FIG. 3 is a top view of the man's garment with monitor accommodation of the present invention;

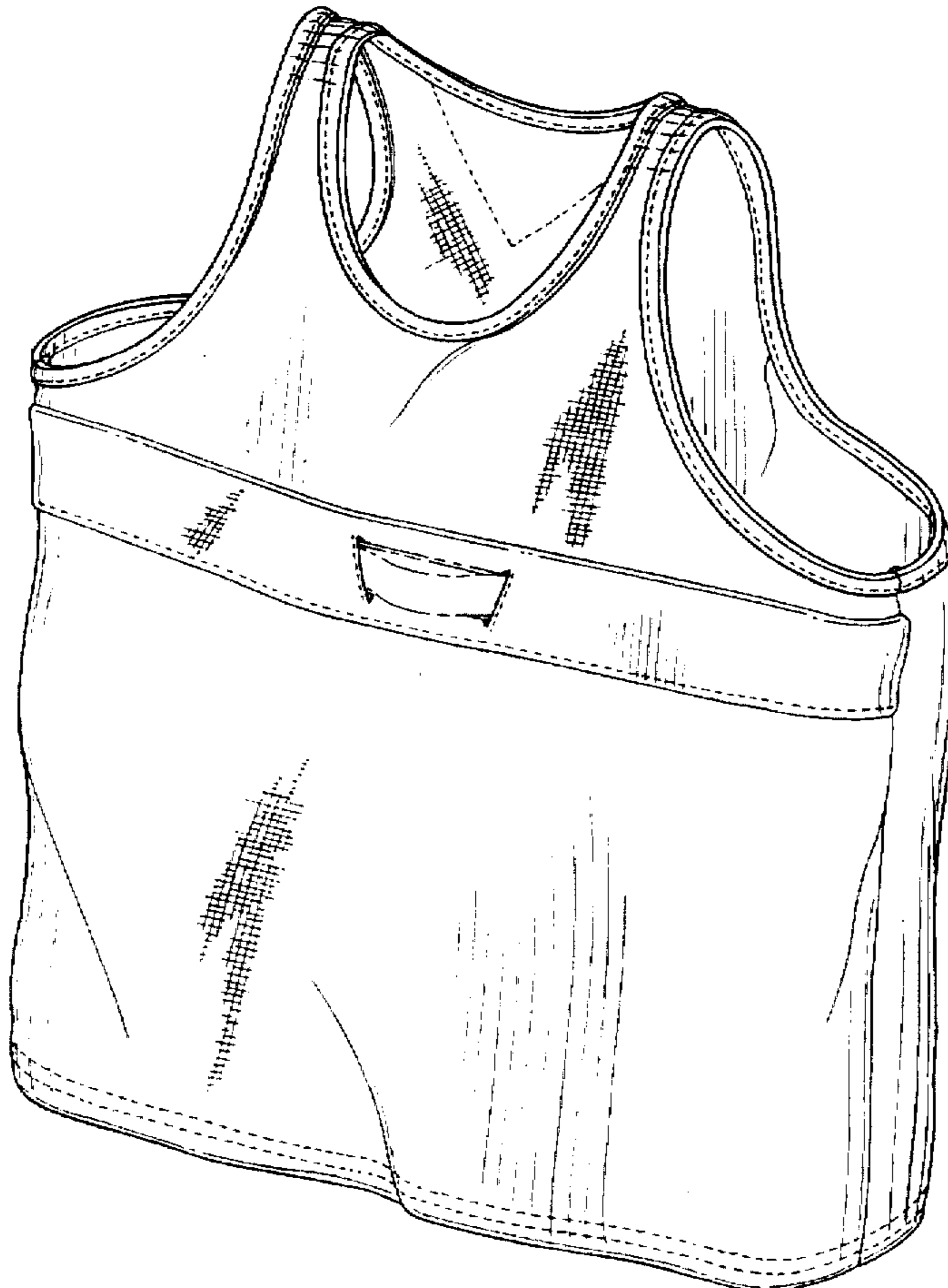
FIG. 4 is a side view of the man's garment with monitor accommodation of the present invention;

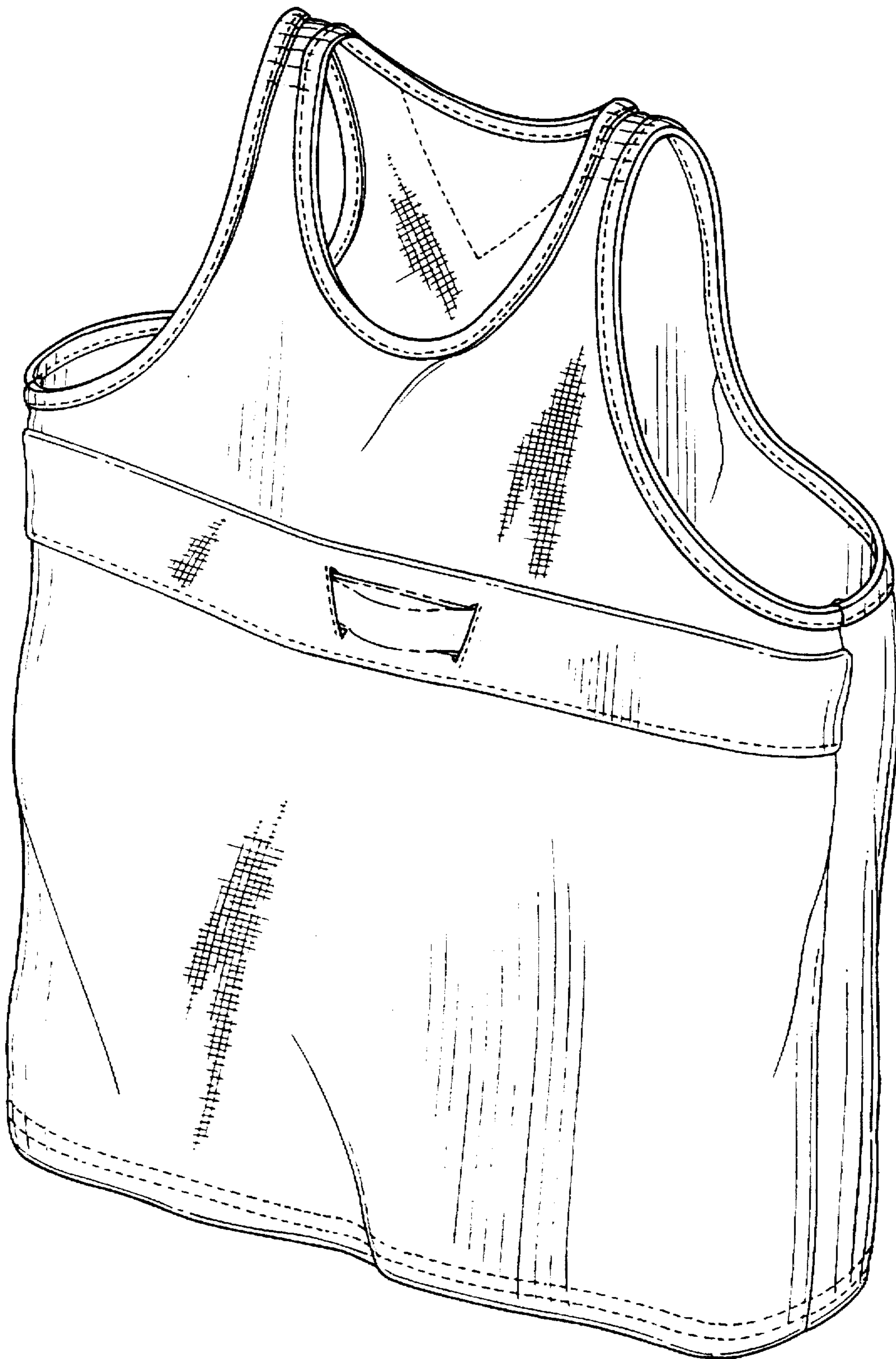

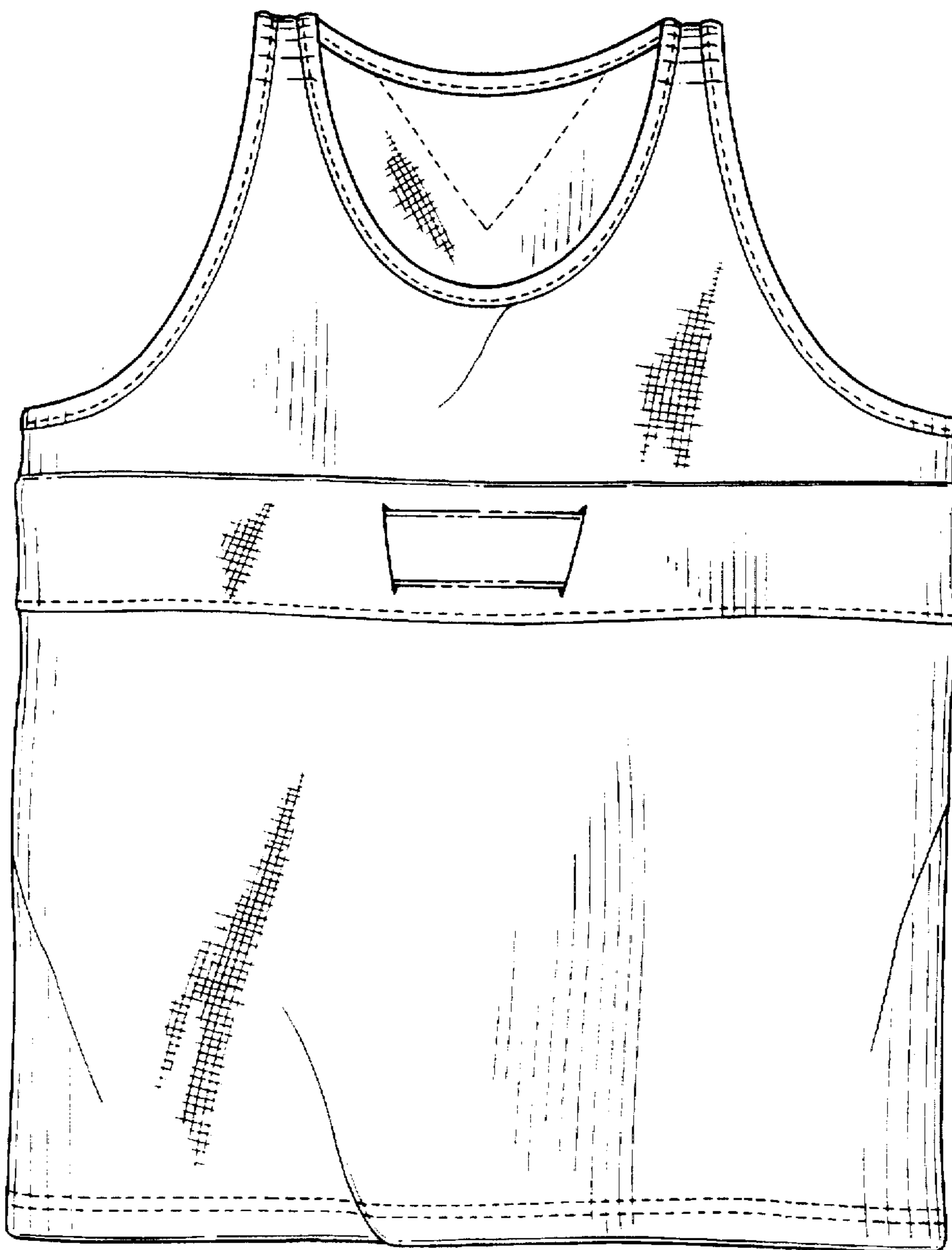

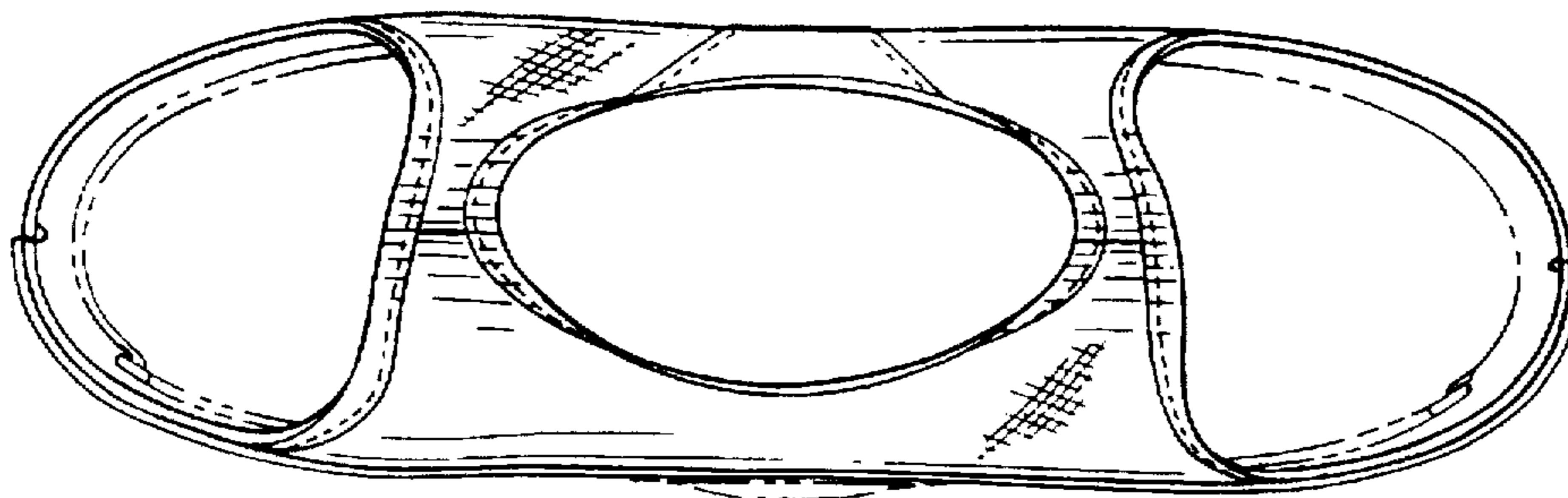

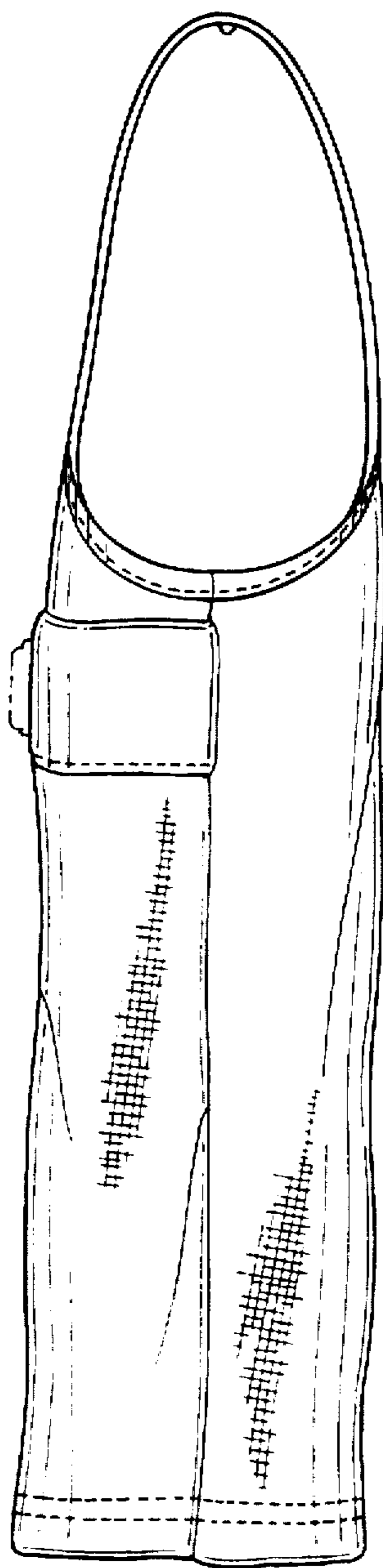

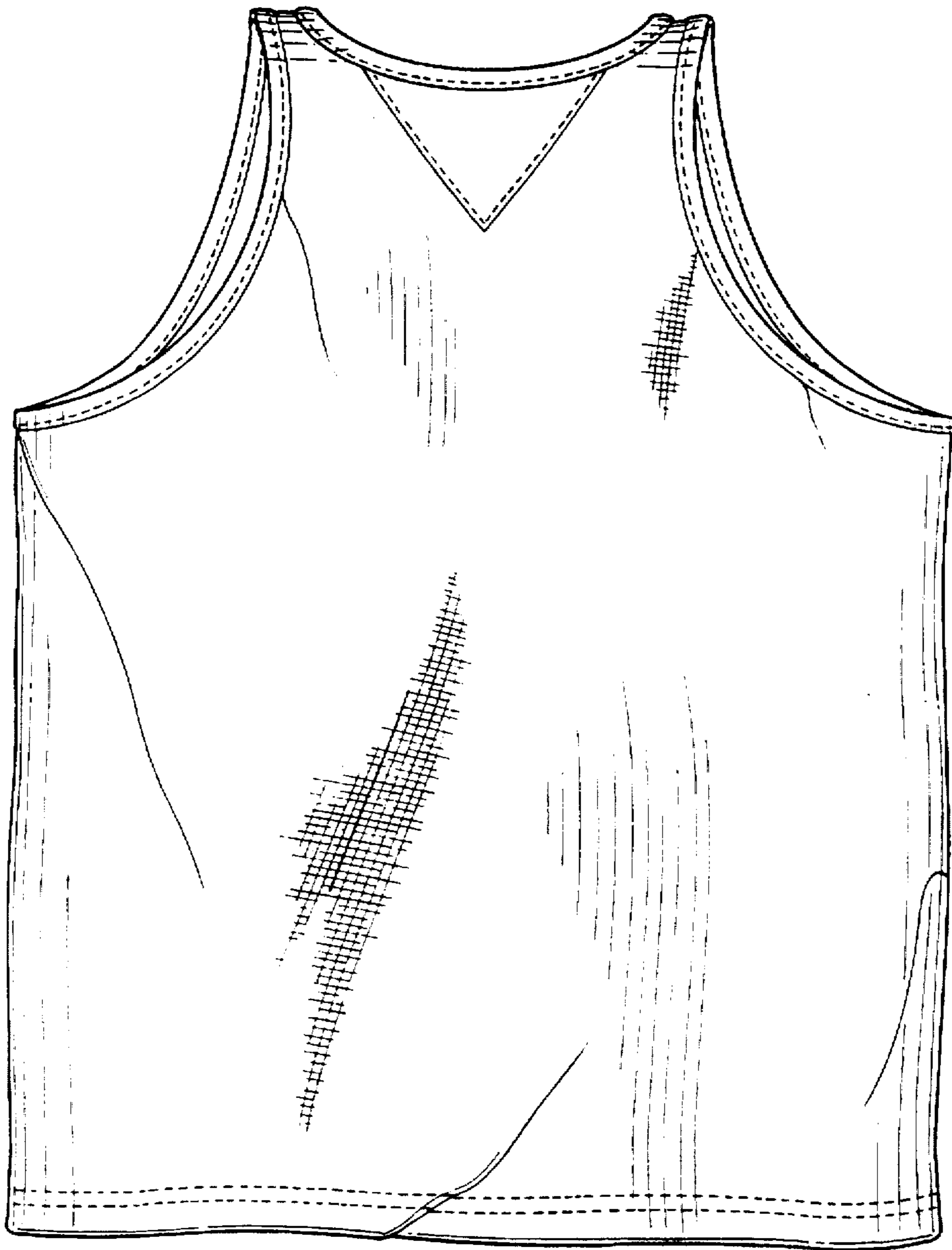

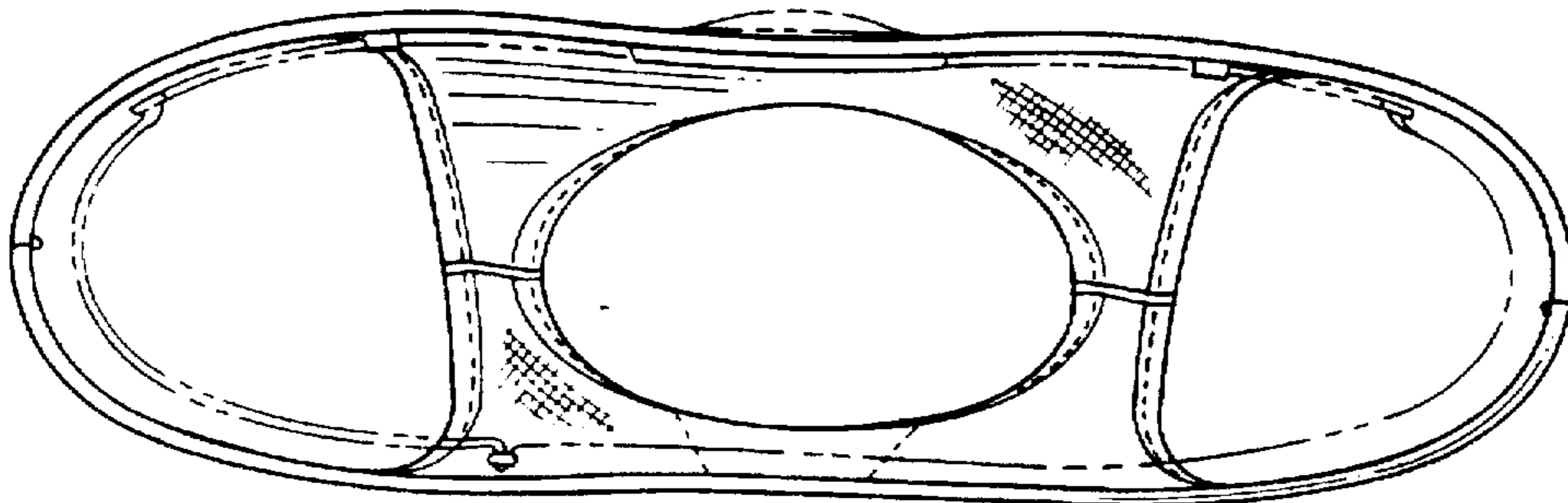
