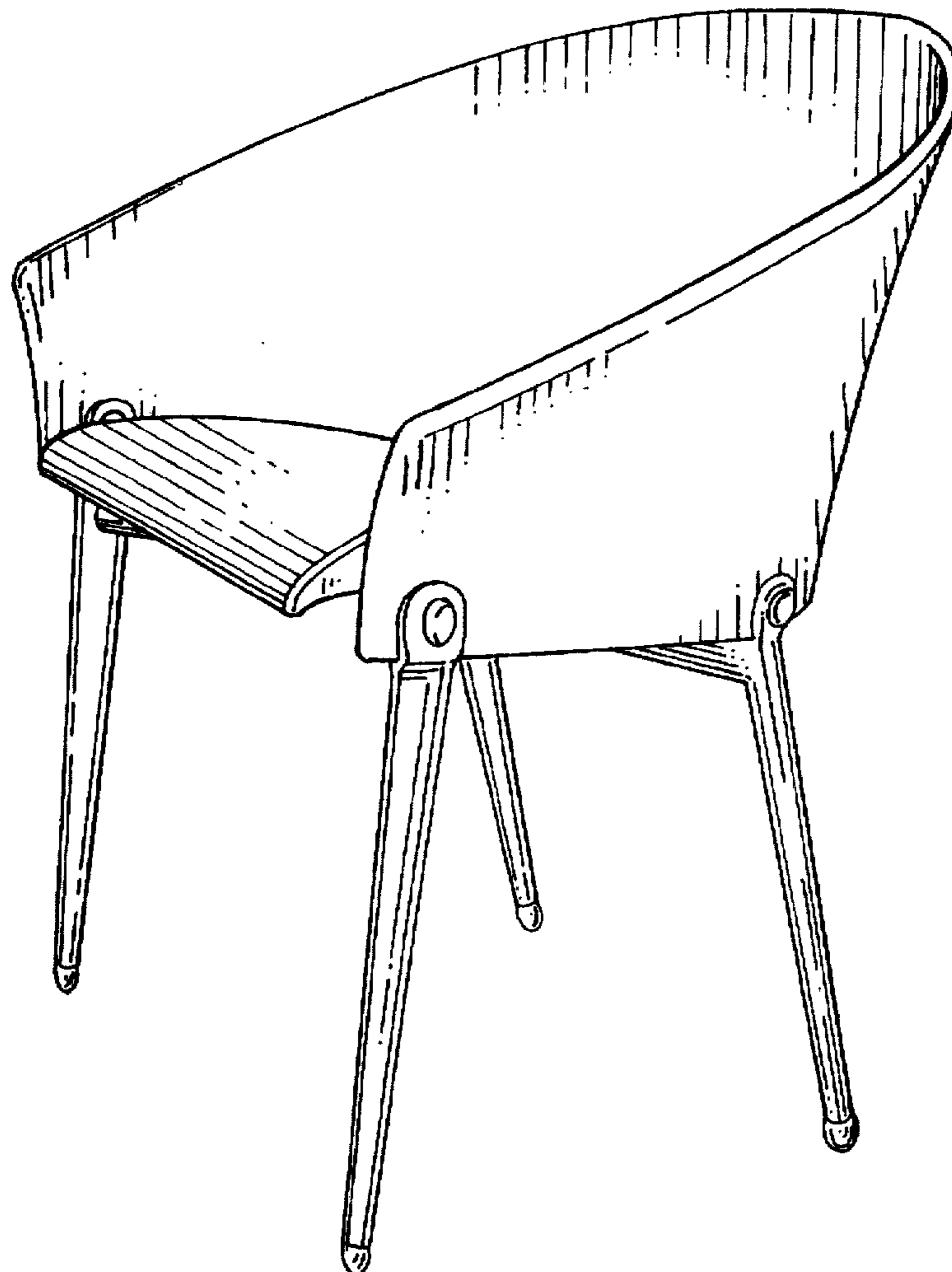
[57] CLAIM

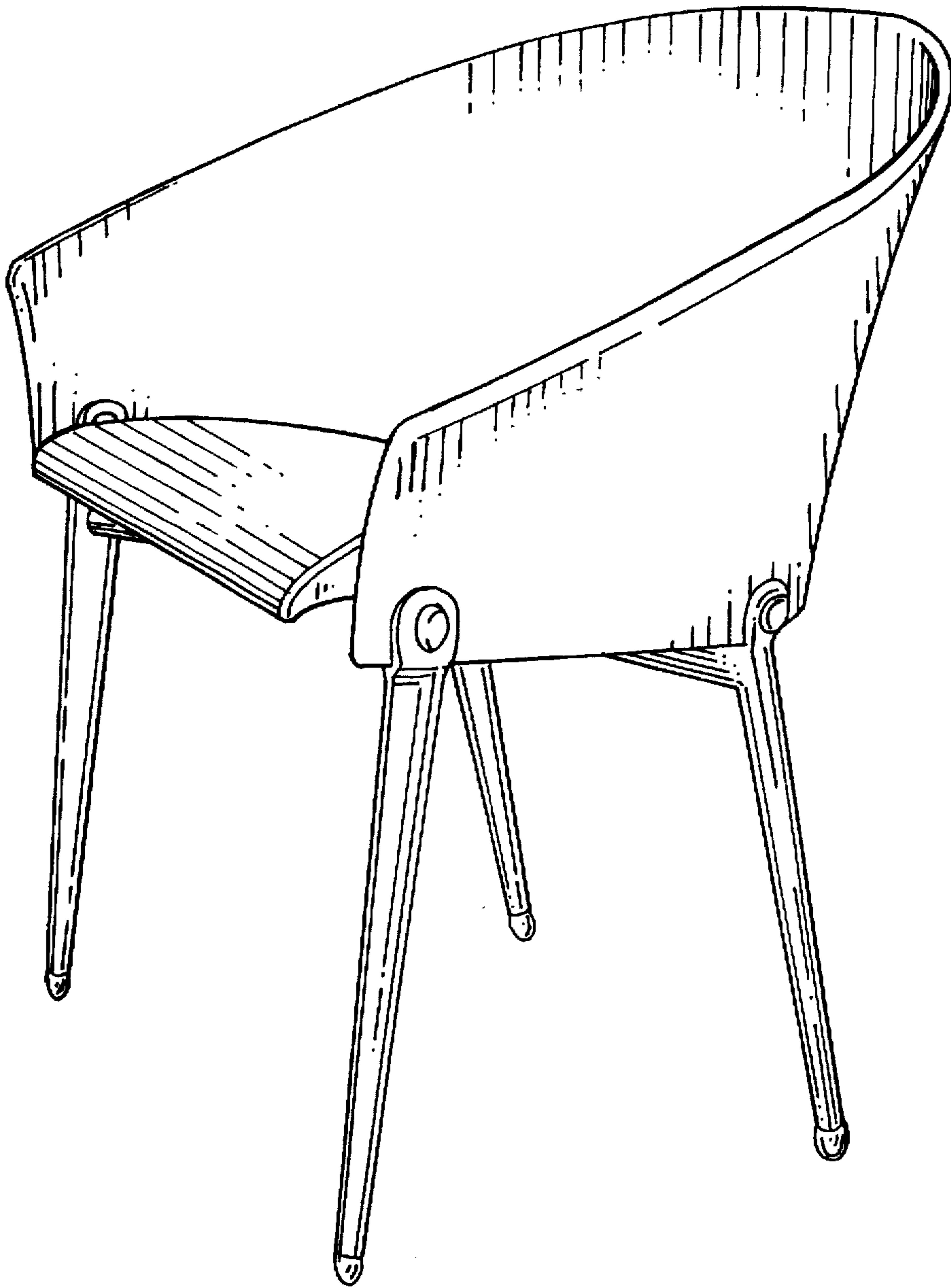

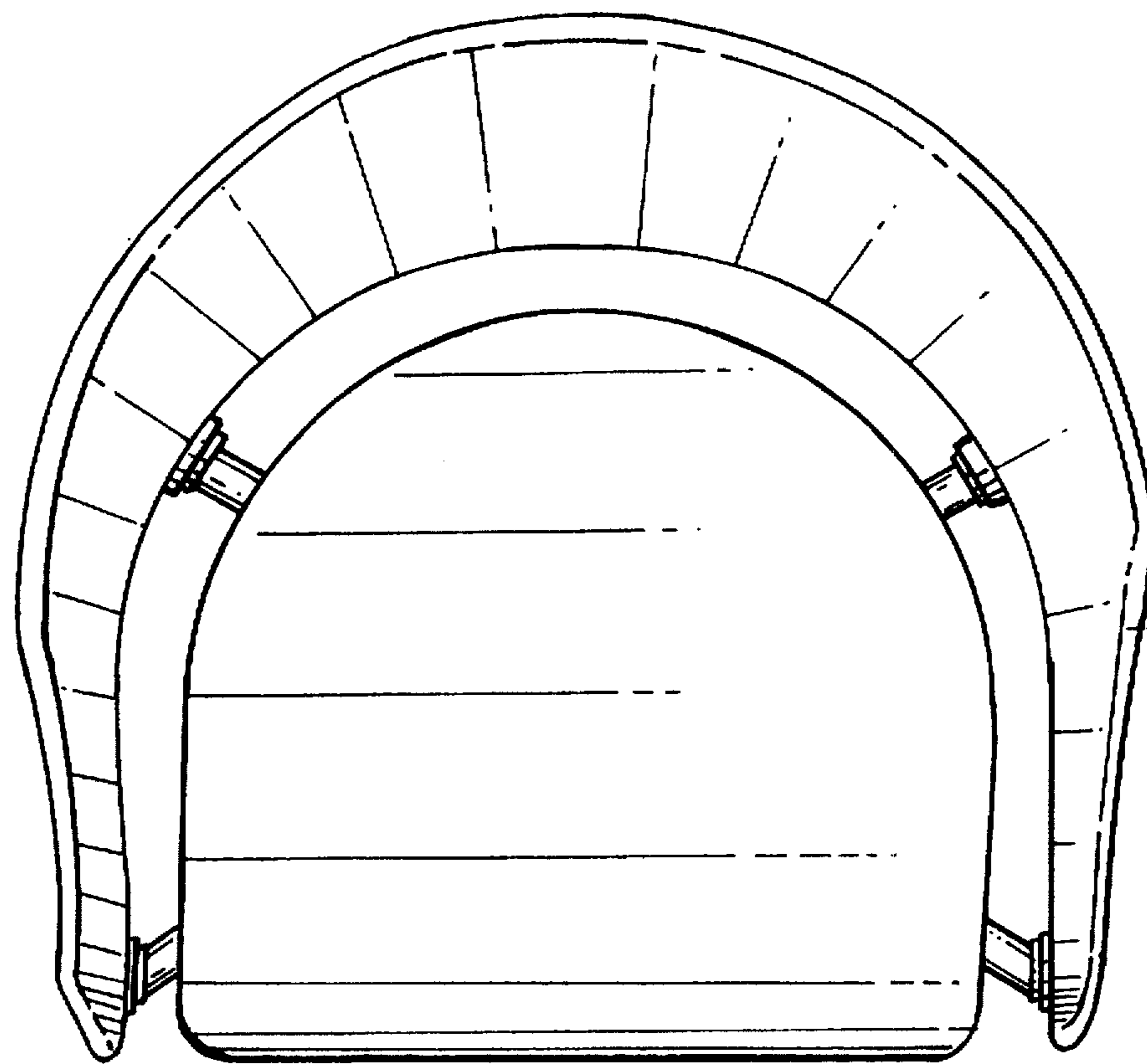

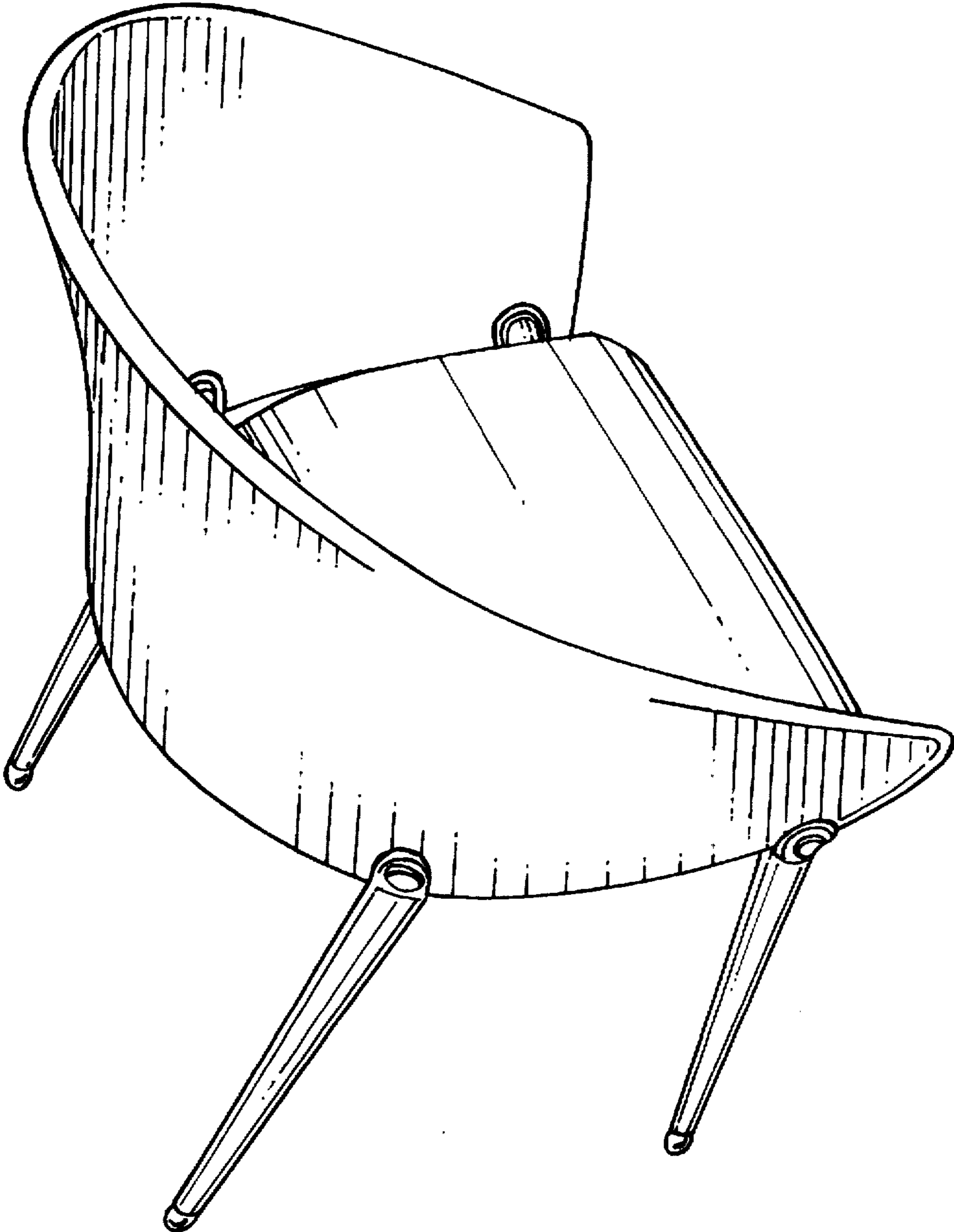

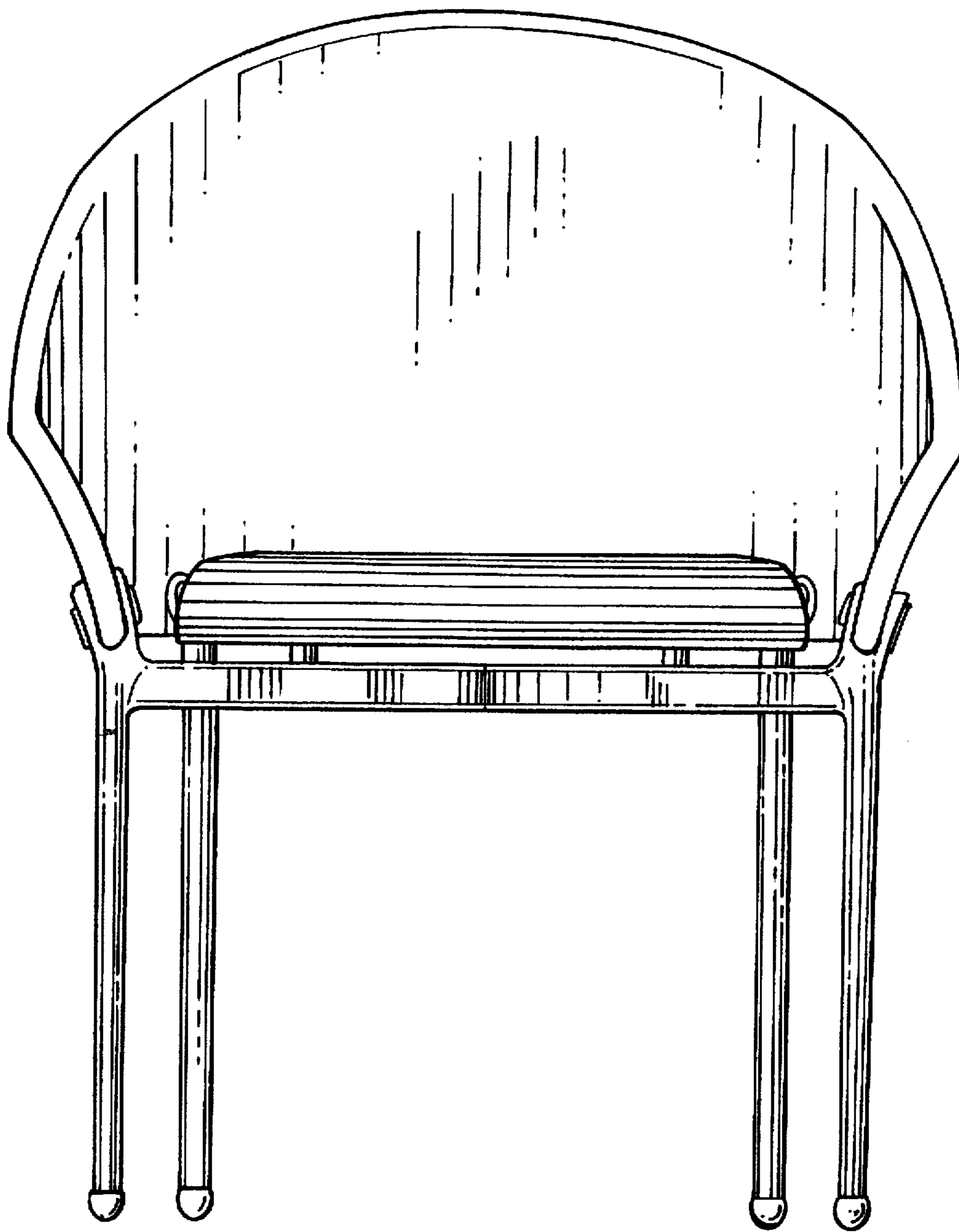

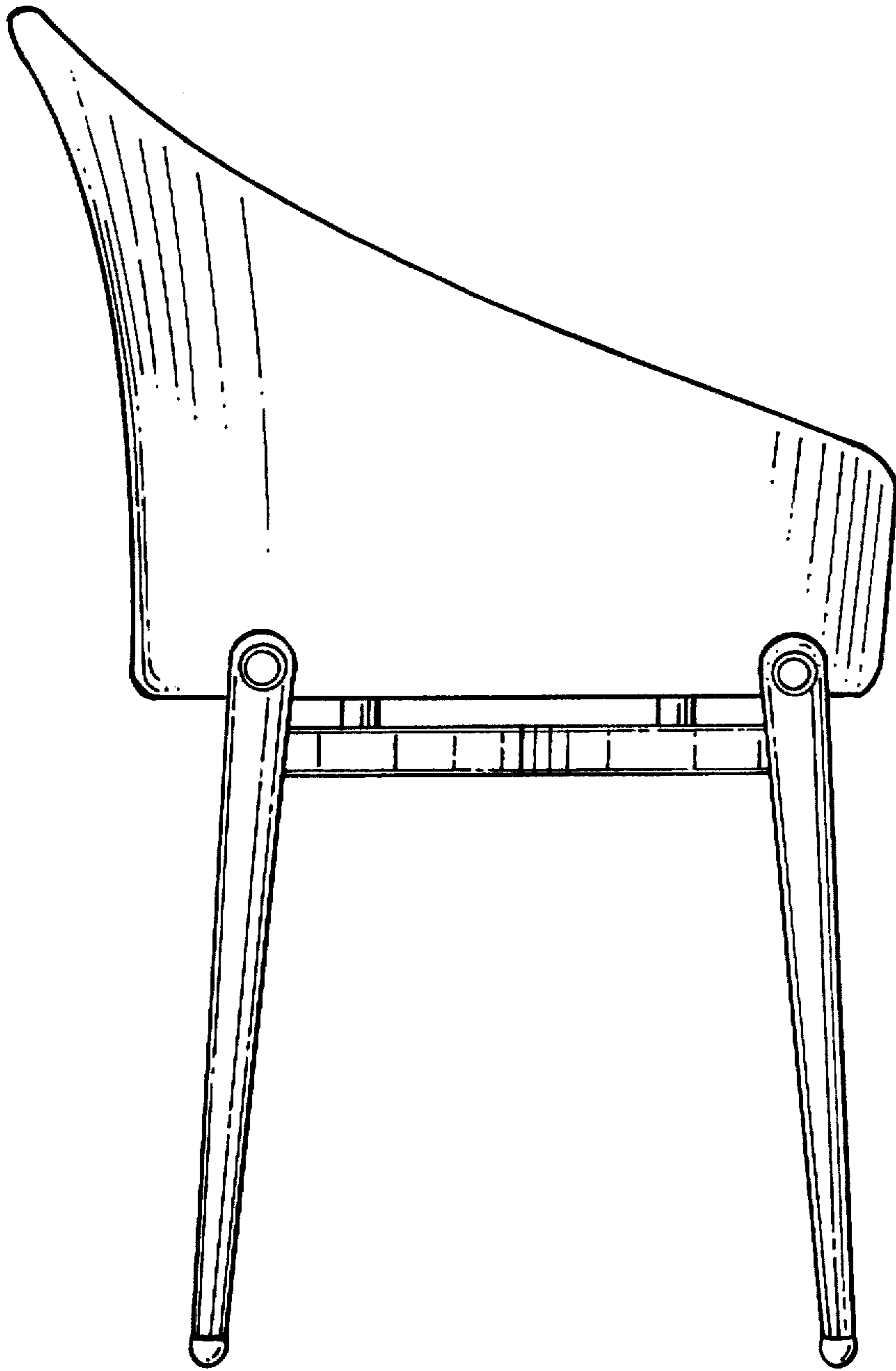

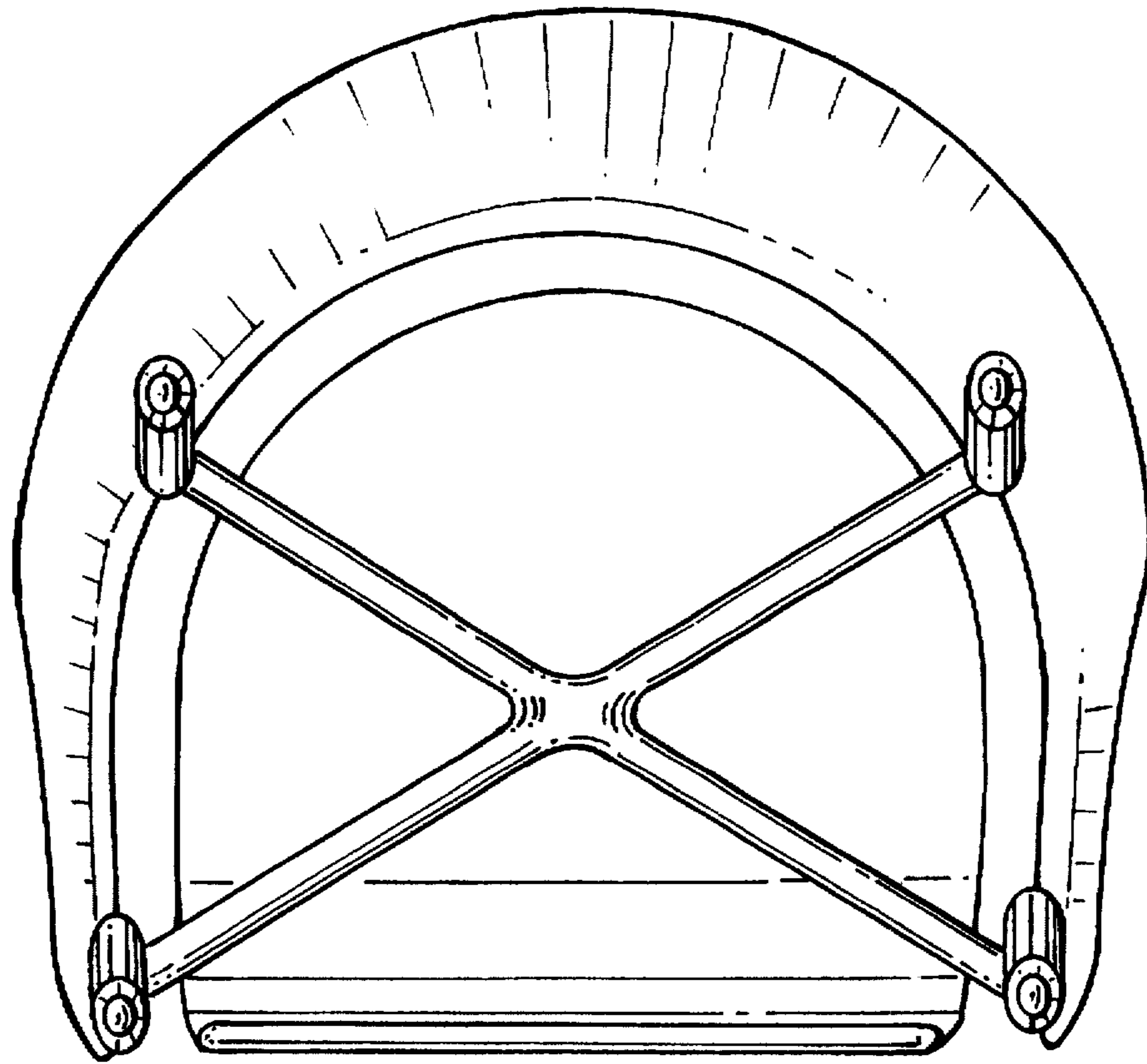
