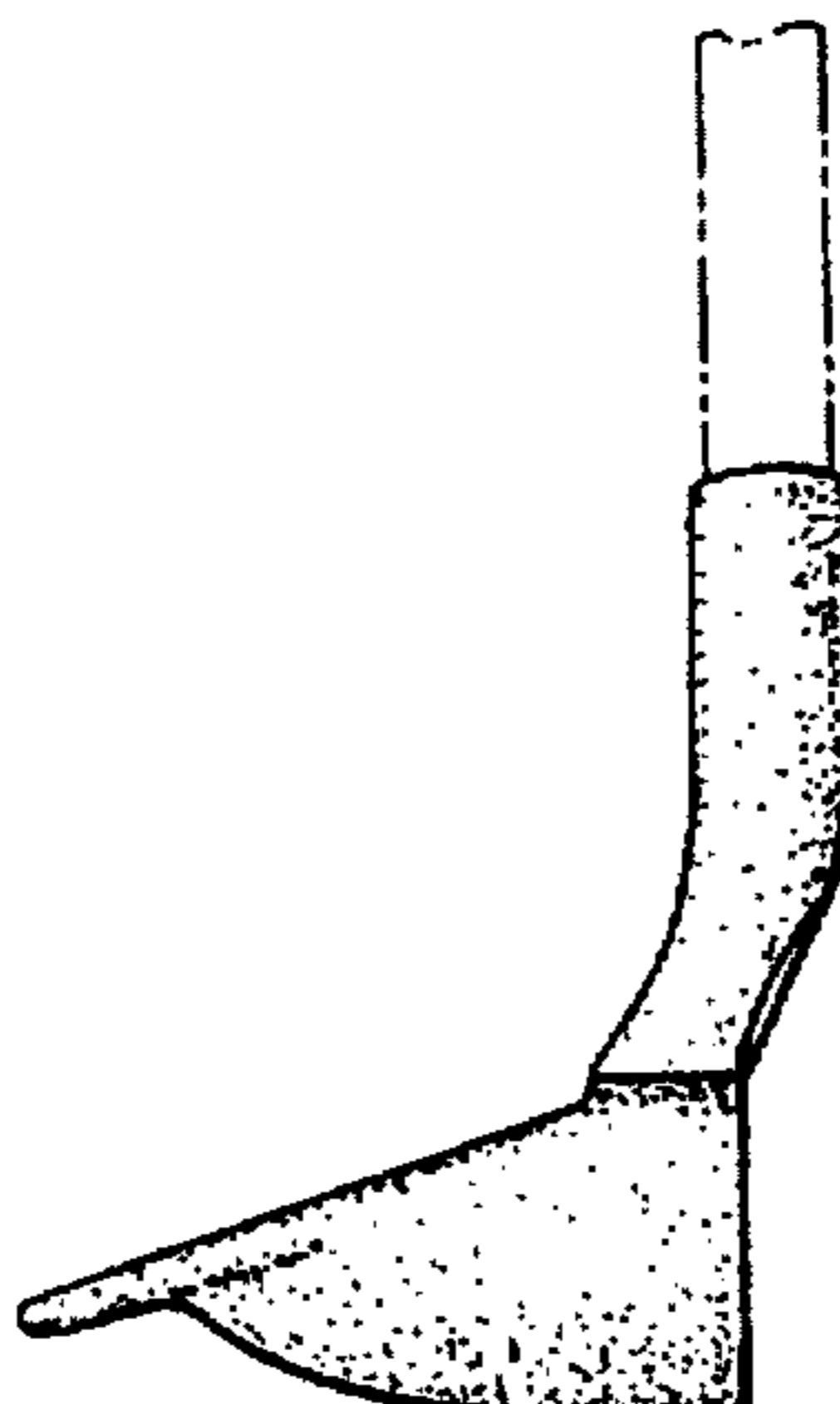
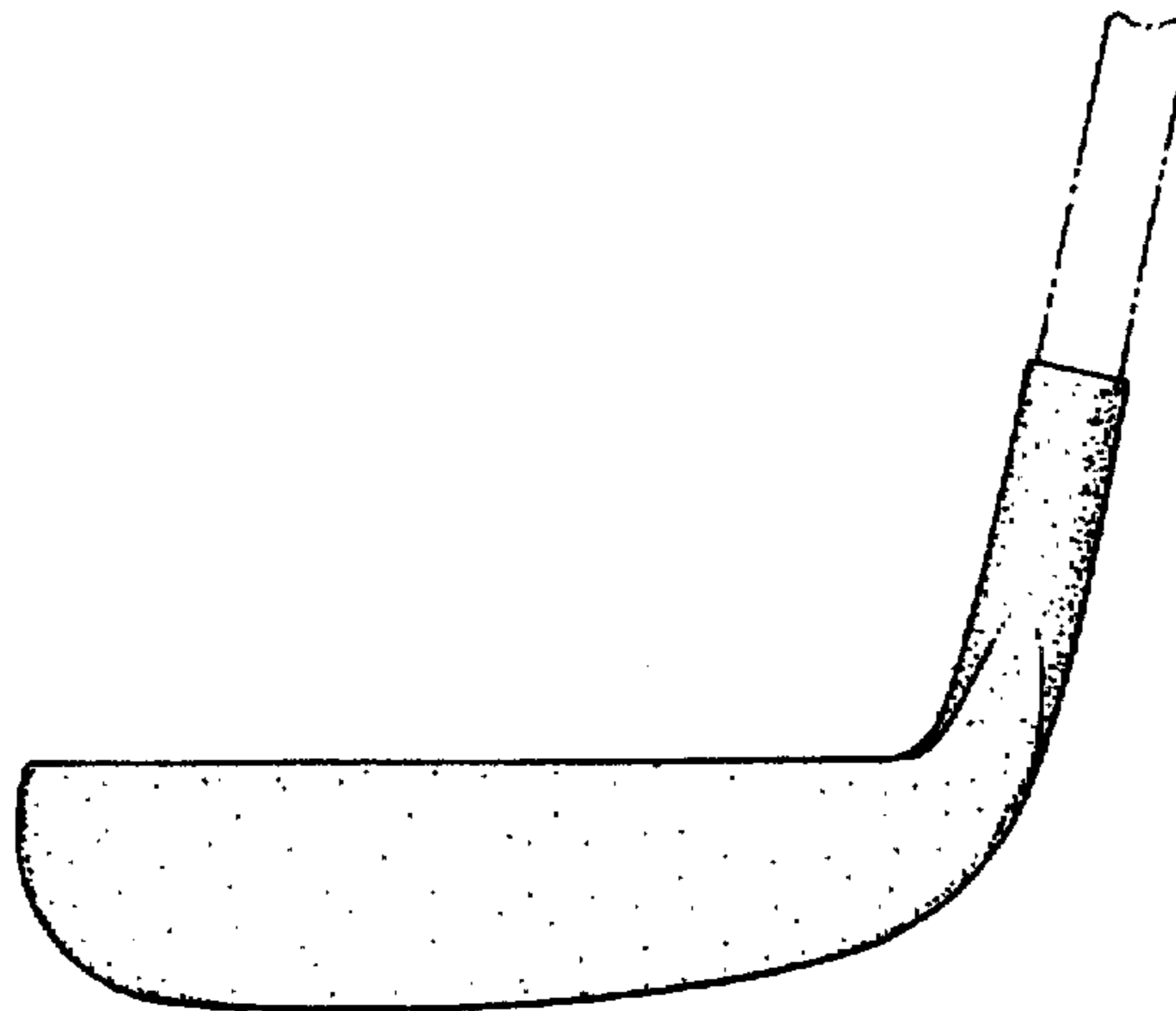
The ornamental design for a golf club head, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevated bottom perspective view of a golf club head showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a back view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a right view thereof.

The broken line showing of a fragmented shaft is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

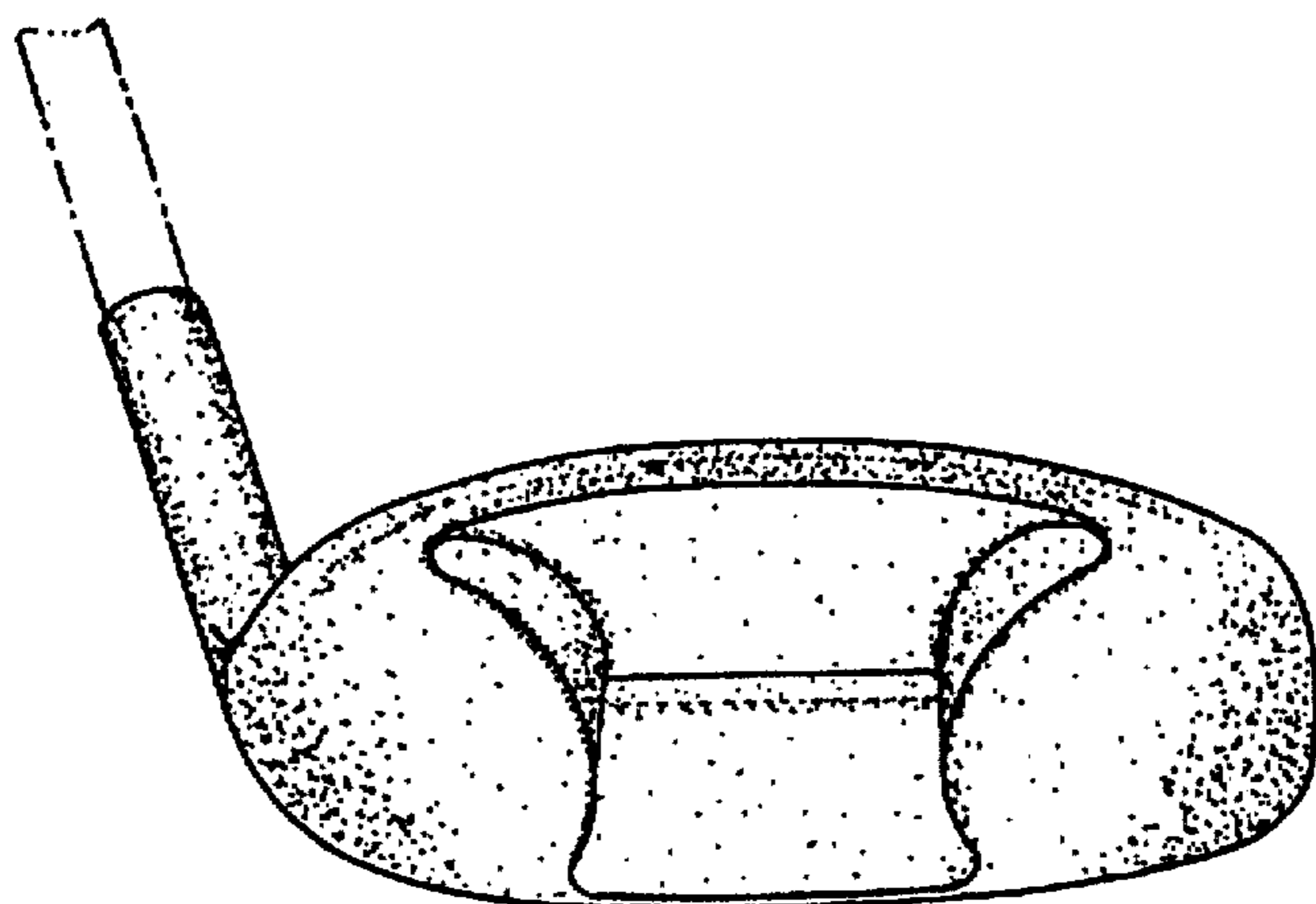

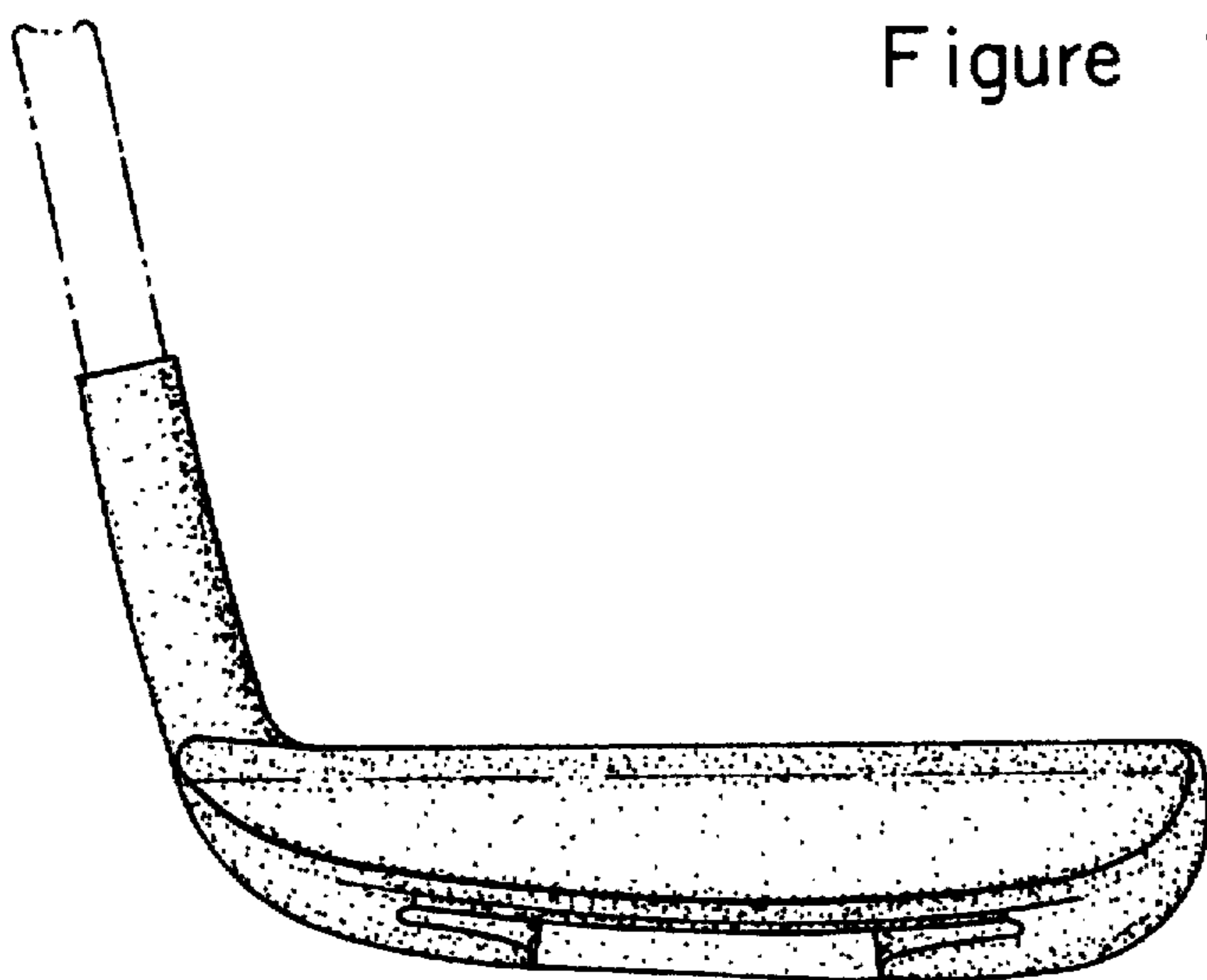

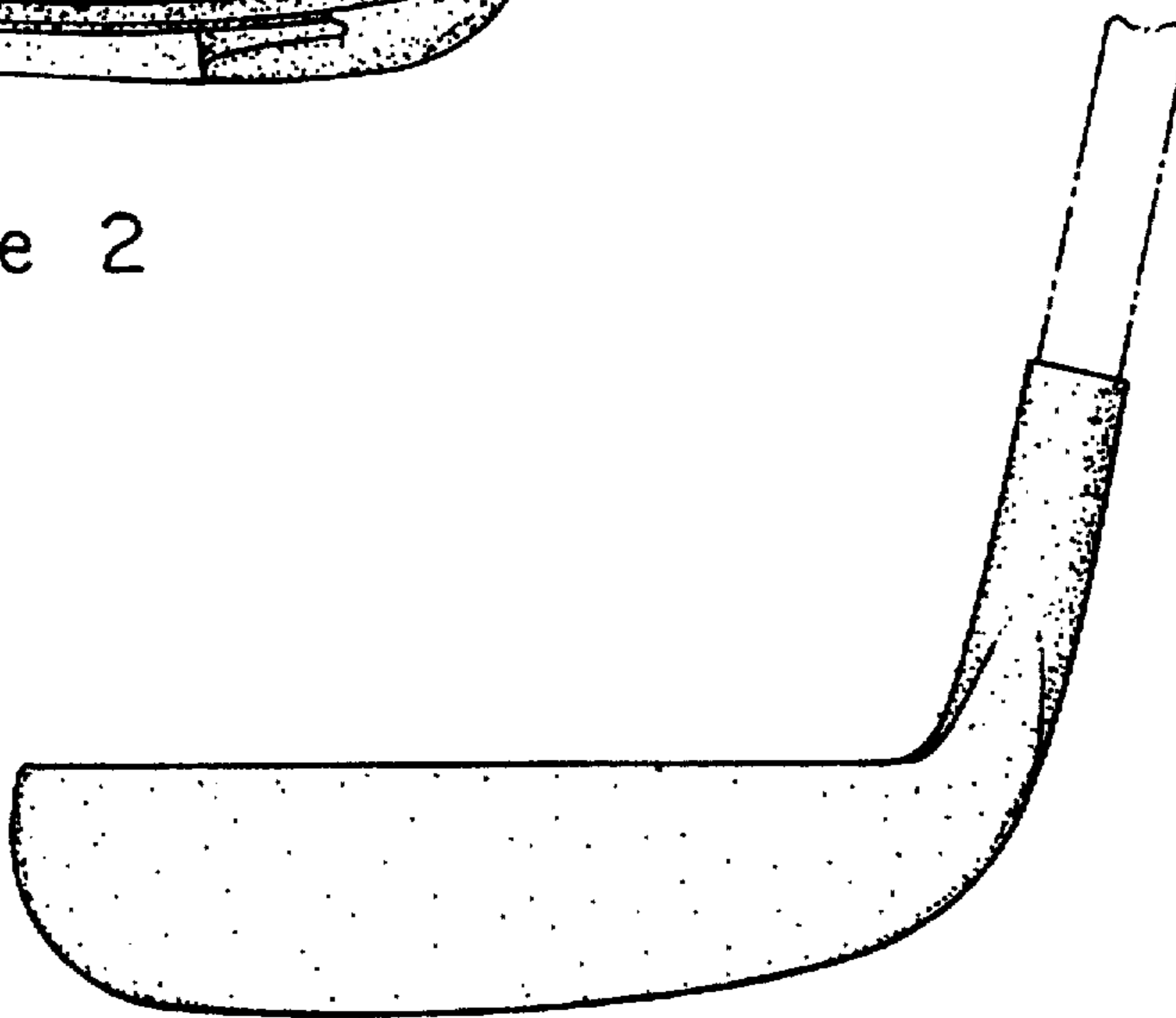

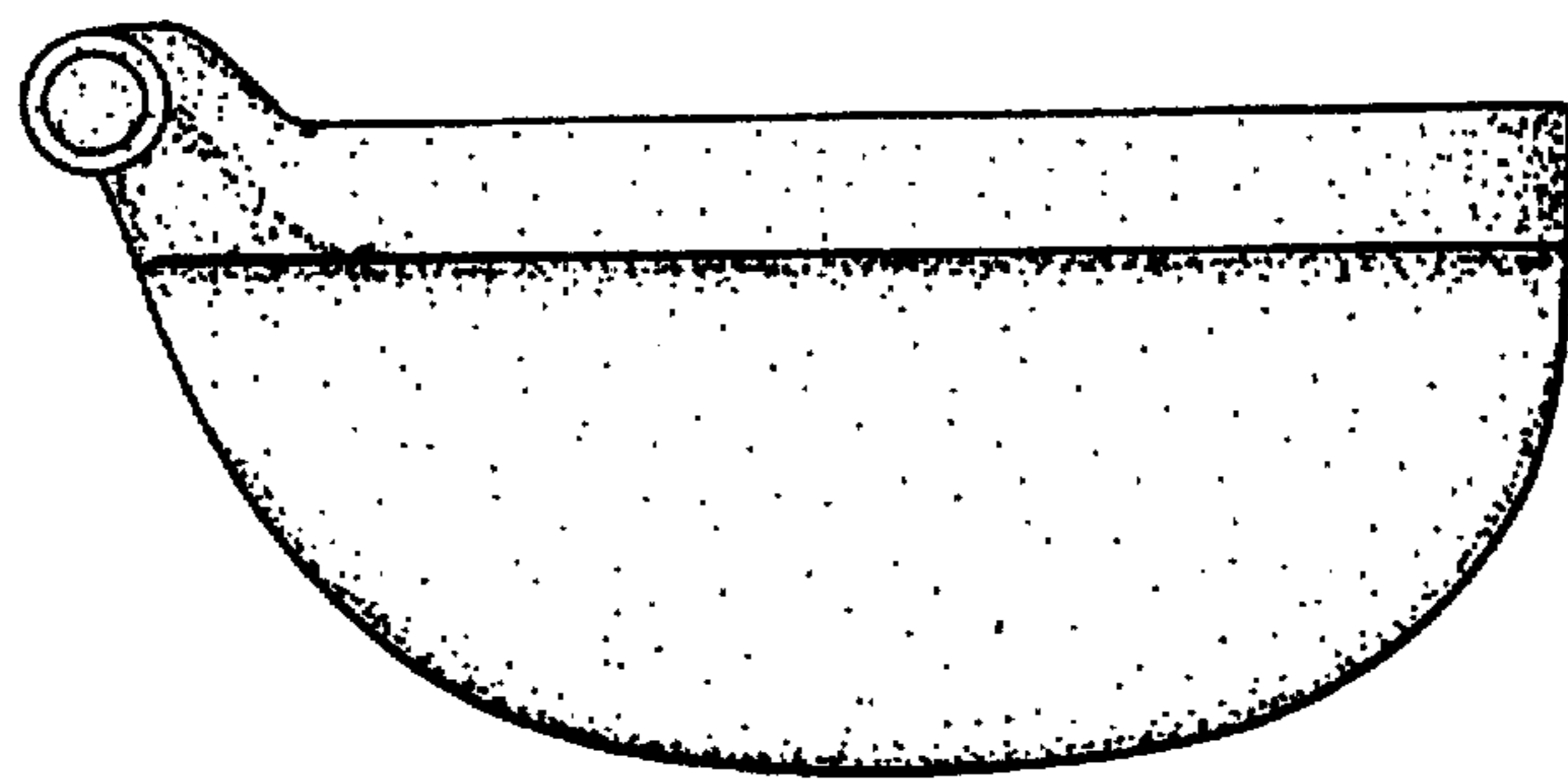

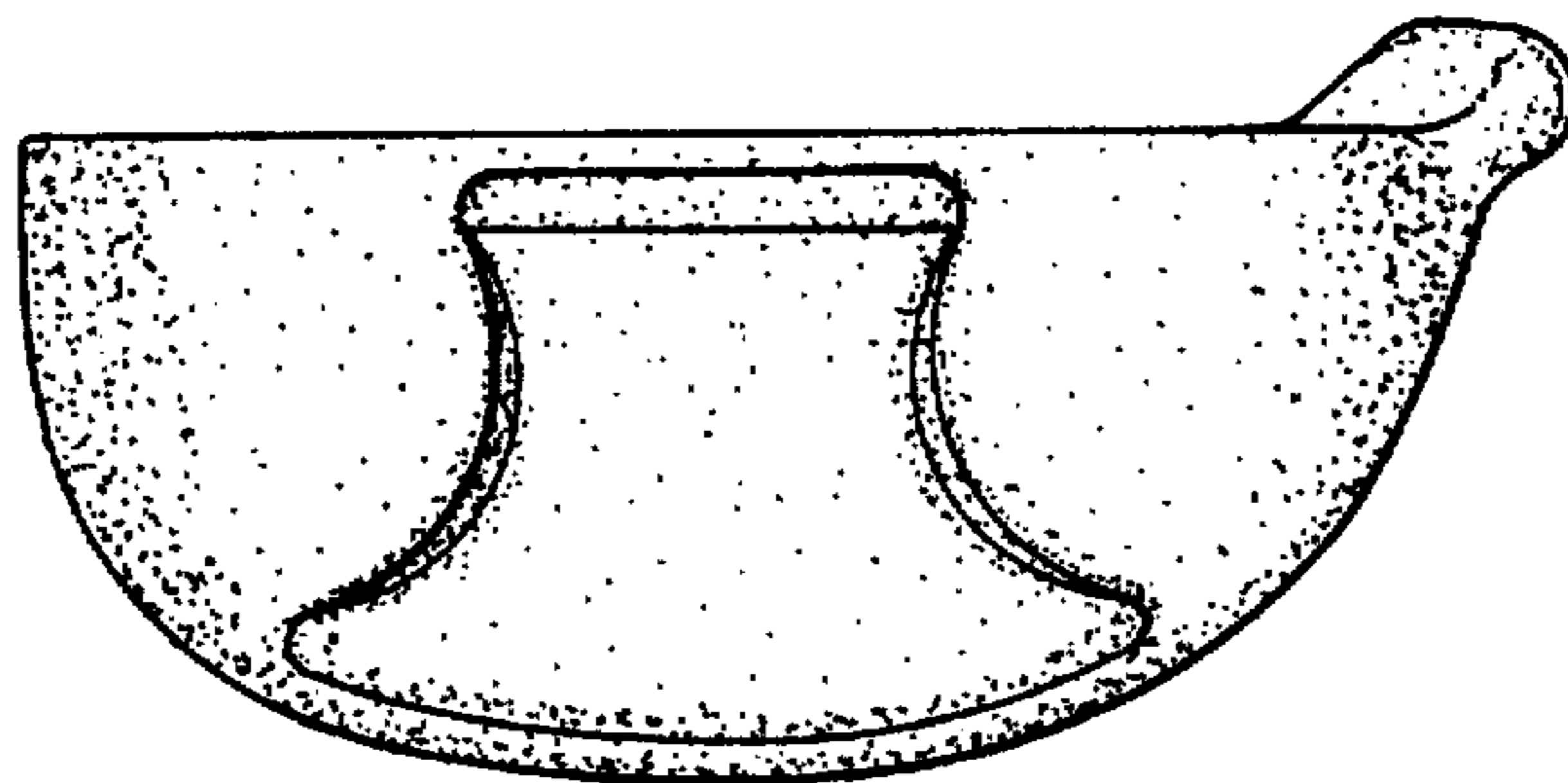

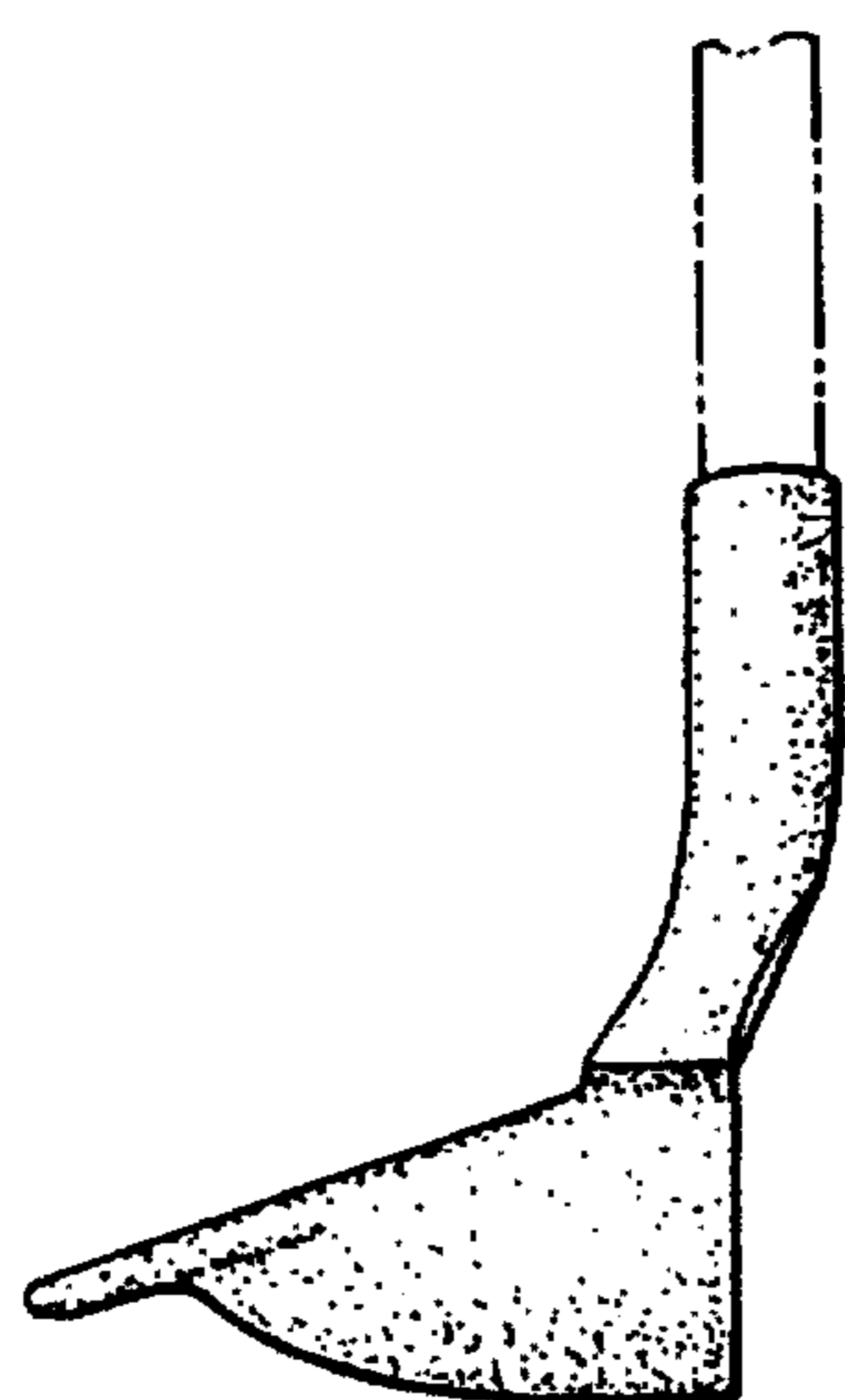

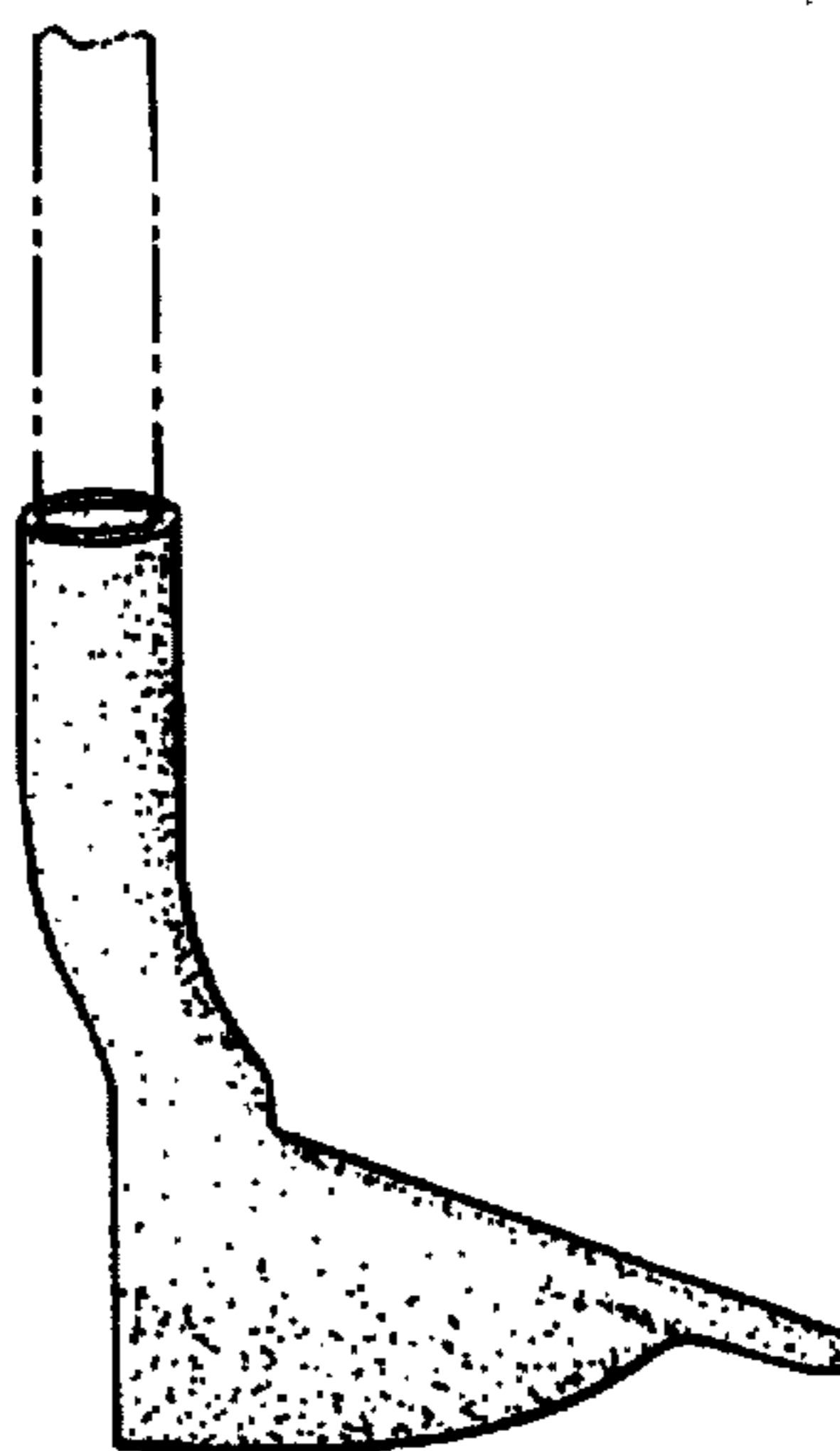
