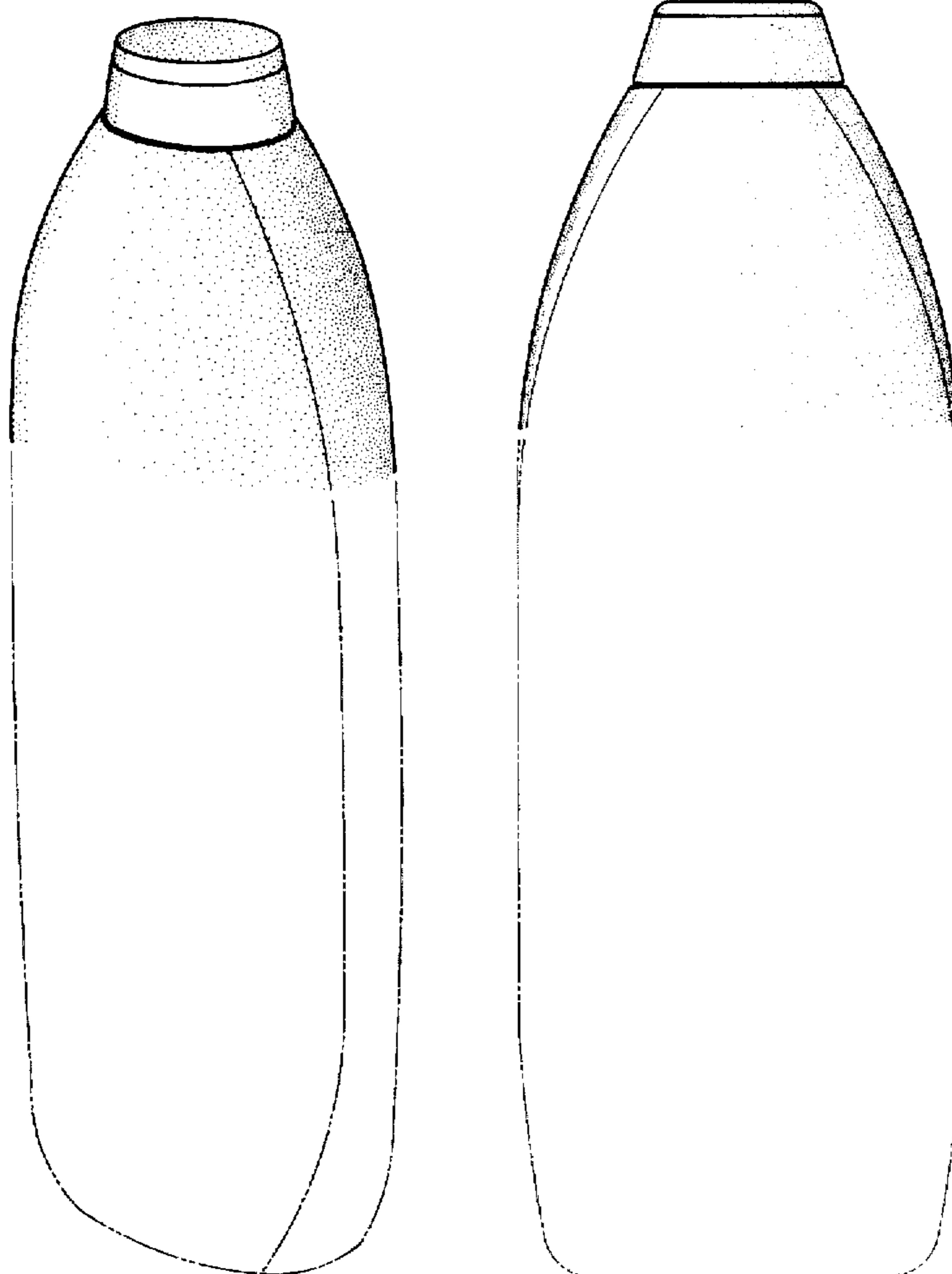
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an upper portion of a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an upper portion of a bottle, embodying our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the back elevational view thereof being the same;
 FIG. 3 is a top view thereof; and,
 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view thereof being the same.
 The broken lines shown in the figures are for illustrative purposes only, and form no part of the claimed invention.

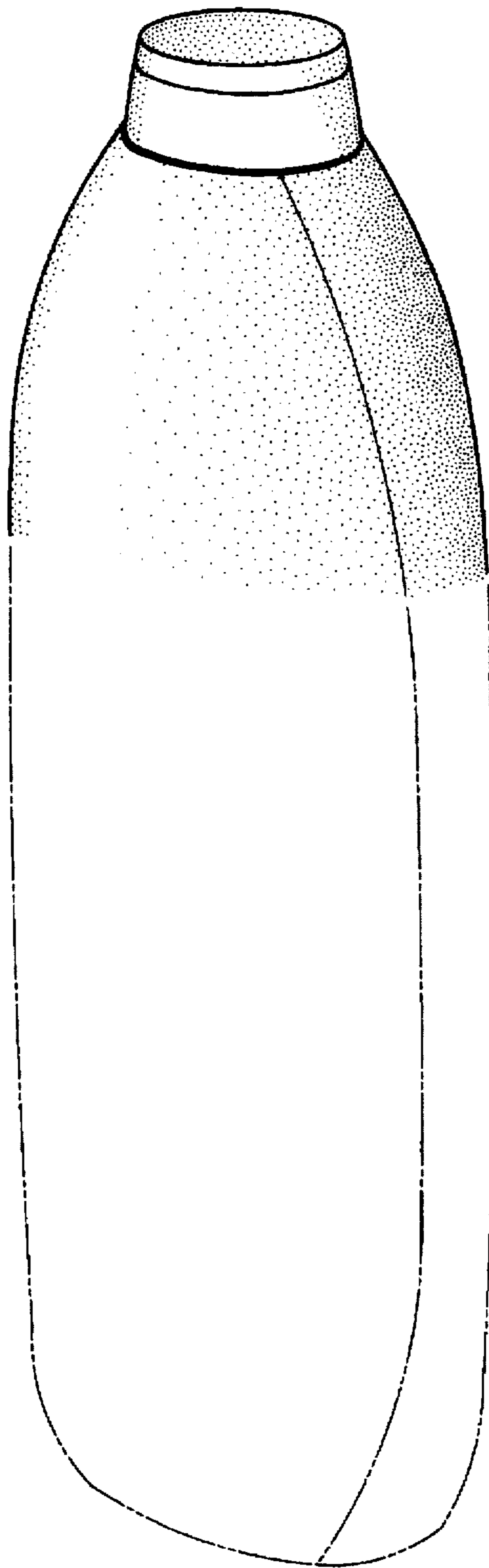

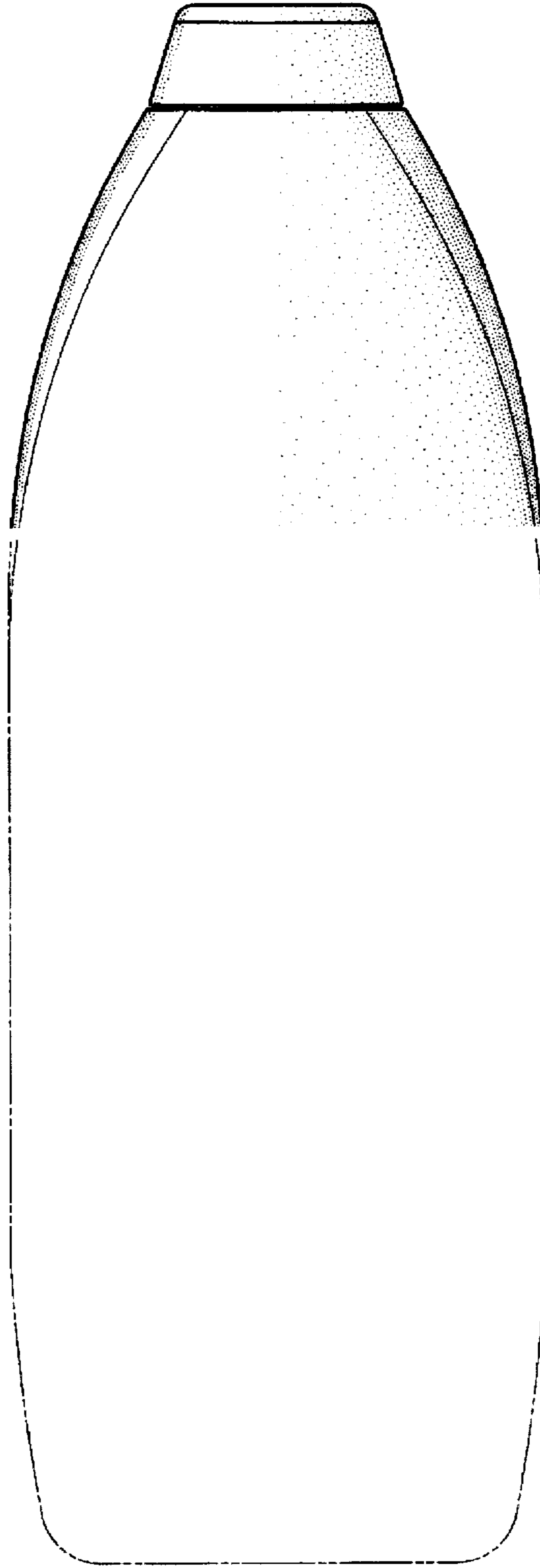

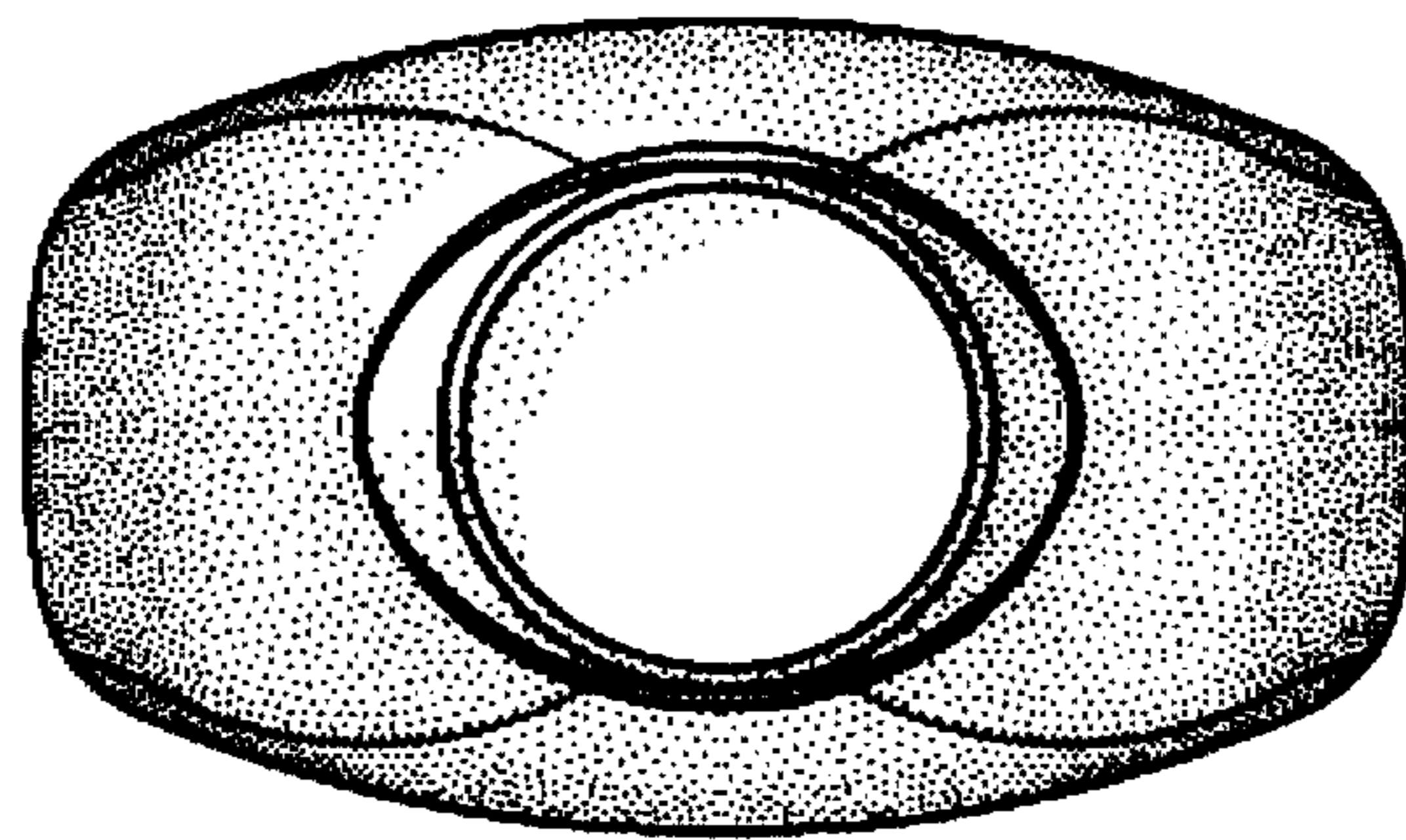

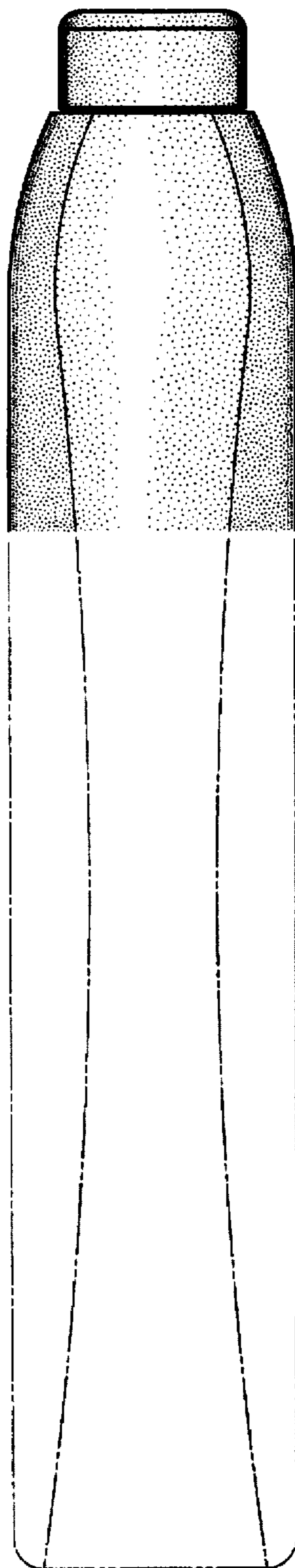
