DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an object recognition board game, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

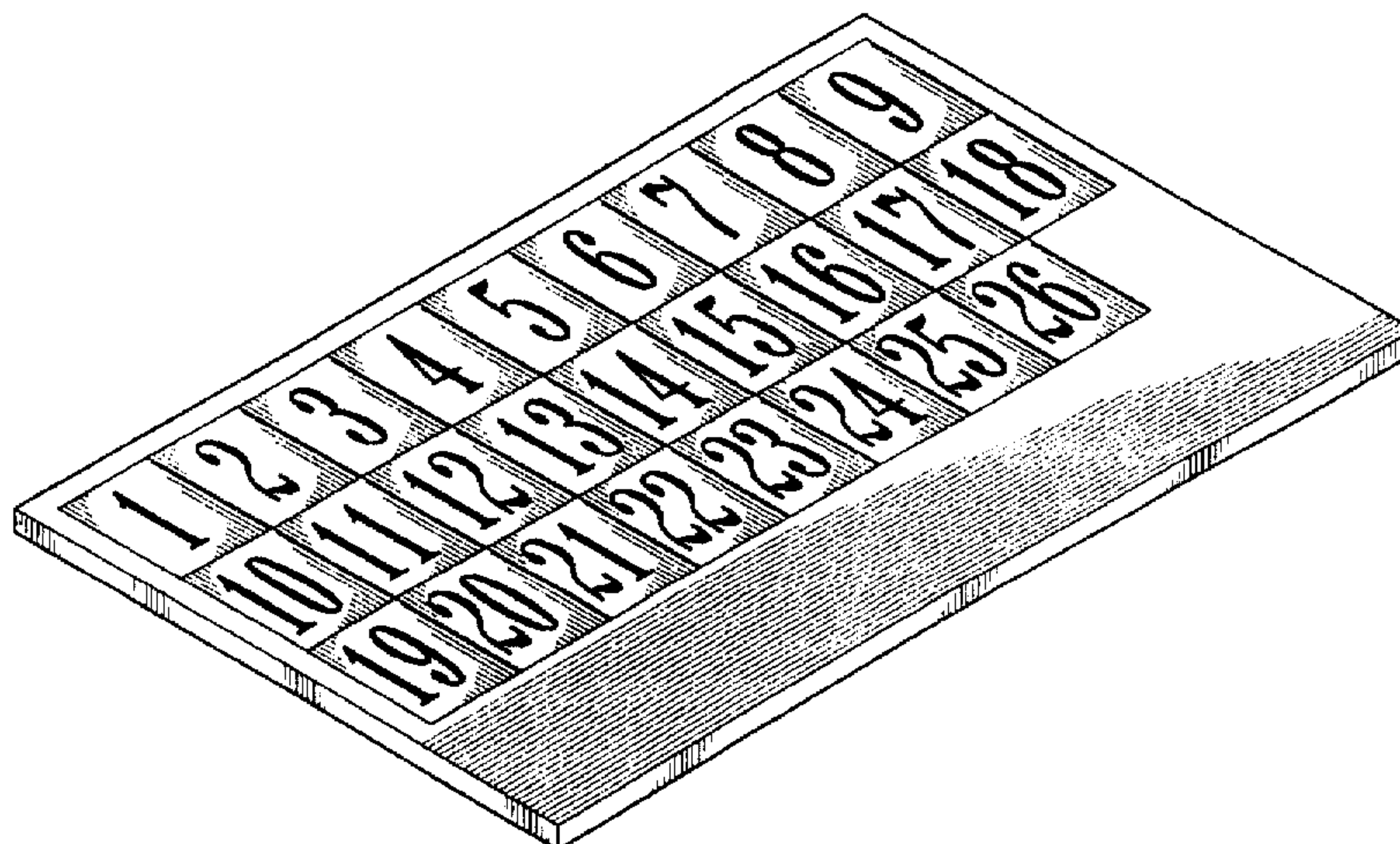
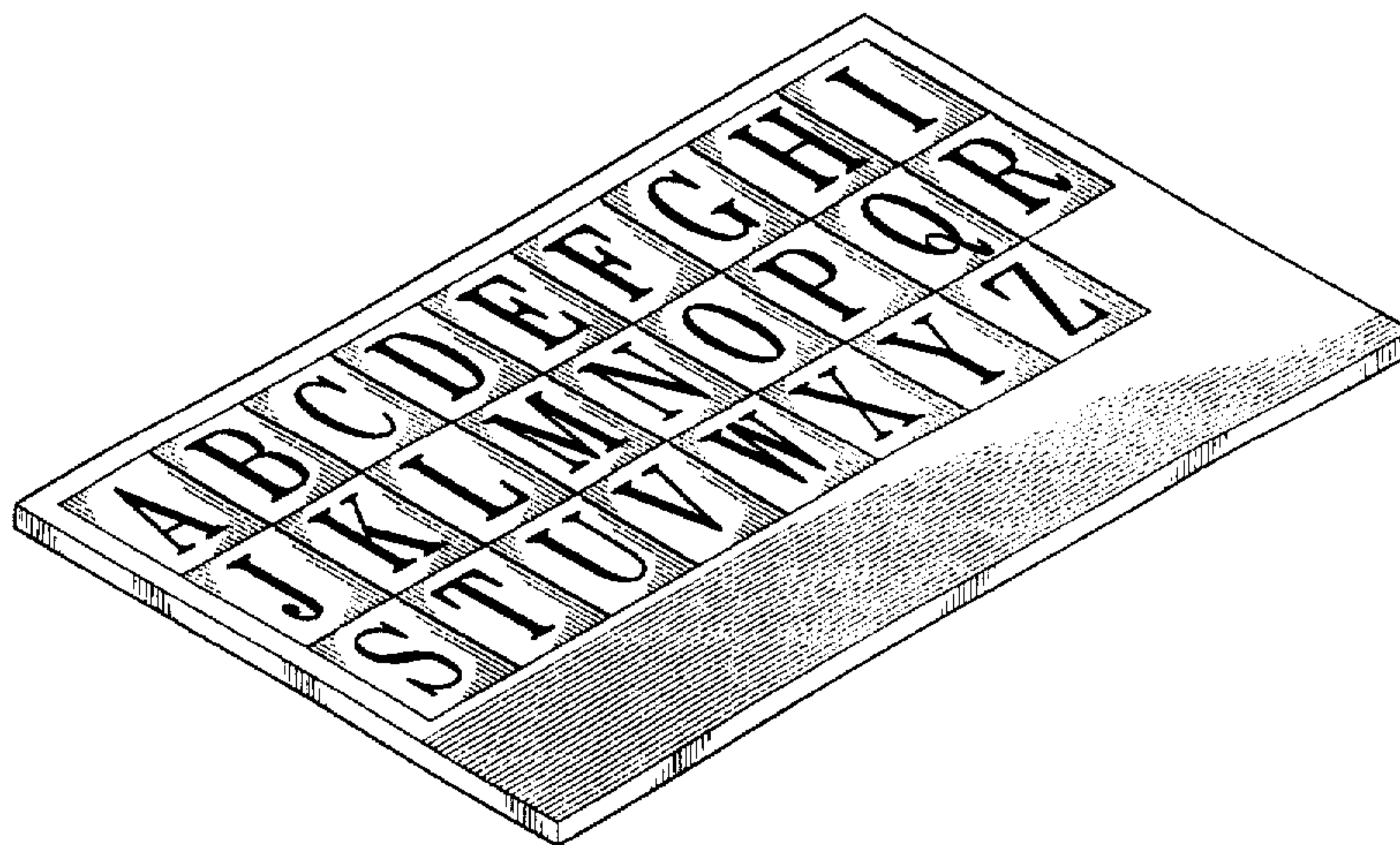
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being identical;

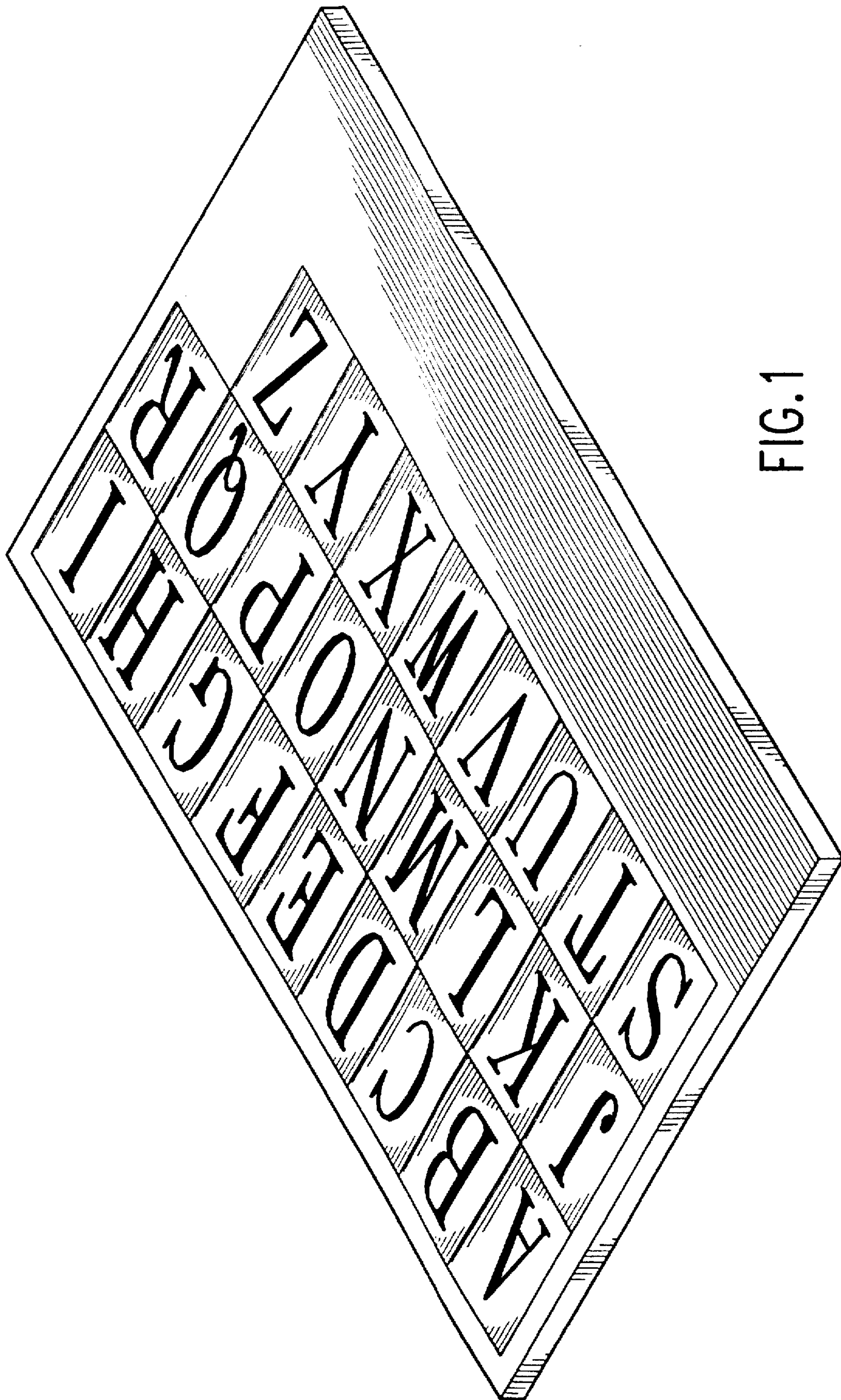

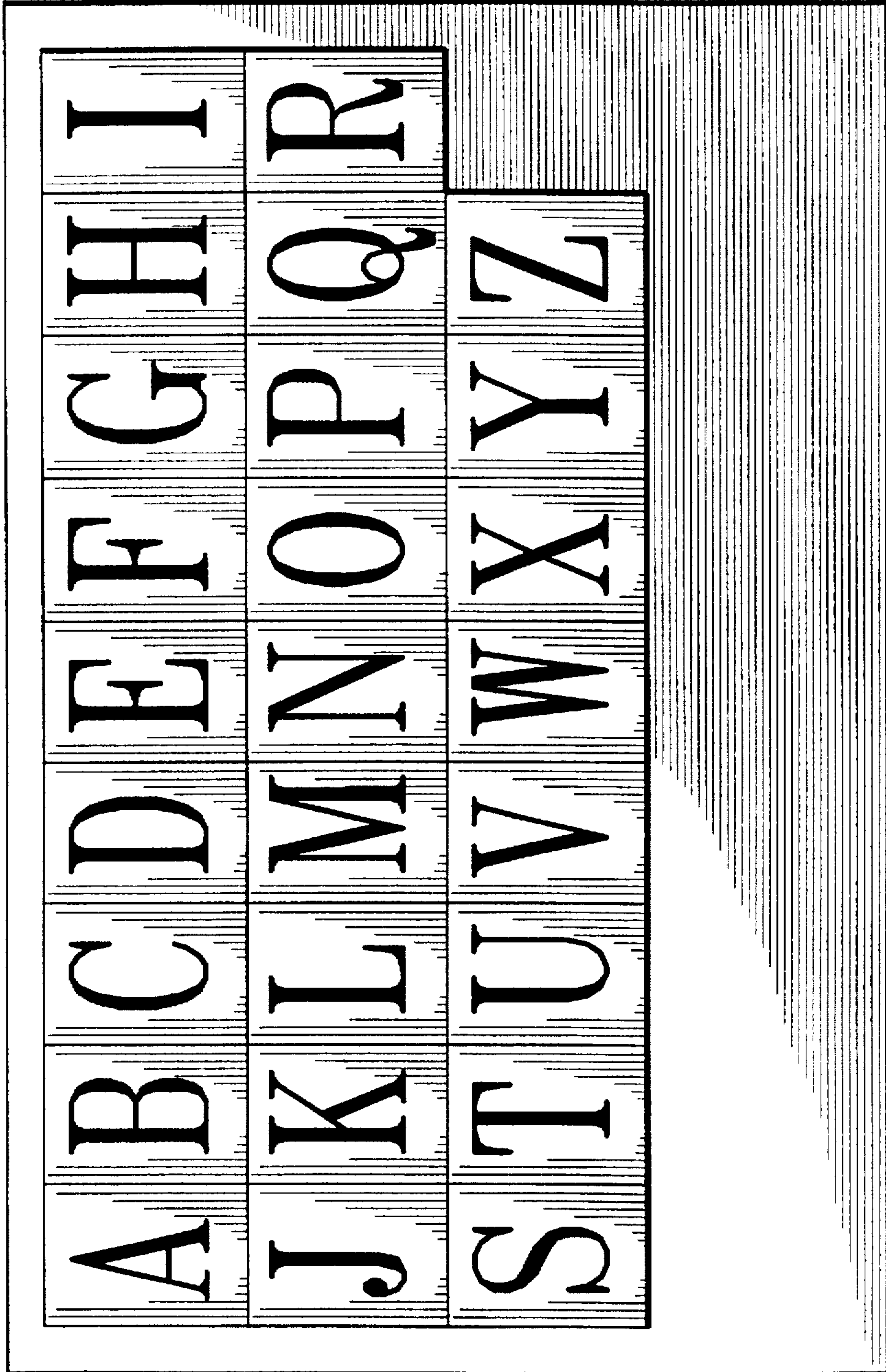

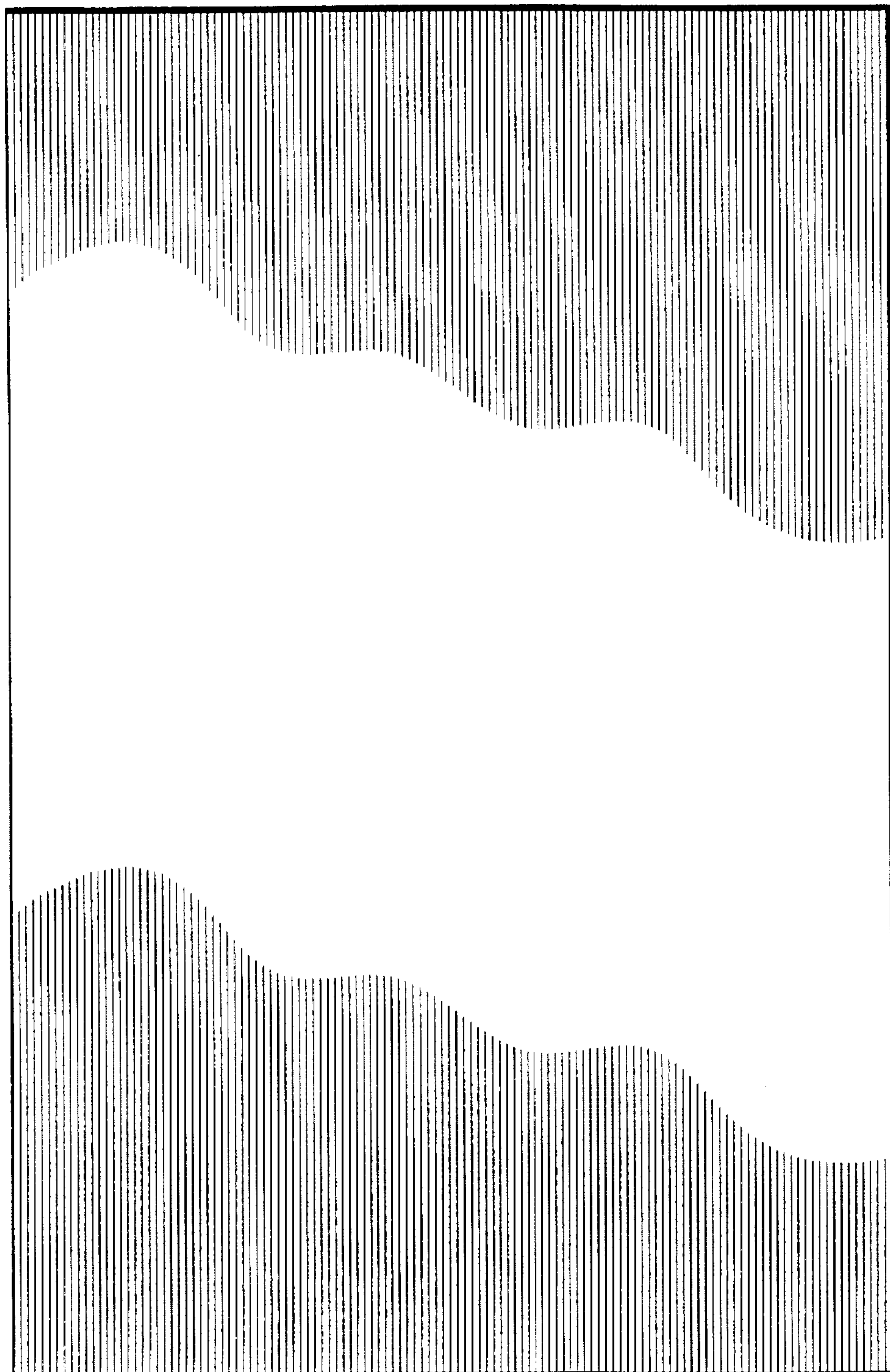

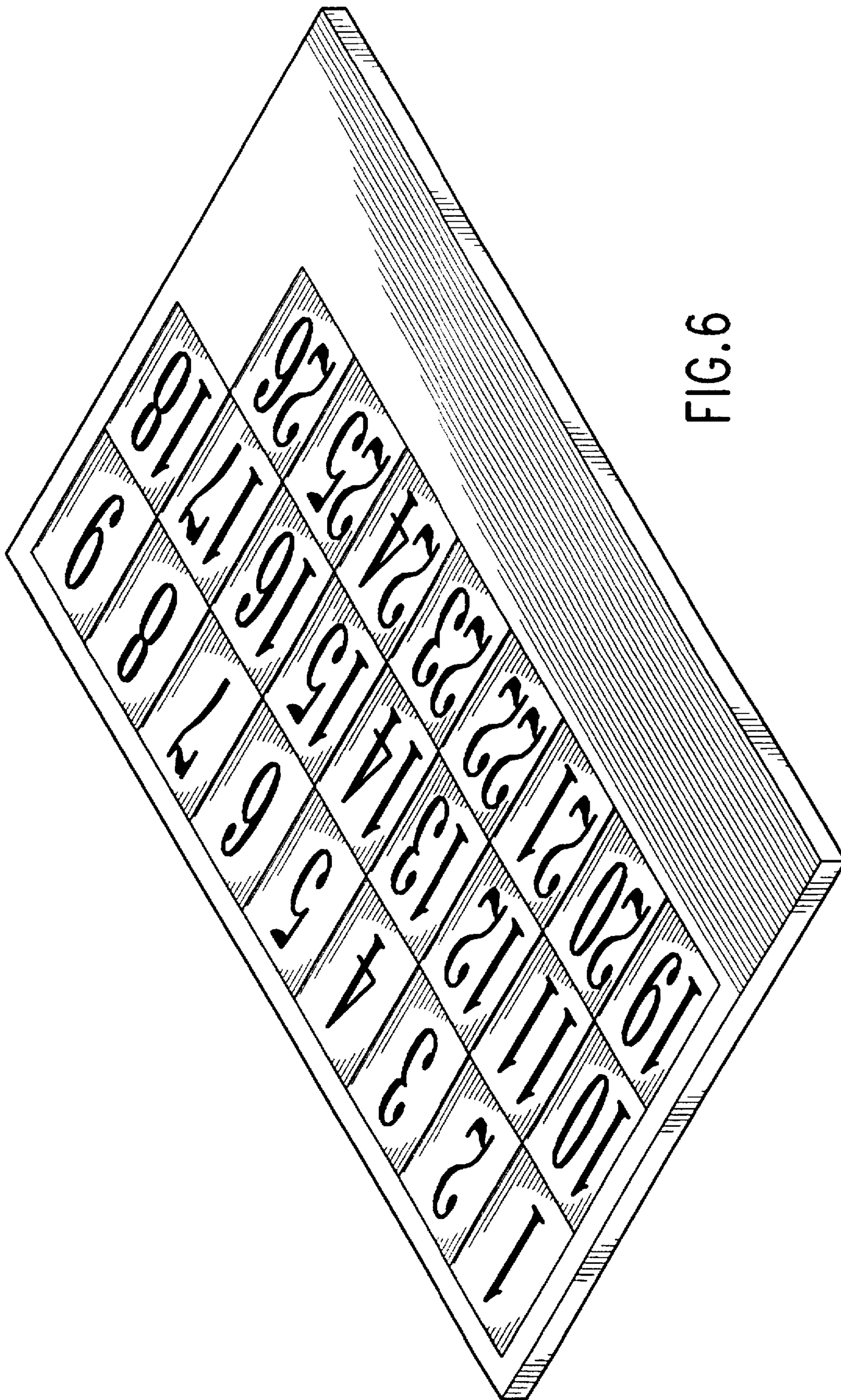

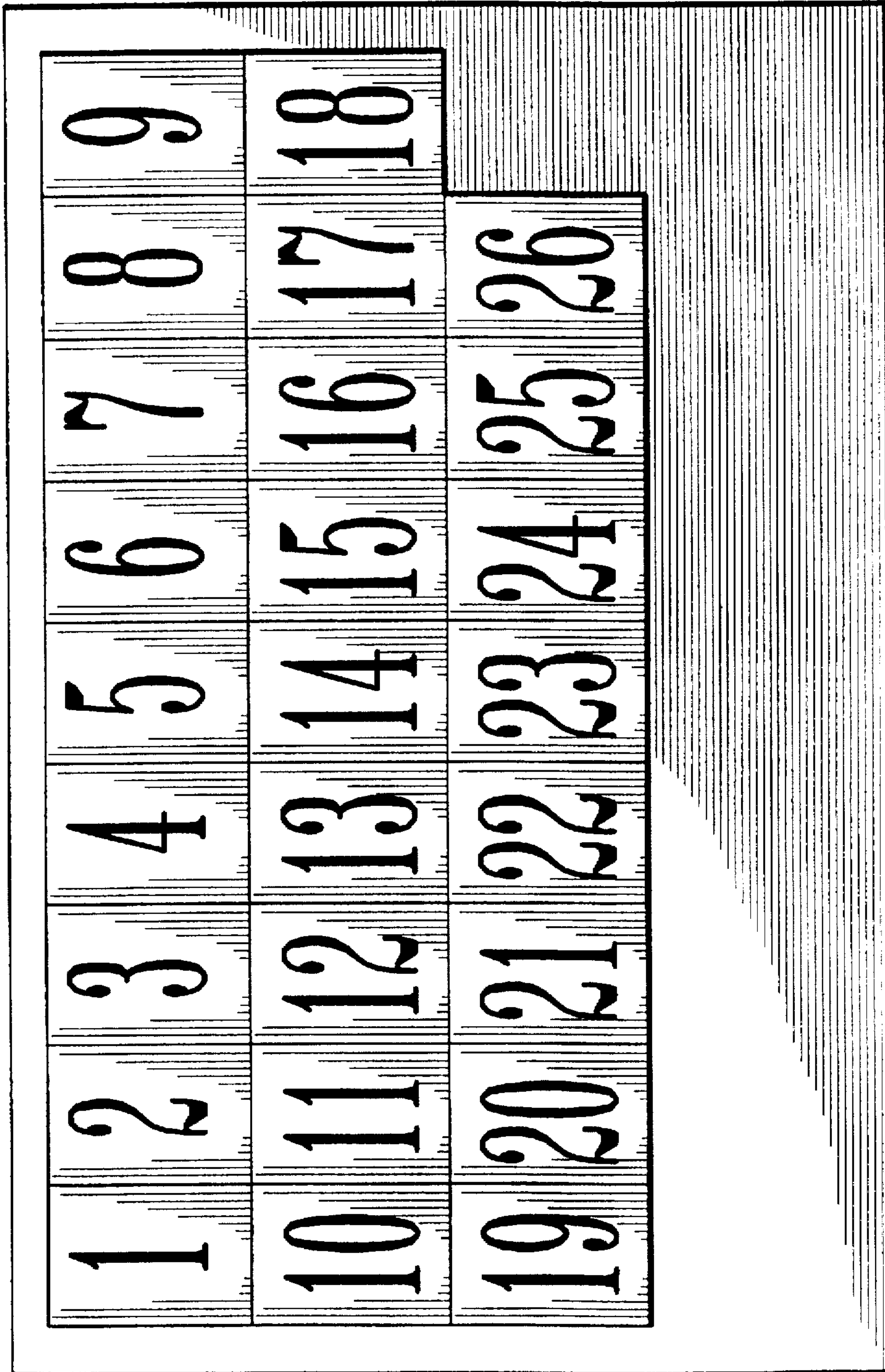
