[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an earring holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an earring holder showing my new design, the broken lines depicting earrings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged sectional view taken on the line 7—7 of FIG. 3; and.

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1, the only difference residing in the length of the article.

The left side elevation is a mirror image of the right side.

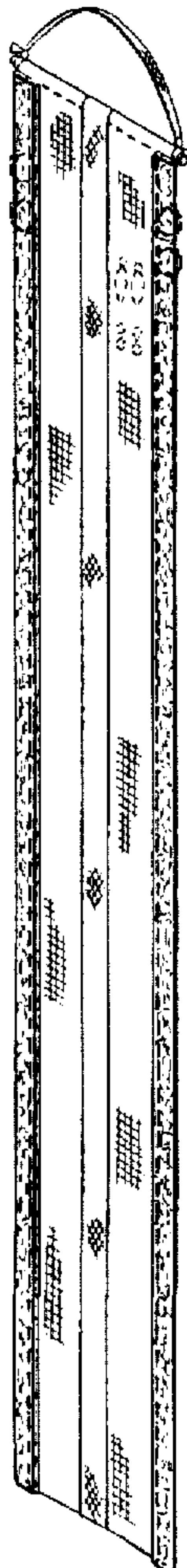

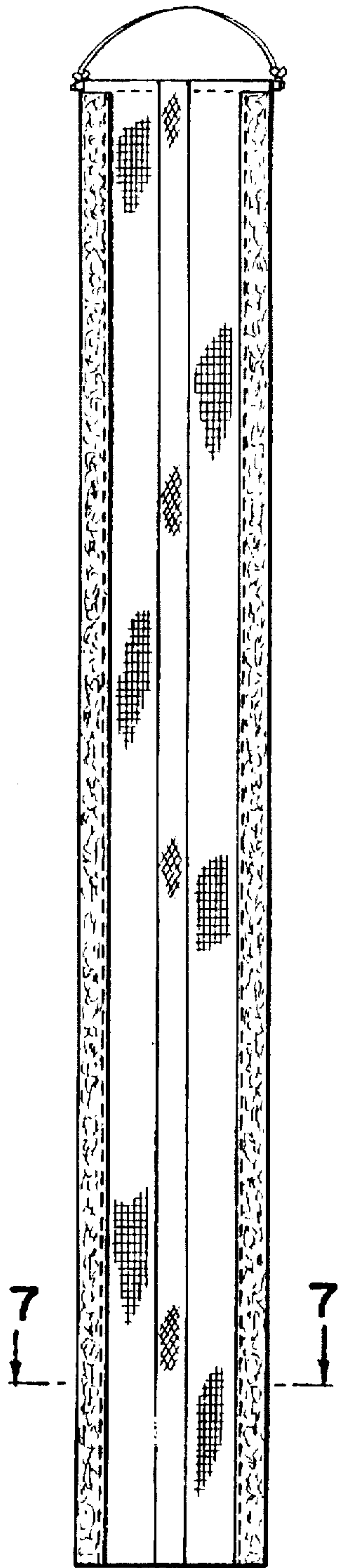
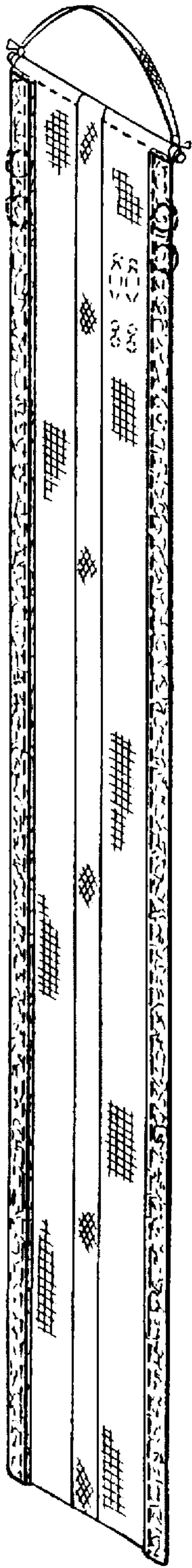

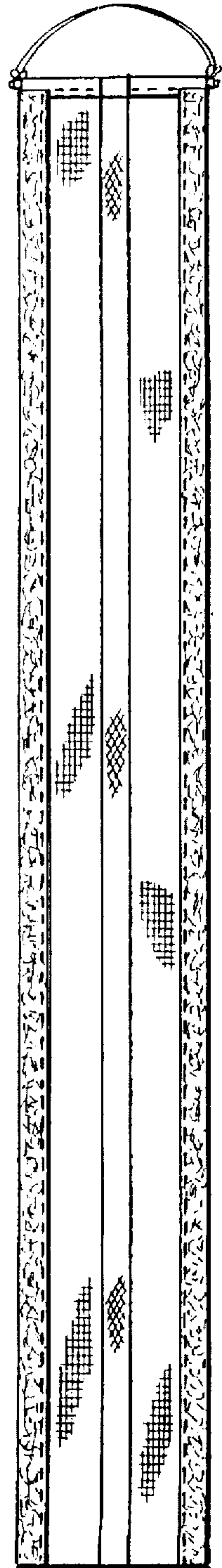

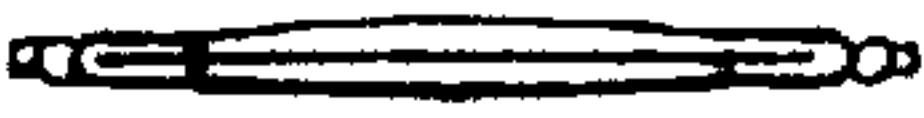

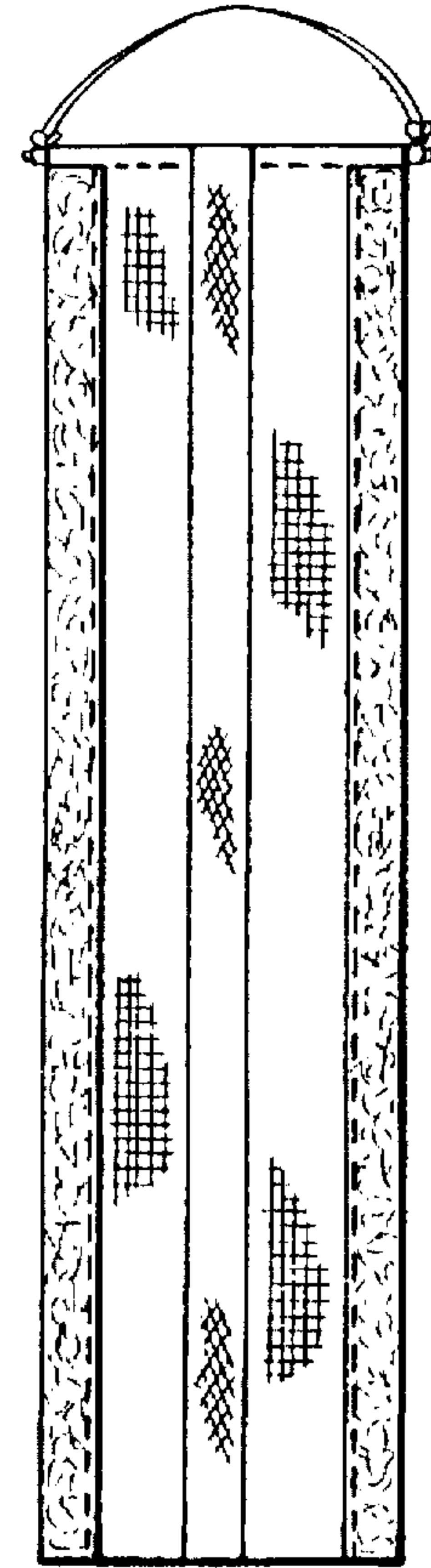
