FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof, showing a key ring and chain for attachment thereto.

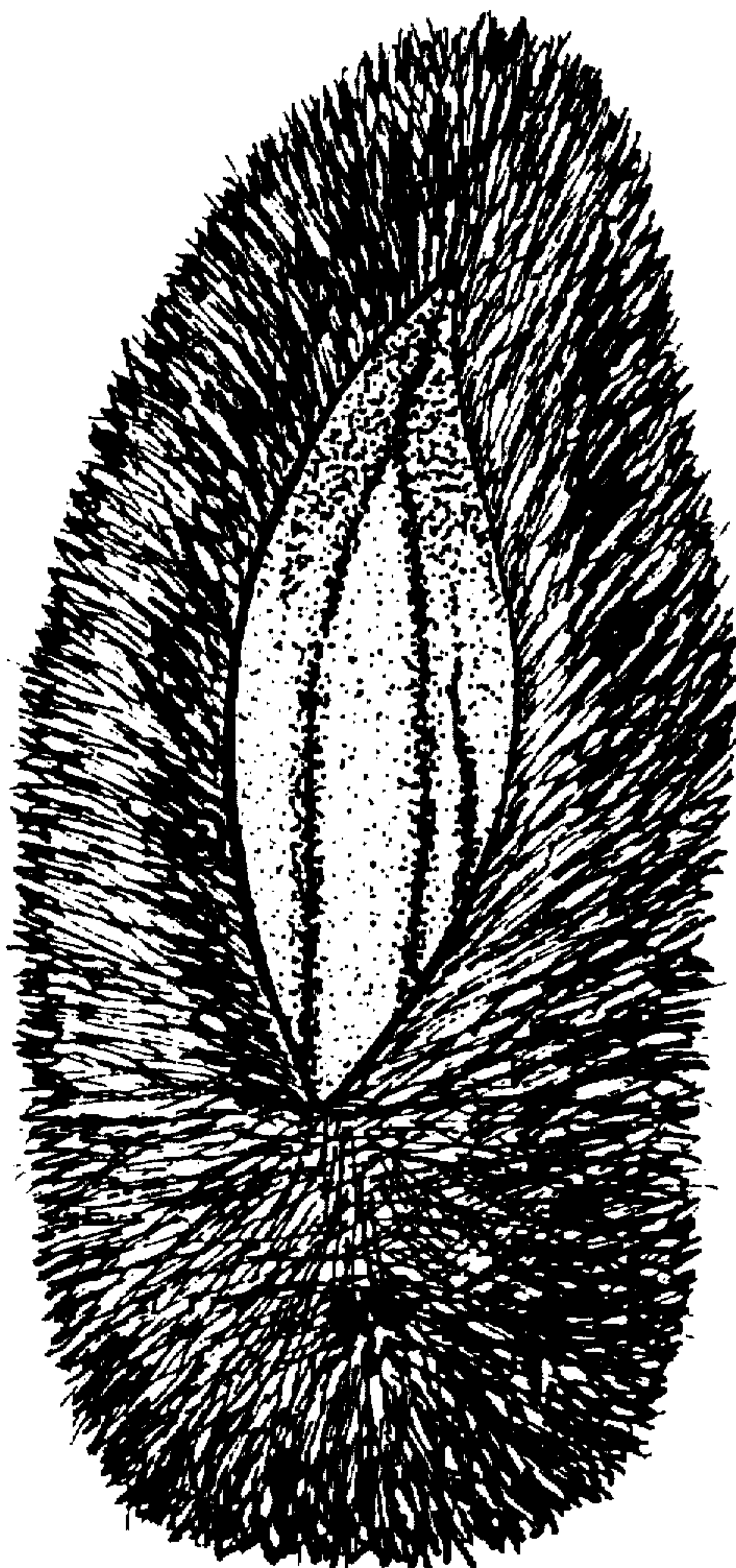

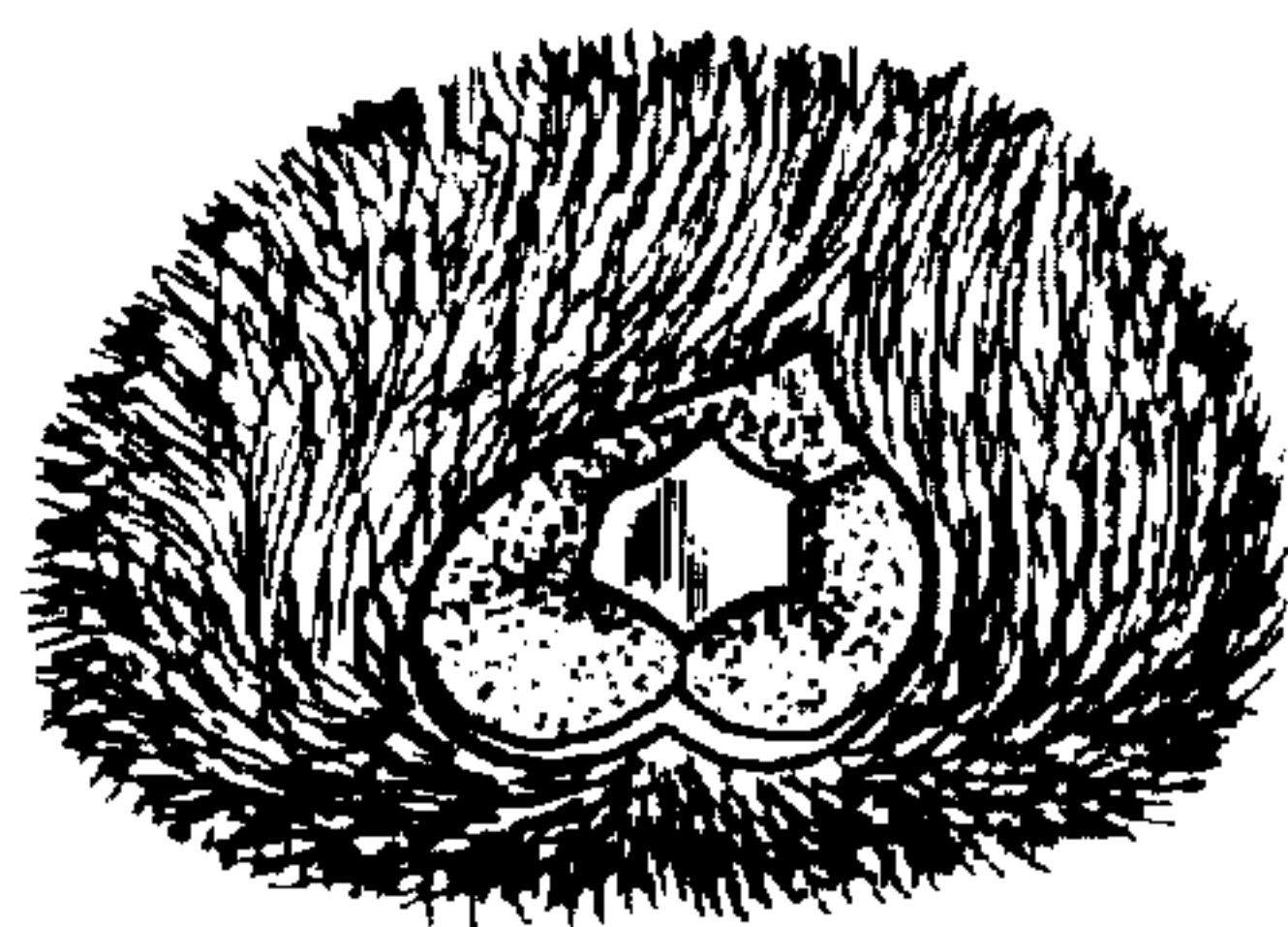

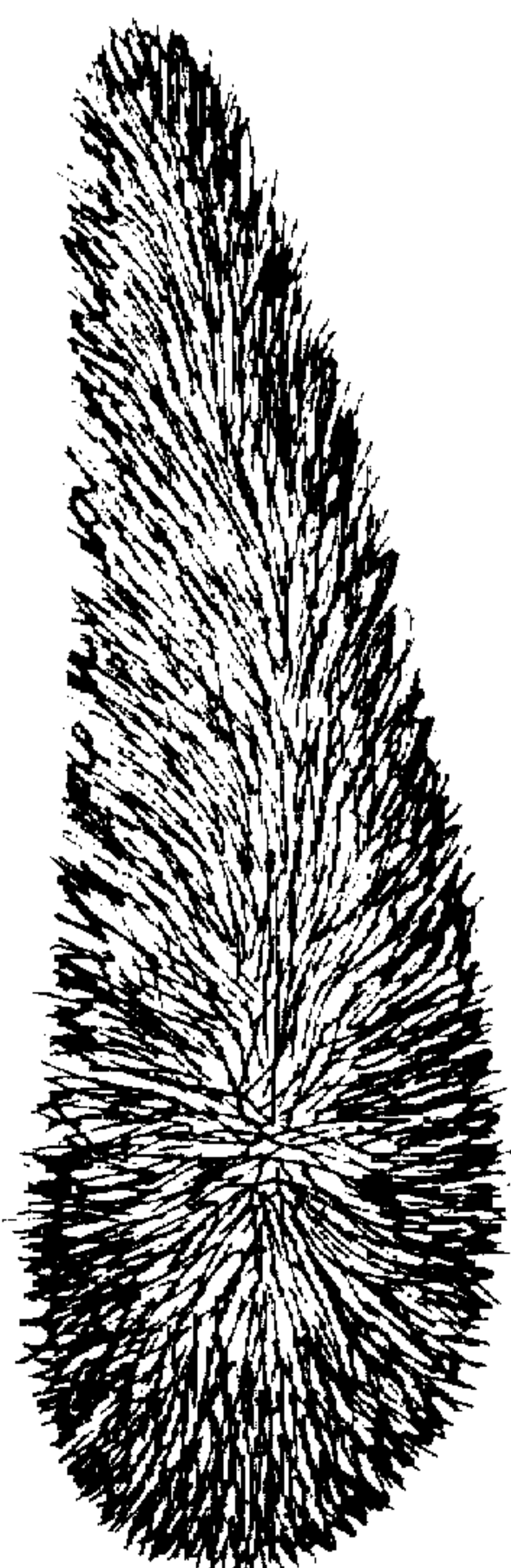

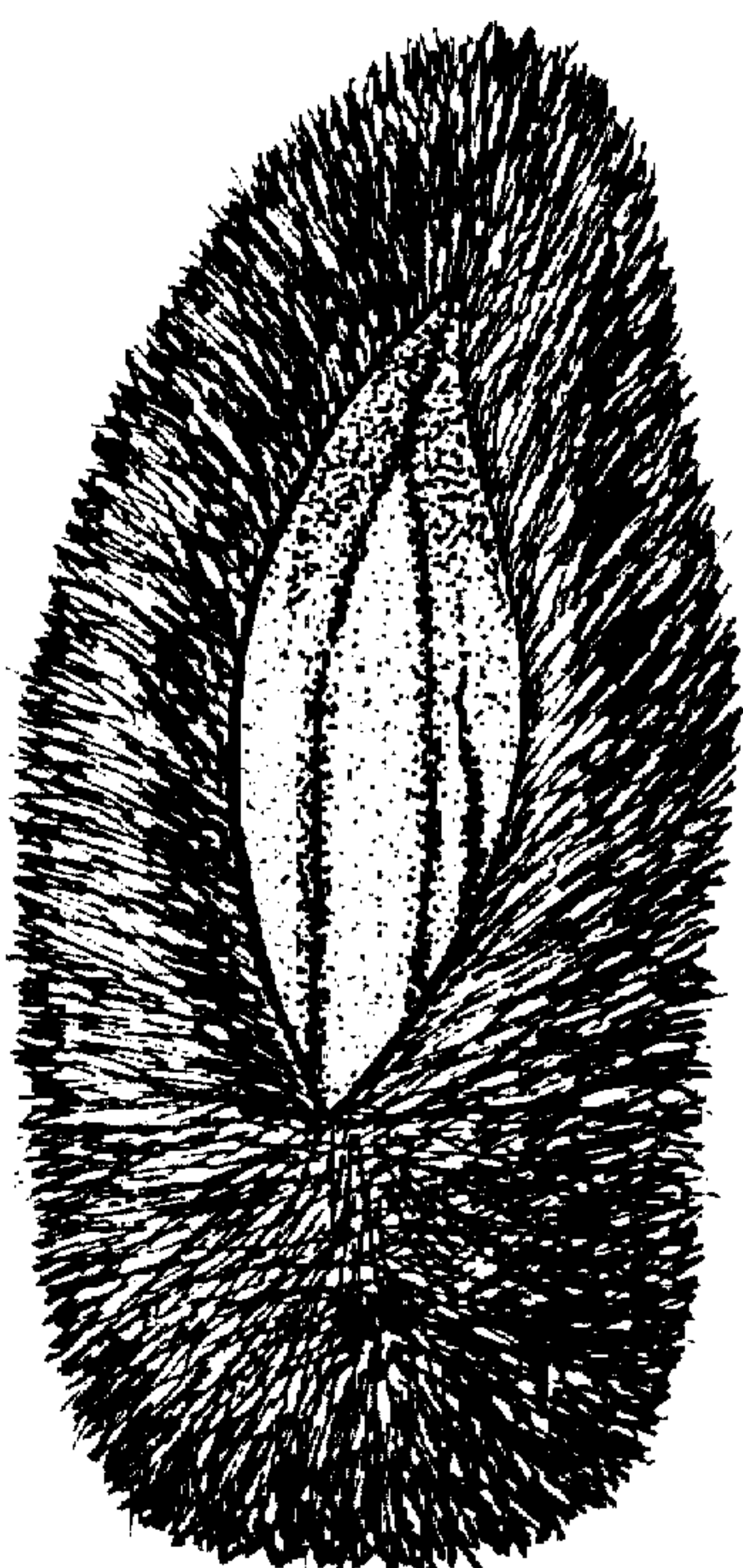

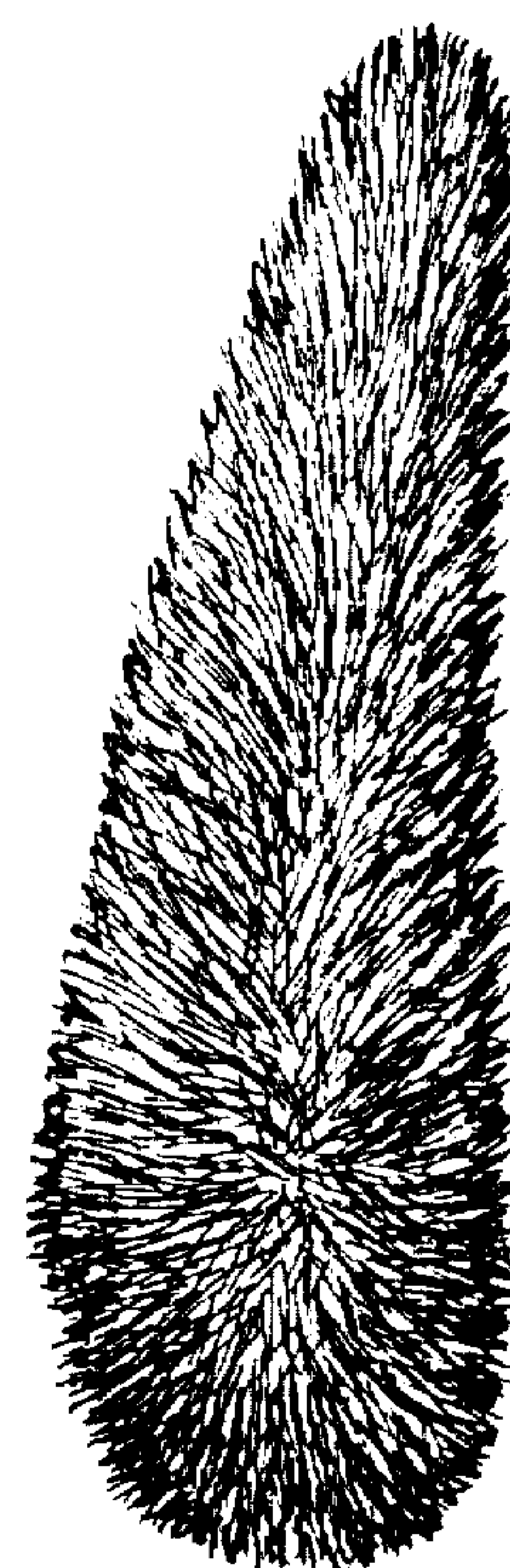

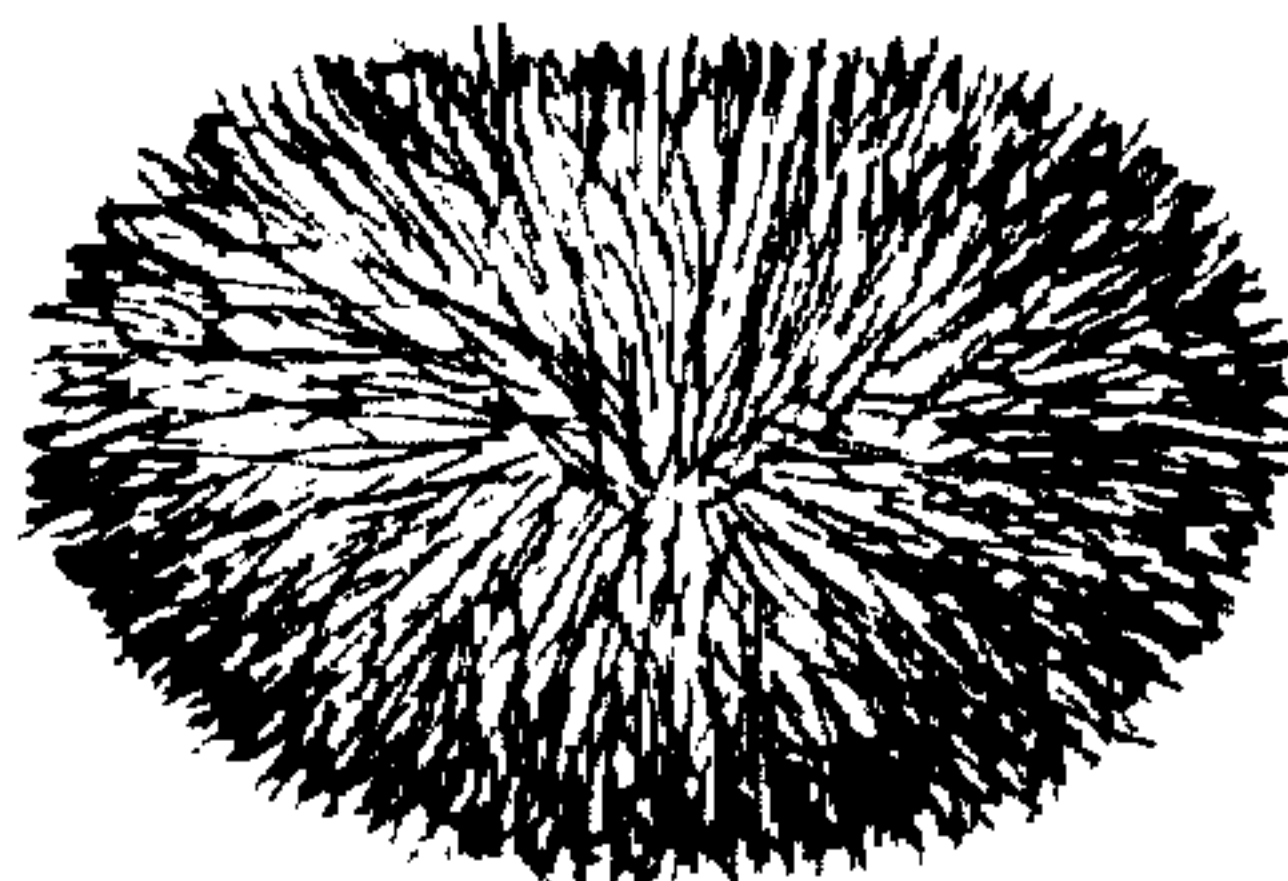

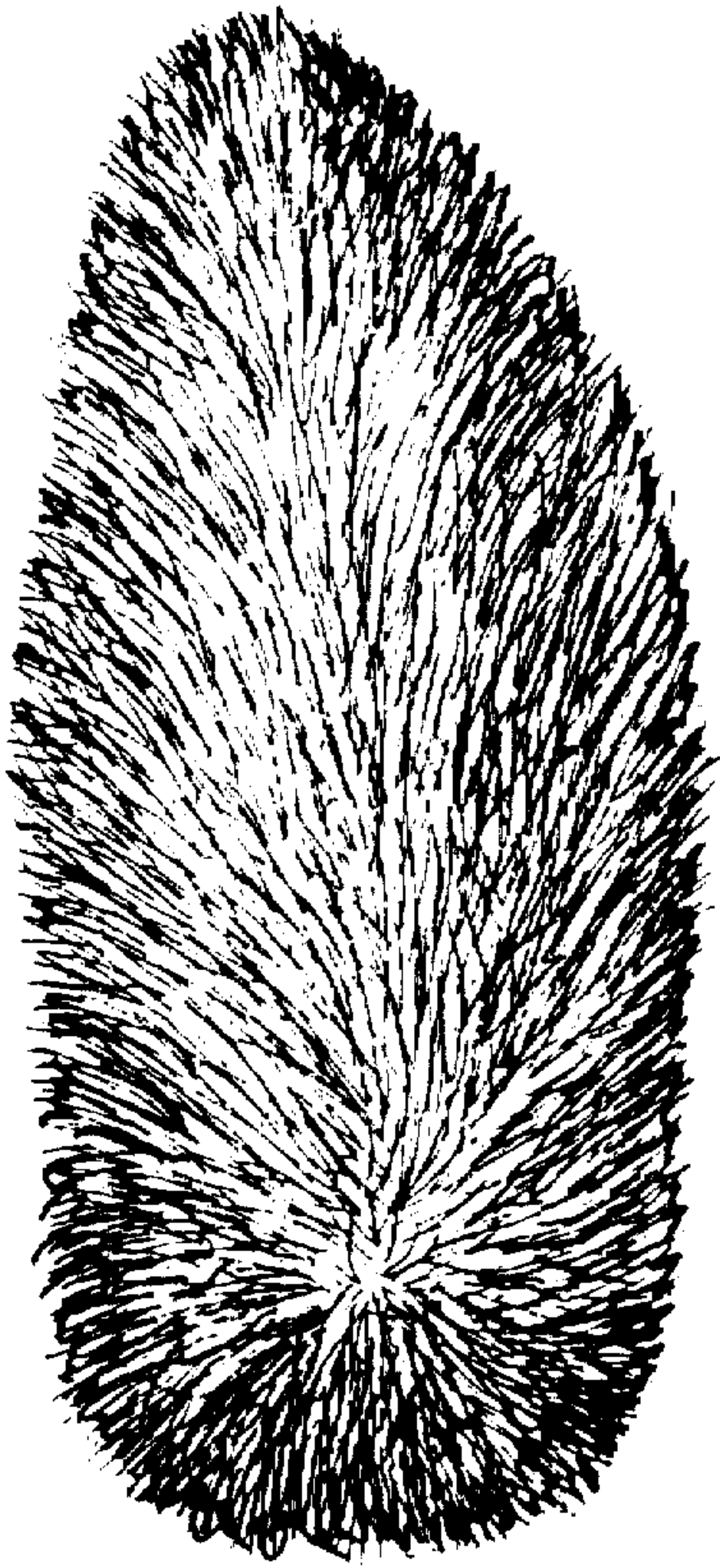

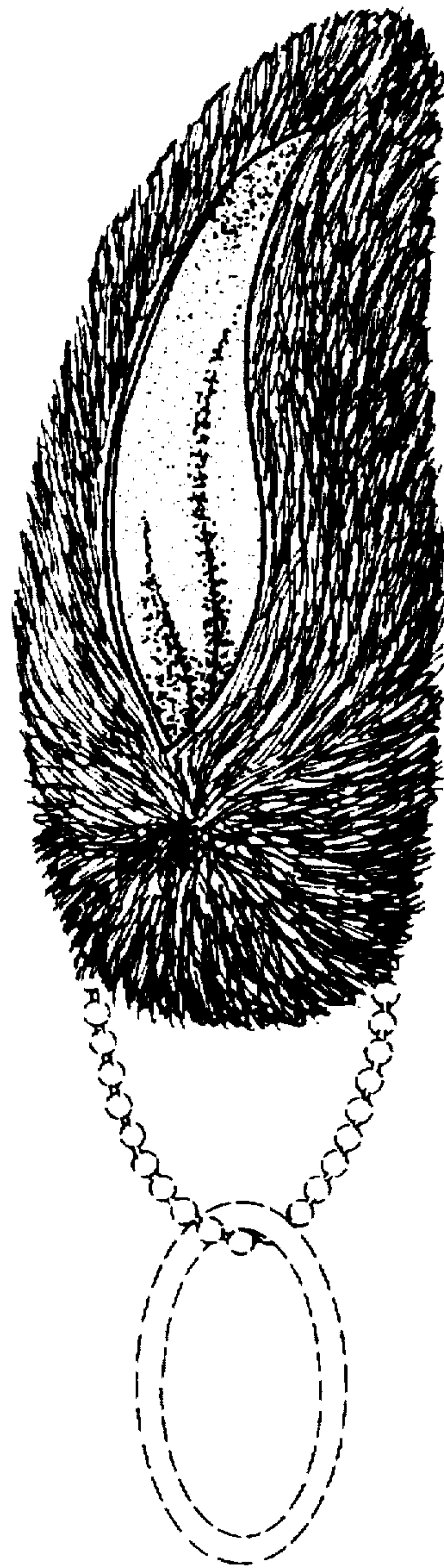
