FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

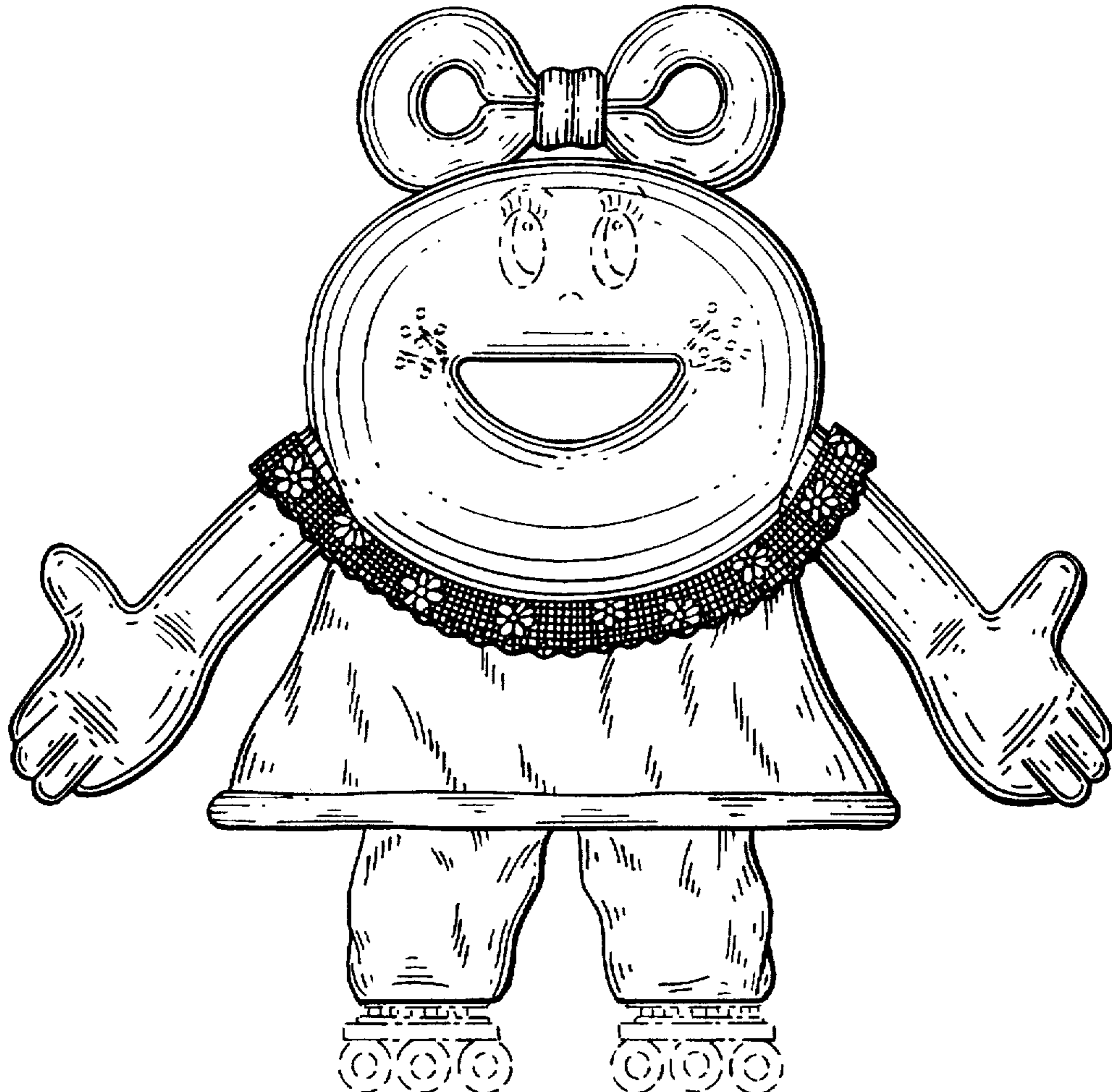
The broken line showing of the in-line skates on FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

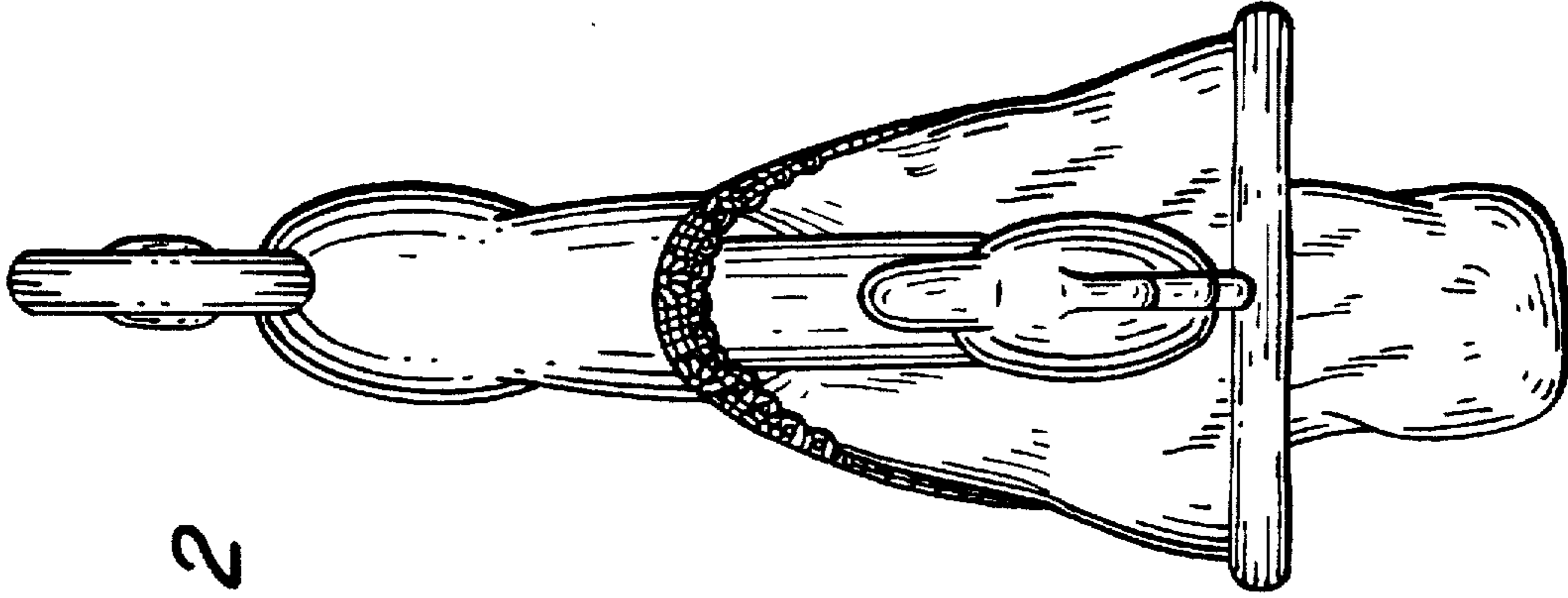

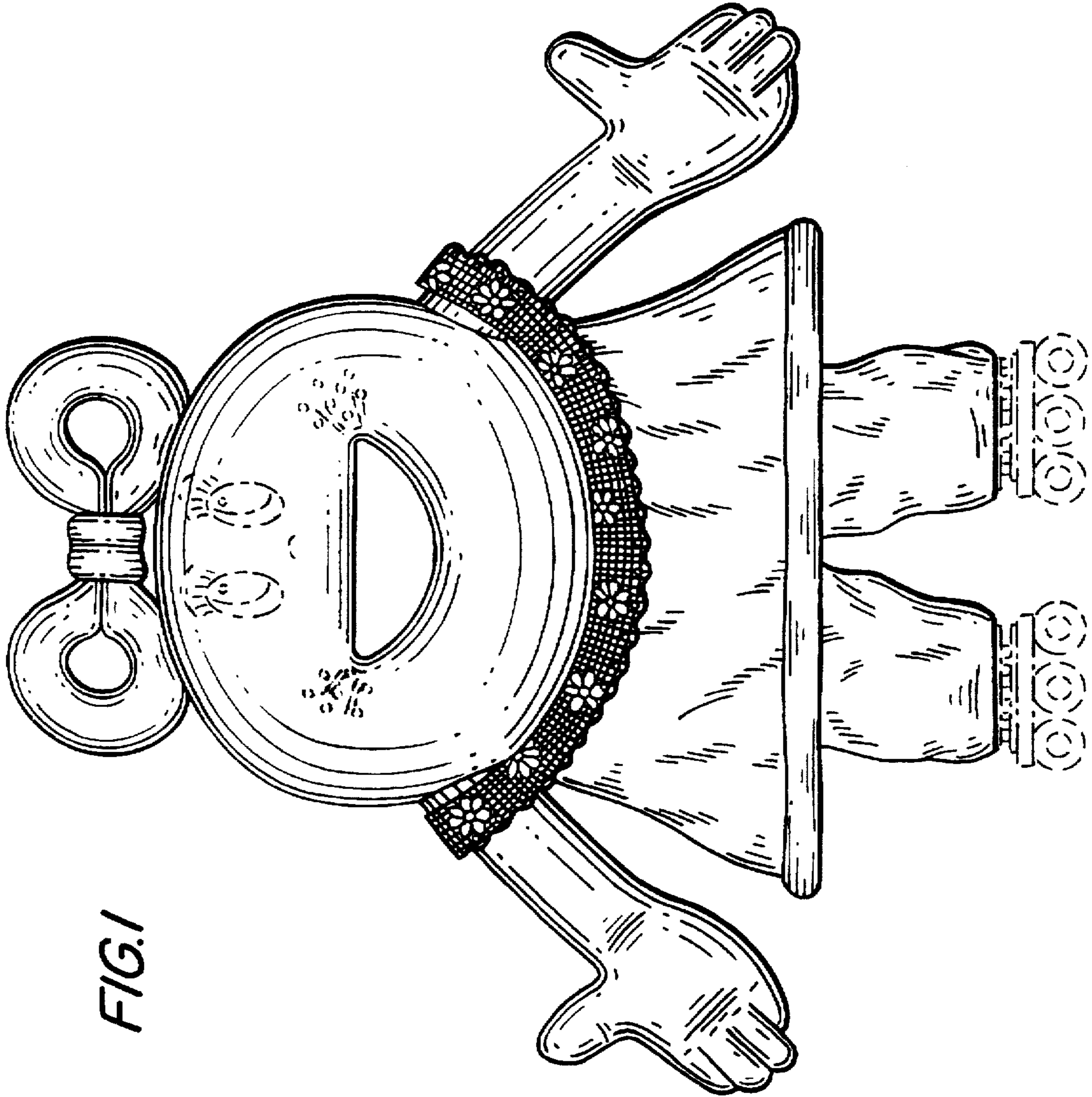

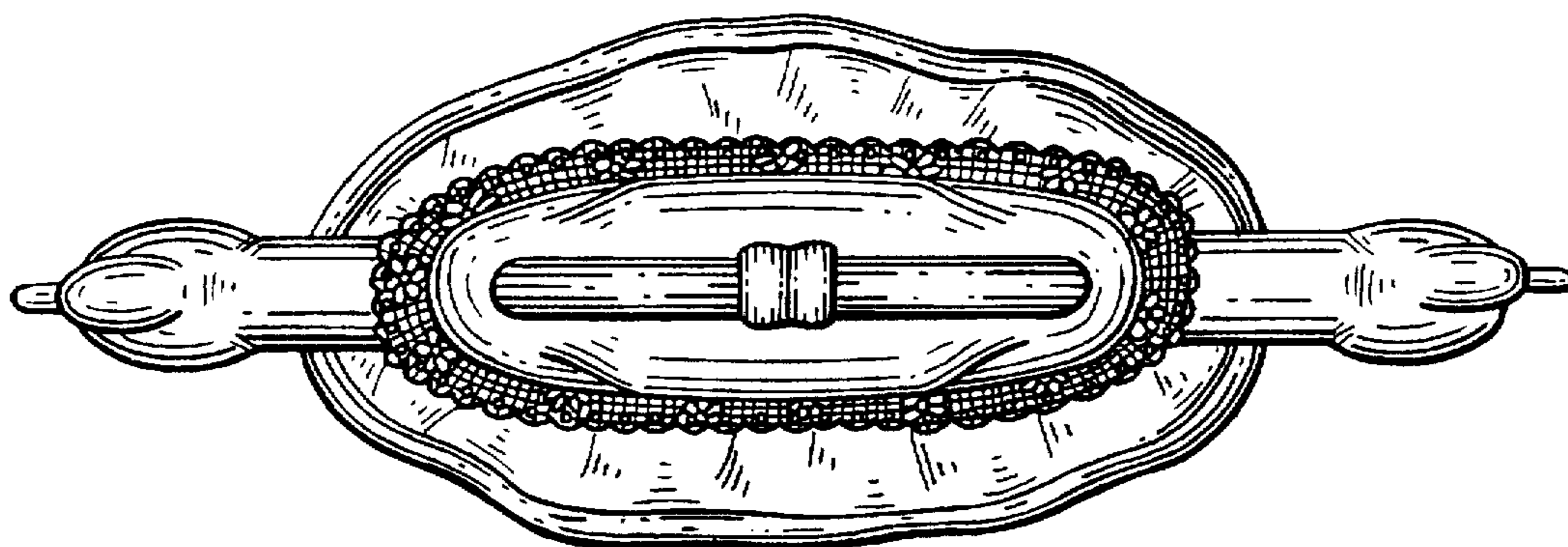

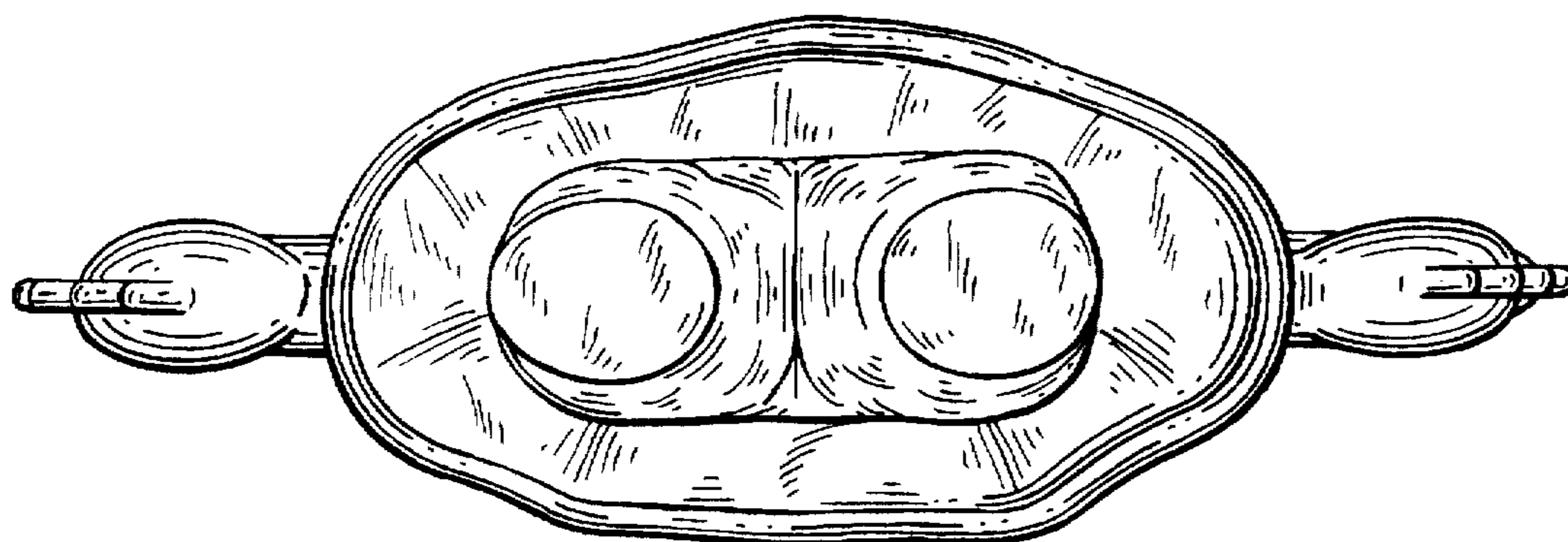
