[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cleaning device for paintball gun barrels, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cleaning device for paintball gun barrels showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a longitudinally fragmented right side elevational view of a cleaning device for paintball gun barrels, the top and bottom plan views being the same and the left side view being a mirror thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a back end elevational view thereof; and,
 FIG. 4 is a front end elevational view thereof.
