The ornamental design for a portable compact disc holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a new, original, and ornamental design of a preferred embodiment of the present invention in its closed position;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof in an open position;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a back elevational view thereof.
The broken lines shown throughout the views are understood to represent conventional stitching.

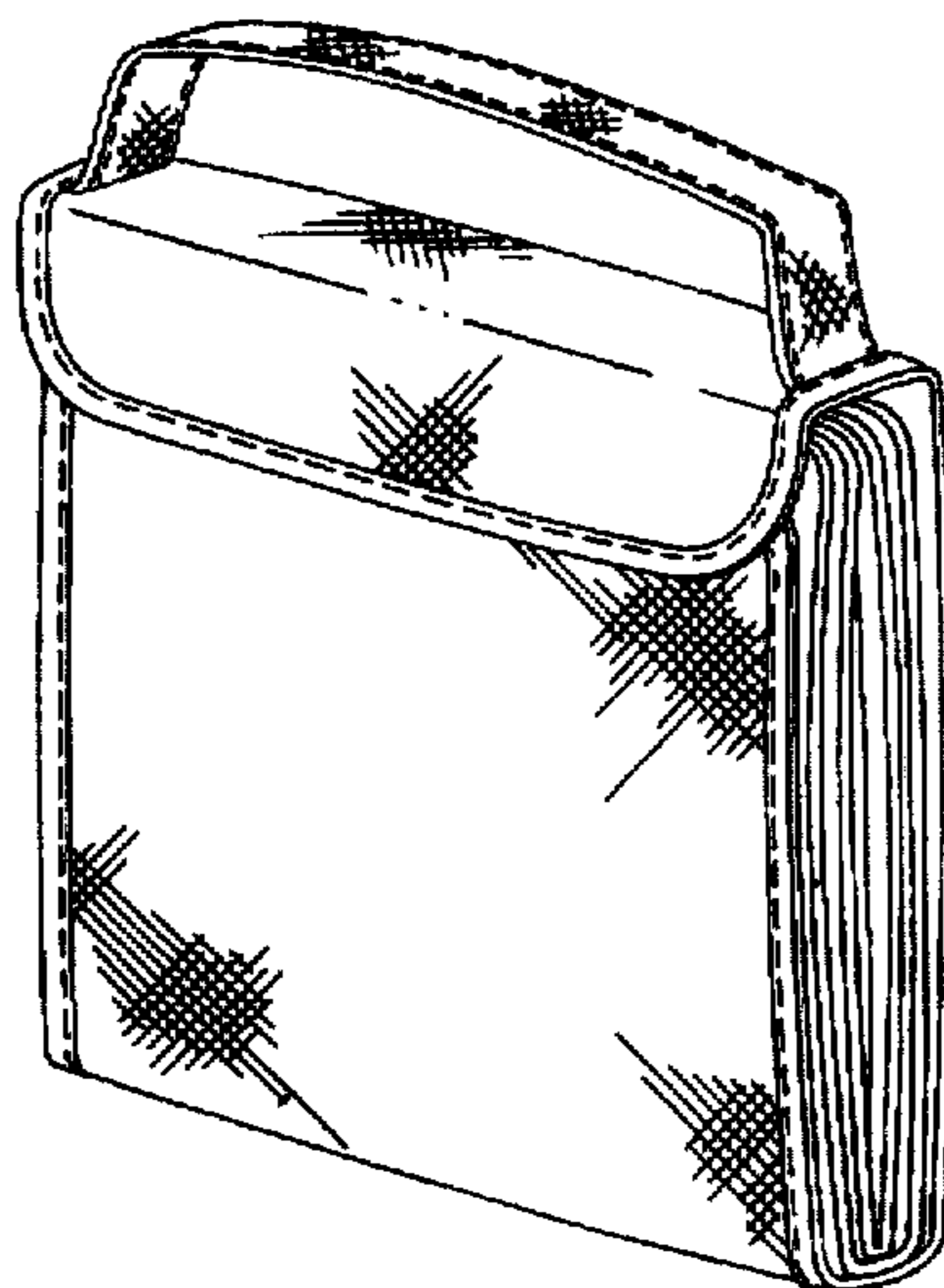

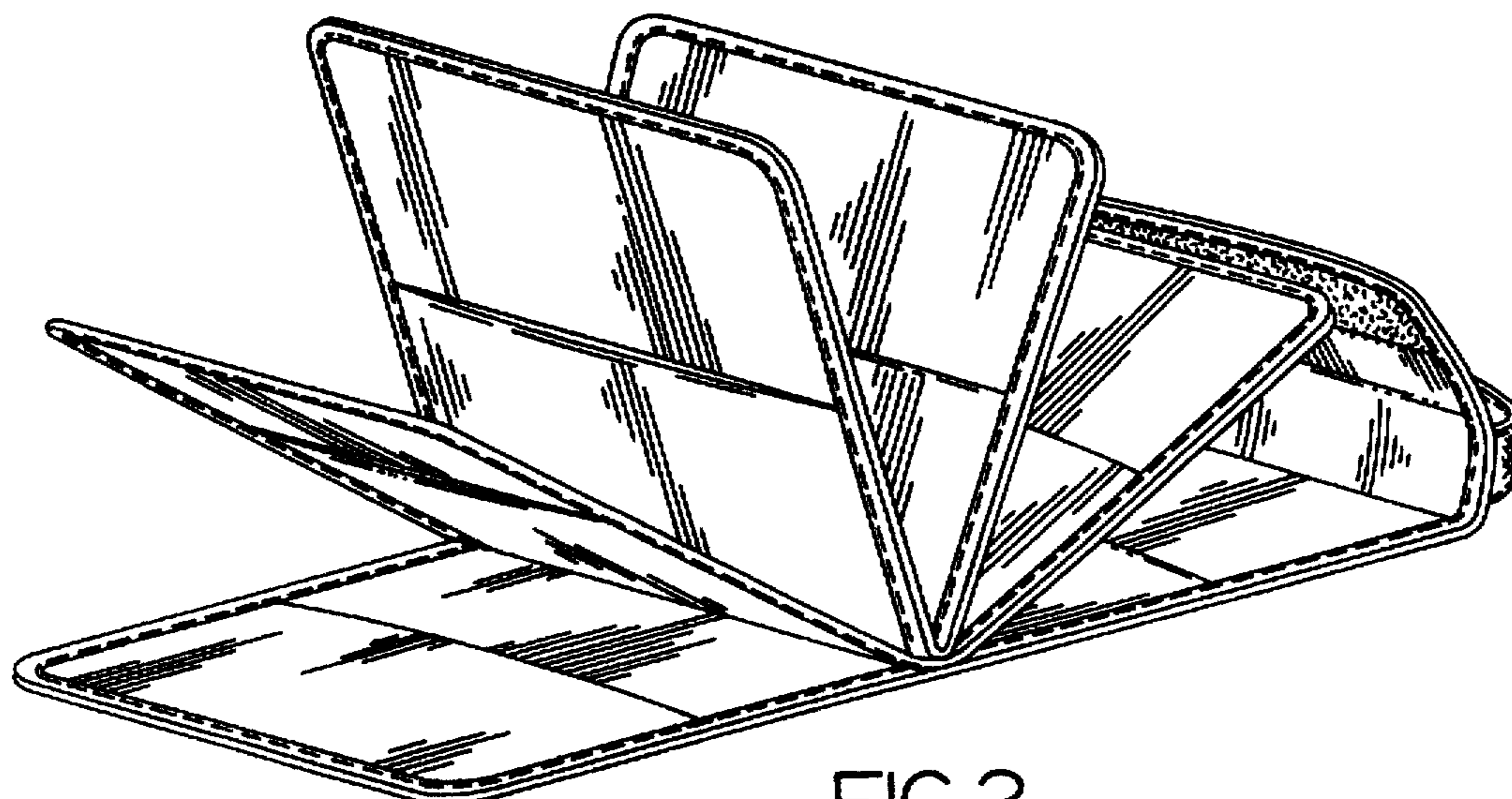
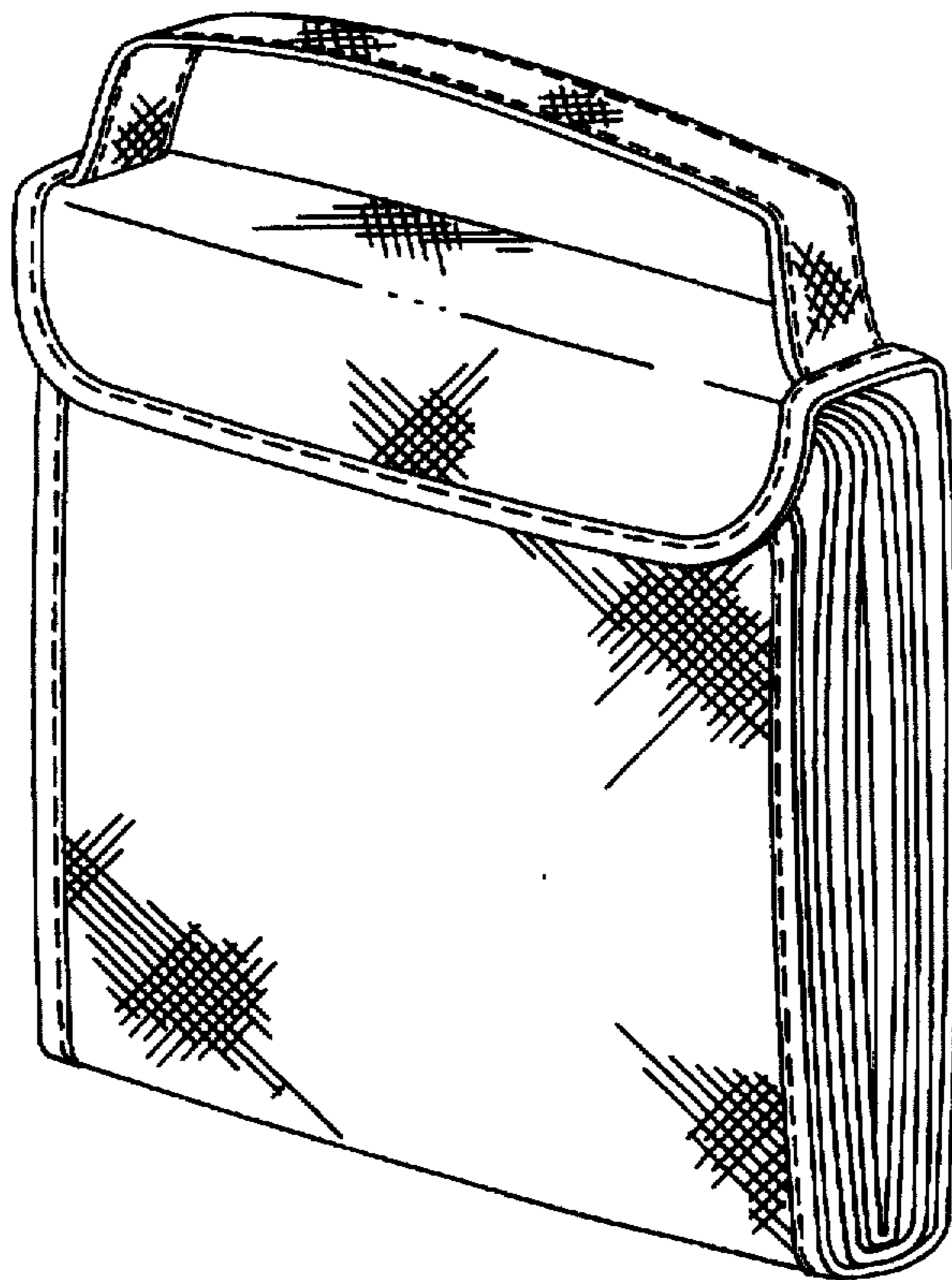

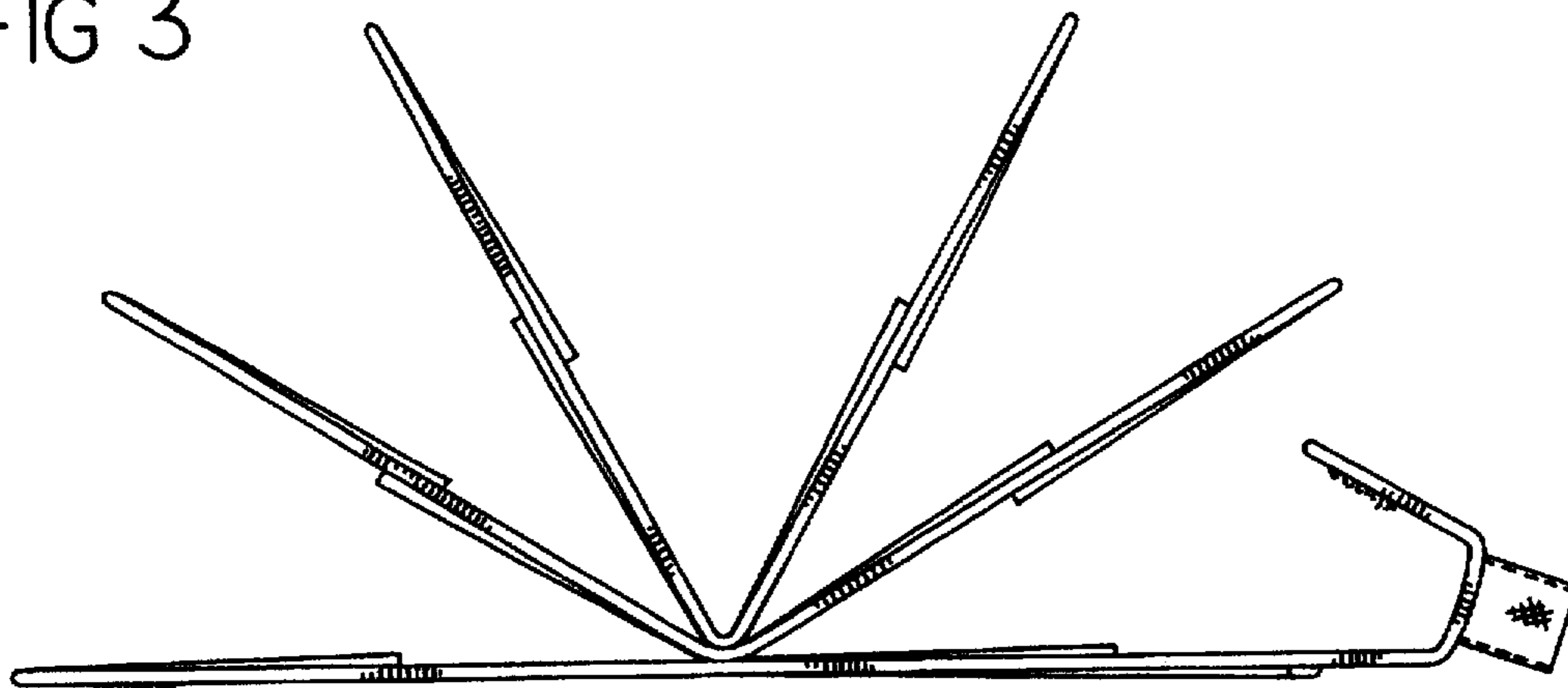

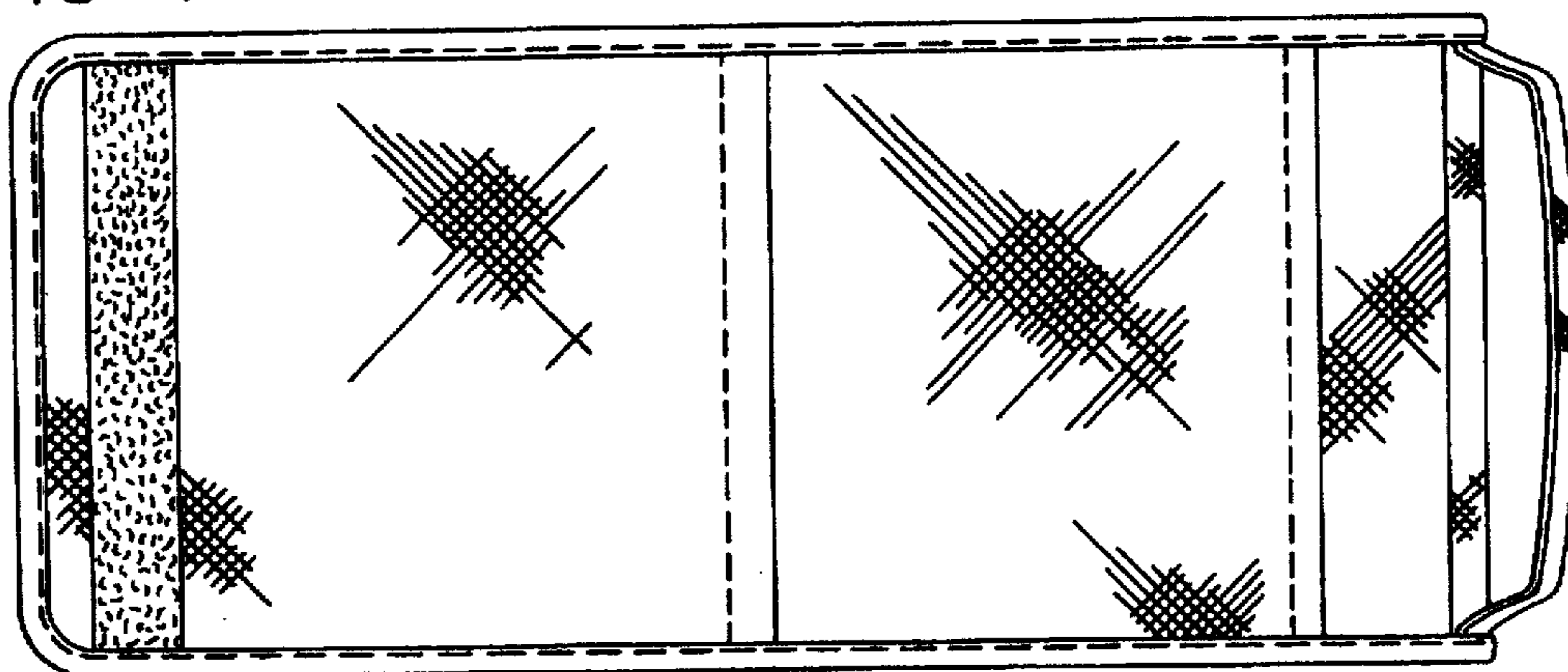

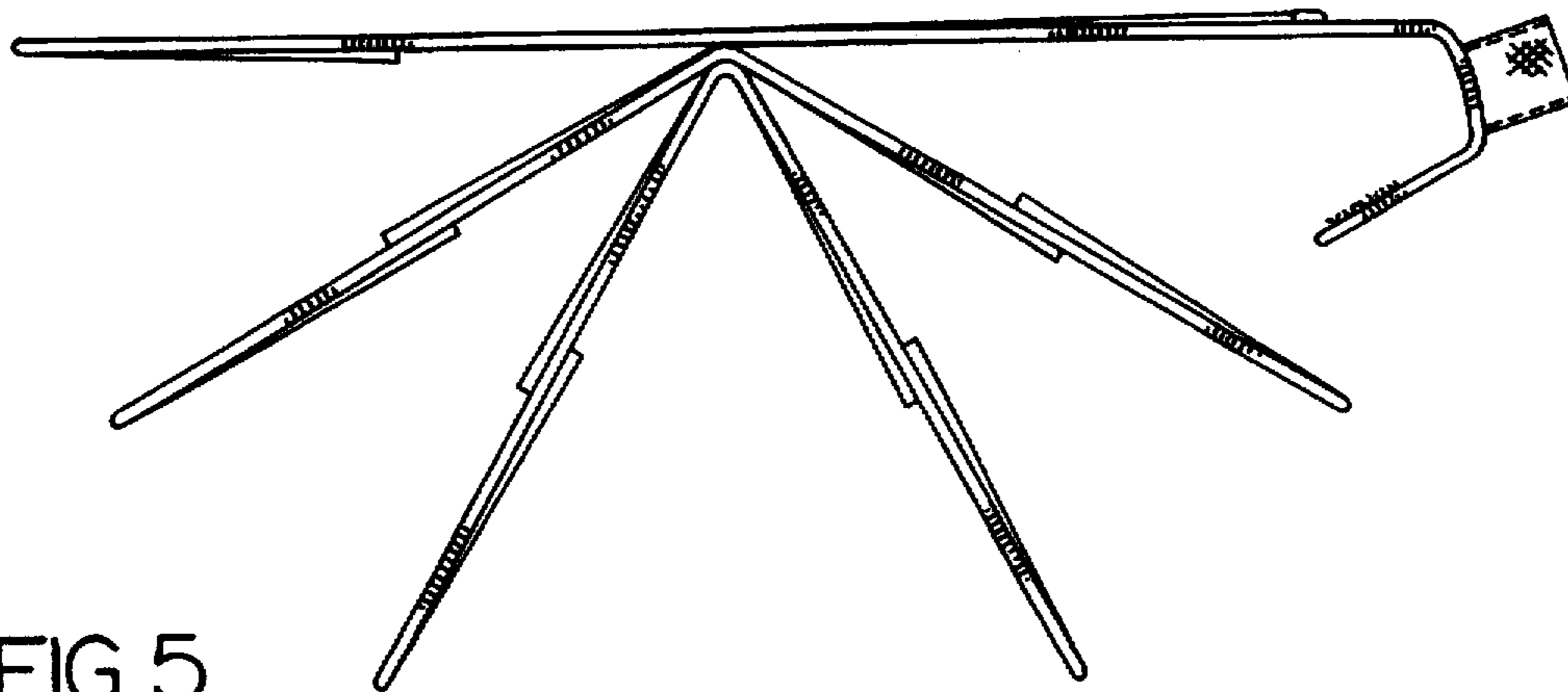

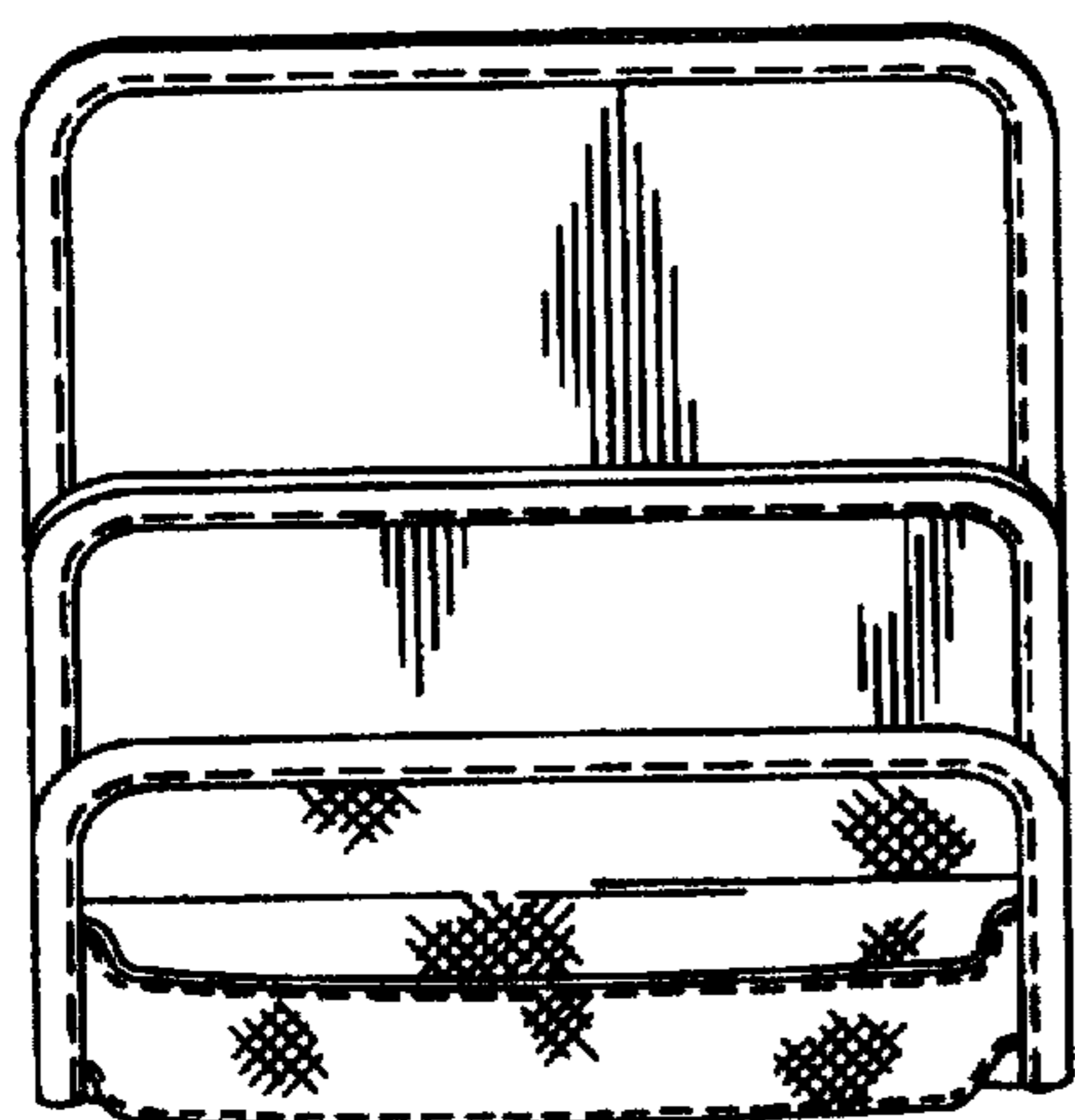
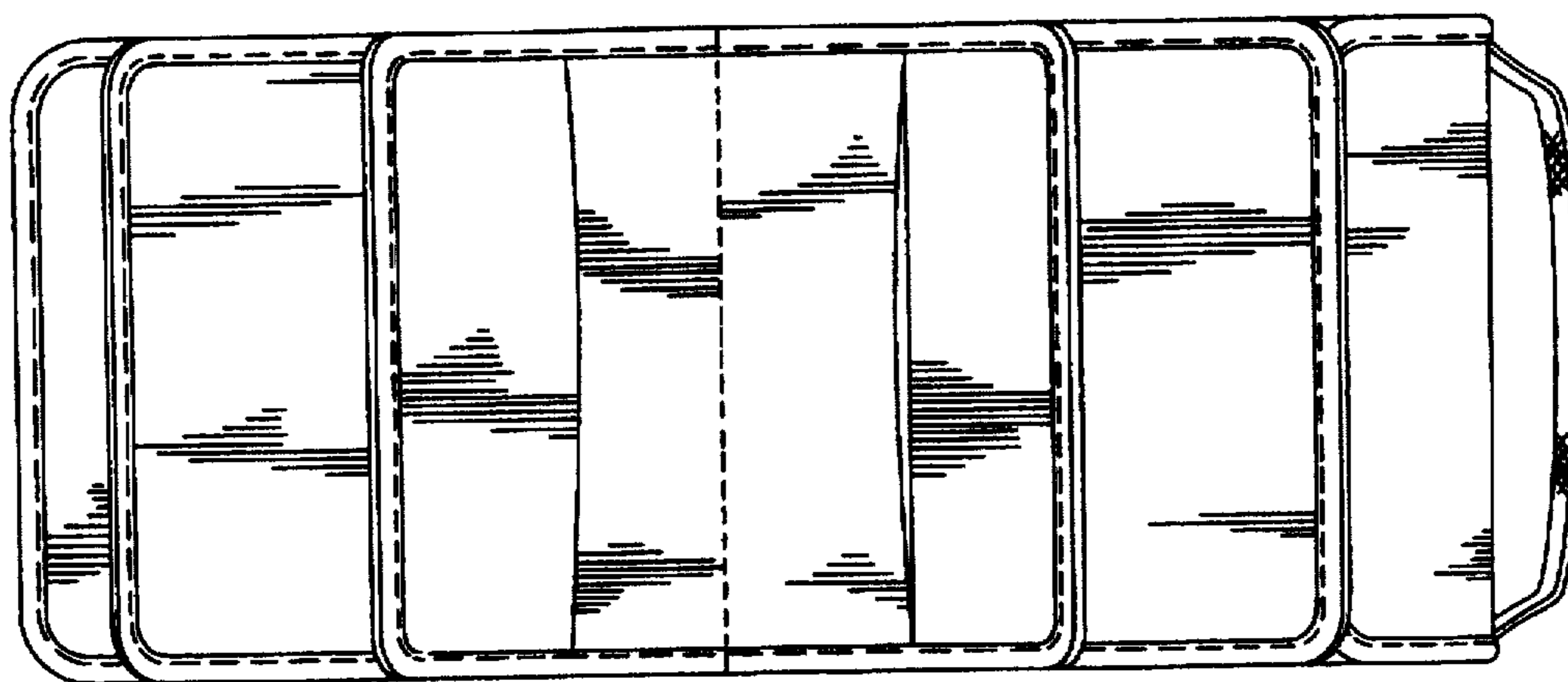

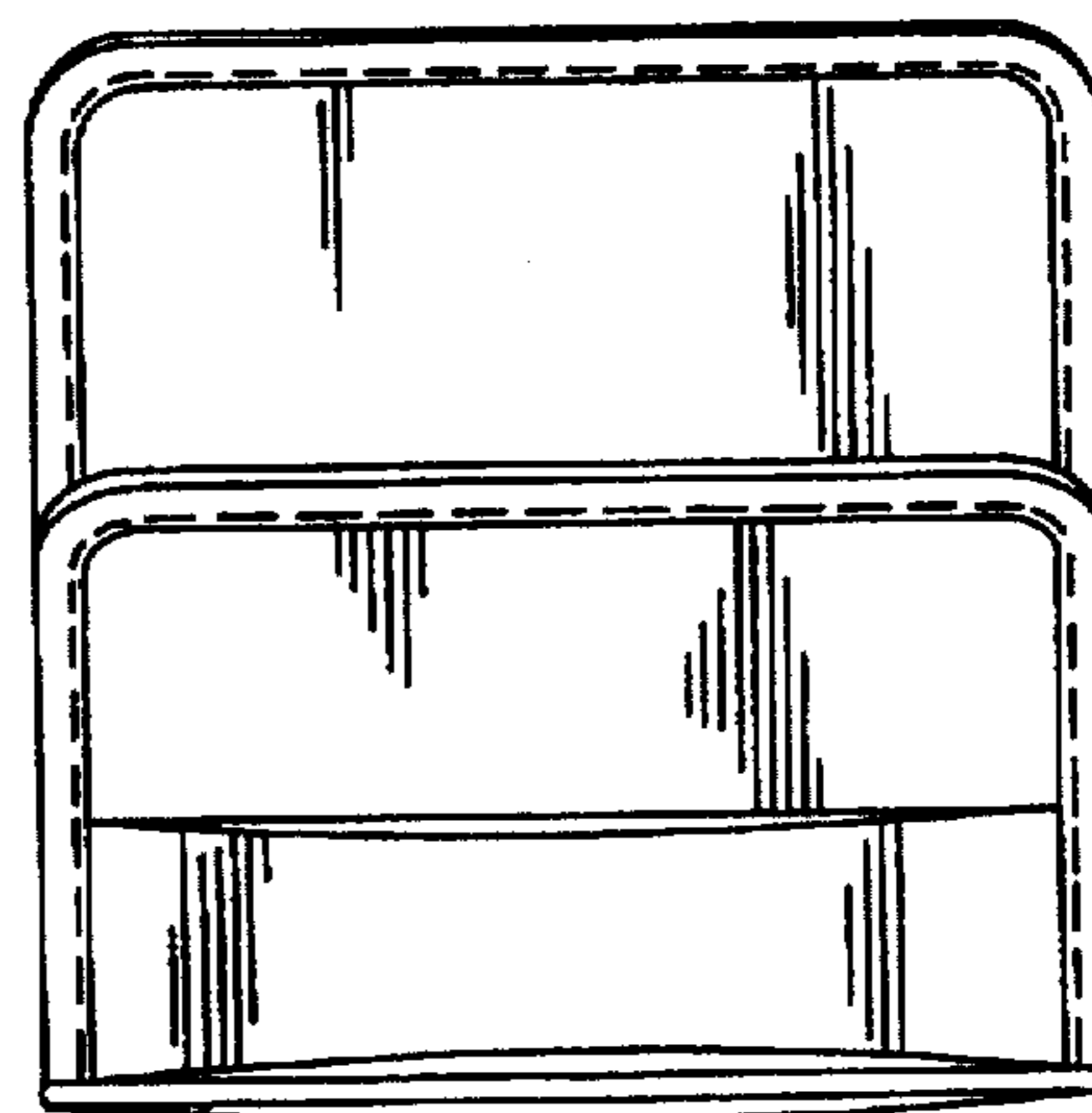
