FIG. 4 is a rear view of the bench.

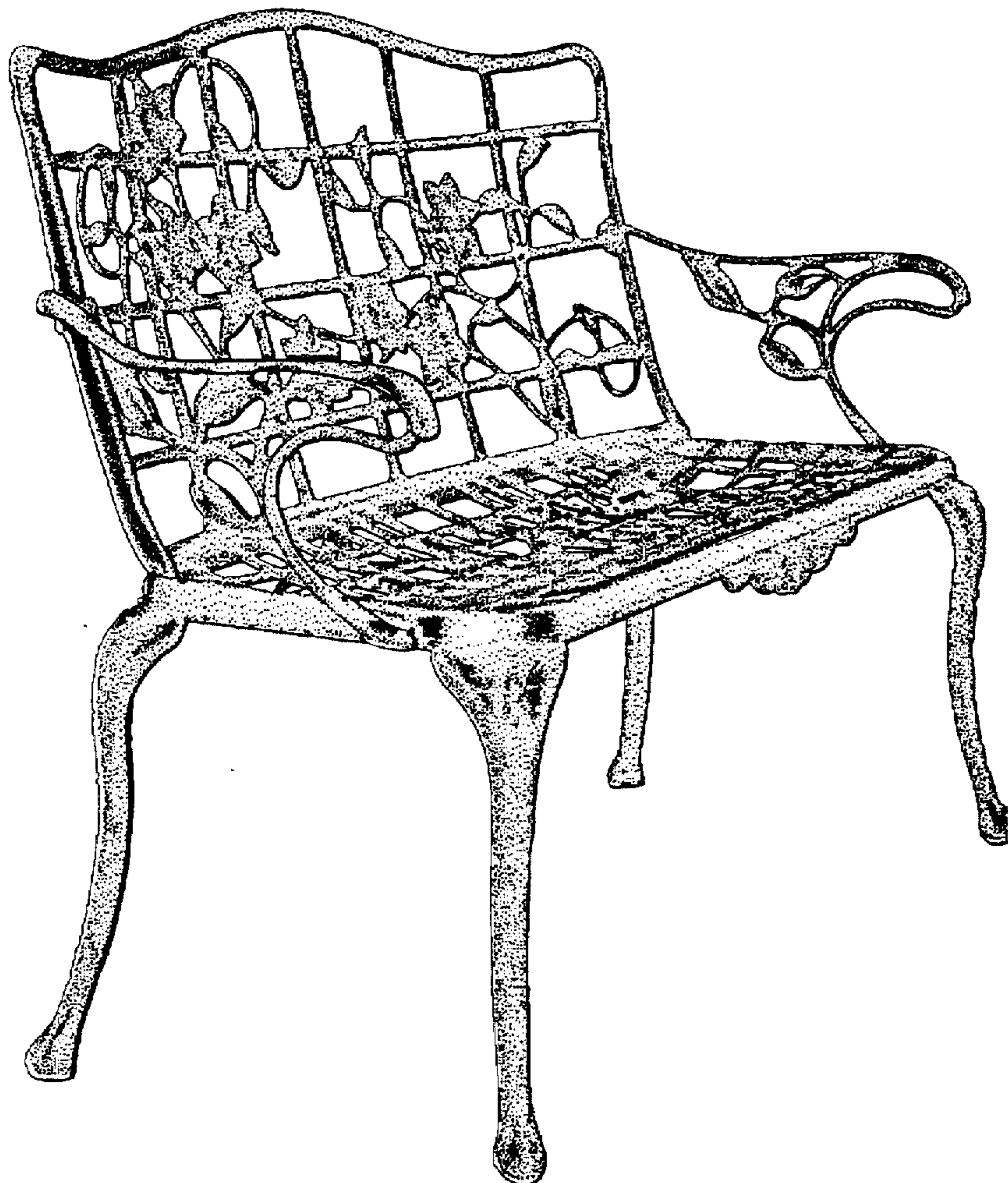

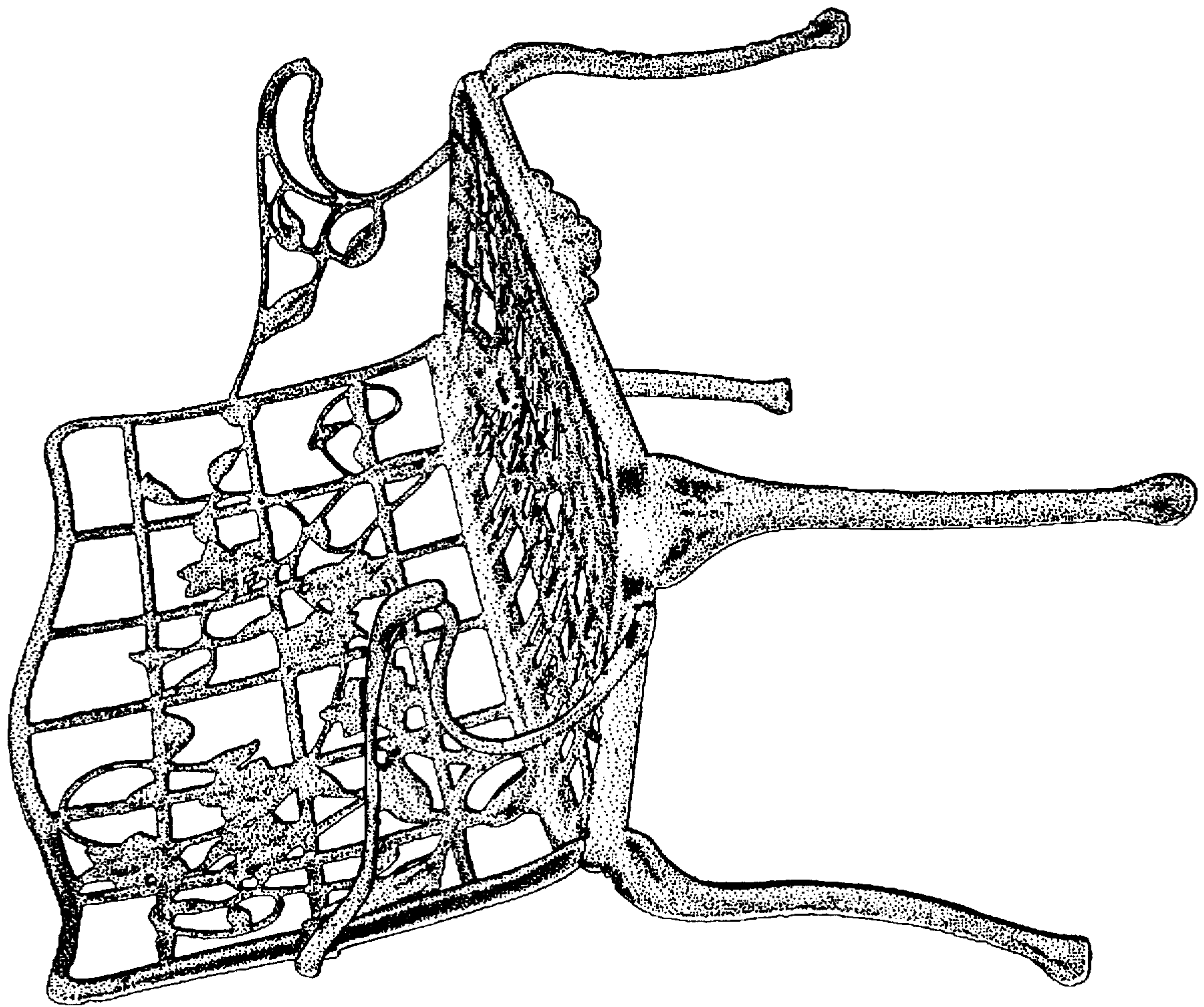

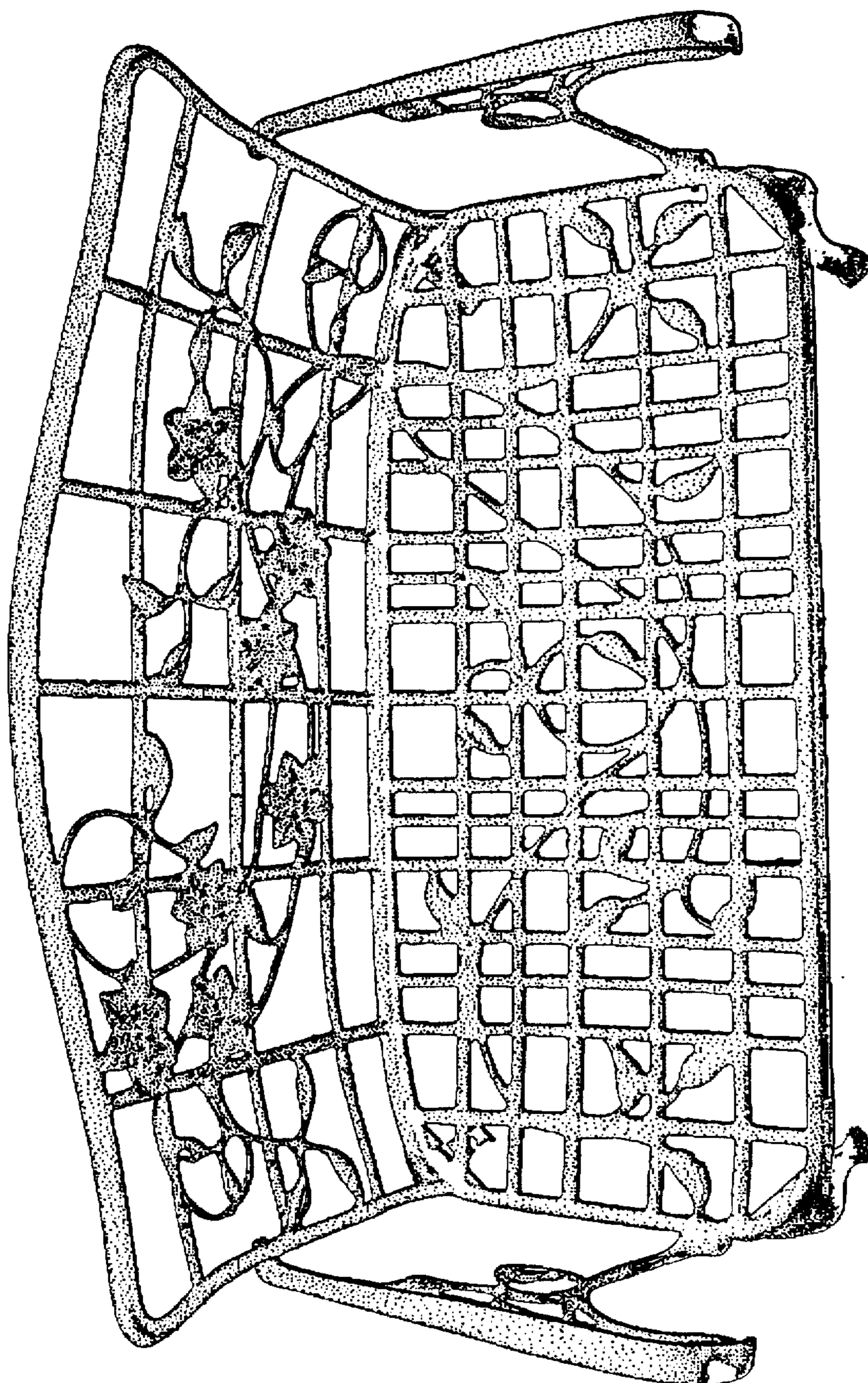

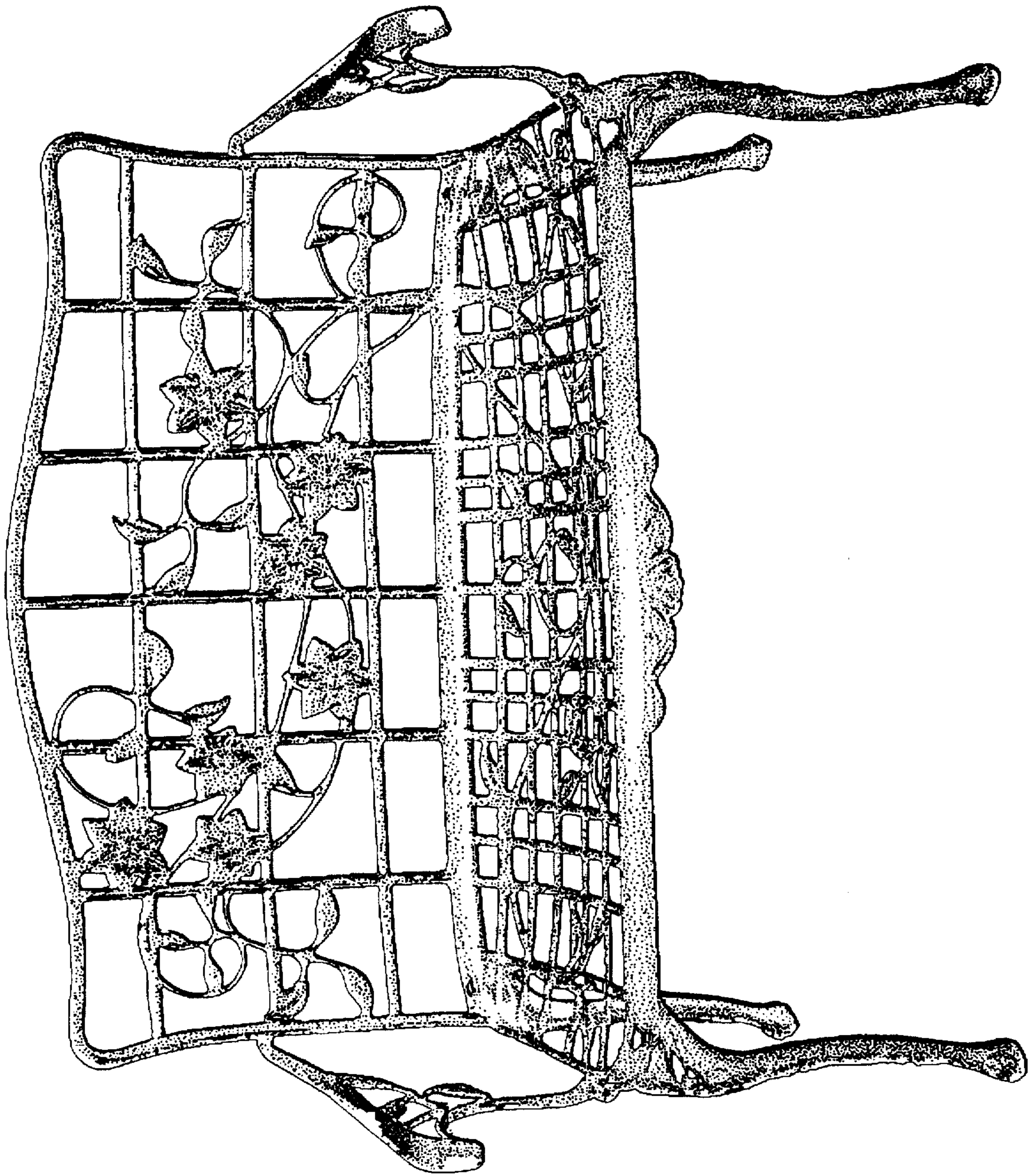

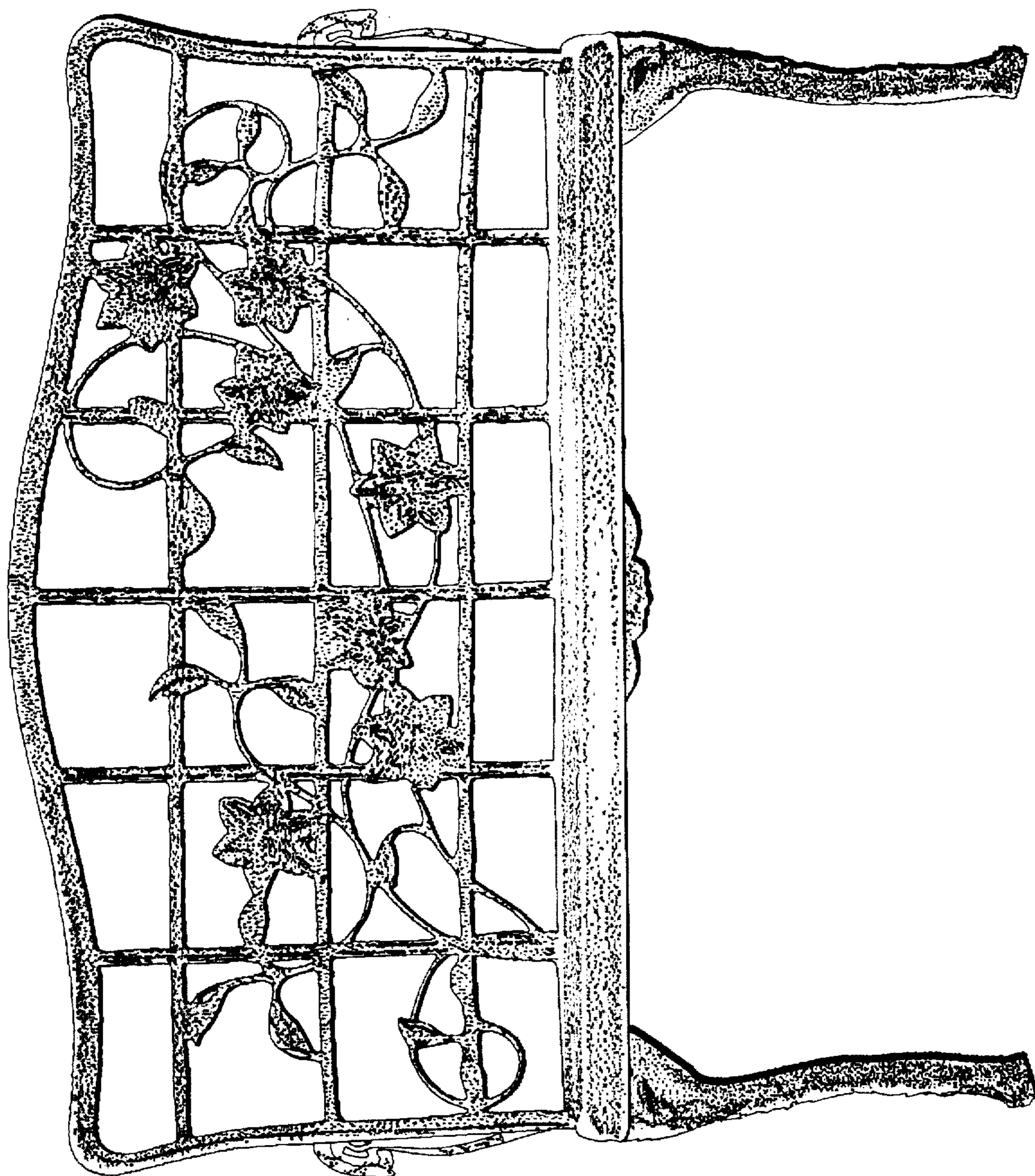
