FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wire shower caddy showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

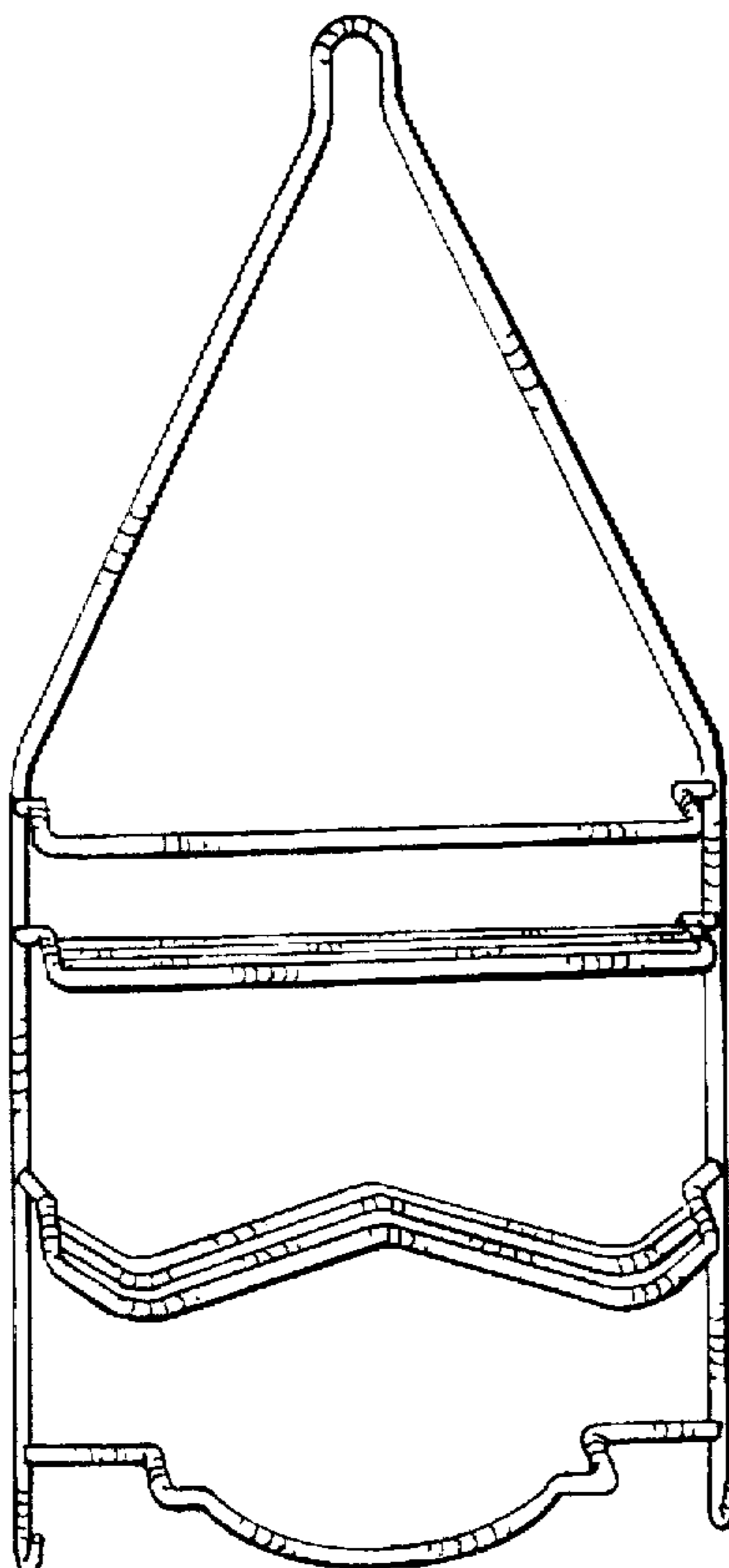
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;

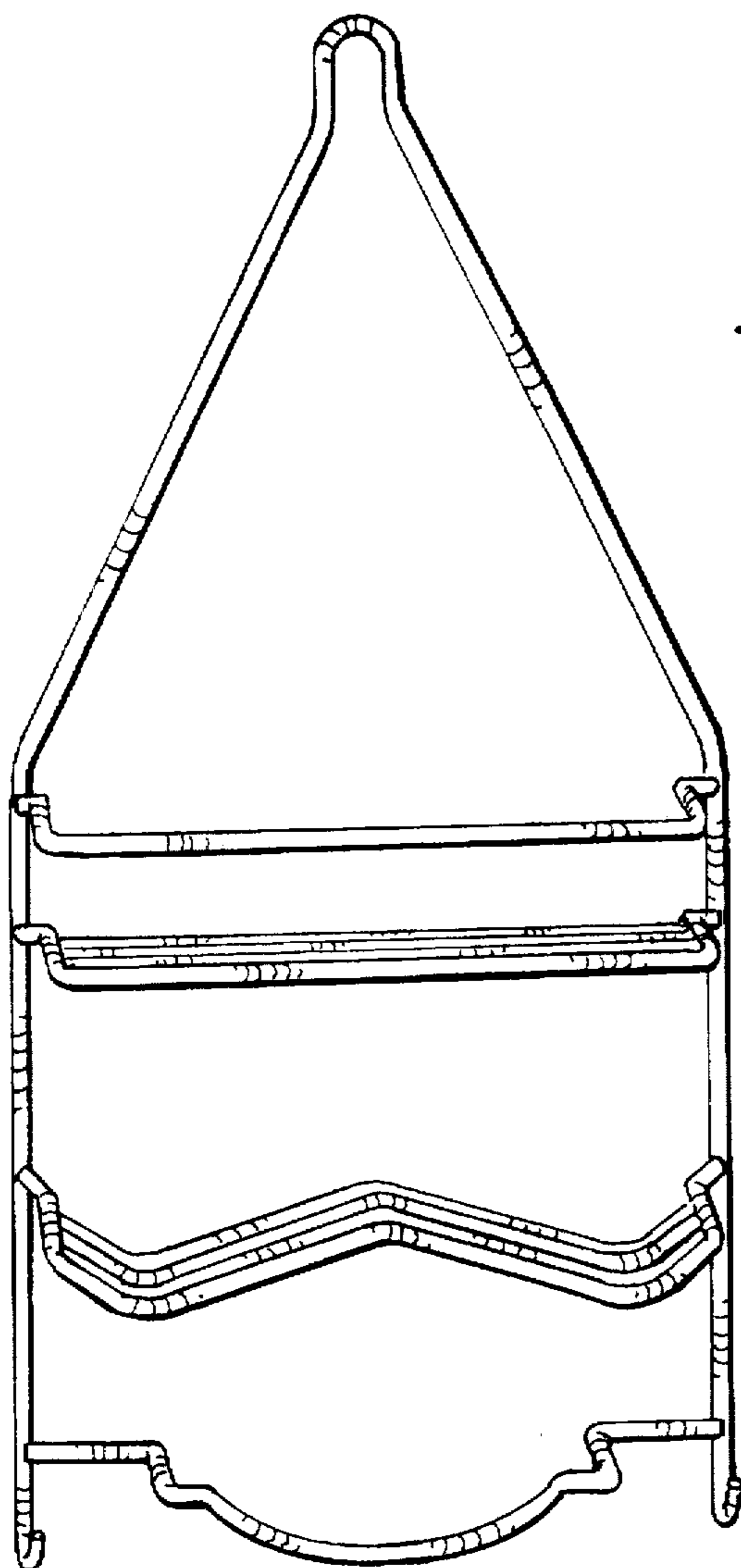

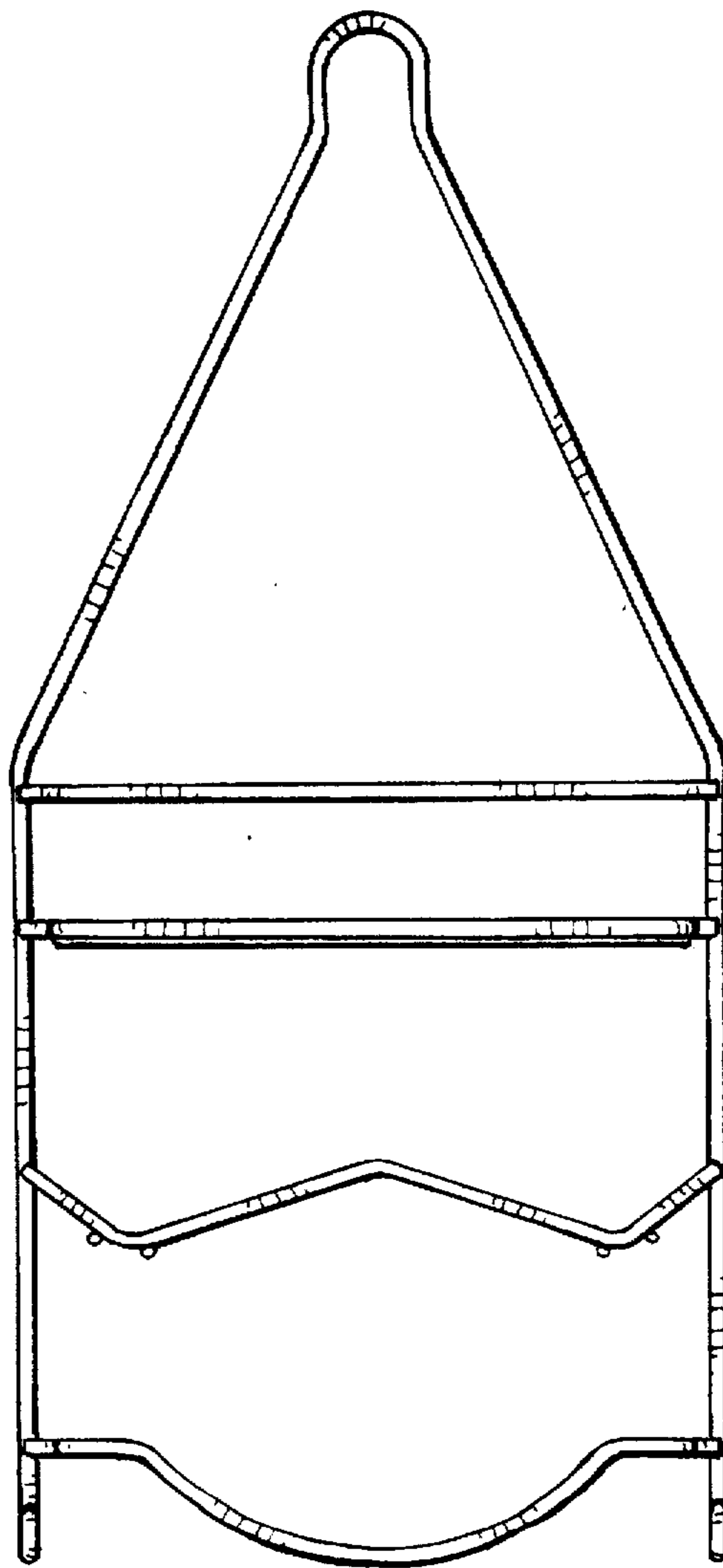

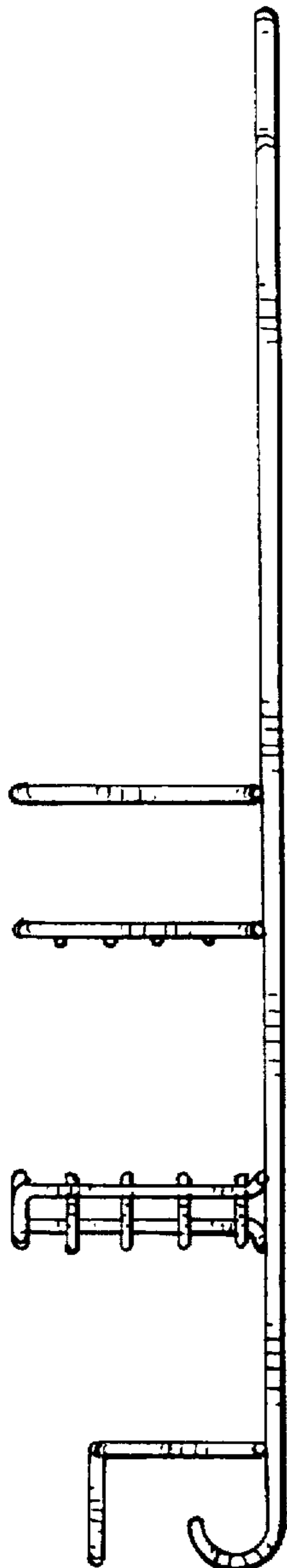
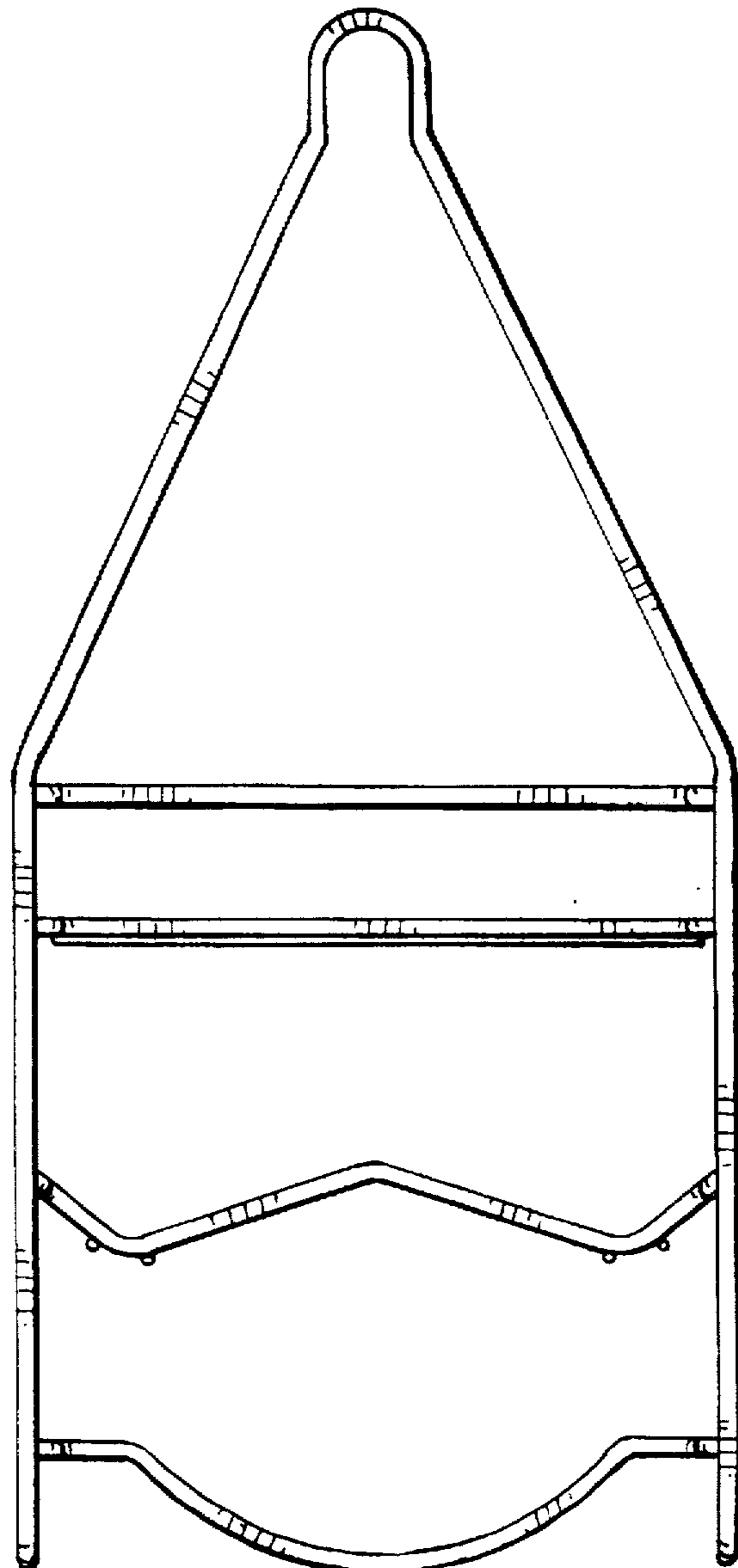

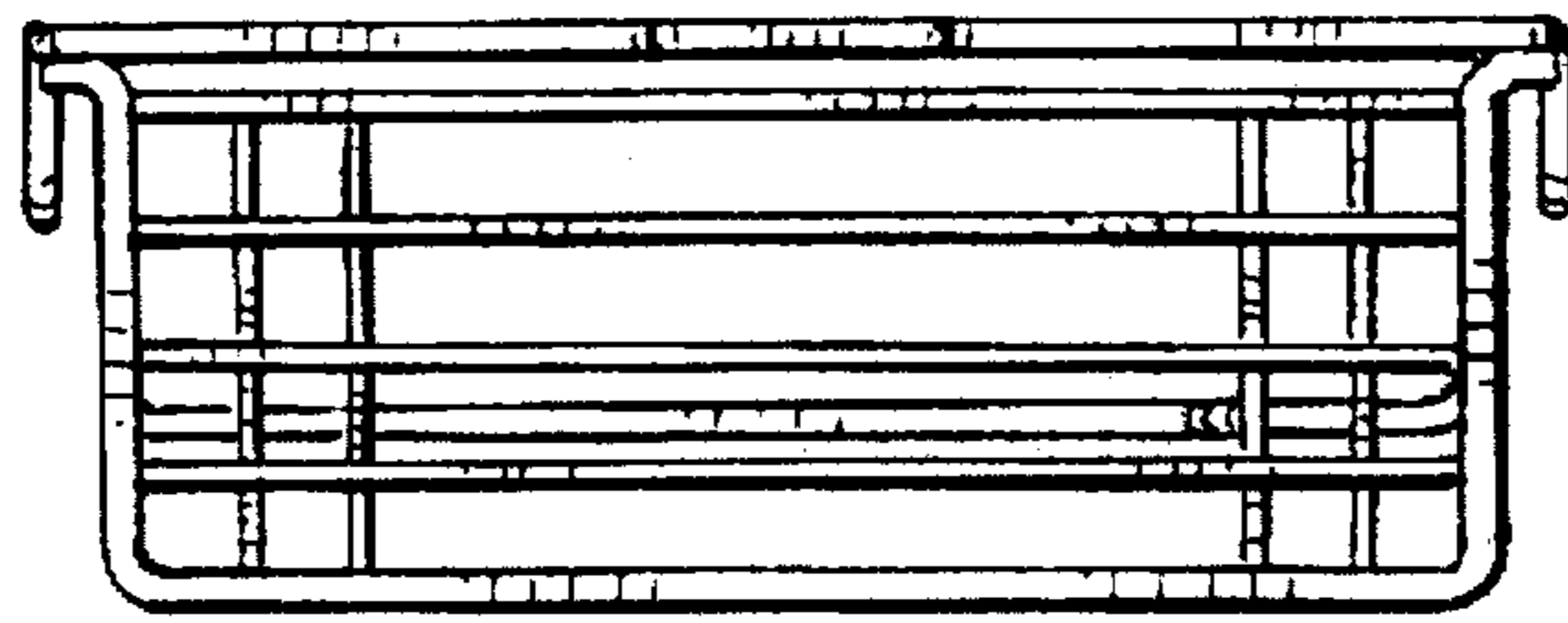

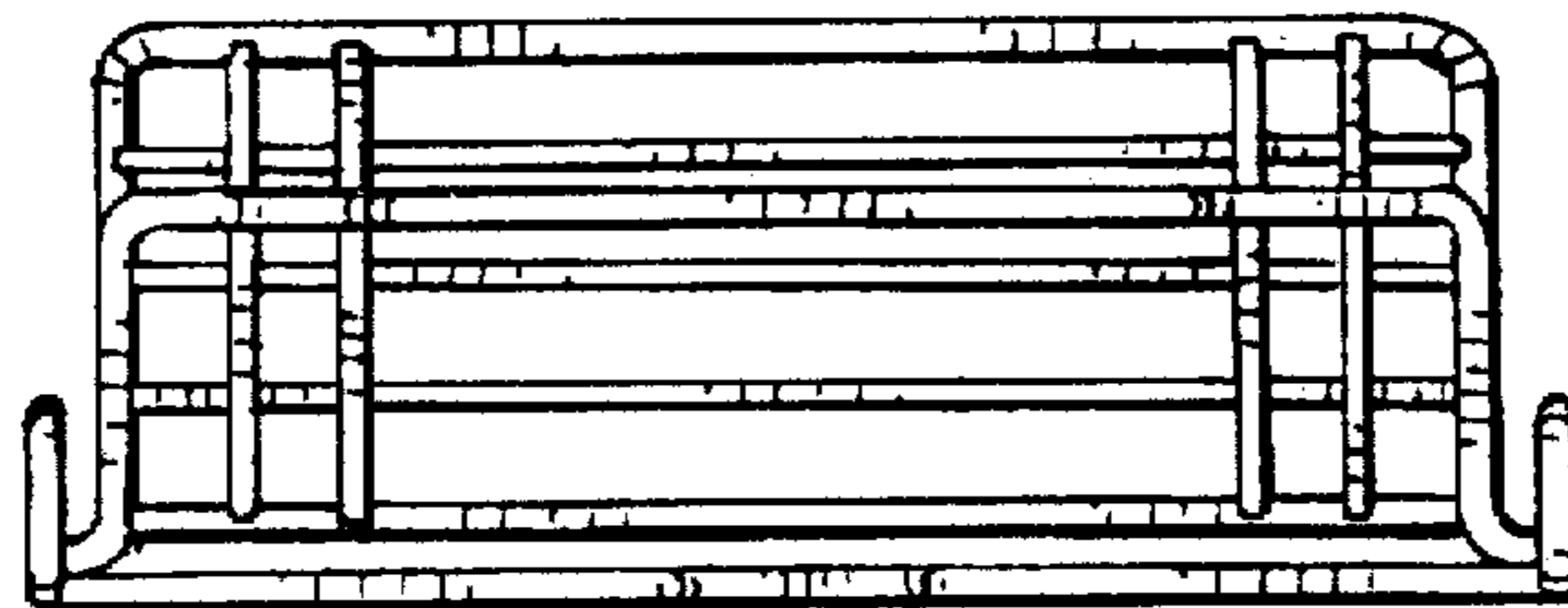
