FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

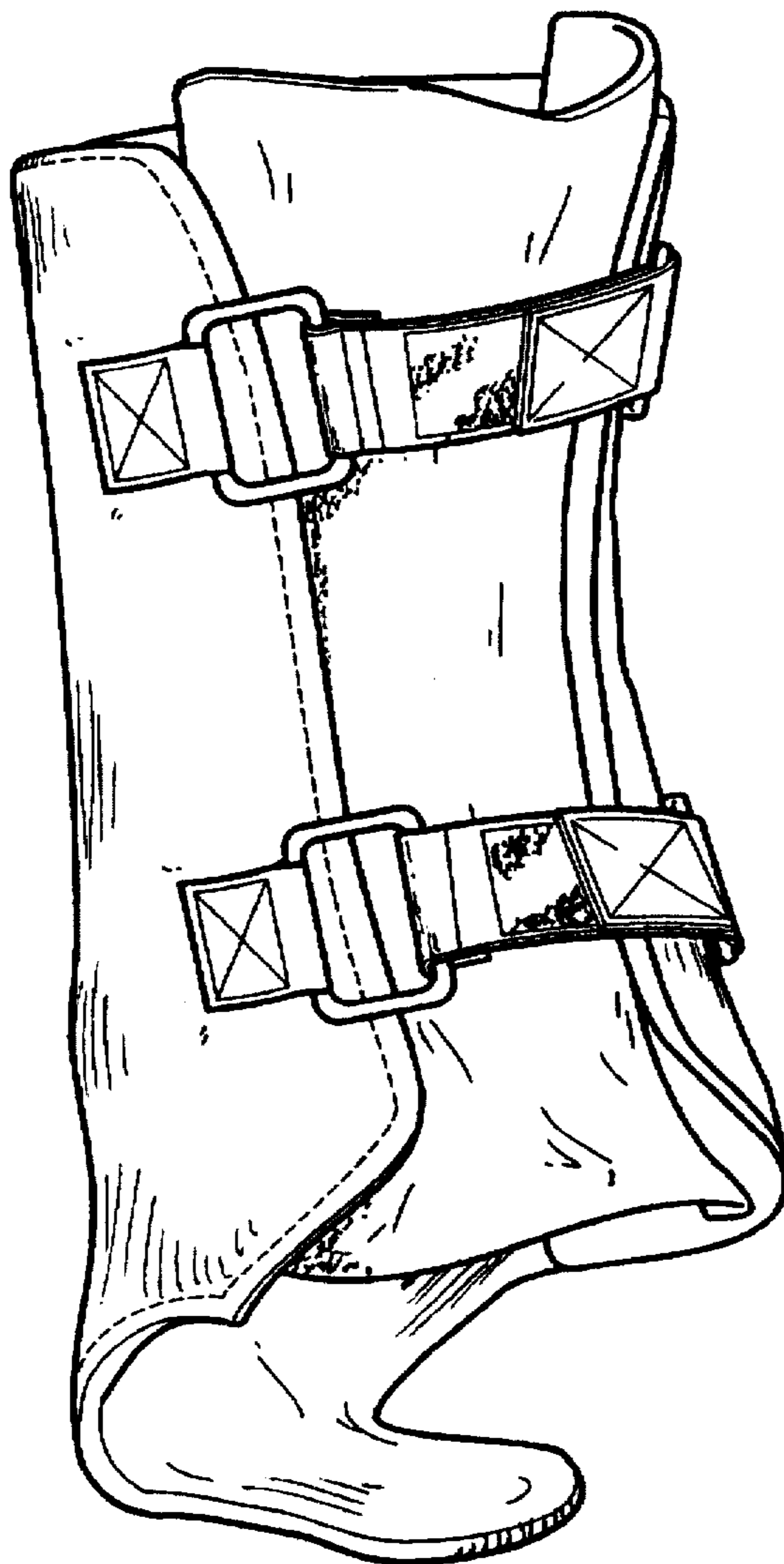
The broken lines on the ankle brace represent top-stitching.

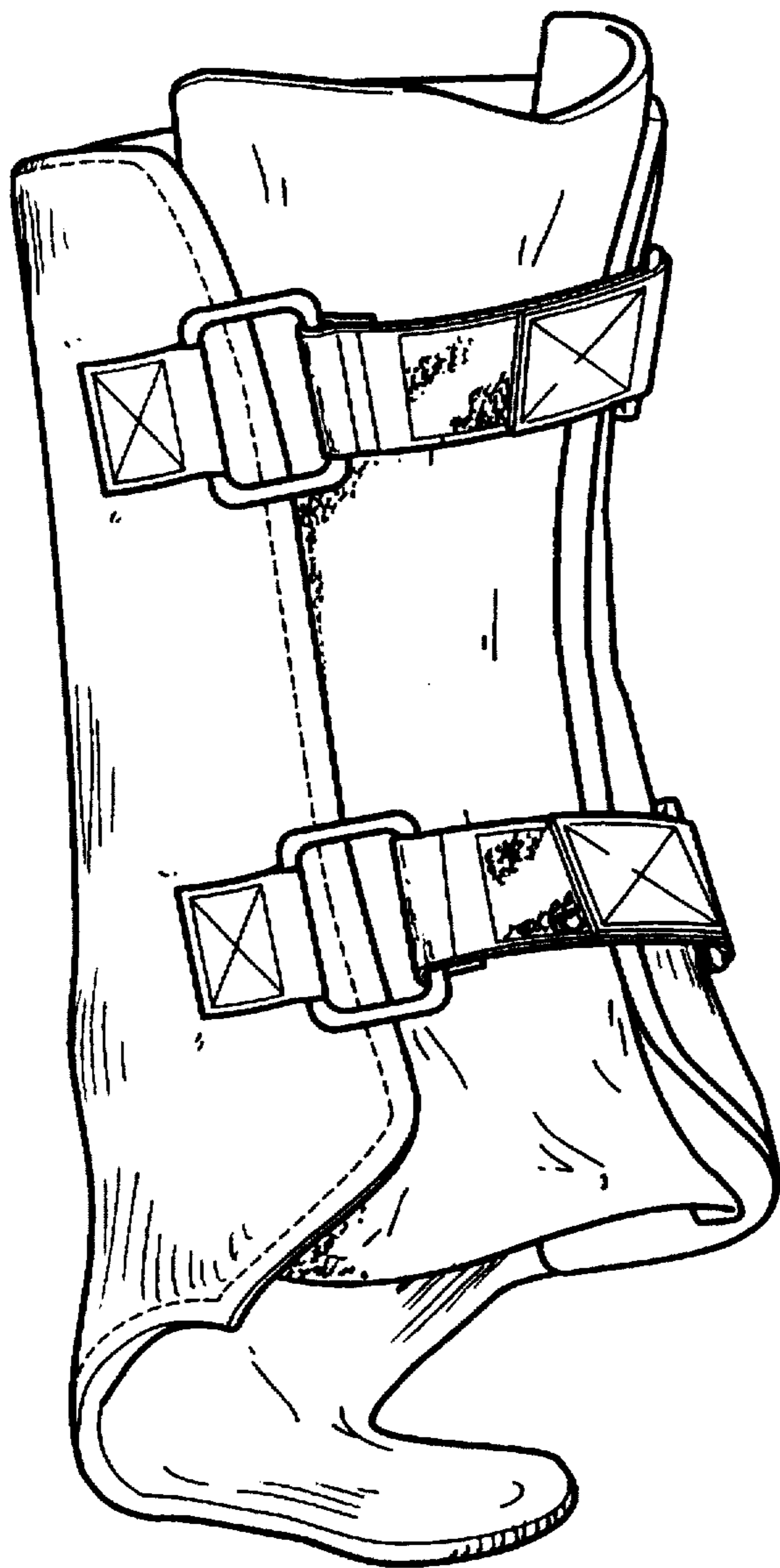

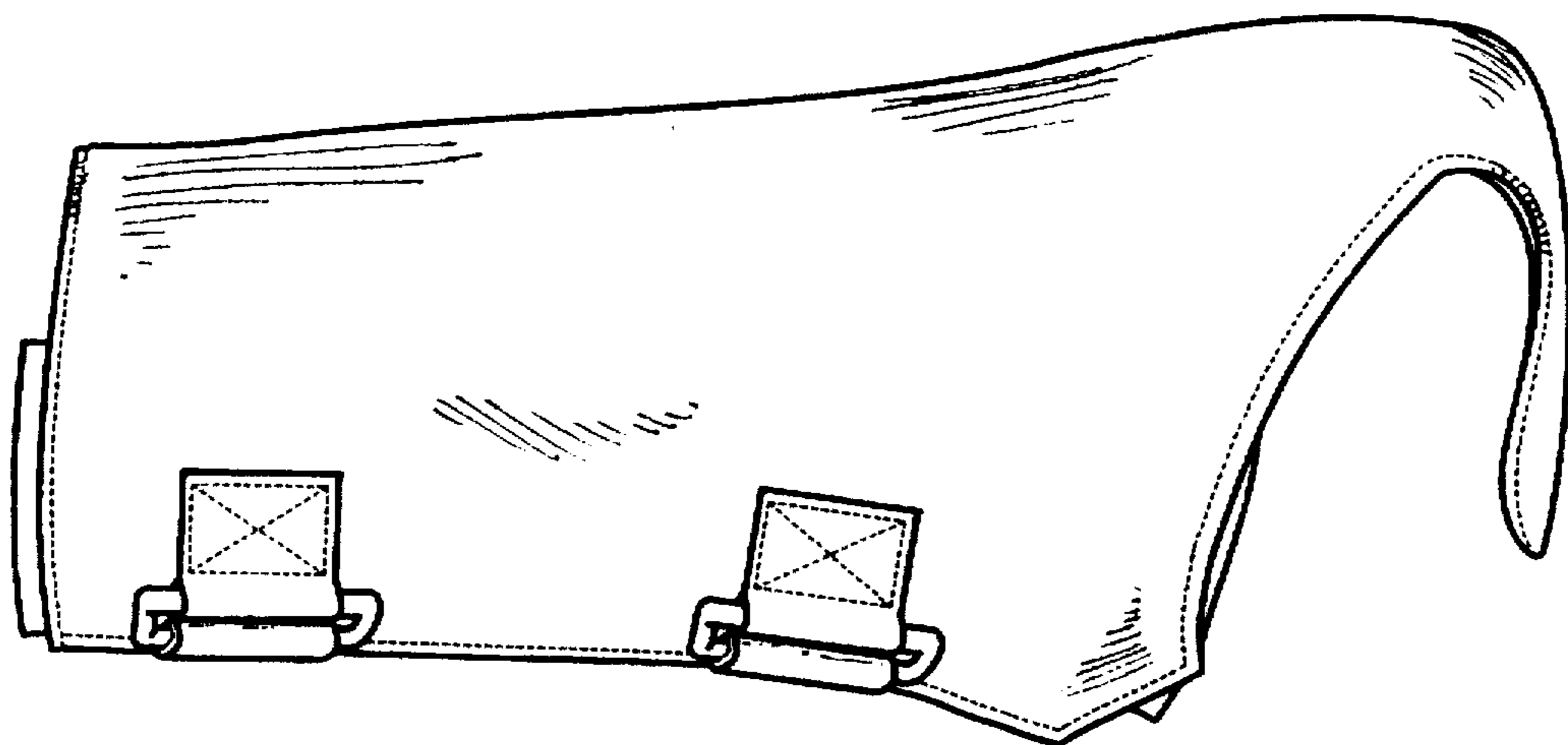

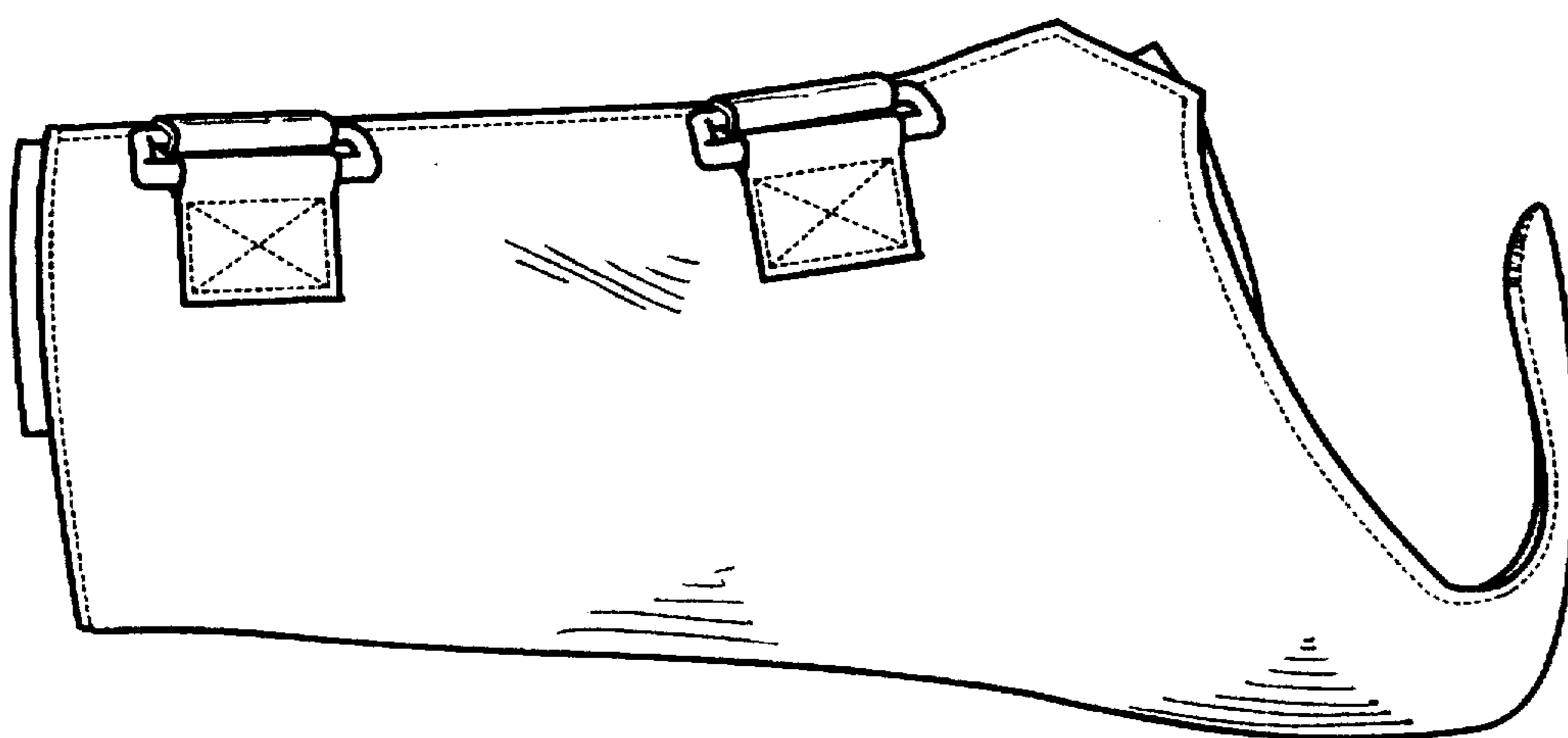

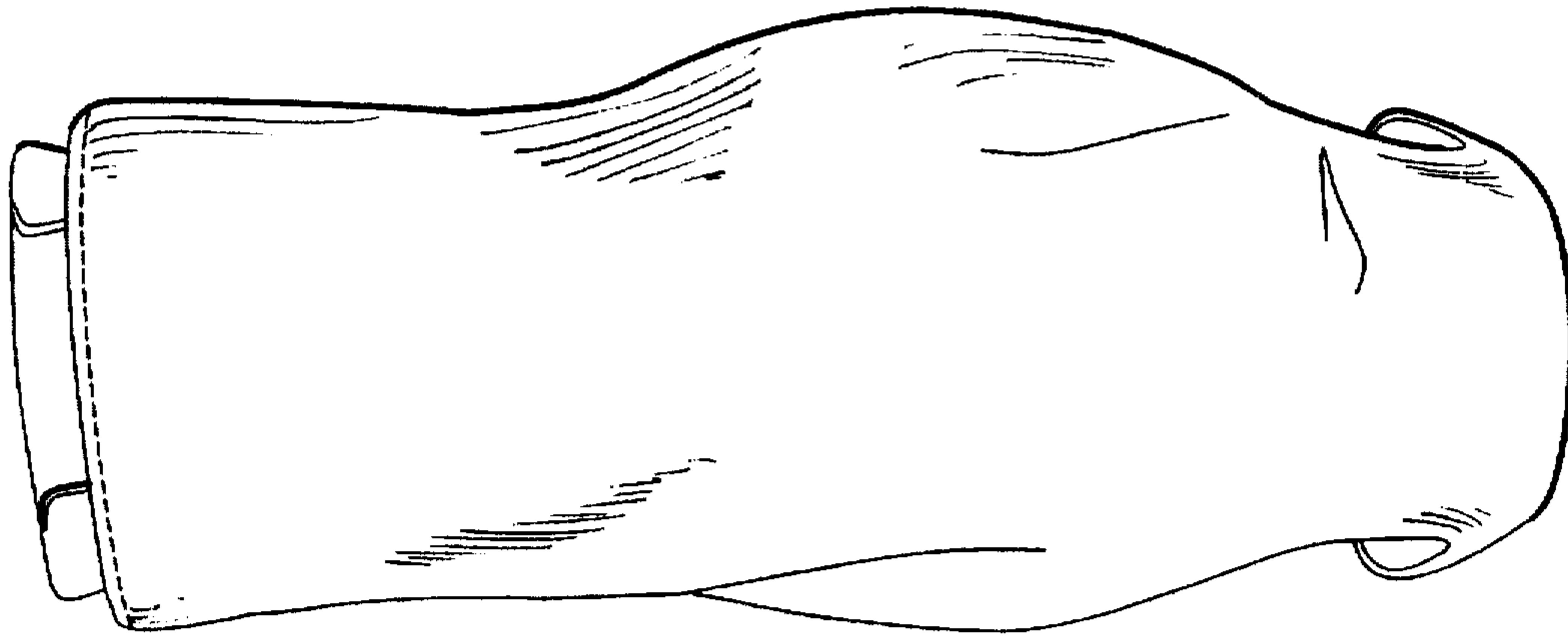

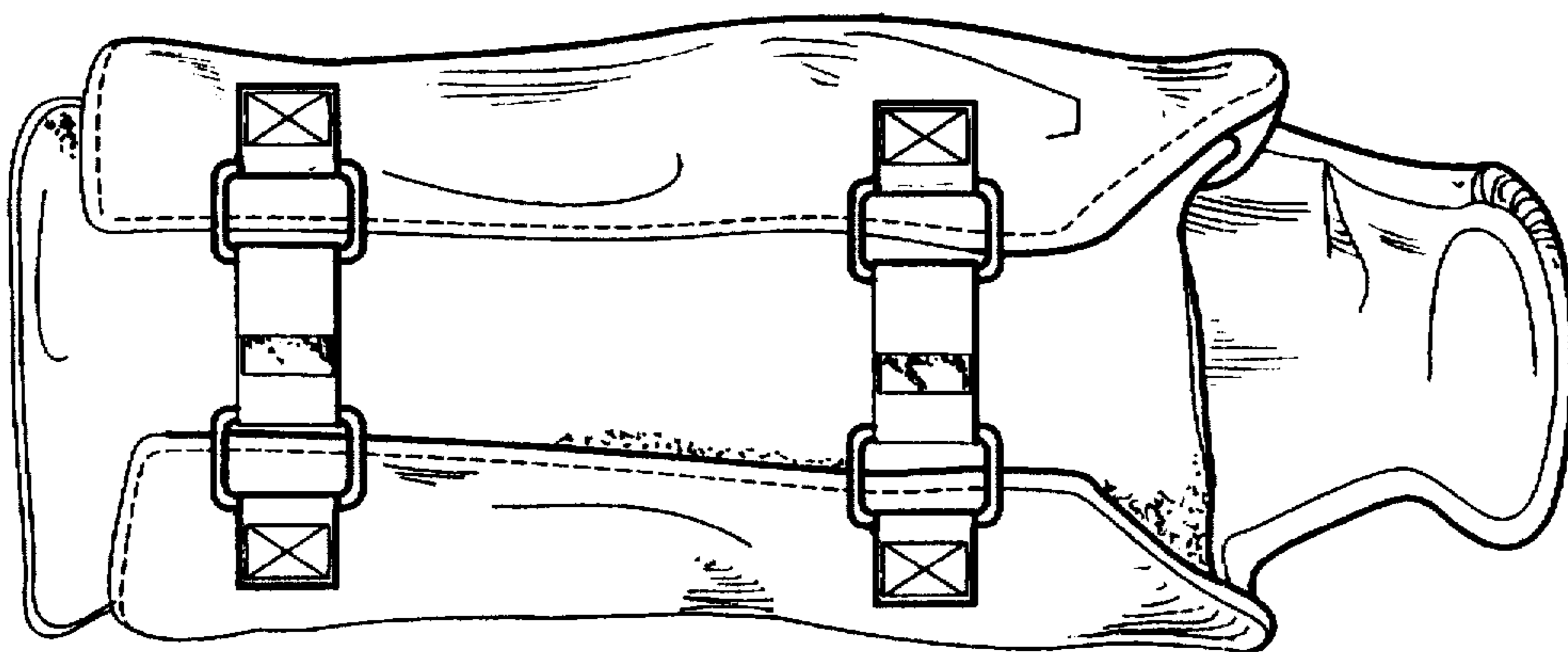

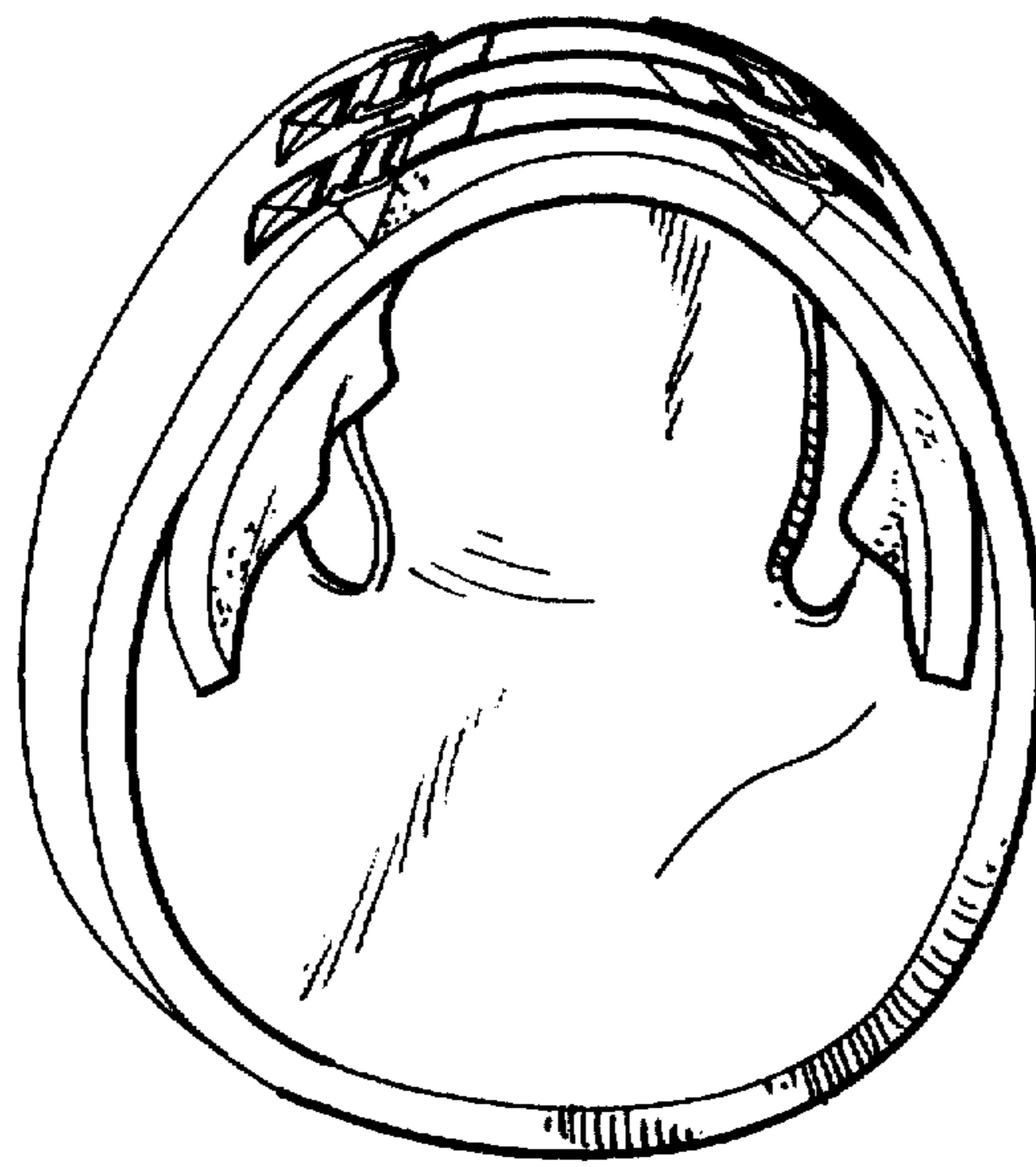

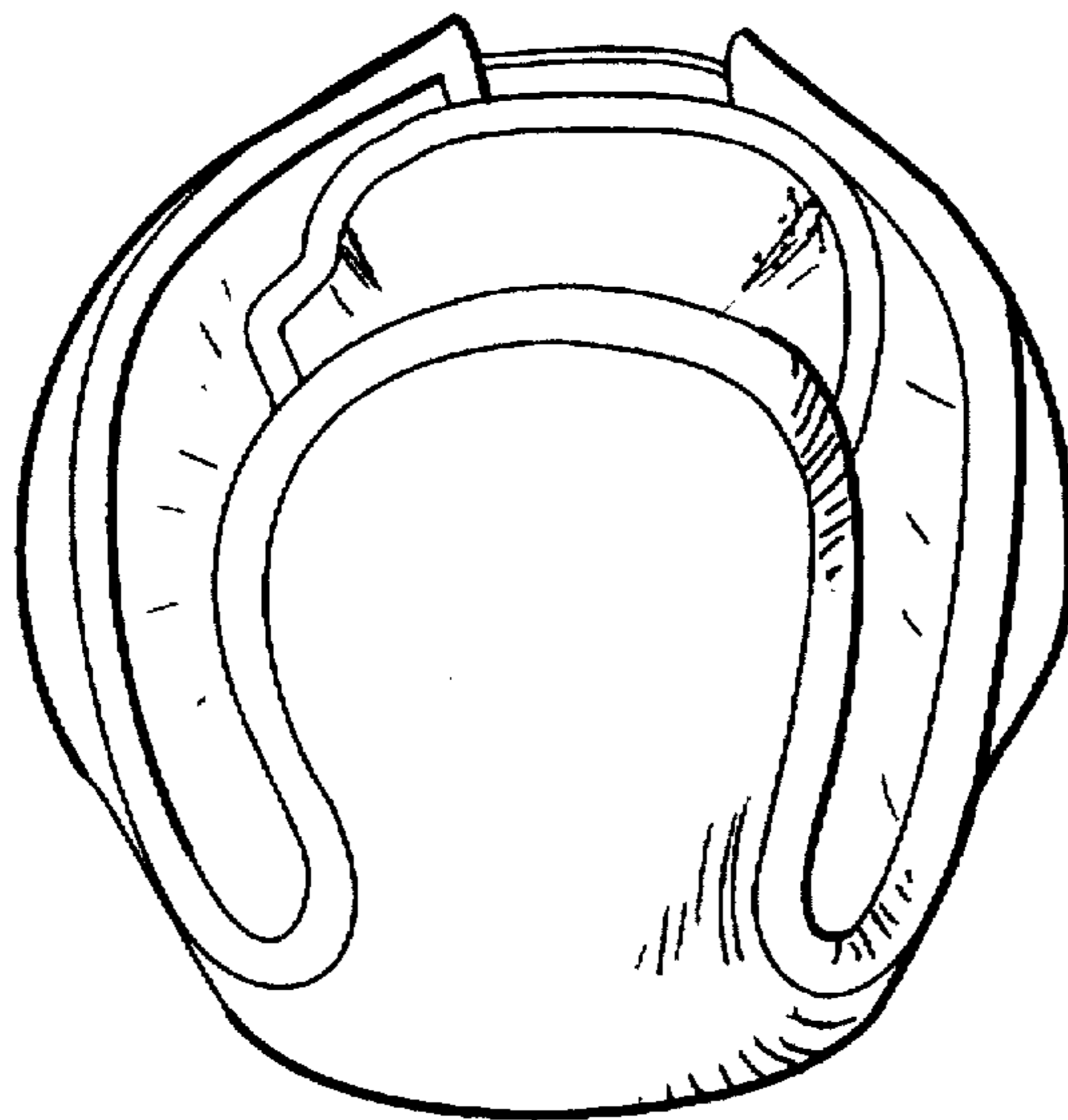
