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[57] **CLAIM**

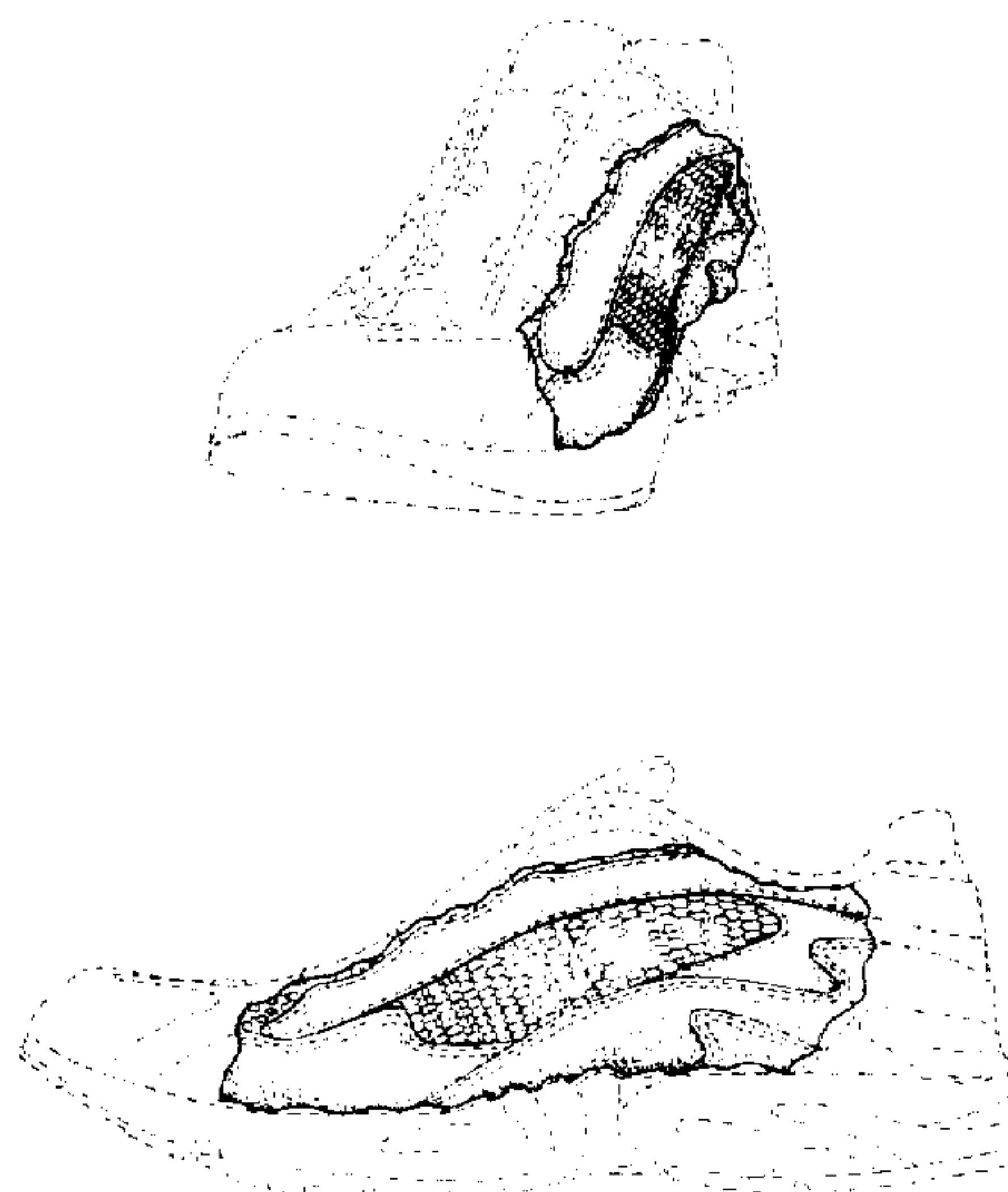
The ornamental design for a portion of a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portion of a shoe upper showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the portion of a shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the portion of a shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the portion of a shoe upper shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the portion of a shoe upper shown in FIG. 1.

The hatching shown in the central panel depicts a uniform gauge mesh. The broken line showing of the stripes under the central mesh panel and the remainder of the shoe are for illustration purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

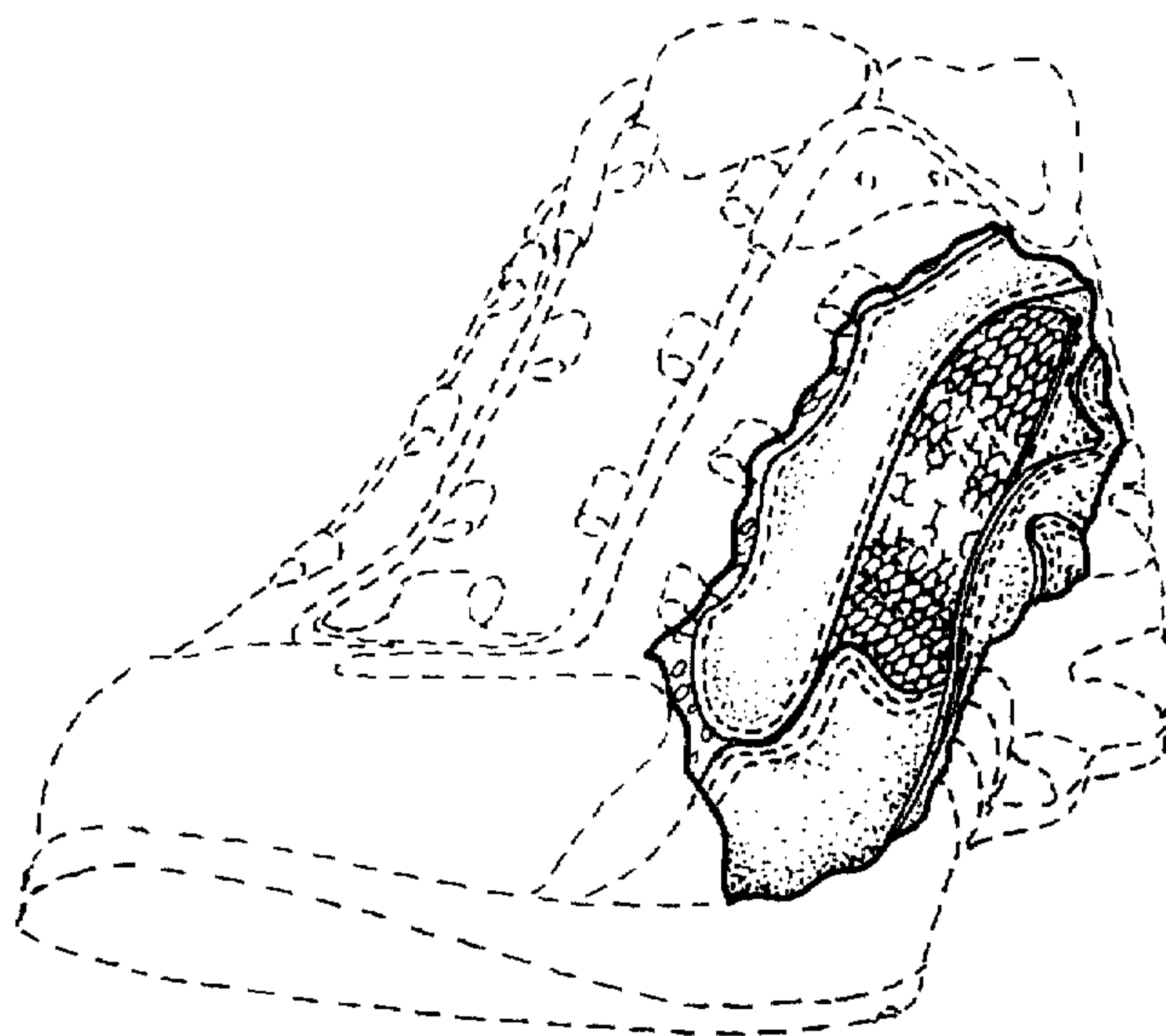

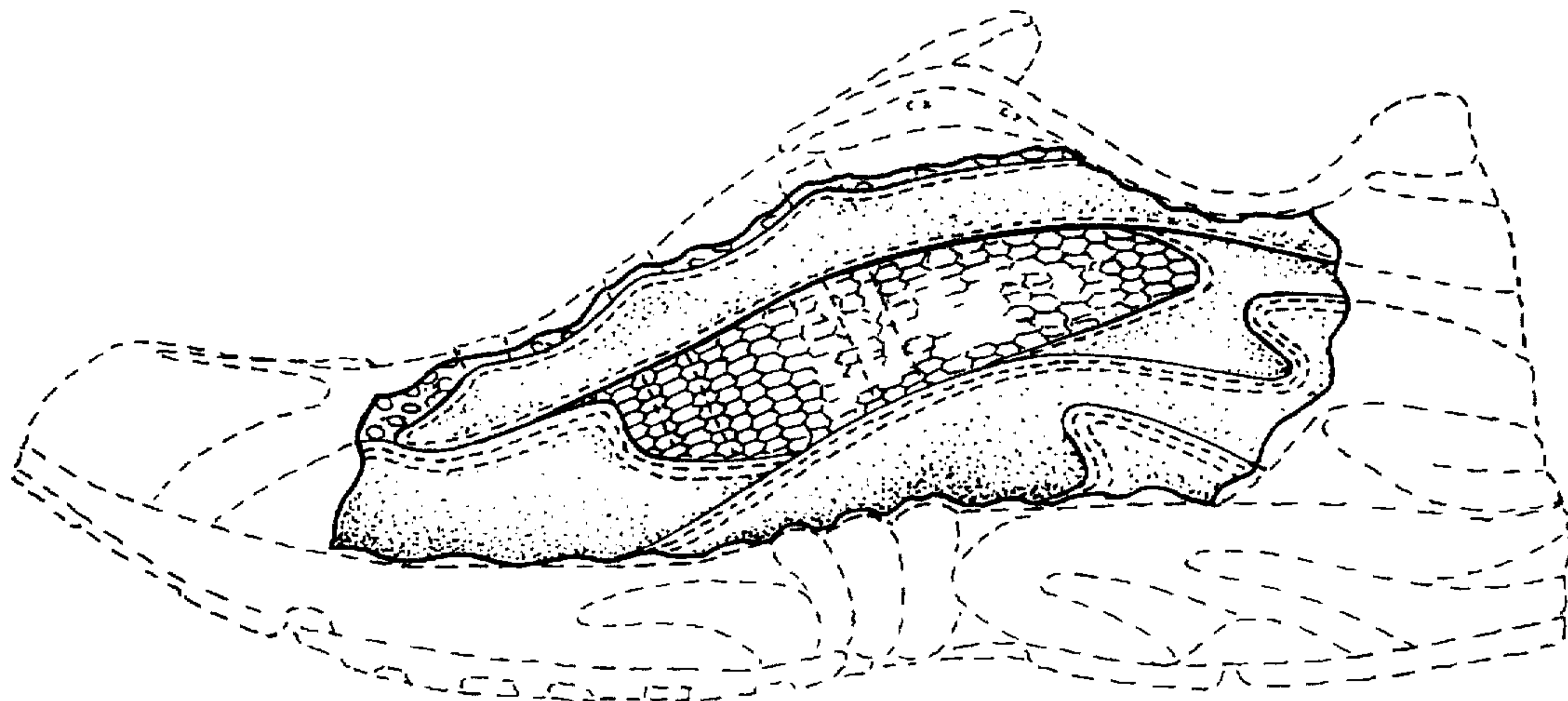

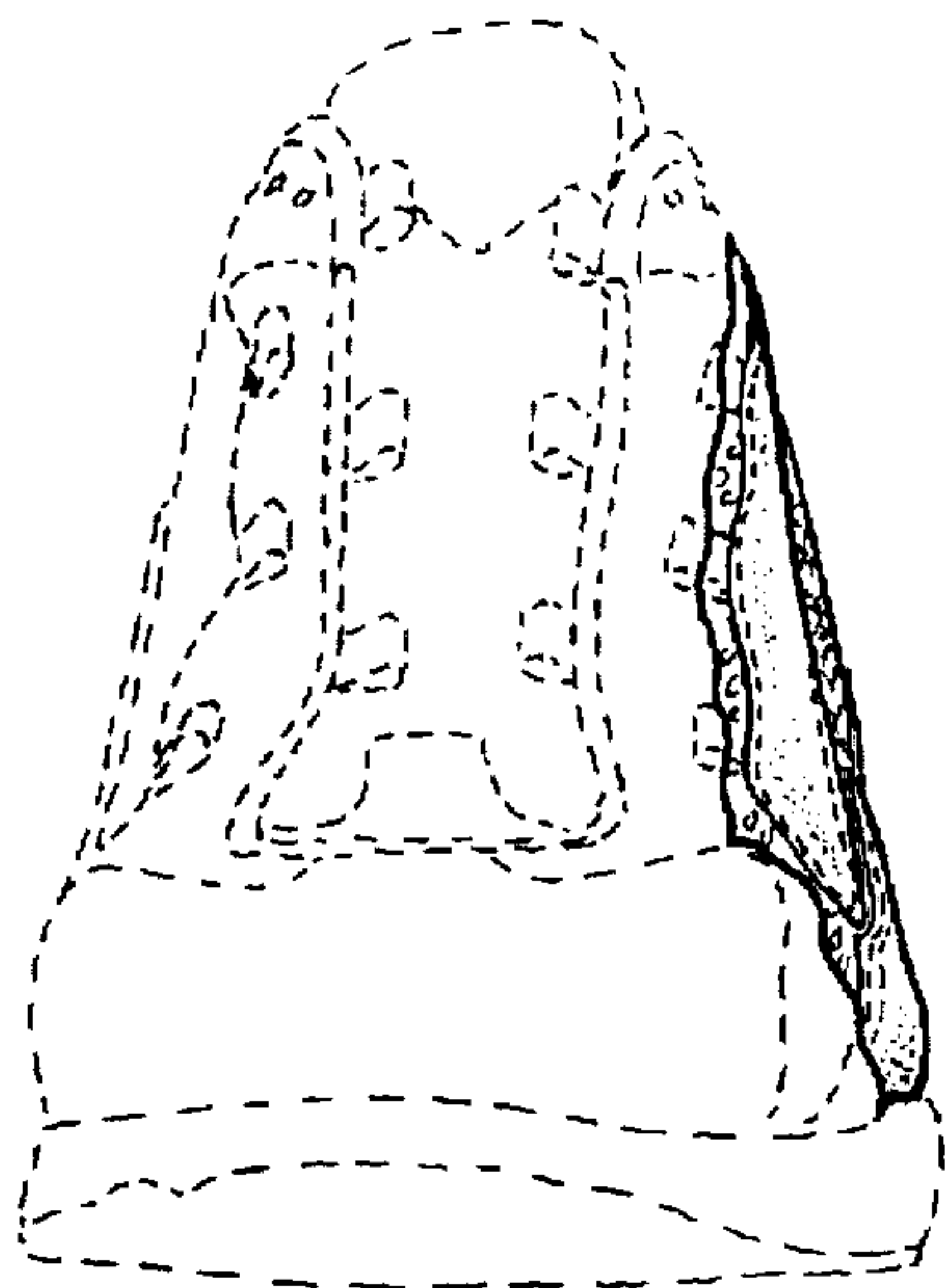

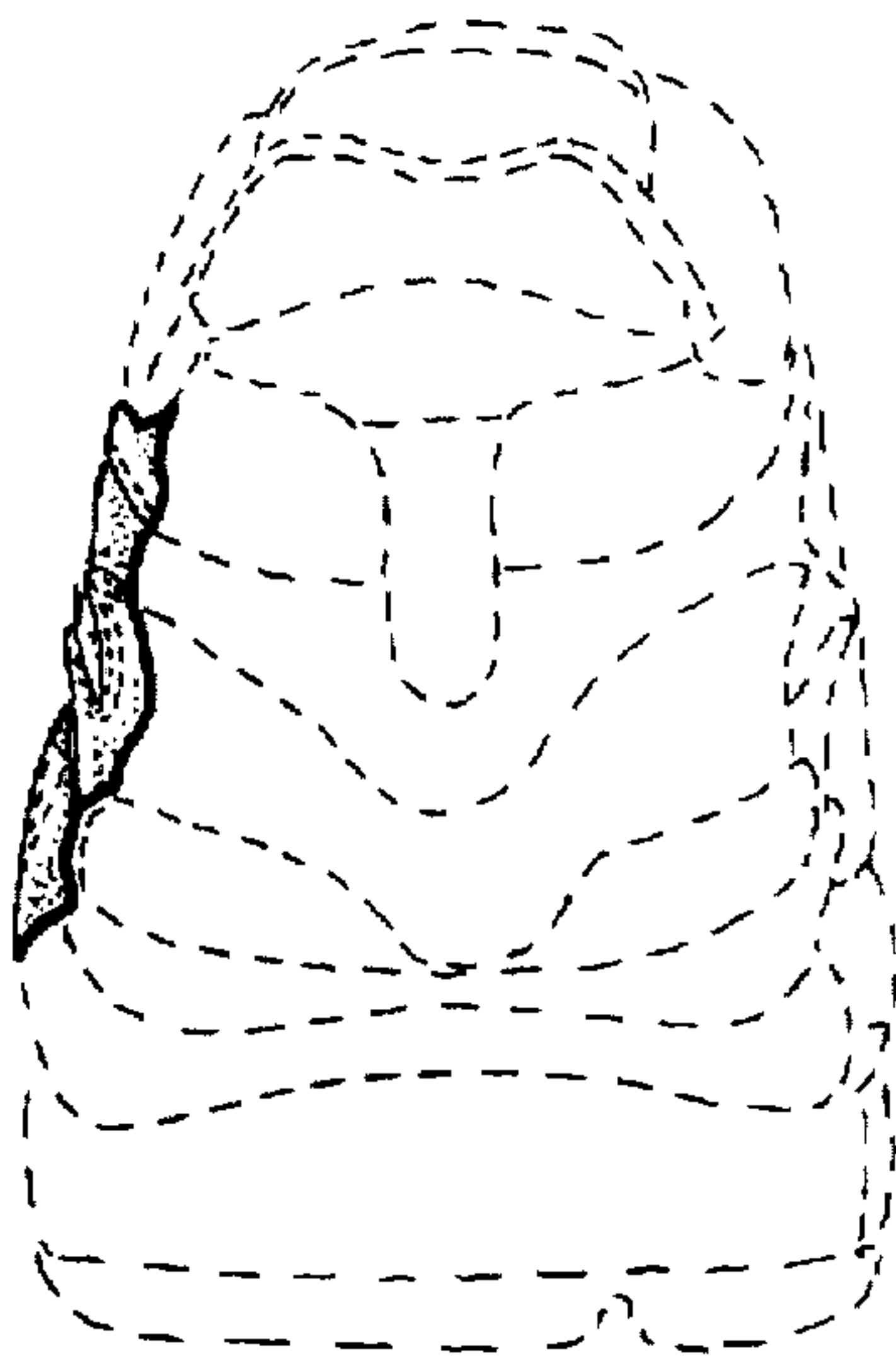

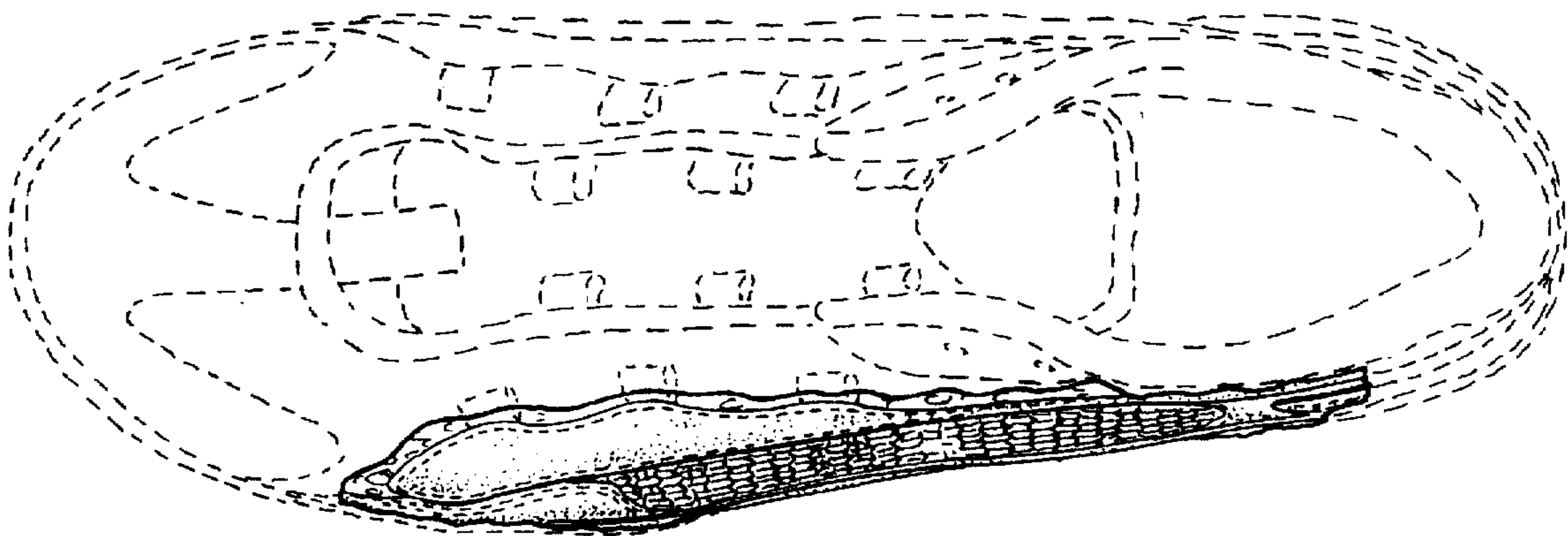
