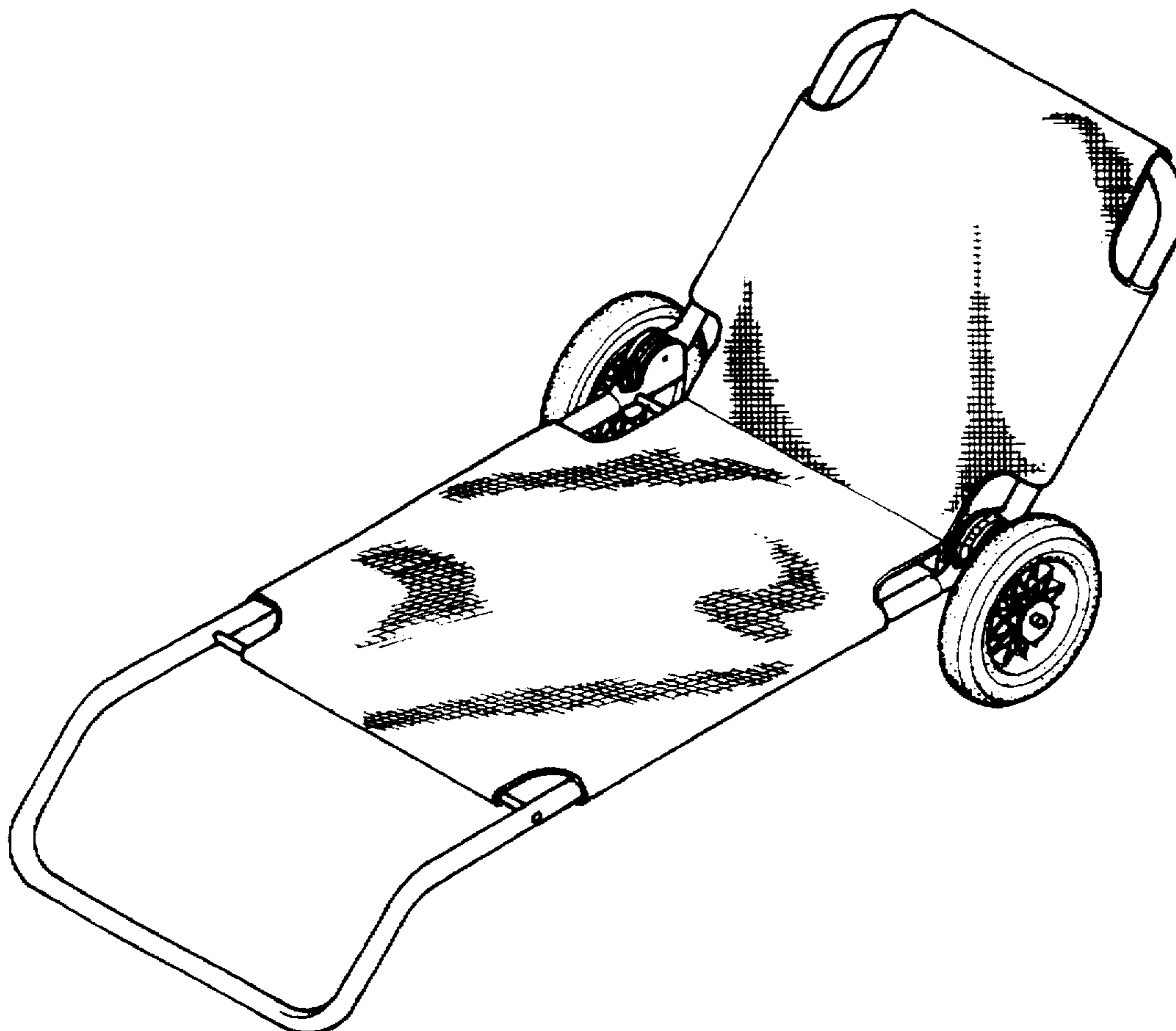

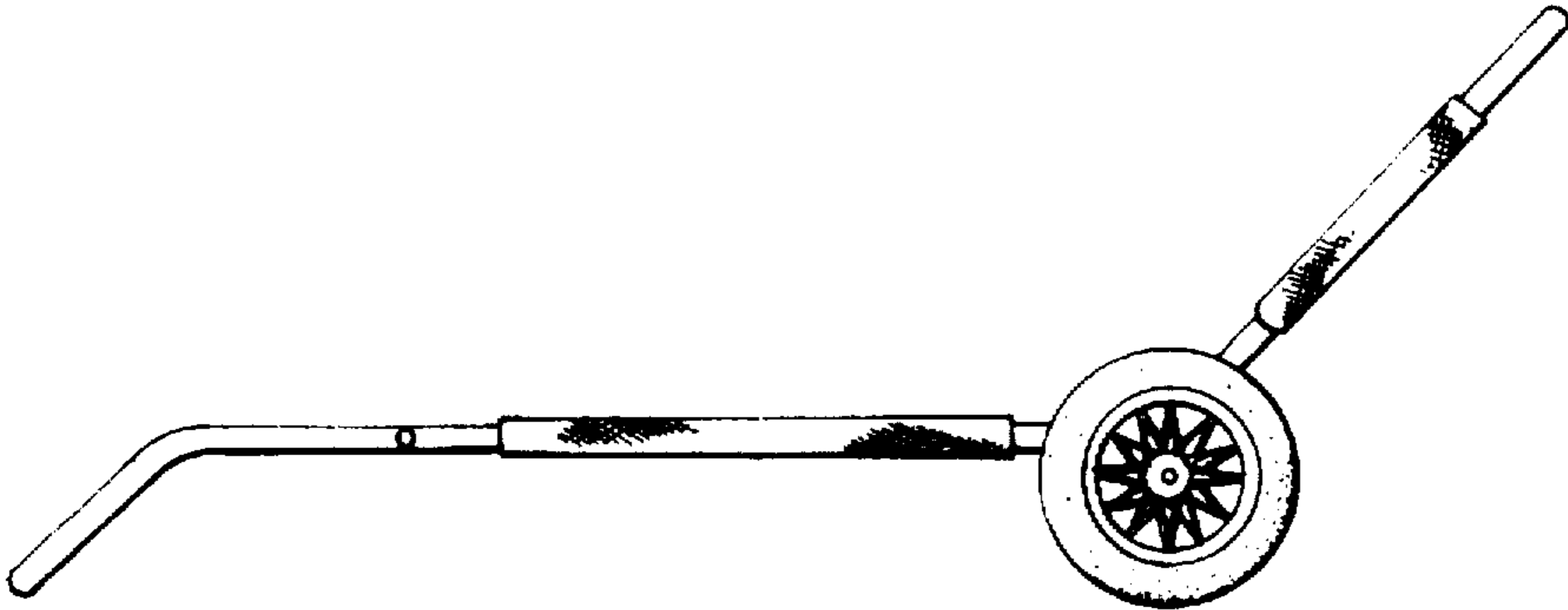
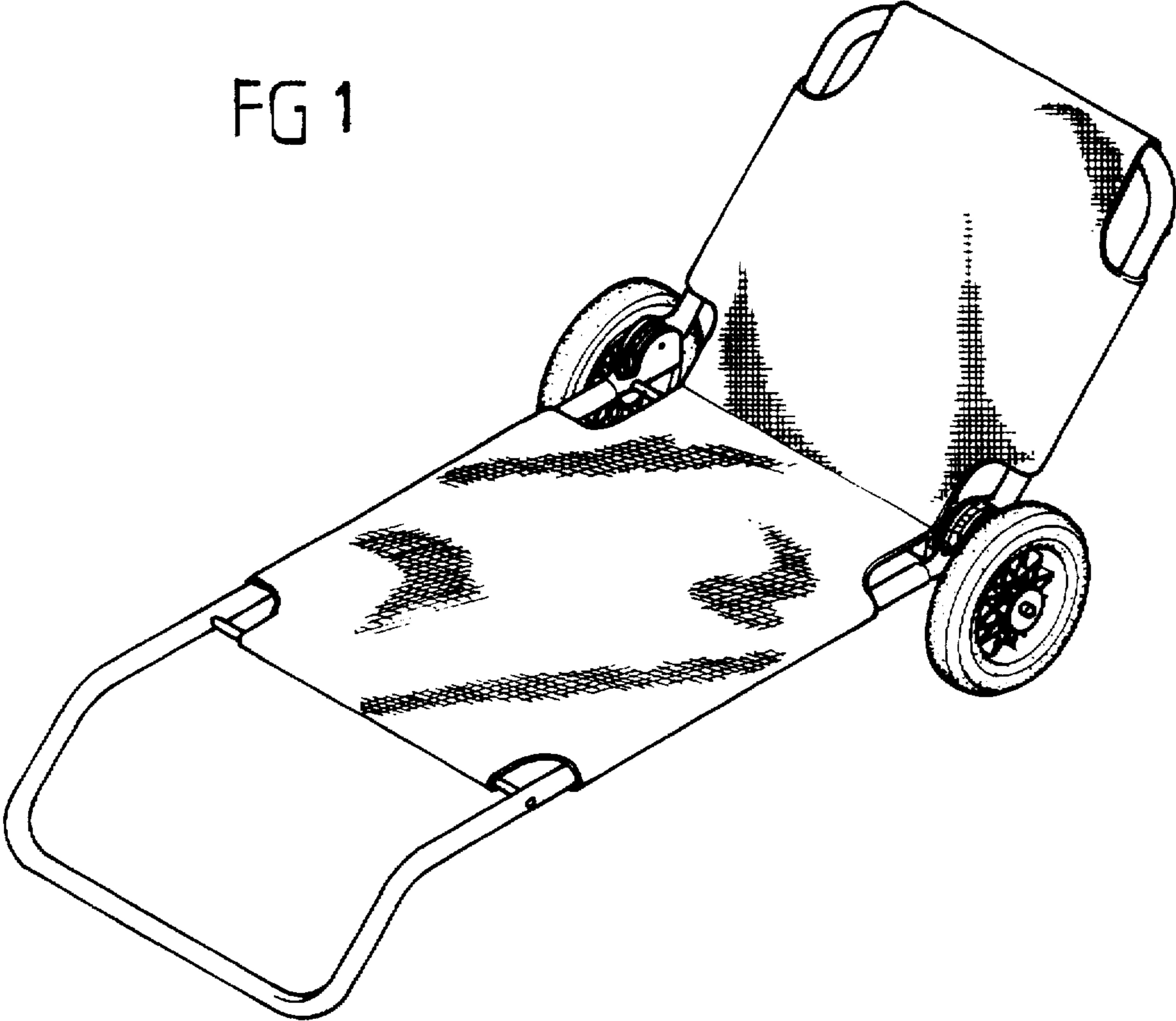
The fragmented cross-hatching shown on the seat and backrest is understood to represent fabric which would be continuous throughout the implied areas.

FIGS. 2 through 6 have been shown on a reduced scale with respect to FIG. 1.

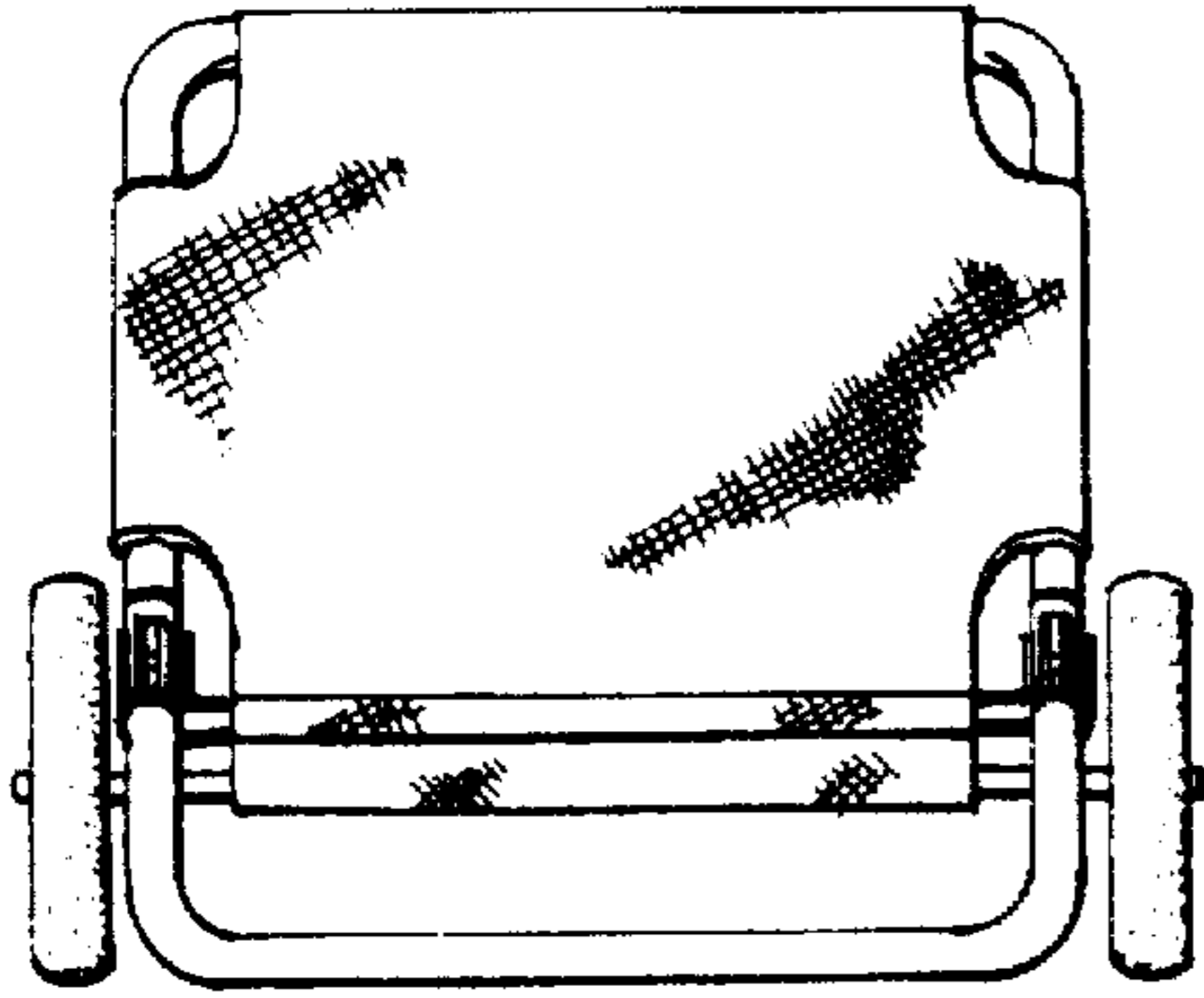

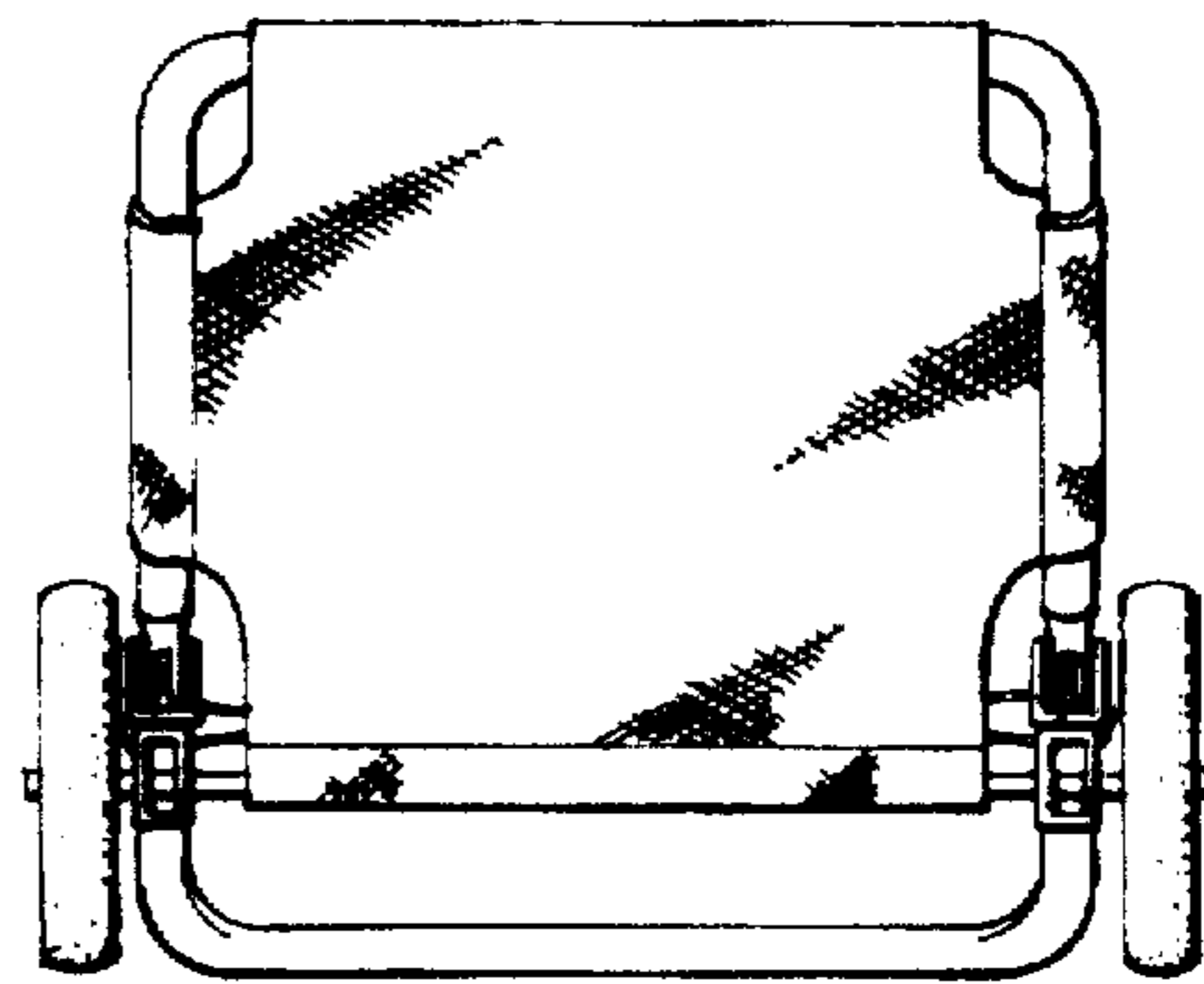

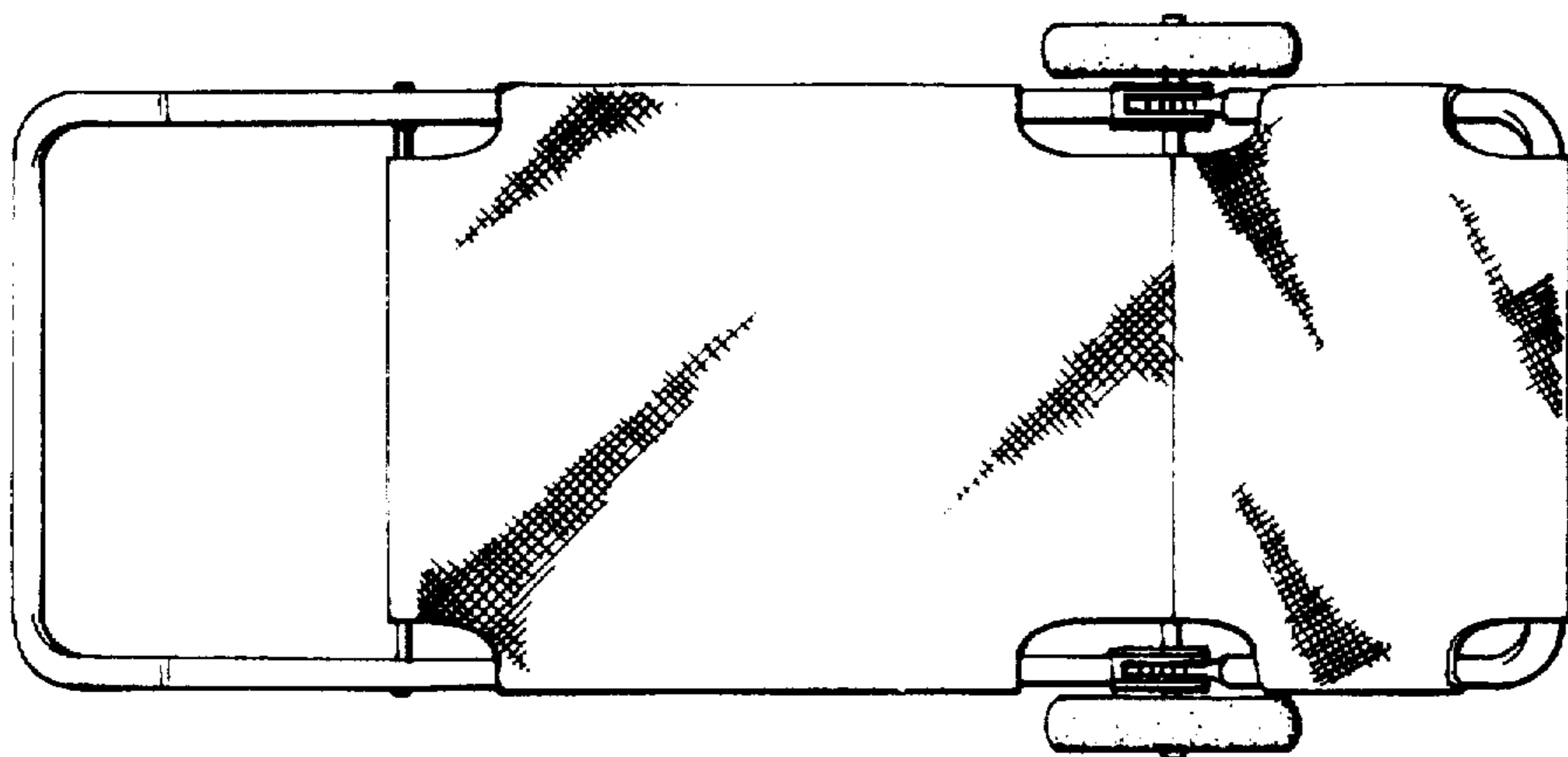

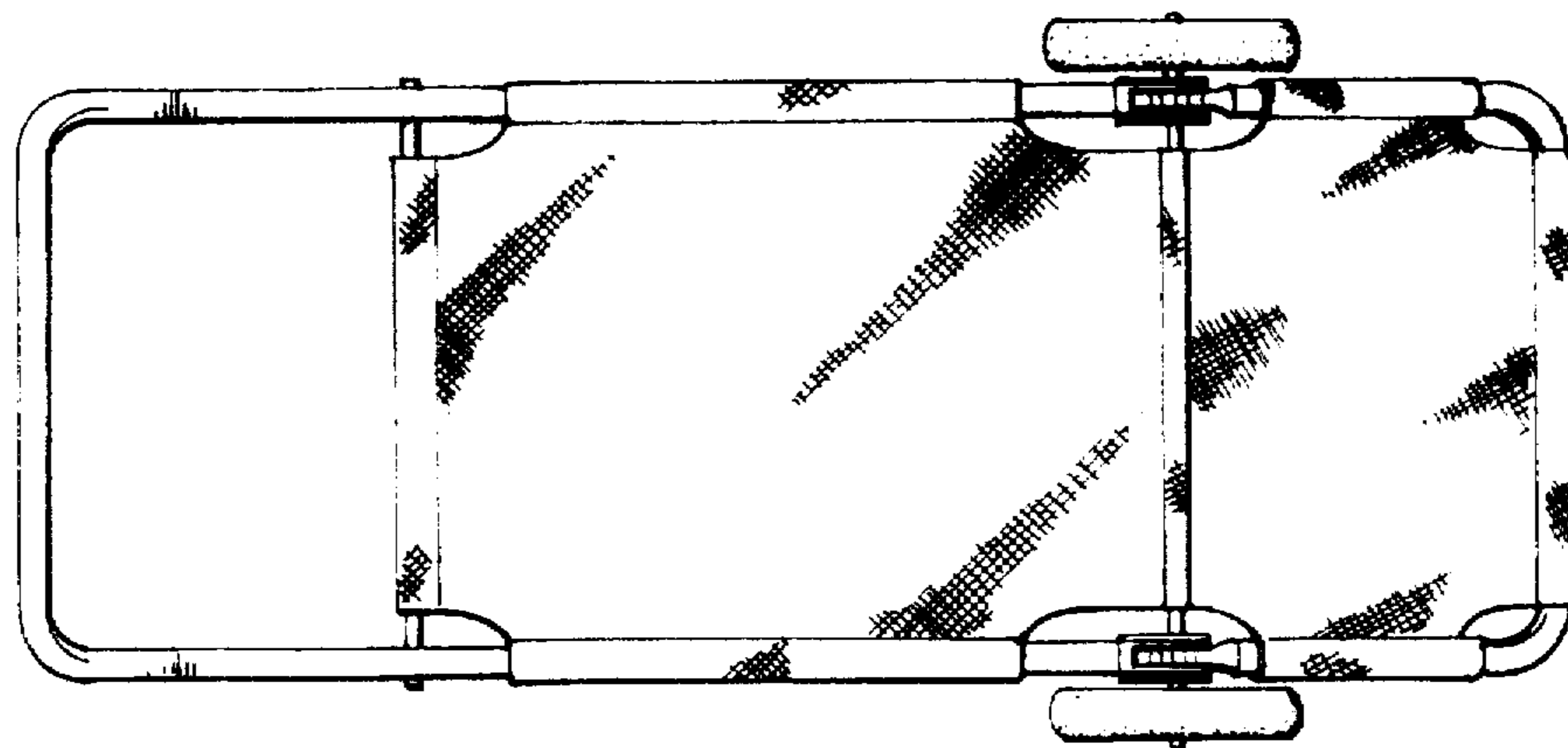
