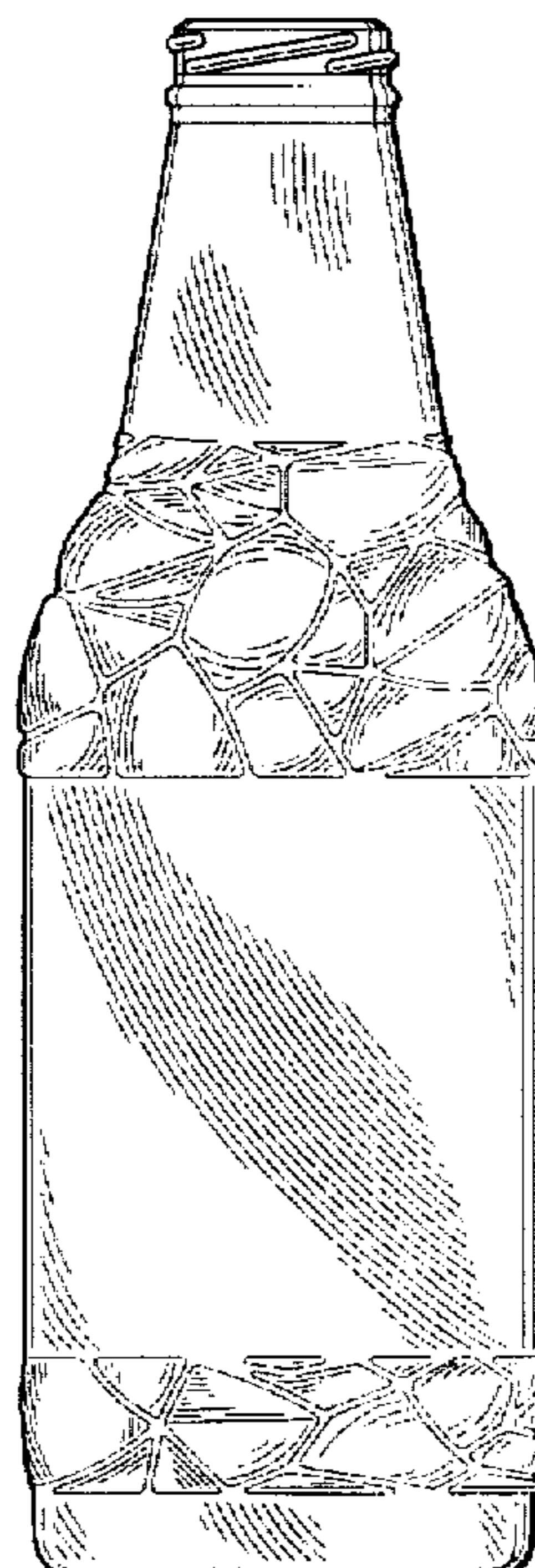
### [57] CLAIM

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a bottle showing our new design; and, FIG. 2 is a front elevation of a second embodiment of the bottle. The bottom, rear and portions of the top and sides of both embodiments that are not shown in the drawings do not form part of the claimed design.

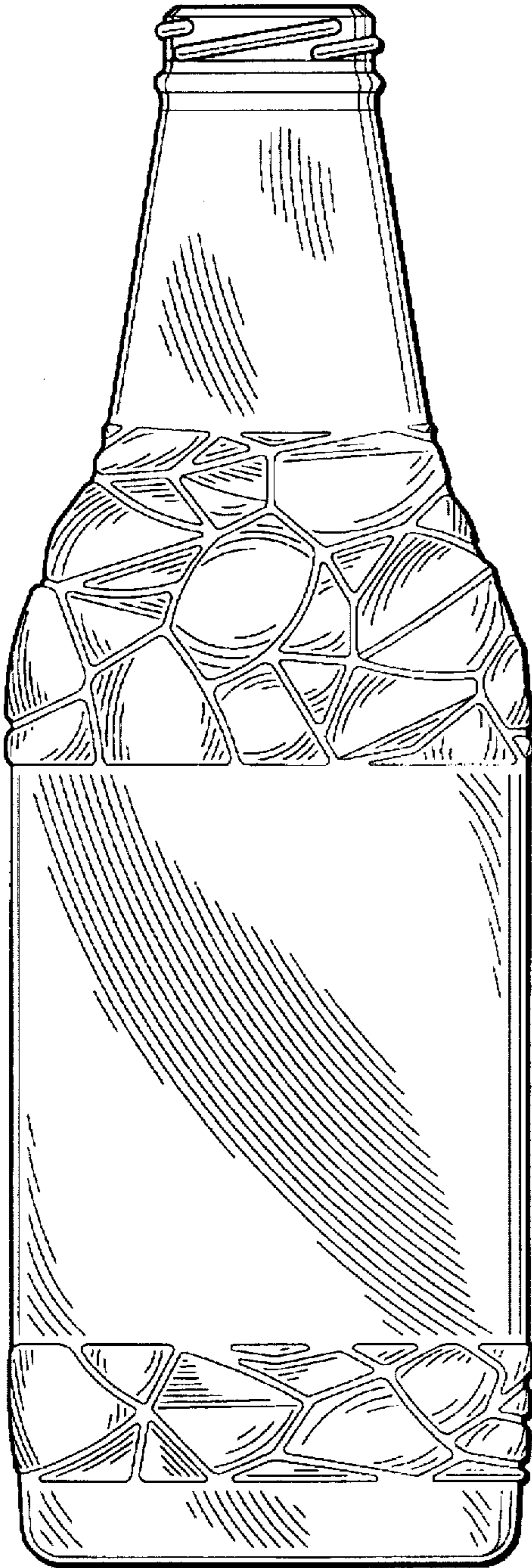

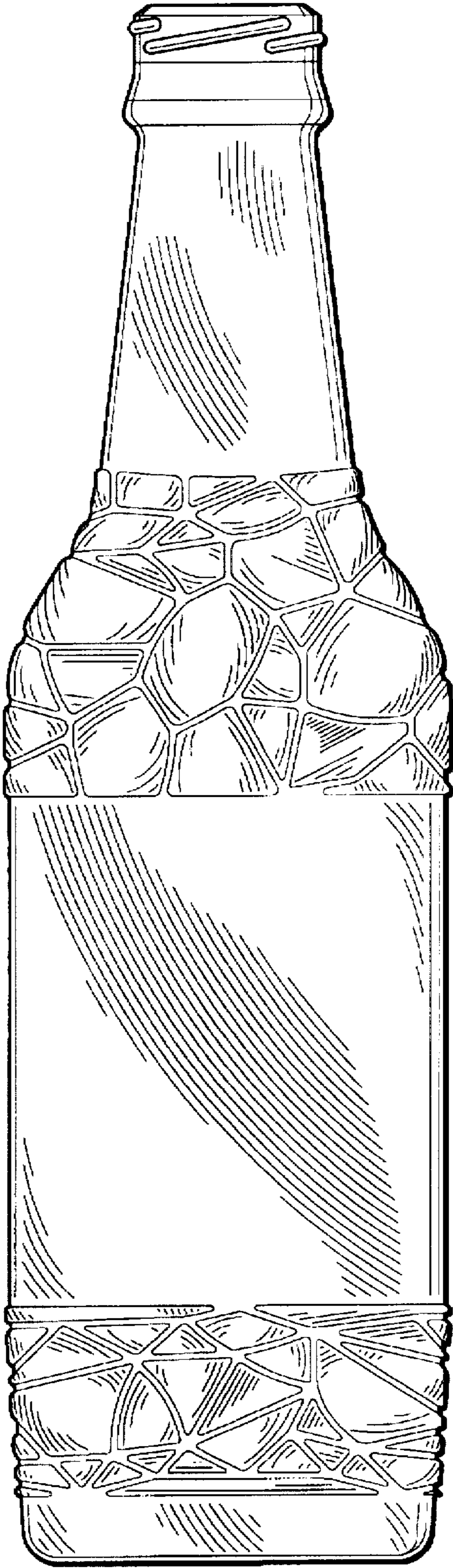
