**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the finger ring showing my new design;

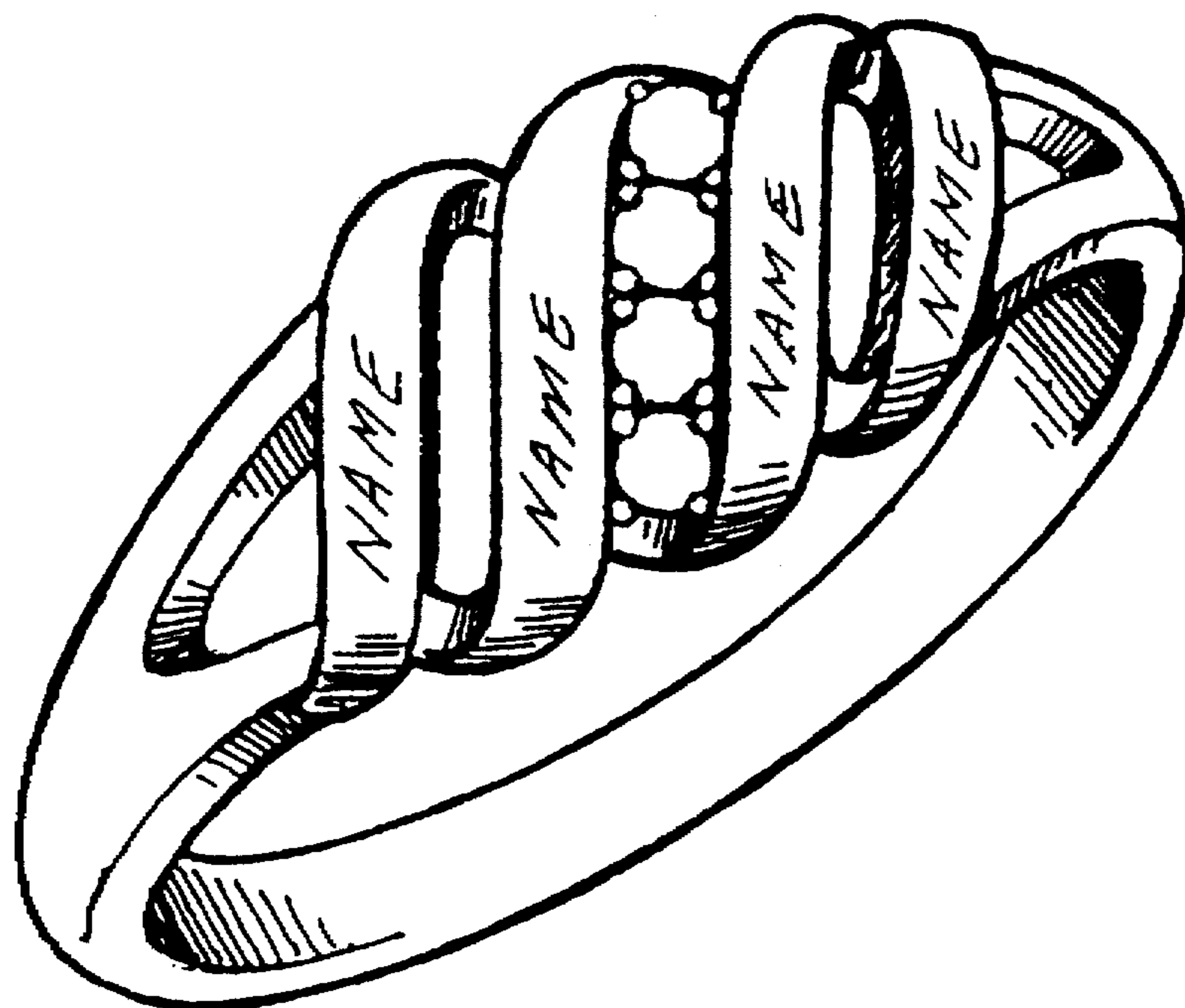
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the finger ring of FIG. 1 (both sides being identical);

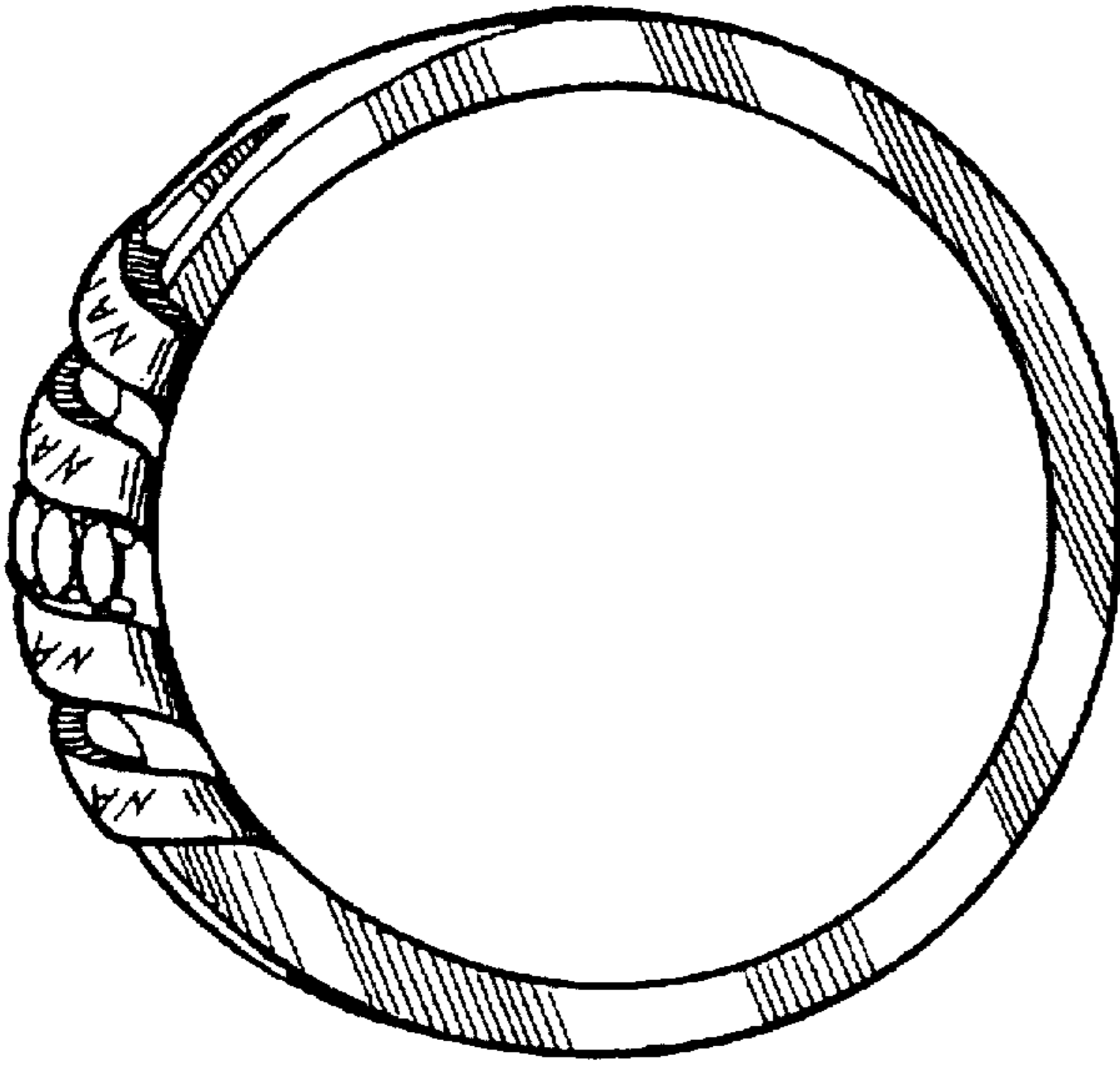

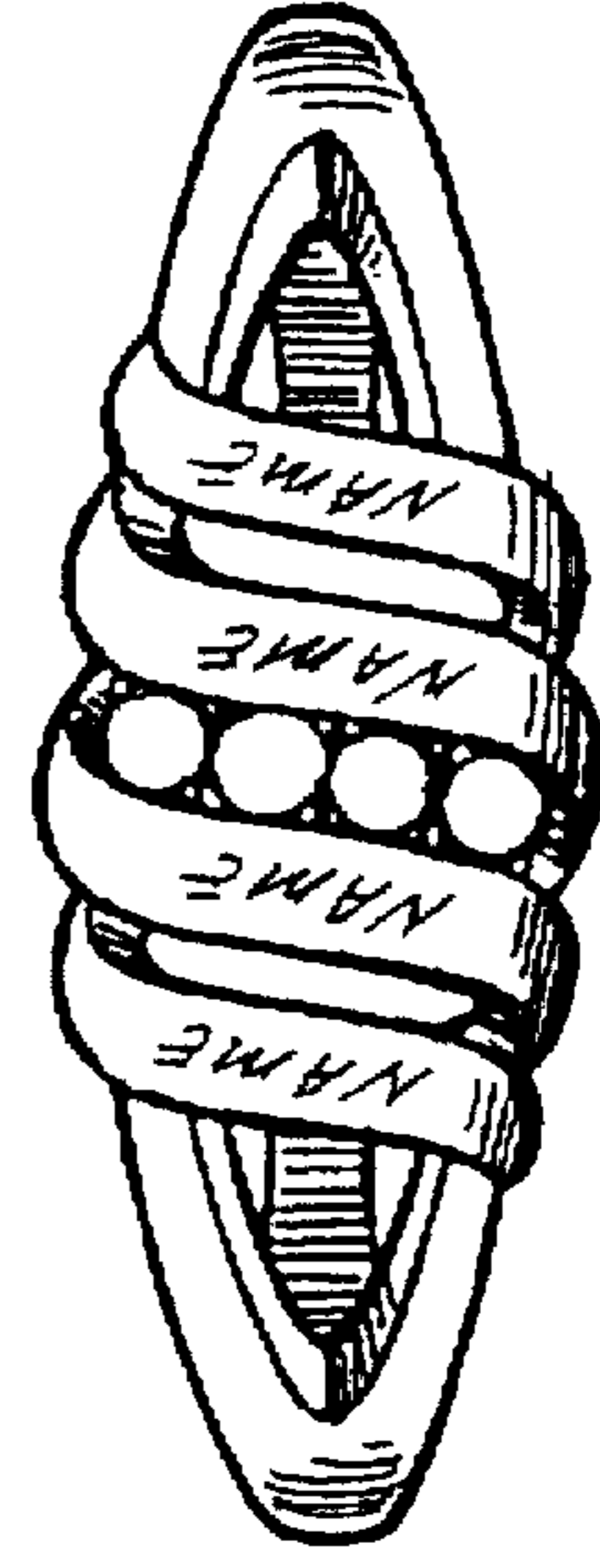

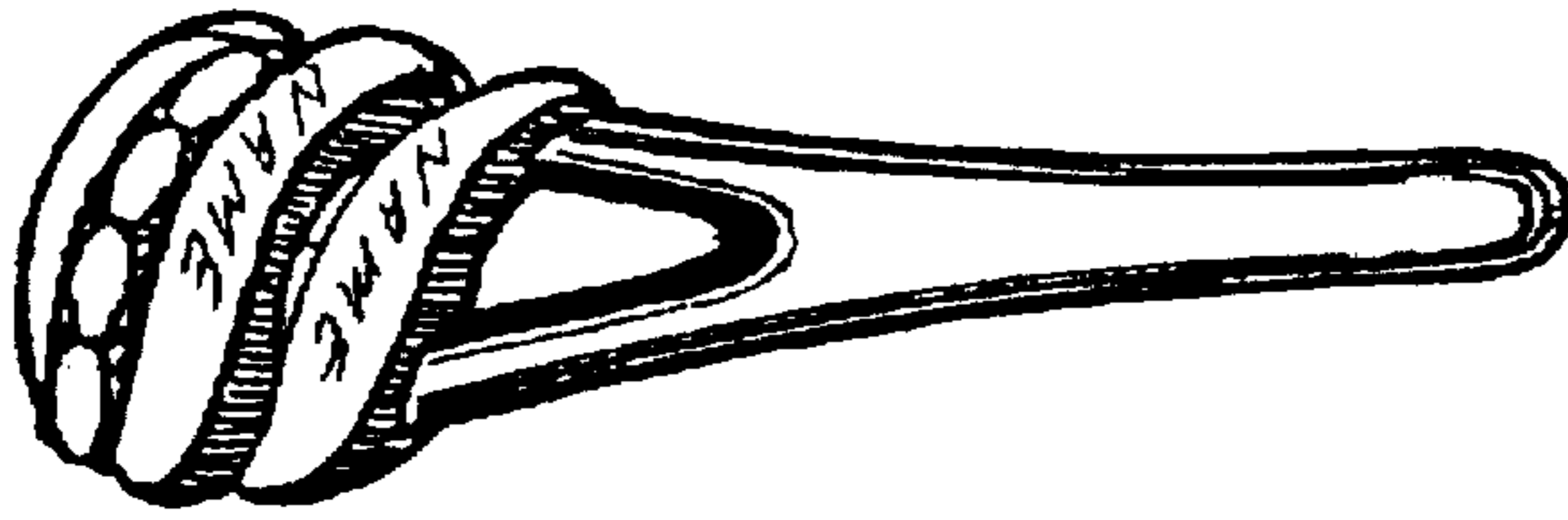

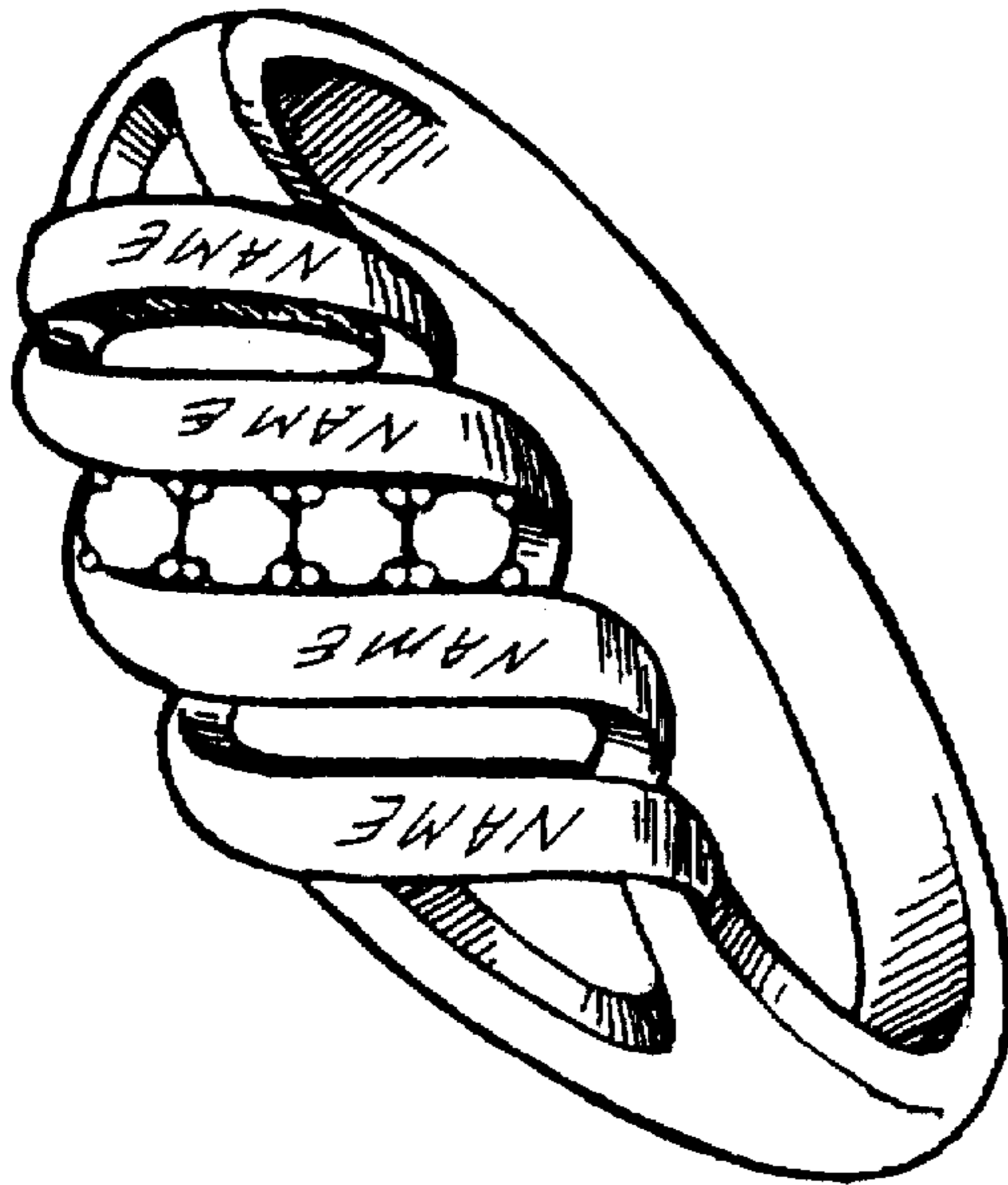

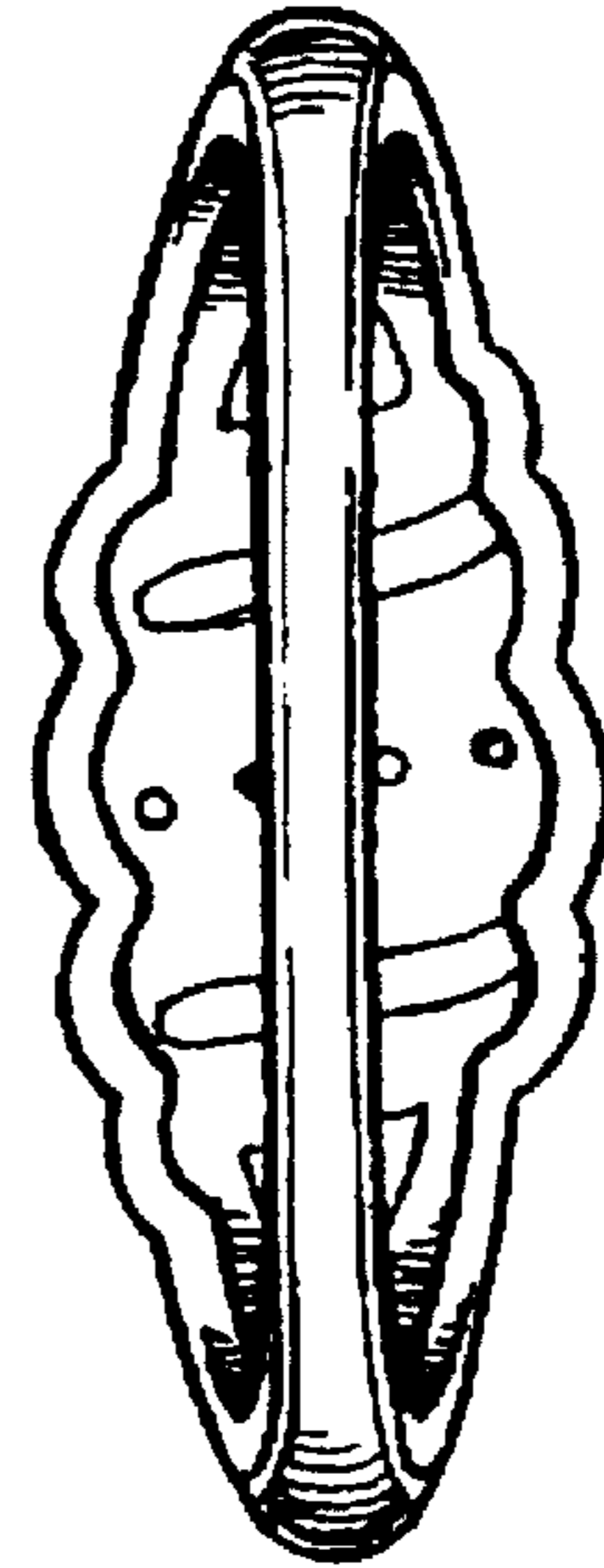
