DESCRIPTION

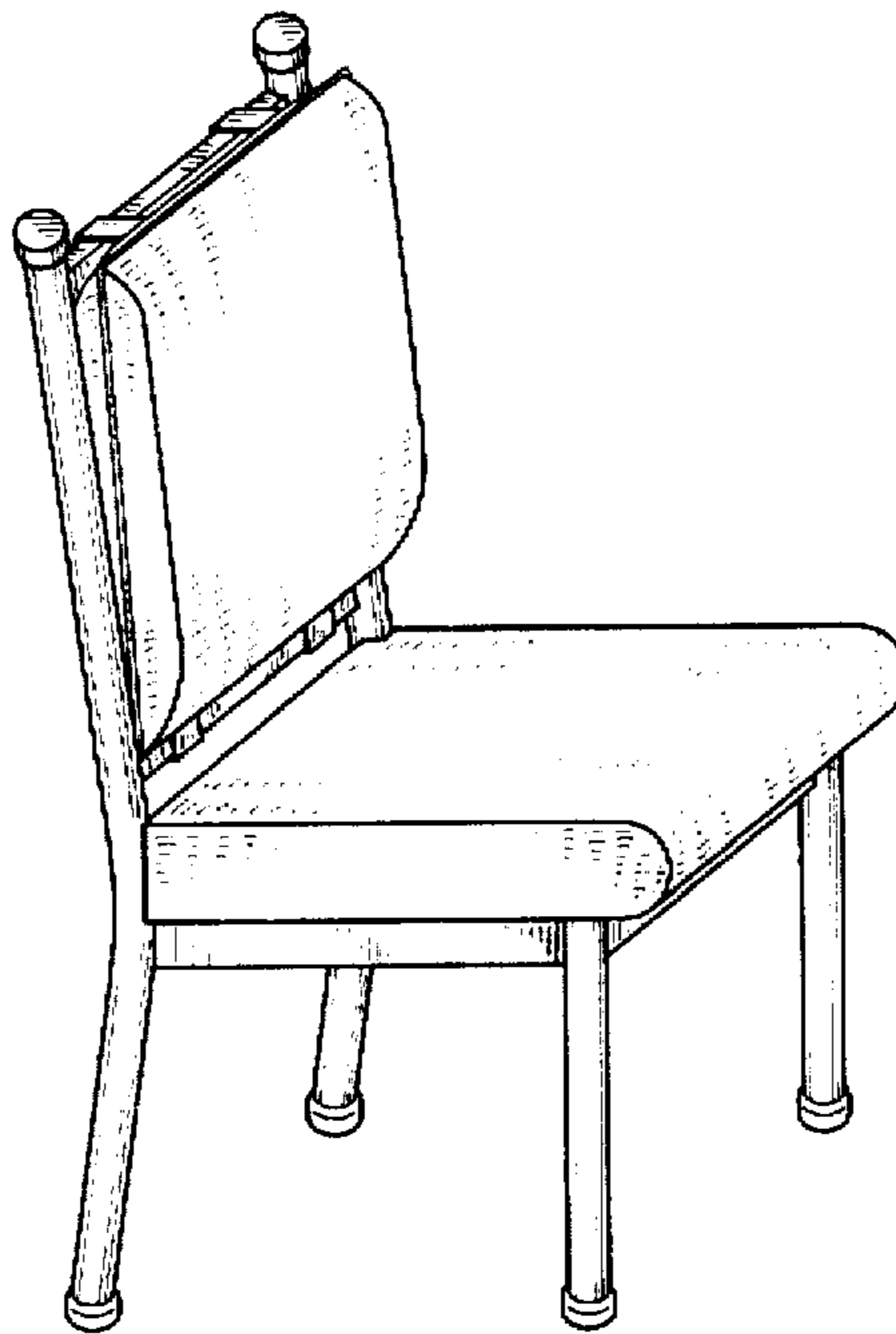
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chair, showing my new design;

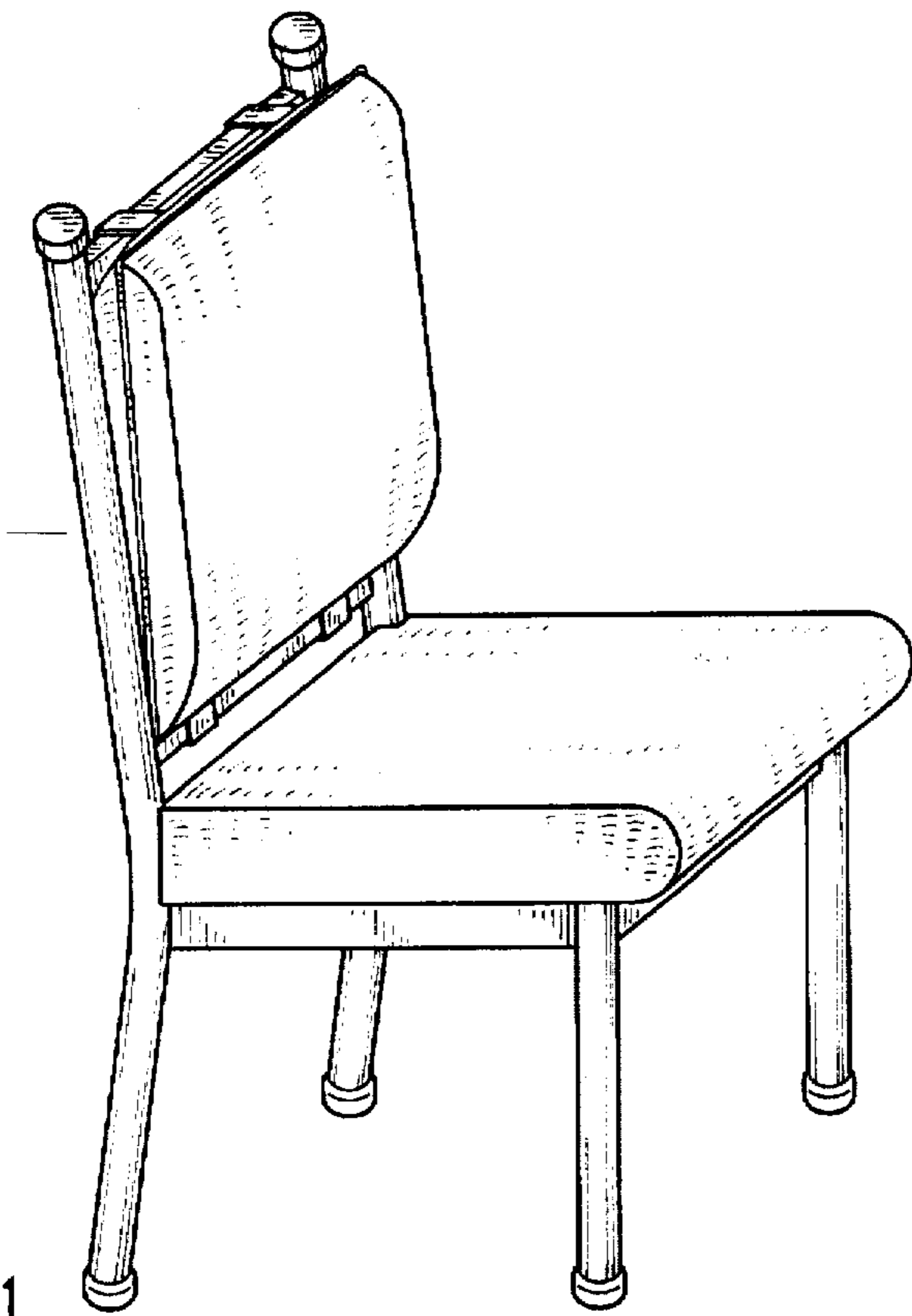

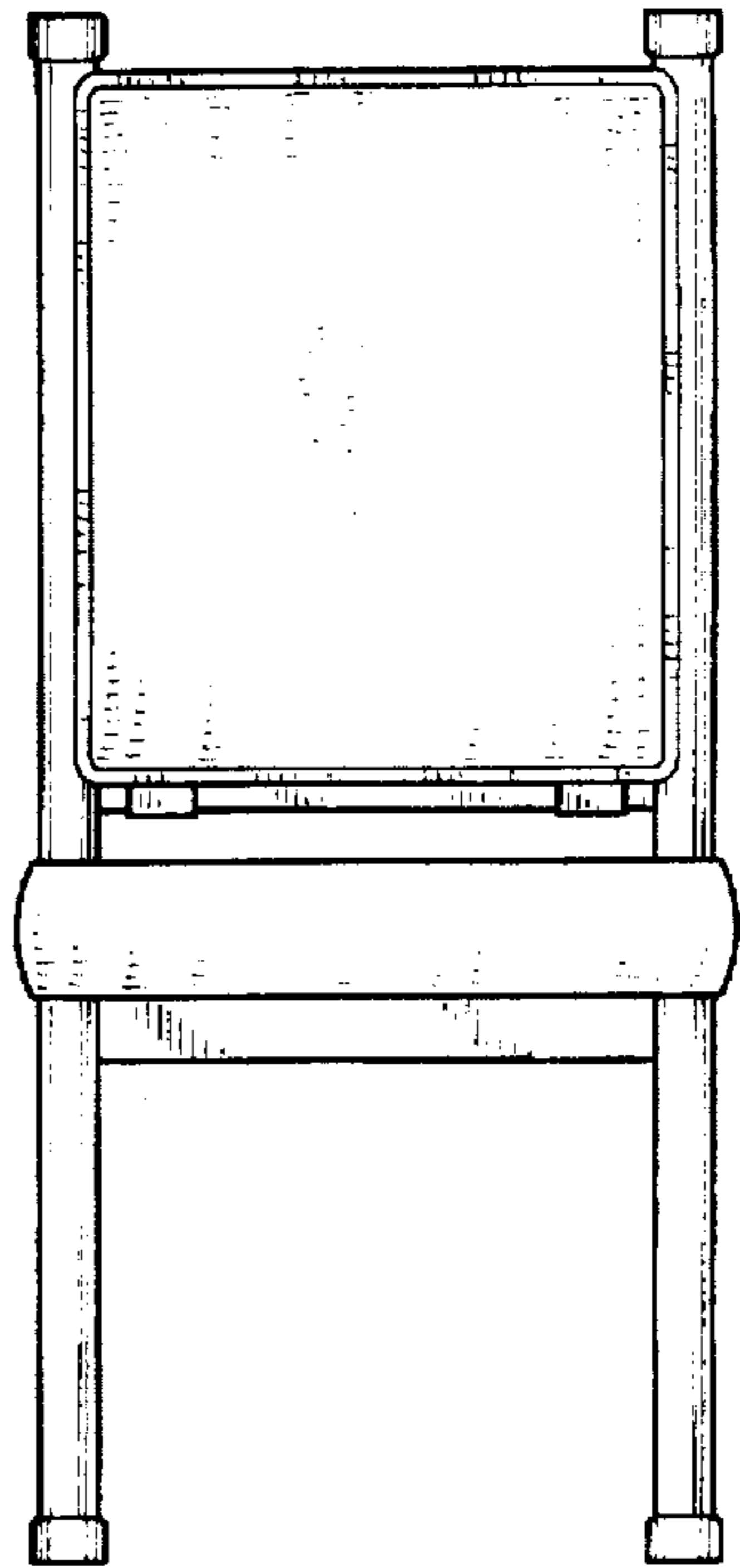

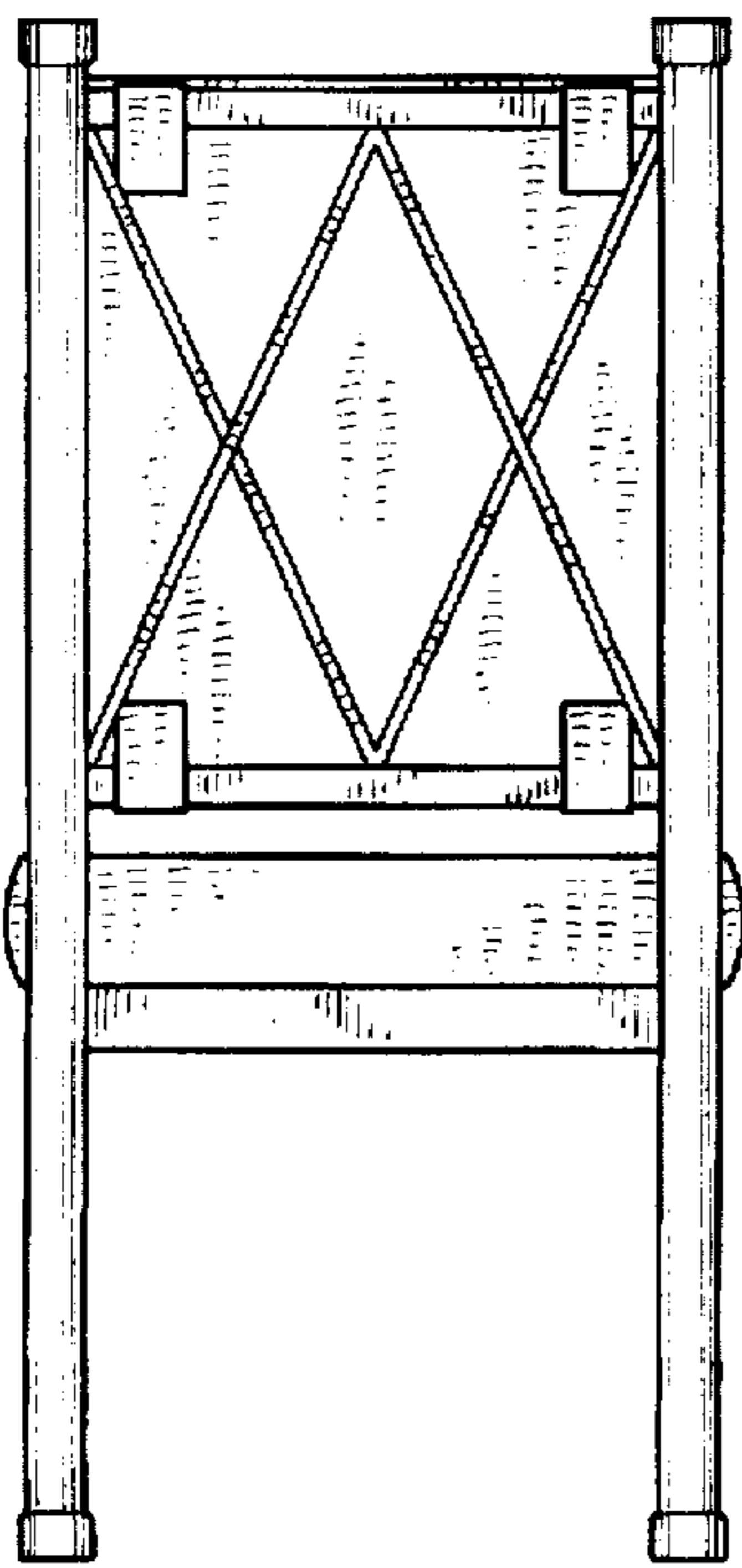

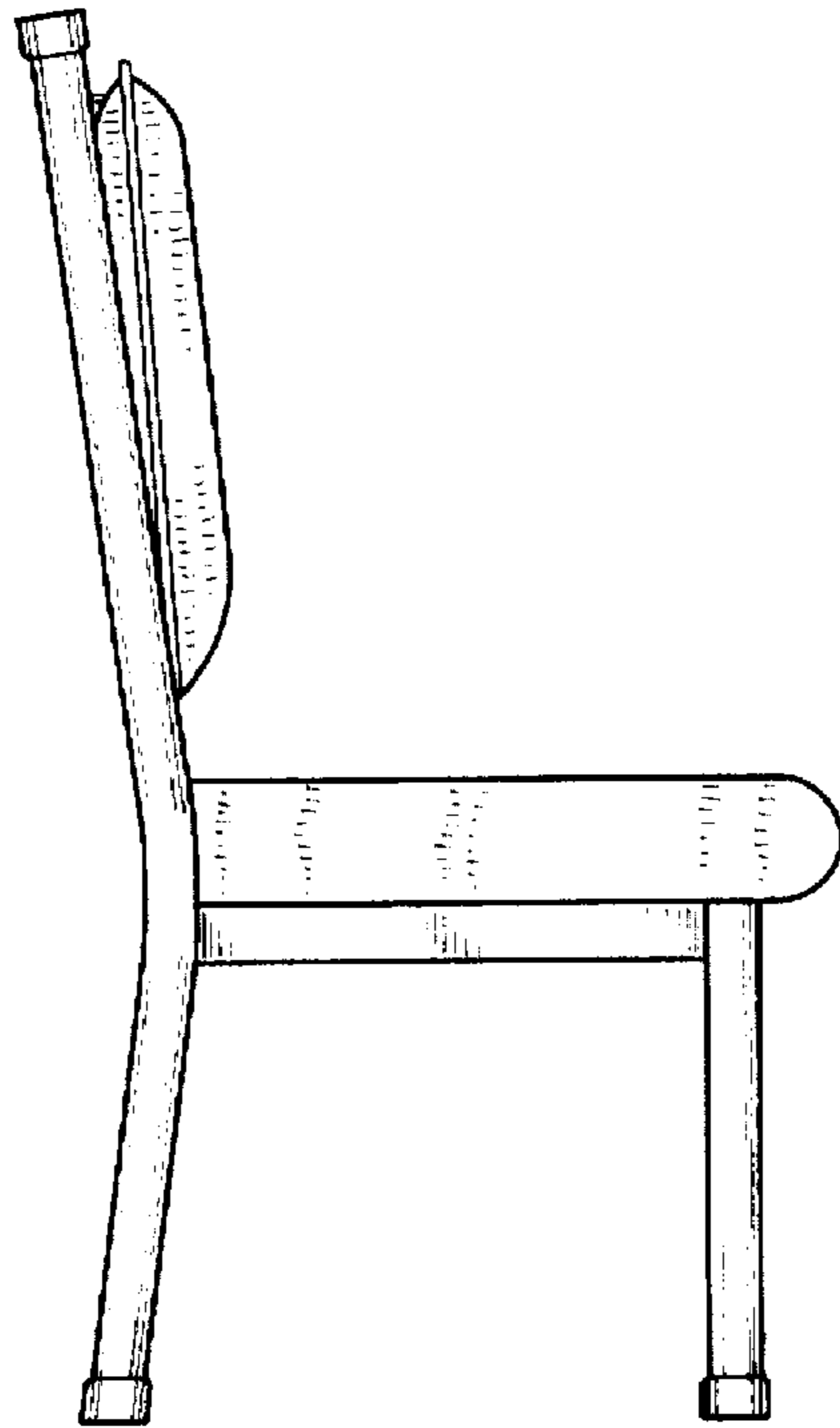

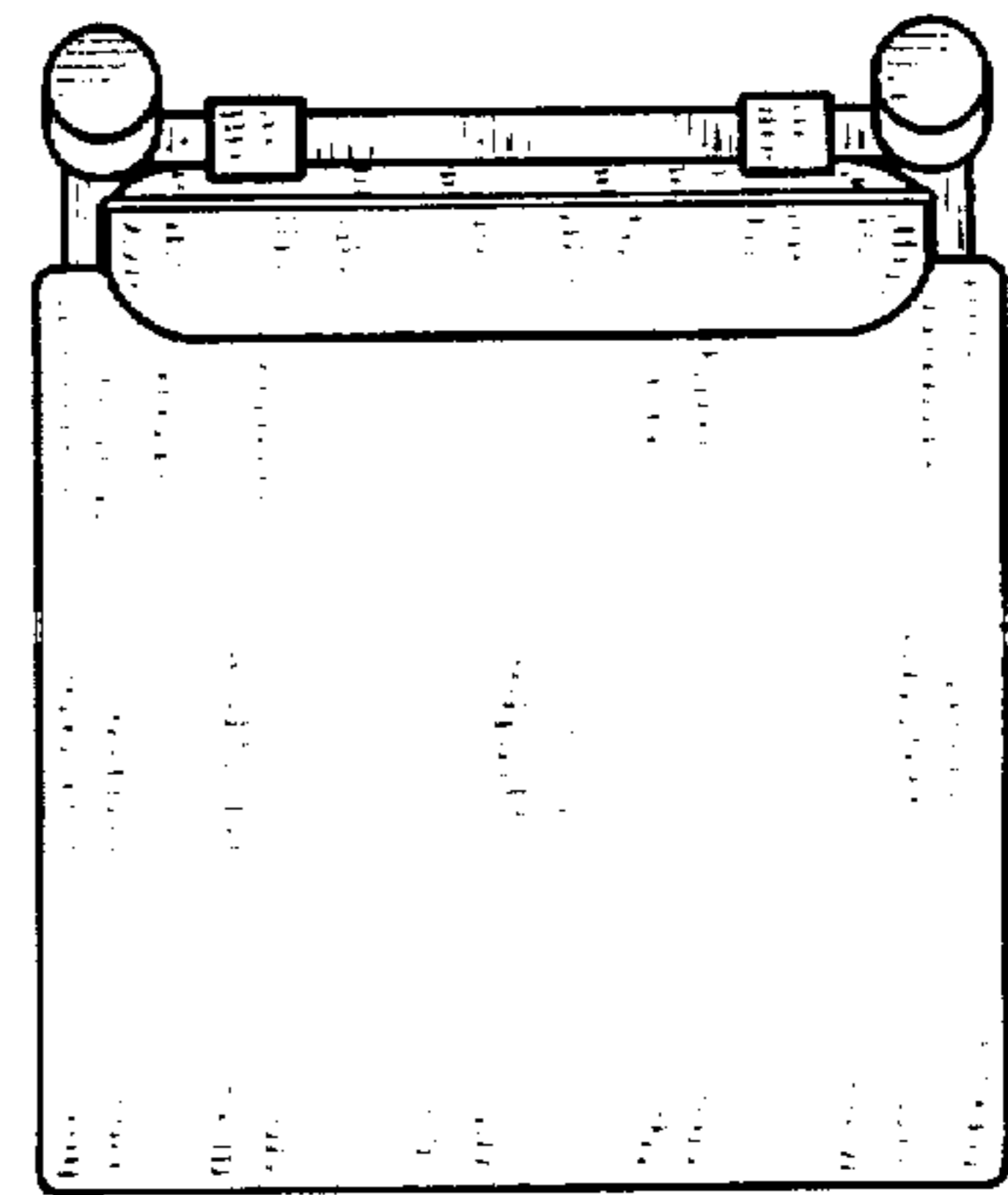

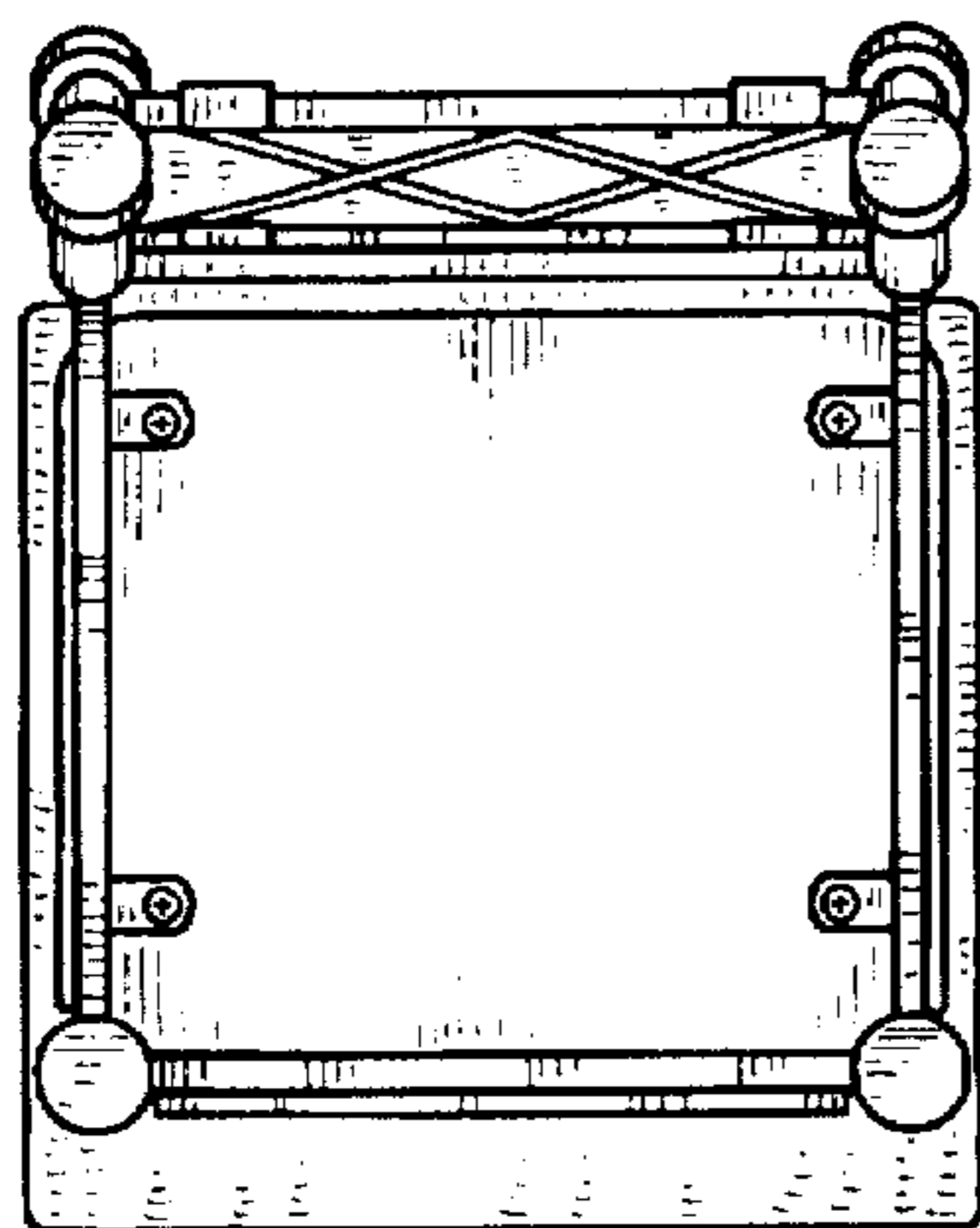
